QUATORZE EN PRIX DU JOCKEY CLUB

France's premier Classic, Sunday's G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly, sees six home-trained colts take on eight from foreign soil. The home team is headed by Sheikh Hamdan's Kutub (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), trained by Freddy Head. Winner of the G2 Prix Noailles in April, the bay was second in the May 14 G1 Prix Lupin last time out. Racing Manager Angus Gold reported, "He has done fine since the Prix Lupin. Freddy worked him on Tuesday morning and was very happy with him. Personally I was very disappointed with him in the Lupin, as he didn't run the same race as he had first time out, for whatever reason. Nothing physical came to light afterwards, but he never changed gear last time. I am hopeful that he performs on Sunday like he did in the Prix Noailles, where I was very impressed with him." Ireland will be represented by Aidan O'Brien's Ciro (Woodman), three-quarter length winner of the Prix Lupin, and Dermot Weld's Muakaad, third in the May 14 G3 Derrinstown Derby Trial at Leopardstown. Of the latter, Gold said, "Dermot feels he has come on a lot since he was beaten by two good horses last time, where the fast ground didn't really suit him. He feels he is a worthy contender." The six-strong English contingent include two from Godolphin--Listed Predominate S. winner Roscius (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Broche (Summer Squall), a conditions winner at Doncaster May 27.

DETTORI UNDERGOES SURGERY

Jockey Frankie Dettori, injured in Thursday's plane crash which claimed the life of pilot Patrick Mackey, underwent surgery on his fractured right ankle yesterday. "They are taking Frankie into the [operating] theatre now," Dettori's business agent Peter Burrell told PA News. "The surgeon wants to clean some muck out of there and then insert two screws. Then hopefully he will be out [of the hospital] within 24 hours." Dettori, 29, is expected to be out of action for two-to-three months. He and Ray Cochrane, 42, who suffered burns and bruising to his face and chest but was reported to be resting comfortably vesterday, issued a statement which said, in part, "We feel so lucky to be alive. Patrick did a fantastic job and we're sure that without his skill, the plane would have hit the dyke and we would have been killed for sure. We would both like to extend our sympathies to his family and assure them that we owe our lives to his skill and courage."

Former handicapper Skip stepped up in class to win the Listed R+V/VTV Sprint-Pokal in Munich May 7 and took a further step up the ladder here, but was somewhat fortunate to do so. Last year's G1 Middle Park S. winner Primo Valentino (Ire) (Primo Dominie {GB}), seventh in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas May 6, was made the 16-10 favourite and swept to the lead from the start, setting a strong pace, but coming back to the field early in the straight. Tertullian raced through to grab the lead and looked the probable winner, but jockey Terence Hellier eased up on him a shade too soon and he was caught on the wire by both Skip and Super Lover.

Running Stag attempted to make all the running in last year's renewal of the MassCap, but was caught near the wire by Behrens for a half-length loss. With Behrens missing this race due to a stone bruise, Running Stag will be able to breathe a bit easier. "I think it would have been a very neat race," said trainer Phil Mitchell after Behrens' defection. "I know my guy is better than last year, and we still would have made a few alterations." The world-travelling Running Stag prepped for this effort with an impressive allowance score at Belmont May 24. Lightly raced David attempted to take the GII San Bernardino H. Apr. 9 from the start, but fell short by just a head to Early Pioneer, with General Challenge finishing 2 1/2 lengths further back in third. The handsome chestnut has been training strongly at Belmont since that outing and is expected to come out of the gate running. "We'll win or lose on the front end," remarked trainer Mike Hushion. "He's a one-dimensional horse. That's one of the reasons we chose this race, because it looked like there were no horses that could run with him early."

The filly Seltitude, 1 1/2 lengths back in third that day, has the potential to turn the tables. She was handing 10 pounds to Watching last time, but is six pounds better off here. She was also making her seasonal debut and did not get a clear run in the closing stages.

Chavez Thrown:

Jockey Jorge Chavez, last year' Eclipse Award winner, was thrown from his mount St. Florene (St. Jovite) in yesterday's second race at Belmont Park. Chavez was treated and released, suffering only some bruises. "Everything is OK, Jorge is fine," said his agent Richard DePass. "Jorge is sore, there's no mistake about that. Whether he rides or not tomorrow [Saturday] will strictly be his decision." St. Florene, making her first career start for trainer H. James Bond, suffered a compound fracture of the right front medial condyle bone and was humanely destroyed. Chavez was scheduled to ride Pleasant Breeze in today's MassCap at Suffolk Downs, also for trainer Bond.

Fans Vote for New York Champions:

New York racing fans voted for the century's top horses, trainers and jockeys in New York on nominees selected by racing historians and experts. Horses were divided first by gender, then into four 25-year quarters. For the period of 1900-1924, Man O'War and Regret took home the honors; for 1925-1949, Citation and Top Flight were voted the best; for 1950-1974, Secretariat and Ruffian led the balloting; and for 1975-1999, Seattle Slew and Personal Ensign received the greatest number of votes. The human categories were divided into two 50-year periods. For 1900-1949, "Sunny Jim" Fitzsimmons was the top trainer while Eddie Arcaro was voted leading jockey. For 1950-1999, Woody Stephens led the voting among trainers while Bill Shoemaker topped the list of jockeys.
