HOLDING COURT AT CHANTILLY

Supplemented only this past Wednesday, Holding Court (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) produced a stunning frontrunning display to claim yesterday's Prix du Jockey Club and emulate his sire, who won the Classic in 1994. Unplaced in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in September, Holding Court returned to take a Haydock handicap event Apr. 22 by 3 1/2 lengths before an allthe-way success in the G3 Prix la Force at Longchamp May 18. The bay was slowly away from the stalls yesterday, but quickly made up ground to go to the head of affairs after a furlong of racing. He continued in this manner until, with no obvious challengers appearing from behind, his jockey stole a healthy and decisive four-length lead rounding the final turn. As Ciro (Woodman) looked one-paced and the favourite Kutub (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}) did not quicken in the manner expected from behind, Holding Court had the race to himself, and, lengthening away in the straight, he extended his lead with a powerful run. Only Lord Flasheart (Blush Rambler) could attempt to close the gap, but he had no chance to get to the winner. Michael Jarvis, whose finest success in France came at Longchamp in 1989 with Carroll House (Ire), has had to wait until now for his first major Classic success, and was delighted. "He showed a lot at home this spring, and we thought that the Prix La Force was the ideal Derby trial," Jarvis said. "We didn't hesitate to supplement here as we thought, even though we prefer winning at Epsom, that Chantilly was ideal for him. [Jockey] Philip [Robinson] said he wanted to get him over to the fence as soon as possible as he loves something to run against. He has so much speed on this easy ground, and he just burns the others off." As far as future plans are concerned, Jarvis commented, "I suppose we will have to supplement him for the Irish Derby (The Curragh, July 2) as there is a £1 million bonus on offer there, but I will have to discuss it with Mr. Good. If he doesn't run there, we will go for the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [Ascot, July 29]. He is not entered in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Longchamp, Oct. 1]." Robinson added, "You never know you have won a race until you cross the finishing line, but I felt pretty confident turning for home as I had plenty of horse left and I saw nothing coming to me." Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said of the runner-up, "My horse is consistent and has never ran a bad race. He gave his best again today and was beaten by a better horse."

FUSAICHI PEGASUS OUT OF BELMONT

Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector) suffered a minor injury in his stall Saturday afternoon which will keep him from running in the third leg of the Triple Crown, the June 10 GI Belmont S. Second in the GI Preakness last time out, the colt gouged a small chunk out of the hoof wall on his right front foot. "At 2 o'clock [Saturday] afternoon, he was asleep at the back of his stall," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "A noise startled him and he rushed to the front of his stall, slipped and caught his right front hoof on the door. He gouged a small piece the size of a dime out of the side of his hoof." While the injury did not cause Fusaichi Pegasus to become lame, Drysdale has decided to skip the Belmont anyway. "There is no soreness," he said, "but he couldn't work [Sunday] and we want to preclude further injury. He will ship to California on Tuesday and he should be able to resume training in about four or five days." As for what's next, Drysdale said, "We haven't made any future plans yet. I will talk to [owner Fusao Sekiguchi], who is obviously disappointed that we will not be able to run in the Belmont, and map out a campaign for the rest of the year." As Preakness winner Red Bullet (Unbridled) will also bypass the race, this marks the first time since 1970 that neither the Derby nor the Preakness winner will compete in the Belmont.

Aptitude Works:

Aptitude (A.P. Indy) worked six furlongs yesterday at Hollywood Park in 1:15 1/5 under jockey Alex Solis. The Bobby Frankel trainee worked in company with Mojave Moon (Mr. Prospector), undefeated in two U.S. starts and aiming for his stakes debut in the June 11 GII Californian. "He worked fine, finished real strong," Frankel said of the Derby runner-up. "I didn't want him to do too much; he didn't need much. He gallops strongly every day." *Triple Threats cont. p.* 5

Australian-bred Fairy King Prawn gave trainer Ivan Allan his first Japanese Group 1 success from four tries, coming from off the pace to win the Yasuda Memorial at Tokyo yesterday. Restrained towards the back of the pack as the leaders set fast fractions, jockey Robbie Fradd called upon the five-year-old with 400 meters to run and he responded to get clear late for the victory. Godolphin invader Diktat, sixth in the Keio Hai Spring Cup last out, finished well to secure the place spot. Jockey Daragh O'Donohoe, on the runner-up, said, "When we turned for the final stretch, he (Diktat) was forced to run where the ground was blotchy. I'm not afraid to say that if we raced on easier ground, we could have taken the winner."

