Sydney-based jockey Larry Cassidy is poised to take his third premiership title and notch more than 100 wins for the third straight year, but until Monday, Group 1 wins were proving elusive this season. When Cassidy sent grand campaigner Yippyio out wide in this affair, eyebrows were raised, but the jockey had picked the best going on the wet track and his mount outfought the veteran Sharscay in the final stages before notching a 1 1/4-length win. Yippyio won the Queensland Derby at Eagle Farm as a three-year-old and was made early favourite for the Melbourne Cup on the strength of that victory, but he suffered a virus and it seemed he never quite regained his old form until this start. "To have a Melbourne Cup runner is the thrill of a lifetime and we were heartbroken when he got the travel sickness and nearly died," said owner Geoff White. Trainer Allan Denham will nominate Yippyio for another Melbourne Cup assault in November, but acknowledged he would be meeting a far stronger field.

Puntilla proved that lack of racing experience was not a hindrance to winning her first Group race, and a Classic to boot. Unraced as a juvenile, she eventually made her debut when winning at this course and distance May 1, and then finished second in her only other start at Baden-Baden June 2. Starting here as a relative outsider, she came with a strong late charge to cause a minor shock by winning in the dying strides. Rounding the final turn, Ustimona tried to get away, but her move was soon cornered by Quezon City, who took the lead just inside the quarter-mile marker. It was the late show for Puntilla, who came up from midfield and snatched the lead in the final strides from the odds-on favourite with Ustimona a battling third. Puntilla's win was the second straight Oaks succes for her sire Acatenango, who was responsible for Flamingo Road (Ger) last year.

Winless since taking last year's Epsom Cup, American Boss was off eight months after that start, returning to be fourth in a stakes in February. The runner-up in the G2-Jpn Nakayama Kinen Feb. 27, he also placed second in his most recent trip, the G3 Niigata Daishoten May 14. Breaking from post 11, from which he won the Epsom last year, the bay was rated in the middle of the field behind a quick pace over the deep ground. On the final turn, the five-year-old dug in, reaching the lead in mid-stretch and driving to a 1 1/4-length victory. "The going was very soft and we hit the front earlier than I had planned," jockey Teruo Eda said, "but he never gave up running till the wire."

After taking a novice race Jan. 9, Yuwa Falcon finished poorly in a lower plate race later that month and was freshened for 2 1/2 months. The three-year-old returned triumphant with an impressive five-length victory in his last outing Apr. 2. Stepping up in class here, he broke cleanly to take the lead, set the pace and went on to a three-length romp under jockey Eiji Nakadate, making it two in a row. "I was trying to settle him, but he had a nice break," Nakadate said, "so I let him run as he wanted. He had a lot of energy left at the last turn,

Just how small the world has become was demonstrated once again Saturday. At Epsom, the Vodafone Derby was deservedly won by Sinndar, a member of Grand Lodge's second Irish crop, while 10,000 miles away the Queensland Derby fell to Freemason, a member of Grand Lodge's first Australian crop. This magnificent double looks even better in light of the fact that Sinndar was sired at the comparatively modest fee of IR9,000gns and Freemason at a fee of A\$15,000.

Grand Lodge's current Coolmore fee is IR12,500gns and you can be sure it will be readjusted upwards following his very bright start. His first crop, around 90 foals, had every right to do well and it has, with a total of six stakes winners. Raise A Grand, Chelsea Manor and Indian Lodge have all won at Group level and the last two have run well in Group 1 company this year.

Sinndar heads Grand Lodge's second crop, which also includes the promising Sandmason and the smart French colt Petroselli, who contested the French Derby. In Australia, Grand Lodge's eldest runners also include Freemason's fellow Group 1 winner Shogun Lodge.

Sinndar's win represents as big a triumph for the Aga Khan and his team as it does for Grand Lodge. With four homebred winners of the Derby in the space of 20 years, His Highness has now moved ahead of his grandfather, who bred only three of his five Derby heroes.

