GOOD AS GOLD

They don't get much better. Heritage Of Gold (Gold Legend), sent off the 9-10 favorite in yesterday's GIII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill Downs, put away pacesetter Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) in the final furlong and cruised away to a four-length score to remain undefeated on the year. "This was no fluke today," jockey Shane Sellers said. "As an older mare, she has come into herself." Now five, Heritage Of Gold was six-for-10 last year, winning the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. on the main track and the GII Diana H. on the turf. She ended the season with a third-place finish behind Beautiful Pleasure and Banshee Breeze in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but no one has been able to beat her this year. Off for 4 1/2 months, the blaze-faced bay returned to take the Mar. 19 GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup S. and then the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom H. She ran into a favored Silverbulletday in her latest, the May 5 GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H., and posted yet another win depite a six-wide trip as the crowd's choice faded to fourth. Odds-on to add to her resume vesterday, she sat second while Silverbulletday set moderate fractions, was floated wide on the first turn and again as they raced into the stretch, but had little trouble taking over the lead en route to her fourth straight. The mare could get a rematch with Beautiful Pleasure in her next start, the July 30 GI Go For Wand S. at Saratoga.

French Derby cont.

Kutub and Ciro renew their rivalry for the third time this season and will likely vie for favouritism in today's G1 Emirates Airline Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly. Kutub won their first encounter impressively when beating Lord Flasheart and Ciro in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp Apr. 23. Ciro, winner of last year's G1 Grand Criterium, reversed placings with different tactics when he and Kutub next met in the G1 Prix Lupin at the same track May 14. But the pace of that race was not to Kutub's liking, although Ciro was a game and deserving winner. The extra distance today will be to Kutub's advantage and it will be no surprise to see placings reversed once more. Lord Flasheart, bound for the United States after this, comes into the equation on his Greffulhe run and gave the form a boost on his only subsequent outing when a battling winner of the G2 Prix Hocquart at Chantilly May 8. He has solid place claims for his European swansong. Holding Court, a FF250,000 supplementary entry, is another worthy of consideration based on his recent form. By a French Derby winner, he was a very impressive winner of the G3 Prix la Force at Longchamp May 18. That trial has been a useful pointer in recent years, with Dream Well (Fr) going on to win the Derby in 1998 and Nowhere To Exit (GB) finishing runner-up last year. All carry 128 pounds. *Odds by Victor Chandler.

Giovana, who missed 14 months after being blinded in one eye earlier in her career, was looking for her first Group win after finishing on the board in a pair of Group races in New Zealand this season, but as far as jockey Chris Munce was concerned, "She was half-pace all the way and I never felt like she was going to lose." New Zealand trainer Roger James is unsure whether the filly will head into next week's G1 Queensland Derby at Eagle Farm. "She hasn't had a hard run today and I think we might, but I'll wait and see how she is during the week," James said.

A game Reenact recorded a poignant win for his owners Geoff and Beryl White, carrying the same colours as his 20-year-old sire Marscay, who died three weeks ago following complications from surgery for colic. The late stallion picked up his 13th individual Group 1 winner with this sensational last-to-first victory. Despite drawing the extreme outside barrier in the 17-horse field, jockey Gavan Duffy was confident Reenact had the necessary class to win. "I knew he'd get a long way back from the alley, but I wasn't worried because I knew I was on the best horse," the jockey, who ditched his nascent training career to return to the saddle, told Australian Associated Press. "In the straight he was coming so quickly I knew he had it won even though he was a fair way off them." Geoff White believes the colt is poised to become Marscay's second Derby winner. "It's pretty obvious the way he gets to the line he's going to run a mile and a half at least," White said.

Globetrotting Running Stag, runner-up in this race last year, went on to an impressive success in the GII Brooklyn H., shipped to England to be fifth in the G1 Eclipse S., then returned to New York to win the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. and run fourth in the GI Woodward S. He headed back across the Atlantic for his next outing, running second in a conditions race at Lingfield, and finally flew to Sha Tin to run second in his 1999 finale, the G1 Hong Kong Cup. The United Arab Emirates was next on the itinerary, with another second in an allowance race before a seventh-place effort in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai World Cup. The bay came back to the States this spring and picked up a Belmont Park allowance score May 24. Sent off the MassCap favorite after the defection of Behrens, he tracked David through honest fractions, came with his challenge as they raced out of the turn and proved best. "I thought from the day I bought him that he was very special," trainer Philip Mitchell said. "I got such a buzz when I saw him. He's done everything I thought he would do. Who knows where this guy can go." Added jockey John Velazquez, who picked up the mount when Shane Sellers opted to stick with Heritage Of Gold, "I rode him about a year and a half ago and he was very green. He was just never completely focused on what he was supposed to do. He's a much more mature horse this year. He knows what he's supposed to do and he showed it today." While plans for the winner were not announced, trainer Richard Mandella said of his late-running runner-up Out Of Mind, "The horse ran a terrific race. We may have to supplement him to the [July 9] Hollywood Gold Cup."

