INJURY JEOPARDIZES BEST'S DERBY HOPES

Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby may have lost its 11-4 favorite when 2000 Guineas S. winner **King's Best (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}) suffered a recurrence of a muscle injury sustained last week. Joe Mercer, racing manager to King's Best owner Saeed Suhail, said, "I have just spoken to [trainer] Michael [Stoute] and he was not quite satisfied with him this morning. He pulled a little muscle in his quarters last weekend and it could be a recurrence of that. He is having therapy at the moment and we will see how he is in the morning. He will have a canter tomorrow morning and we will see how he is. We will have a word with the owner and make a decision tomorrow morning." After initially removing the Michael Stoute-trained colt from their lists, William Hill reinstated him yesterday afternoon. A statement released by the company stated, "Because of the declaration stage, all bets are now effectively non-runner no bet and therefore, Hills have reverted to their original betting this morning and will take a Rule 4 deduction if King's Best is withdrawn." Amid the uncertainty surrounding King's Best, another 15 three-year-olds were entered in Saturday's classic, including the likely second choice **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who drew post three. After some debate **Barathea Guest (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}), third in the 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 6, was entered Saturday and will line up in the two hole. Speaking on behalf of owner John Guest, Tim Corby, said, "Barathea Guest breezed impressively under Philip Robinson on Wednesday, and he is in great spirit. He will run at Epsom on Saturday."

BAILEY TO RIDE AT ROYAL ASCOT

American champion jockey Jerry Bailey will make his debut appearance at this month's Royal Ascot meeting in England. The rider has been booked to pilot Team Valor and Heiligbrodt Racing Stable's two-year-old filly **Strange Destiny (GB)** (Mujadil) in the June 21 G3 Queen Mary S. Agent Ron Anderson confirmed the assignment yesterday. Purchased by Kentucky-based Team Valor a day after her May 1 debut at Chester, Strange Destiny was a two-length maiden winner at Warwick Sunday.

Henry Cecil has won this race a record six times, with three of those coming in the last four years. Cecil will be represented this year by **Love Divine**, who inherited ante-post favouritism by winning the Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood May 24. Jockey Richard Quinn was in ebullient mood last night as he spoke of his ride on the favourite. "She did it well at Goodwood," he said. "It was only the second start of her career and she will obviously come on for it. She has a lovely temperament, travels, settles and quickens up--everything you ask. She's in great order and you can't fault her." Love Divine will be tested to the full by a competitive field, not least **Kalypso Katie**, who was expertly ridden by Mick Kinane to claim the G3 Musidora S. at York May 16. She had **Lady Upstage** and **Miletrian** behind her that day, but the lack of a convincing early pace there has led to scrutiny of the form. Gerard Butler puts forward **Whitefoot**, who won the Listed Sun Life Of Canada Fillies' Trial at Newbury May 19, having previously finished fourth in the G3 Classic Trial at Sandown Apr. 29 behind Epsom Derby hopefuls **Sakhee** and **Going Global (Ire)**. Michael Stoute will be hoping that **Petrushka** can bounce back from her disappointing run in the G1 1000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 7, where she ran on to be third to **Lahan (GB)**, having previously impressed when taking the G3 Nell Gwyn S. Newmarket Apr. 18. Godolphin hold two entries, with the first string being **Melikah**, who caught **Barry Hills' Clog Dance** on the line in the Listed **Pretty Polly S.** at Newmarket May 7. She will have to overcome inexperience here, however, while the two-year-old form of the runner-up stands up to close inspection, having run 1000 Guineas winner **Lahan** to a neck in the G2 **Rockfel S.** in October.

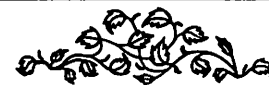

A small but select field of four contest this renewal, with Godolphin holding half of the entries in a bid to follow last season's success with Daylami (Ire). The first string **Fantastic Light** runs for the first time in the royal blue, having been transferred from Michael Stoute, under whose handling he improved throughout last season and this spring. Winner of the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York last August, he has already shown that he has trained on well this year by taking the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 25. Connections may have most to fear from Stoute's **Daliapour**, runner-up in last year's G1 Epsom and Irish Derbies when trained by Luca Cumani. He won the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 11 in his first appearance since injuring himself when last in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in July. Ian Balding's **Border Arrow**, who was running on well when second to Shiva (Jpn) in the May 30 G3 Brigadier Gerard S., showed his ability to handle Epsom when third to High-Rise (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby in 1998.

Undefeated **Roxelana** was tested against stakes competition in her fourth career start in the Gill La Troienne at Churchill Downs on May 4 and responded with an overpowering 11 3/4-length victory. The bay filly has won each successive start by increasing margins and gets her first test beyond seven furlongs in the one-turn mile. "I don't think the extra furlong should be a problem for her," said trainer William Huffman, "She amazes me each time she runs. She's done everything so easily." **Darling My Darling**, who placed in the G1 Matron and Frizette at Belmont as a two-year-old, makes only her third start this year. She finished a fast-closing third in the G1 Beaumont at Keeneland on April 21. **Dream Supreme** returned from an eight-month layoff with a decisive 9 1/2-length victory in a Pimlico optional claimer on May 19 for new trainer Bill Mott.