The lightly raced Astra, beaten only once in her first six starts, won the Apr. 13 GIII Jenny Wiley at Keeneland in her only other trip to the post this year. The bay filly settled in behind the early leaders as Tout Charmant led just ahead of Happyanunoit and Sweet Ludy (Ire) (Be My Guest). GI Matriarch winner Happyanunoit took over in upper stretch but could not hold off the powerful late kick of Astra, who drove to a half-length victory. "You never really know how they will react until you get them in the paddock, but today, she was a standout," said winning trainer Simon Bray. "And she ran absolutely great. It was a huge race and now we know she can run against the best." About the winning filly, rider Kent Desormeaux added, "She's built very well and she's a very powerful filly. And give Simon Bray a lot of credit because he had her breathing fire today."

PRIX JEAN PRAT EMIRATES AIRLINE-G1 results cont.

The Spanish-trained Suances created a big enough impression when taking the G3 Prix de Guiche at Longchamp May 18 to attract the interest of Jed Cohen's Red Baron's barn, who subsequently purchased the colt. This was scheduled to be his European swansong before being shipped off to California to begin the rest of his racing career, but his highly impressive Group 1 victory may convince connections to continue a European campaign. Settled in fourth on the rail early as Three Points set a steady pace from the Godolphin challenger Pacino and the Ballydovle representative Bach, his jockey allowed him to coast along until, with three furlongs to run, he switched him to the outside and asked for his effort. He travelled easily alongside Pacino, who had gone to the front, before quickening away in a matter of strides to go clear inside the final two furlongs. Hubert Guy, the French Bloodstock Agent who acted in the sale, said, "We are extremely pleased with this success and all tributes go to the trainer who has done a sensational job with this horse. The colt is supposed to leave for the United States soon, but we will talk to the owner and see if he would consider leaving him in France for one more race, the G1 Grand Prix de Paris Longchamp June 25."

Injury curtailed Silvano's three-year-old season after he had won the G2 Oppenheim-Colonia Union Rennen and then finished fourth in both the G1 Deutsches Derby and the G1 Deutschland-Preis. On his first start back this year he was four-length runner-up to Catella in the G2 Gerling-Preis in Cologne Apr. 30, but gained handsome revenge on the filly here. Laveron was the reluctant leader at a moderate pace, followed by Catella and Silvano. Swinging into the straight, Catella quickened into the lead, but Silvano was soon on terms with her and the two raced neck and neck to the furlong marker where Silvano took command and raced away for an easy win, with Flamingo Road a never-threatening third.

Allowed to settle early, the dark bay filly moved up four wide turning for home, took charge with a furlong to run and outbattled Trip to the wire. "Momentum carried her to the lead and she lived up to her ability," said winning jockey Pat Day.

Zarkiya had looked unlucky when finishing fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 14, having been blocked repeatedly when trying to unleash a run which saw her finish in front shortly after the post. She had previously been runner-up to Devon Heights in the Listed Prix d'Angerville here Apr. 28, and this race gave her an opportunity to claim the Group race victory that she undoubtedly deserved. She was brought with a perfectly timed late rattle to win here in a show of masterly horsemanship from Gerald Mosse. Held up at the back early as first Devon Heights, and then Starine (Fr) (Mendocino) took the field along, Mosse made a steady move on the outer turning for home, and he looked to be cruising with two furlongs remaining as Devon Heights regained the lead up front. When her jockey let her down soon after, she made up the ground guickly, plunging for the line as Penny's Gold mastered Devon Heights, to pass them both in the dying strides. His Highness The Aga Khan said, "She is a very nice filly and she deserved to win it. We had hesitated to run her in the race as it came only three weeks after the French Guineas and now it's again only three weeks until the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 23. But we are always prepared to run in a good race in England with the right horse and if she is fine, she might very well run there next."

