SINN-FULLY GOOD AT EPSOM

Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge), named after a mountain range in Iraq, yesterday became the first Irish-trained winner of the G1 Epsom Derby since Secreto in 1984 and the Aga Khan's fourth winner of the race following the victories of Shergar (1981), Shahrastani (1986) and Kahyasi (1988), all homebreds, with a one-length victory at Epsom. Sinndar's most notable success to date came in the G1 Aga Khan National S. at The Curragh last September. He suffered his only career defeat on his seasonal debut this year when second in the Listed Ballysax S. at Leopardstown April 16, but made amends in winning the G3 Derrinstown Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 14. Kingsclere (GB) (Fairy King) set off at a fast pace taking a wide course going the uphill first half mile in under 53 seconds. Sakhee (Bahri) and Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian) then took control to set a more sensible pace with Wellbeing (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and Sinndar placed handy in behind and Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells) not far away in midpack. Rounding Tattenham Corner on the run for home, Sakhee made his bid, with Sinndar tracking Sakhee's run. Beat Hollow also made a move approaching the final quarter mile, but was blocked at a critical point and the race was beyond him. Sakhee was hard ridden but still led entering the final furlong, yet Sinndar wasn't giving in. Sinndar hit the front in the last 75 yards, staying on strongly to deny the brave Sakhee. The Aga Khan enthused, "My grandfather won the race five times, but not with a homebred, and it was a hidden wish of mine to win the race with a homebred. It has now happened four times, which is a wonderful thing for a breeding operation like mine. It is real happiness." Despite having trained at the highest level for over 20 years, this was John Oxx's first Vodafone Derby winner. Oxx said, "He (Sinndar) doesn't tell you a lot from his homework; he works with handicappers and he'd never make headlines from that. He showed us that he was very well and the omens were good because he looked the best he has ever looked before we left to come here. He was well in himself and we hoped the extra two furlongs would, with a good pace and a test of stamina, be in his favour. He has improved every time he's run and he goes on all types of ground--fast, firm or heavy, it doesn't seem to matter to him. THIRD TIME THE CHARM

Bob and Beverly Lewis watched in 1997 as Touch Gold snatched immortality away from Silver Charm and just last year witnessed a courageous Charismatic just fail in his Triple Crown attempt. It was hugs and kisses all around yesterday as Commendable (Gone West) gave them their first Belmont, to go along with two Derby and three Preakness wins. Fourth in the GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 8, the chestnut was fourth in the Mar. 4 GII San Rafael in his two-turn debut and filled the same spot behind Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII San Felipe Mar. 19 with blinkers added for the first time. The \$575,000 yearling came fourth as the 2-1 favorite in Unshaded (Unbridled)'s GII Coolmore Lexington, but was a welldefeated 17th in the Kentucky Derby in his last start. Before a crowd of 67,810, Hugh Hefner (Bertrando) set the pace from the outside with Commendable his shadow through the opening furlongs. Wheelaway (Unbridled) was tucked away neatly in third as Unshaded and favored Aptitude (A.P Indy) lingered at the back of the strung out pack. Jockey Pat Day aboard the eventual winner turned up the heat on the leader rounding the far turn and hit the front turning for home, as the race favorites were rolling up into contention. Commendable began to inch away leaving the eighth pole and was able to withstand late runs from Aptitude up the rail and Unshaded on the grandstand side to give Day his third Belmont victory and trainer D. Wayne Lukas his fourth. Unshaded was quickly dismounted on the clubhouse turn following the race and was treated for "mild" heat exhaustion, but walked back to the barn under his own power. "We felt this might be his best race," Lukas said of the winner. "You have to look at what you are up against in the race and the field you are faced with. A lot of this was contingent on getting Pat Day to ride. I'm not saying we wouldn't have run without him, but getting Pat was important to out decision to run." Day, whose most recent experience on the colt was in the Lexington, rode with supreme confidence. "When we got to the quarter pole, I knew we had a pretty good cushion," he said. "I didn't know what the last quarter mile had in store for us, but he kept rolling and when I asked him, he just kept going." Bobby Frankel, who trains the race favorite, was beside himself following the race. "I'm very disappointed. He was way too far back. He ran a really good race, but used himself up getting to the winner." Belmont Chart p2

A listed stakes winner in England, but never able to crack the upper echelon, Manndar was sent to the U.S. at the tail end of his three-year-old season to finish fourth in the GII Oak Tree Derby and an excellent second in the GI Hollywood Derby. Third in the GII San Gabriel H. in his first try against elders New Year's Day, the bay was fourth in the GII El Rincon H. Apr. 8, before bursting into prominence with a 1 1/2-length victory in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill May 6. Manndar was reserved in seventh while saving ground through the opening furlongs, as Middlesex Drive (Pine Bluff) took the field through moderate fractions. Turning for home, Yagli (Jade Hunter) forged to a short lead, but was soon engulfed by a crush of horseflesh, including Manndar, who tipped out at the top of the lane and closed resolutely through the final furlong to score his second consecutive Grade I. Yagli crossed the wire fourth, but impeded Honor Glide (Honor Grades) at midstretch and was disqualified to sixth. "When you've got the best horse, things tend to go right," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani. "I had the best horse in here and we got the trip. He settled real nicely off the pace and ran when I asked him."

