SLICK SCORE IN LA COUPE

Making his first start in the blue silks of Godolphin, **Slickly (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) was no less than impressive when outclassing seven opponents for an unchallenged win in yesterday's G3 La Coupe at Longchamp. Undeclared in three starts until finishing fourth to Montjeu (Ire) in last year's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly in June, Slickly improved his record by winning the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp in his next start. He ended the season by finishing second to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville last August and fifth to Sendawar (Ire) in Longchamp's G1 Prix du Moulin in September. Sent straight into the lead, he set a generous pace in advance of **Milord Fontenaille (Fr)** (Nashamaa {Ire}), **Agol Lack (Gulch)** and **Kerrygold (Tel Quel {Fr})**, but the race was tempered by a leg injury to **Ultimately Lucky (Ire)** (Kris {GB}), who was pulled up after halfway. Once into the straight Slickly continued to travel well and only needed to be pushed out with minimal effort throughout the final quarter mile to pass the line an easy winner. Agol Lack ran on in good style to hold the late flourish of Kerrygold for second, although neither mounted a serious challenge. Winning rider Sylvain Guillot enthused, "I was in control all the way and he was quite impressive when he quickened. I had plenty left underneath me and I really liked the way he won."

HOLLYWOOD DEBUT FOR GODOLPHIN

Two-year-old filly **Hamsaat Hi Haat** (Hennessy--Balenciaga, by Gulch) will become the first-ever juvenile starter in the U.S. for Godolphin when trainer Eoin Harty tightens the girth for Sunday's fifth race at Hollywood Park. The bay, purchased at last year's Keeneland July Sale for \$650,000, is out of a daughter of Sacahuista, champion three-year-old filly of 1987 and the winner of the Breeders' Cup Distaff that season. Among her competition is **Smart Timing** (Miswaki), a \$400,000 yearling purchase owned by Bob and Beverly Lewis and **Fort Lauderdale** (Montbrook), for whom Nelson Bunker Hunt paid \$390,000 at this year's Ocala March Sale of Two-Year-Olds.

Jane Smiley to Speak at Hall of Fame Inductions:

Pulitzer Prize-winning author Jane Smiley will deliver the keynote speech at this year's inductions into Thoroughbred racing's Hall of Fame, it was announced yesterday. Smiley won the Pulitzer Prize for her novel *A Thousand Acres* and is currently on the best-seller lists with *Horse Heaven*, which is set in the world of horse racing. The Hall of Fame ceremonies will be held Monday, Aug. 7 at the Fasig-Tipton Sales Pavilion in Saratoga Springs, New York, beginning at 10:30 a.m.

Turfway Announces Fall Schedule:

The \$1.15 million Kentucky Cup Day scheduled this year for Saturday, September 16, highlights the 22-day fall meeting at Turfway Park in Florence, Kentucky. The centerpiece race of the fall schedule is the \$500,000 GII Kentucky Cup Classic, a race which last year produced Breeders' Cup Classic winner Cat Thief. Other main events include the GII Kentucky Cup Sprint for three-year-olds and the GIII \$250,000 Turfway Breeders' Cup H. for older fillies and mares. Racing is scheduled for Wednesday to Sunday beginning Sept. 6 and continuing through Friday, October 6.

Zimmerman Recovering Following Spill:

Jockey Ramsey Zimmerman, injured in a spill in Wednesday afternoon's seventh race at Arlington International, is stable and is listed in fair condition, according to Bob Niersbach of Northwest Community Hospital in Arlington Heights. Zimmerman is to be transferred from the hospital's Intensive Care Unit to a regular room. No decision has been made on the timing of Zimmerman's release from the hospital.

Mocha Express Retired:

The reigning Texas-bred Horse of the Year Mocha Express (Java Gold--Gayla, by Lord Gaylord) has been retired due to a recurring ankle injury. Bred by William S. Farish and W. Temple Webber Jr., the six-year-old won the GIII Ark-La-Tex H. in 1999, but scored arguably his most impressive victory when coming from behind to beat Littlebitlively and Nite Dreamer in last year's Lone Star H. The dark bay retires with 16 wins from 34 career starts and earnings of \$960,216, second among Texas breds only to Groovy (\$1,346,956).

Calder Racing Secretary Bob Umphrey has added a unique event to the track's Summit of Speed card July 15. The \$50,000-added Rocket Man S. will be contested at two furlongs and is open to two-year-olds and up. Any juveniles which are entered will be asked to carry 105 pounds, three-year-olds will tote 117 and older horses will be saddled with 122 pounds. "The day is all about speed and we thought this race could give horsemen a unique opportunity with the straight quarter-mile run to the finish," Umphrey said.

Top four-year-old Sendawar, a hugely impressive winner of the G1 Prix d'Isphahan at Longchamp on his seasonal reappearance May 21, has been supplemented for next Wednesday's G1 Prince Of Wales's S. at a cost of £20,000. If he takes his place, he is set for a long-awaited clash with Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking The Gold {USA}). Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre is looking forward to the race and said: "Sendawar is very well at present and will take his chance in the race, providing the ground is good on the day. If not he will remain in Chantilly." Of other race plans he added: "I will also have **Zarkiya (Ire)** (Catrail {USA}) in the Coronation Stakes." The G1 Coronation S., set for next Friday June 23, will also provide another intriguing clash as Pascal Bary has announced that owner Ecurie Skymarc Farm will pay the necessary £20,000 at today's supplementary stage to add Bluemamba to the race. Bluemamba and Zarkiya last met in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 14, where Bluemamba proved a worthy winner and Zarkiya an unlucky-in-running fourth. Bluemamba worked at Chantilly's Les Aigles turf yesterday and pleased her trainer with her work. Bary said: "Bluemamba is very well and Olivier Peslier, who will have the ride at (Royal) Ascot, came to have a feel aboard the filly. She went well and he liked the way she worked. She will take her chance in the Coronation Stakes."

COME TOGETHER, SAYS SAVILL
