LOVE CONQUERS ALL

Love Divine (GB) (Diesis {GB}), sent off the 9-4 favourite for yesterday's G1 Epsom Oaks, received a perfect ride and kicked in the straight to beat Kalypso Katie (Ire) (Fairy King) by two lengths, giving trainer Henry Cecil his seventh victory in the race. Last year the filly found one too good in a Doncaster maiden in November, but as a late-developing type, she was given plenty of time to come to herself in preparation for this Classic. The plan looked as though it might go awry when she became ill in the spring, but she recovered in time to take the Listed Lupe S. Goodwood May 24 in style. She came here with the burden of history, as no horse had ever won that trial before going on to Epsom glory, but she ended that jinx with a great performance. Settled on the rail in a prominent position early, as Clipper (GB) (Salse) took the field along at a reasonable pace, covering the first half mile in :57.5 seconds. Love Divine was travelling well on the track to keep her position with Kalypso Katie shadowing her on the outside. As they rounded the turn, both Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain) and Melikah (Ire) (Lammtarra) had a lot to do to make up the ground, but Richard Quinn on the favourite and Mick Kinane on Kalypso Katie were where the pace was, and they both moved up to the front rank. When Quinn asked his filly to quicken with two furlongs remaining, she did so emphatically, instantly slipping away from Kalypso Katie. As she lengthened up the straight, she edged right on the camber, but her turn of foot had ensured her victory, with the runner-up unable to find the pace to close the gap. Melikah finished fast and late to almost take the tiring runner-up, while Petrushka ran on to gain fourth. An emotional Cecil said, "This was only her third race, and she could have done with another one, but she's a very good filly, as she was very ill. She is still very green, and she didn't have a very hard race, and Richard [Quinn] also said so. It's marvellous for the Harris', who haven't been involved in racing for very long. I've been very lucky to have been given a very good filly to train. Now we'll take one day at a time." Quinn added, "She was very, very good. It wasn't a true run mile-and-a-half race, and I was fortunate to be the first to go. It's a big team effort--great credit to the lads as all the horses were sick in the spring and they have done all the work--and I'm just the lucky man to have steered this girl round here. Henry Cecil is a genius." *Chart p. 3*

DERBY DREAMING

With the withdrawal of ante-post leader King's Best (Kingmambo), favoritism for the 221st edition of Epsom Derby will be disputed by a pair of Sadler's Wells colts, Beat Hollow and Aristotle. The Coolmore stallion has yet to sire a winner of the Epsom Classic, but has a very good chance to do so today. Ballydoyle trainer Aidan O'Brien will be hoping that Aristotle can open his own Epsom Derby account. As a two-year-old he carried the Magnier silks to victory in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in November, and he showed he had lost none of his ability when finishing first in the G2 Prix Greffulhe Longchamp Apr. 23, only to be disqualified for interference as he swerved left in the closing stages. Any further easing in the ground seems likely to suit him, as his Group 1 performances have been on soft and heavy ground. Henry Cecil, winner of yesterday's Vodafone Oaks with Love Divine (GB), has won this race four times since 1985 and will be hoping that Beat Hollow can follow up last year's winner Oath (Ire) for Warren Place, but this promising colt missed out on valuable experience with illness last month. His best performance came in the Listed Newmarket S. May 5, where he beat stable companion Sandmason (GB) in striking style. The G2 Dante S. at York May 17, won by John Dunlop's Sakhee (Bahri), is seen as a trial of great consequence for this Classic. It produced the 1994 and 1997 winners, Erhaab and Benny The Dip. This year's renewal was run on fast ground at a fast pace, with Sakhee getting the better of Pawn Broker (GB) and Godolphin's Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian) in third. John Oxx's Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge) won the G1 National S. at The Curragh in September, and he has returned this season with two fine efforts giving weight away at Leopardstown, the latter of which involved success in the G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial May 14. He will be looking to give his owner, His Highness The Aga Khan, his fourth Derby winner. If there is an outsider to trouble the main principals, it could be Going Global (Ire) (Bob Back), who was caught on the line by Saddler's Quest (GB) in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 13, after rain had softened the ground considerably before the start. *Field p. 2*