It is tempting to wonder whether Erhaab's 1994 Derby win influenced Sinndar's production. Erhaab is by Chief's Crown out of a granddaughter of Never Bend, whereas Sinndar is by Chief's Crown's son Grand Lodge out of a great-granddaughter of Never Bend. Grand Lodge seems to be very well suited by this line, producing Sinndar and Petroselli from mares descending from Never Bend's son Mill Reef, and Raise A Grand from an Irish River mare. Chelsea Manor's pedigree also contains Never Bend, as his second dam is a Riverman mare.

Sinndar appears to possess the fine blend of stamina and speed one would have hoped for from a mating between a champion juvenile and Sinntara, a slow developer who recorded her first win at the end of July as a three-year-old. Sinntara did even better when she moved up to two miles, winning a Listed race and taking the Irish Cesarewitch by nine lengths.

Sinntara was bred to stay well. Her sire, 1984 Breeders' Cup Turf winner Lashkari, once tackled the Grand Prix de Paris over 1 7/8 miles and her dam, the Top Ville mare Sidama, won four times at up to 1 1/2 miles.

The main distinction of Sinndar's fourth dam, the Coaltown mare Bielka, was that she was a daughter of Marcel Boussac's celebrated mare Tourzima. This daughter of Tourbillon produced three notable sisters-Corejada, Gloriana and Albanilla--and their influence lives on roughly half a century after their births.

Corejada, winner of the French 1000 Guineas and Irish Oaks, produced the top performers Apollonia, Macip and Arcor; Arcor's finest effort was his second in the 1962 Derby. Gloriana's granddaughter Licata produced the French Derby winner Acamas and the Arc-winning Akiyda. Significantly, Licata shared the same sire, Abdos, as Sinndar's third dam Stoyana and Abdos also made his mark with this family when he was mated with Albanilla's grand-daughter Kelty. This mating resulted in Delsy, who became famous as the dam of the French Derby winner Darshaan and of Darshaan's Group-winning three-parts sister Dalara. Dalara nearly produced a Derby winner at her first attempt, her first foal being the 1999 runner-up Daliapour, so Sinndar's family has made quite an impact on the Derbys in England and France. Now Daliapour has won the Coronation Cup to initiate a wonderful Group 1 Epsom double for their breeder and the Tourzima female line.

BELMONT RATINGS DROP The overnight television ratings for Saturday's GI Belmont S., hurt by the fact there was no Triple Crown on the line, declined 48 percent from a year ago. The broadcast, aired on ABC from 4:30 to 6 p.m., earned a 3.4 rating and a 9 share, representing 3.4 million viewers and 9 percent of the television audience during that time period. The Belmont was the only leg of this year's Triple Crown to show a drop in the ratings. The figures were the lowest ever for an ABC telecast of the Belmont. NBC will begin airing the Triple Crown events next year.

KING'S BEST BACK TO WORK

G1 2000 Guineas S. winner King's Best (USA) (Kingmambo {USA}), forced to miss the Epsom Derby on Saturday due to a muscle problem, is reported fine by Racing Manager Joe Mercer after a series of tests were carried out over the weekend. He said yesterday, "The results of the tests were satisfactory and he will return to normal cantering on Friday. I would think that Royal Ascot would be ruled out."