INGLIS SALE OFF TO GOOD START

A weanling filly by Zabeel (NZ) brought A\$165,000 to top the opening session of the Australian Weanling and Broodmare Sale at Newmarket, Sydney yesterday. Out of stakes-winning Rampage Queen (NZ) (Wild Rampage), the bay, catalogued as lot 300, was purchased by Glemel Pty Ltd. from the consignment of Widden Stud, agent. A colt from the first crop of Langfuhr out of Sharpatan (Diesis {GB}) was responsible for the afternoon's second-highest priced offering. The half brother to Group 1 winning two-year-old Isolda (Sir Tristram {Ire}) was knocked down for \$120,000 to the bid of Chatham Lodge of New Zealand. The chestnut was consigned to the sale by Coolmore Australia as agent. Also sold for \$120,000 was hip number 29, a colt by Zabeel (NZ) out of Star (Danehill). The bay was consigned to the sale by Philippa Duncan Bloodstock Pty Ltd. and was successfully bid on by William Inglis, agent. Gross receipts for 230 lots sold were \$5,132,300 for an average of \$22,314. The weanling portion of the sale concludes this morning with an additional 19 lots on offer as part of the Australian Commercial Industries dispersal, to be followed by select broodmare lot numbers 28 to 272. Bidding commences at 10:00 a.m.

MCCARRON BOOKED TO EPSOM

The services of American jockey Chris McCarron have been enlisted by Godolphin for a cache of races during the Epsom Derby meeting this coming weekend, according to the Godolphin website. He will replace the injured Frankie Dettori, who is recovering from injuries sustained in last Thursday's plane crash at Newmarket Racecourse. McCarron is to partner Melikah (Ire) (Lammtarra) in Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks and is named to ride Fantastic Light (Rahy) in the G1 Coronation Cup on the same afternoon. The 45-year-old will get a leg up on Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian) for Saturday's main event, the G1 Epsom Derby, Jockey Jerry Bailey was also given the opportunity to ride in England on the weekend, but is previously engaged to ride Curule (Go For Gin) for Godolphin in Saturday's GI Belmont S.

Postponed (Summer Squall), winner of the GII Peter Pan S., went a half mile in :47 over the Belmont Park main track. "He was a little sharper than we expected," Randy Schulhofer, son and assistant to trainer Scotty Schulhofer, said. Globalize (Summer Squall), third in the Peter Pan, went six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 2/5 at Belmont. He galloped out seveneighths in 1:26 3/5. Longshot Appearing Now (Demons Begone), who was fifth in the GII Wood Memorial S. in his lone prior graded-stakes try, went six furlongs in 1:14 1/5 at Aqueduct before galloping out seven furlongs in 1:27 and the mile in 1:43.

Australia's highest profile jockey Shane Dye, 33, will take up a one year contract to ride for the Hong Kong Jockey Club next month. Dye has 89 Group 1 wins including eight this season and has made no secret of his aim to topple George Moore's record 119 Group 1 wins. "I am leaving at the top of my game; no-one can dispute I am at the top," Dye told the Sun-Herald. "I will come back; it may be one, two, maybe three years but I will return home. I have much to achieve in Australia." Dye rode the season's best two-year-old Assertive Lad (Zeditave {Aus]) and Tie The Knot (Nassipour) this season. "To leave behind the best two-year-old in the country and a stayer like Tie The Knot made the decision all the more difficult. It is not going to be easy in Hong Kong, competing against the best in the world, but it is a challenge I'm willing to accept." Darren Beadman is likely to ride 10-time Group 1 winner Tie The Knot this spring. Dye has ridden the stayer to nine Group 1 victories. "I will miss Shane, he is a wonderful jockey and a fantastic personality and we've had a great association," said Tie The Knot's owner Sandy Tait. "He will come back an even better rider for the overseas experience and at this stage in his career it is probably the right thing to do and I wish him well." Tie The Knot is due back at Walter's Warwick Farm stable in a fortnight to prepare for another Cox Plate showdown with champion New Zealand mare Sunline who relegated him to second last year. "I wouldn't say he definitely won't run in the Melbourne Cup but it's very unlikely," Tait added.