ELEVEN SET FOR BELMONT BATTLE

Despite the absence of both the Derby and Preakness winners, a contentious field of 11 sophomores will go postward in the 132nd renewal of the GI Belmont S. Kentucky Derby runner-up Aptitude (A.P. Indy) has been installed as the morning-line favorite. The dark bay colt has lost only to Fusaichi Pegasus and Red Bullet in 2000. The 12 furlongs should be no problem for him, as he is a son of 1992 Belmont winner A.P. Indy and was produced from a half sister to 1979 winner Coastal. "The Belmont is a great race for the pedigree," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "And the money is not bad either." Godolphin has entered Curule (Go for Gin) in hopes of securing their first American classic. Seventh in the Kentucky Derby, he recorded a bullet five-panel breeze in 1:01 Tuesday at Belmont and will have Jerry Bailey in the irons. "We feel that he's got a good shot," said Godolphin assistant Eric Coatrieux. "He's been showing improvement ever since he's arrived in New York." Derby and Preakness third Impeachment (Deputy Minister) will be the only horse to run in all three Triple Crown events this year. Postponed (Summer Squall), from the connections of last year's winner Lemon Drop Kid, has blossomed at the right time, capturing the GI Peter Pan S. May 27. "He's just doing great, and I couldn't be happier," trainer Scotty Schulhofer breezily remarked. "I'm just hoping he feels as good as I do."

Daliapour proved he could handle this track when he was runner-up in last year's G1 Epsom Derby and he won here over this distance in a conditions race last April. He followed up his win in the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 11 with his finest success to date, ridden with confidence and to perfection by Kieren Fallon. Taken to the front early, he set a fast pace throughout, running the first half a mile in a very respectable :56.74, before completing the first seven furlongs in 1:37. This taxed Fantastic Light, and Border Arrow did not help that horse's cause by leaning towards him up the straight. However, Godolphin's challenger did not look at home on the camber here, and jockey Chris McCarron was struggling to keep him balanced. Kieren Fallon stole it up front, only having to keep Daliapour up to his work to win comfortably. The Aga Khan, pleased with Daliapor's performance, said, "That was very nice indeed and he is a very courageous horse. He handles this course well and he put in a brave show. He likes this give in the ground and he had conditions right today. I would now like to run in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 29, but not if the ground comes up firm." Simon Crisford said of the runner-up, "The way the race was run did not work out for him. Chris [McCarron] said that he wasn't helped with Border Arrow hanging into him a bit, but he ran a grand race. We might come back for the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 8, or we might wait for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S."

Finder's Fee, heroine of the GI Matron S. over this trip last season, came rolling through the stretch to hand favored Roxelana her first defeat. The dark bay filly, second in her 2000 bow at Gulfstream, captured the GIII Cicada on April Fool's Day before rallying for third over a sloppy Aqueduct strip in the GIII Comely Apr. 21. Entered in the GII Nassau County at Belmont May 10, the Phipps colorbearer altered course in the stretch when fourth behind C'est L'Amour and Tugger (Twinning). Sent off as the fourth choice in a deep field of 10, she was unhurried early as Roxelana shadowed Imadeed (Alydeed) through quick fractions of :22 2/5 and :45 1/5. Advancing along the fence, she swung to the outside nearing the stretch and rallied determinedly up the center of the track for her second Grade I victory. "We got the pace today, and she was a little bit more relaxed than she had been," said winning trainer Shug McGaughey. "We'll probably try the Mother Goose [7/1, 9f, \$250,000]." Roxelana had a clear lead at the stretch call, but could not hold off the closers. "We have no excuses," said her trainer Blackie Huffman. "We'll go back home now and give her a little break."

An autopsy will be performed to determine cause of death. The chestnut had not shown any signs of distress.