ALL ROADS LEAD TO THE CURRAGH

The July 2 Irish Derby and July 16 Irish Oaks at The Curragh could provide a rematch of the Epsom Classics run over the weekend. Love Divine (GB) (Diesis {GB})'s owners, The Lordship Stud, are pointing the G1 Epsom Oaks winner towards the Irish Oaks. Stud Manager and spokesman Michael Russell said, "We're so pleased to have bred and owned an Oaks winner. We are over the moon--it was more than we could ever have expected. It's absolutely wonderful, and in all probability, if she stays sound, and everything's right, she goes to The Curragh. There should be improvement, as she has only had three races, and seems to be improving all the time, but it's in the lap of the gods." Love Divine could face off against Oaks runner-up Kalypso Katie (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}) at The Curragh. Her trainer Jeremy Noseda reported yesterday, "She's come out of the race in A1 condition. I was happy with the way she ran, but we were just beaten by a better horse. There's a good chance she'll go for the Irish Oaks." Sir Michael Stoute's Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain {USA}) was again in the frame in a Classic, finishing fourth at Epsom. Tim Jones, spokesman for owners Highclere Thoroughbred Racing, said yesterday, "There is a sense of delight that we have once again been placed in a Classic, but also of mild frustration as she didn't have as much luck in running as would have been ideal. She's come out of it well and was on great terms with herself at Epsom, which is a big relief. She remains a star in our eyes, and we hope that the run of the race at The Curragh may suit her better than Epsom. There is no need to make a rush decision, but she's entered in the Irish Oaks, and Michael [Stoute] feels that we should have a go again. She hasn't had a hard time, and she never will. She will have a nice break in the lead-up to her next race."

DERBY MATCH SET FOR CURRAGH

As the first Curragh-based horse to have won the G1 Epsom Derby since 1964, Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA}) will be homeward-bound for his next test, in the G1 Irish Derby July 2. The Classic may see him go head-to-head with G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) winner Holding Court (GB) (Hernando {Fr}), for the fourth match between Derby winners in the last 20 years. The last time two Derby winners hooked up at The Curragh was in 1993, when Holding Court's sire Hernando was runner-up to Epsom Derby winner Commander In Chief (GB). The immediate reaction to the Derby winners' performances was made by the British Horseracing Board, who rate Sinndar at 125 pounds compared to Holding Court's 124 pounds. If they are to clash at The Curragh, Holding Court will need to be supplemented at a cost of Ir£85,000, but trainer Michael Jarvis yesterday described him as "an intended runner," adding connections will keep a close eye on the weather forecast. A Derby double by either horse would be worth a US\$1 million bonus. Plans are not definite for Epsom Derby runner-up Sakhee (USA) (Bahri {USA}). Angus Gold, Racing Manager for owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, said vesterday, "We're thrilled, and very proud of him. We haven't discussed where he goes at all yet, but he'll either stay at a mile-and-a-half, or step back in trip for something like the G1 Eclipse S. (Sandown July 8)." Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), third in the Epsom Derby, may miss the clash at The Curragh in order to drop back in distance, but Teddy Beckett, Racing Manager for owner Khalid Abdullah, said yesterday, "He's come out of the race fine, and we were delighted to be third in the Derby. We have made no decision about future plans as yet." William Hill were keen to price up the G1 Irish Derby yesterday, quoting Sinndar as the 7-4 favourite, with Holding Court at 5-2, and Sakhee at 3-1. Spokesman David Hill said, "This race looks set to be a blinder, and The Curragh is set to stage the biggest title decider since Ali met Foreman for their 'Rumble In The Jungle'."

£10 MILLION MARKETING STRATEGY UNVEILED

The Racing and Betting Marketing Group (RBMG) unveiled a £10 million national marketing strategy for racing and betting. This group, commissioned by the Levy Board Marketing Sub Committee to undertake the development and implementation of the national strategy, released a three-year plan designed to attract an additional one million attendances and to increase off-course betting turnover by one percent above inflation. In addition to an intensive public relations campaign, the plan calls for the establishment of an interactive central information and ticketing infrastructure which will be accessible by telephone and internet.

FORTUNE CASE CAUSES STIR-UP

The Jockey Club is set to investigate the circumstances which led to jockey Jimmy Fortune being banned for five days after being found to have ridden irresponsibly at Newmarket on Sunday, rather than being referred to Portman Square under the 'totting up' procedure. Fortune had picked up a ban at Epsom on Friday, but the Newmarket stewards were unaware of this. John Maxse of the Jockey Club said, "We want to find out what went wrong and install a form of safety net." Fortune now misses the whole of Royal Ascot.