Winner of the G2 Blanford S. in Ireland in her final start at three, Lisieux Rose was winless in five starts last season, ending the campaign with a third-place effort in her attempt to repeat in the Blanford. She made her U.S. bow after a 5 1/2-month lavoff and was all out to take the GII Orchid H. at Gulfstream Mar. 5. The second choice to make it two in a row after the threemonth break, the chestnut mare was sent right to the lead, set a slow pace on a clear lead, turned back the challenge of stablemate Orange Sunset (Roanoke) after a mile and drove home a decisive winner. "There wasn't a lot of speed on paper and the plan was to slow it down as much as possible," winning rider Jose Santos said. "When her stablemate came to her... I gave her a little more and she responded and drew off." The fiveyear-old will point for the GII New York H. July 15.

Having finished sixth behind Watching, Seltitude and Terroir (Ire) (Fairy King) in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 14, Nuclear Debate was allowed to start at relatively long odds. He belied those odds to grab the lead in the closing stages for a belated first Group 2 win. Watching broke well to dispute the lead with Continent (GB) (Lake Coniston {Ire}), but that pair where upstaged as Seltitude went to the front at halfway. Nuclear Debate was reserved in rear, but moved up with two furlongs to run. As the field approached the final furlong Watching, Seltitude and Nuclear Debate were almost neck and neck and it was Nuclear Debate who went to the front inside the final furlong. The winner will now point to either the G2 King's Stand S. over five furlongs June 20 or the six-furlong G2 Cork & Orrery S. June 22; both are run at the Royal Ascot meet.

Unraced at two, Heliotrope captured the Ontario Colleen S. and a Keeneland allowance race at three, but saw her 1999 campaign end prematurely after a sixth-place finish in the Jan. 31 Super Bowl S. on the turf at Gulfstream Park. She came back after nearly 16 months on the shelf and finished fourth in an allowance at Woodbine May 20. Ignored in her second start off the layoff, the Kentucky-bred bay battled on the front end from the break, shook clear at the top of the lane and was stretched to the limit to hang on and take the tight three-way photo. A total of 314 weanlings will be offered today, with a further 20 to go through the ring Monday. The first 27 mares in the dispersal draft of Australian Commercial Industries, a company formed by George Hofmeister when he purchased Segenhoe Stud (now Vinery Australia) in 1998, will also be sold Monday. There will be 853 mares on offer over the last three days of the sale. The sale had previously been held immediately following Inglis' Easter Sale, but its repositioning has provided the auction with extra exposure. With the move, the weanling catalogue has doubled, vendors have had more time to prepare their drafts and the catalogue has attracted more attention generally. Moreover, the later date has enabled buyers to have a glimpse at the efforts of first-crop progeny by shuttle sires such as Gold Fever, whose American Grade III winner Gold Mover has not gone unnoticed. Thirteen mares in foal to Gold Fever have been catalogued. Also offered during the sale will be the first Southern Hemisphere weanlings by shuttlers King Of Kings (Ire), Timber Country, Entrepreneur (GB), Spinning World, Desert King (Ire) and Fujikiseki (Jpn). From the broodmare offering, La Rose Noir (Aus) (Centaine {Aus}), in foal to Zabeel, (Lot 671); maiden mare Zastov (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) (Lot 670); and Flight To Fantasy (Aus) (Bluebird) (Lot 748), in foal to End Sweep, are expected to figure prominently. A total of 15 mares in foal to Flying Spur (Aus), eight in foal to Zabeel (NZ), seven to Danehill and 10 to Marscay (Aus) will also be sought after. First Southern Hemisphere season or freshman stallions represented by mares in foal include Distorted Humor, End Sweep, Favorite Trick, Gilded Time, Peintre Celebre, Red Ransom and Sandpit (Brz). A total of 502 mares sold last year for almost A\$23.5 million, while 125 weanlings sold for A\$2.9 million. A Baramul Stud dispersal brought the overall gross to A\$28.5 million.

SPINNING WORLD TO WINDSOR PARK GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Spinning World (Nureyev-Imperfect Circle, by Riverman) will stand at Windsor Park Stud in Cambridge, New Zealand, relocating from Coolmore NSW for the Southern Hemisphere season. Intikhab (Red Ransom) was scheduled to stand at Windsor Park before suffering an injury. Studmaster Nelson Schick says he is more than pleased with Intikhab's replacement. The five-time Group 1 winner stood his first season at Coolmore in 1998 at A\$50,000 and his first crop foals have averaged A\$228,802.

AUSTRALIA CHANGES BIRTHDAY RULE

The much-debated rule regarding the date a foal is considered to be one year old has been updated following an Australian Racing Board meeting Monday. In the past, a foal born in late July was automatically deemed a yearling only days later while one born Aug. 1 or after was deemed to turn one the following year. Under the new rule, even if a foal is born before Aug. 1, it will not be considered a yearling until Aug. 1 of the following year, provided the dam was first covered on or after Sept. 1 of the previous year. If the mare was bred before Sept. 1, the resulting foal's first year of life will be deemed to begin on Aug. 1 of the year it was conceived. To enforce the new rule, stallion owners will have to sign a memorandum of understanding and suspicious returns will be investigated, with severe penalties for breeders who state their mares were covered in September when it was really August.