The gate-to-wire winner of his first two starts by a combined 14 lengths, Trippi showed a new dimension in the Mar. 11 GIII Swale S. on Florida Derby day at Gulfstream Park, laying just off fast fractions, and rallying through the final furlong to score by 1 3/4 lengths. The bay maintained his unblemished record with a frontrunning tally in the GIII Flamingo Apr. 8 and contested the pace in the Kentucky Derby, before tiring to finish 11th. Freshened a bit and dropped back to a more favorable trip, Trippi was the 2-1 second choice. Off a bit slowly, the Todd Pletcher trainee advanced between horses to lead after a quarter mile, was cut loose at the top of the stretch by jockey Jerry Bailey and cruised home to the easy victory. "I just left it in Jerry's [jockey Bailey] hands," commented Pletcher. "He [Trippi] broke a bit slow, as always, but he got going on his own and there was a place to go and Jerry just let him cruise on up there." Pletcher left his options open for a potential next start. "He may not be a mile-and-a-quarter horse, but up to a mile and an eighth, he's a pretty nice horse."

Intidab has been has been known to uncork a big race from time to time; one need only look at the 120 Beyer Speed Figure he earned when accounting for the 1999 GII A Phenomenon H. at Saratoga, where he had Eclipse champion sprinter Artax in second. The Shadwell homebred was a distant third to the champ in the GII Forest Hills H. Oct. 16 before closing the year with a one-length success in the Eillo S. on the Breeders' Cup undercard Nov. 7. A one-length second behind Bevo in a Belmont allowance May 12, Intidab was the slight second choice behind GI Carter H. winner Brutally Frank. Oro de Mexico set the pace well off the rail, hanging Brutally Frank out wide as Intidab loped along in sixth. Four wide turning for home, jockey Robbie Davis shifted the seven-year-old towards the inside to lead past the eighth pole and inched clear of the pace-pressing runner up. "This horse runs so well on the outside, but when the leaders were drifting out, I had to take him to the inside," commented Davis, an idea which drew praise from victorious conditioner Kiaran McLaughlin. "I thought that was a clever move," he said.

Perfect Sting kept her 2000 record perfect with a laststride victory. A winner of consecutive Grade I events last year, the bay filly closed out her sophomore campaign with a sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. She returned to action with a half-length score in the GIII Beaugay at Aqueduct May 7 and was sent off as the overwhelming favorite here. Rating along the inside, she switched out for running room and got up just in time to nail Ronda on the line. "There was a 1 3/8-mile race last week [the Sheepshead Bay], but we opted to pass and run her here," said winning trainer Joe Orseno. "Her next race will be in New York in July [the GII New York H., July 15], then the Diana [GII, Sept. 4], then a \$750K race [GI Flower Bowl, Oct. 7] and the Breeders' Cup."

Second in both prior starts this year, Trans Island added a second group win to his portfolio here in a most thrilling finish. He was unlucky to come up against an in-form Indian Lodge (Ire) when runner-up in the G2 KLM Mile at Sandown April 28, and he filled the same berth behind Aljabr in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 20. Kieren Fallon sent Trans Island straight into the lead from a keen Fly To The Stars (GB) (Bluebird) and Duck Row, as Ramooz and Yakareem were ridden with patience in the rear. Once into the straight, approaching the three-furlong marker, Fallon made a decisive kick for home. Duck Row responded and made a bold bid on the outside on the run to the final quarter mile. Both horses proved game as they fought neck and neck throughout the final eighth, with Trans Island rallying courageously to put his head in front on the line. Winning trainer lan Balding said, "That was good. He's a very brave horse and deserved this win having finished second in two big races. He was giving the second five pounds and Kieren (Fallon) said he was brave to fight back after he was headed momentarily. We were keen for him to make the running as he is a natural frontrunner."

One of her victims that day was subsequent G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Reve D'Oscar, who reopposes today. The form of the Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 21, suggests that Reve D'Oscar should finish in front of Folie Danse, Hidalguia and Goldamix. That may not be the case, however, as all of the aforementioned certainly have place claims at least. Lady Of Chad won last season's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and reappeared with a fine win in the G3 Prix de la Grotte at Longchamp Apr. 23. She disappointed when unplaced in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 14, but raced far too keenly on that occasion and can be afforded one more chance. New Story was second to Lady Of Chad in the Prix Marcel Boussac and, because of niggling setbacks, had not set foot on the track until winning a conditions race at Chantilly May 30. She is a filly of some potential and should not be discounted.

Although horses are required to parade in racecard order, permission can be sought and given for them to parade out of sequence. The stewards did not accept the explanations offered by the trainer and jockey at the subsequent inquiry.
