CLASSY FIELD FOR STEPHEN FOSTER

The GII Stephen Foster H. has become one of the most important stops for top older horses in recent years and this year's edition, to be run at Churchill Downs this afternoon, has attracted another quality field, including four Grade I winners. Ecton Park (Forty Niner), winner of the GI Super Derby last season, seems to have returned from a trip to Dubai in top form. Fifth in the World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 25, he came back with an impressive 8 1/4-length victory in the William Schaeffer H. over a sloppy Pimlico track on Preakness Day. Trainer Elliott Walden, who saddled champion Victory Gallop to win this event in trackrecord time last year, said of his 2000 runner, "I think he's a horse that cycles around and I'm hoping he'll be in peak form [today]. He gives me every indication that he is. I think he belongs at the top of the handicap division, and the [Stephen Foster] is a good test for him." The favorite in the field is Golden Missile (A.P. Indy), who finished third behind fellow Foster starter Cat Thief (Storm Cat) in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic. After hitting the board in five of six starts, the chestnut scored a breakout two-length victory in the GI Pimlico Special when reunited with Classic jockey Kent Desormeaux in his latest. K One King (Apalachee), who missed 10 months after finishing eighth in the 1999 Kentucky Derby, was a dull sixth as the favorite at Pimlico, but scored his Grade I win in his previous outing, the Oaklawn H. Apr. 8. Chester House (Mr. Prospector) has been a bit of a disapointment this year after finishing a fast-closing fourth in the Breeders' Cup Classic in his first start on U.S. soil. The son of top turf mare Toussaud returned to the grass with a close third in the GII Explosive Bid H., but tired to be third in the GIII Excelsior H. last time out Apr. 29.

BELMONT TO HOST BREEDERS' CUP 2001

The 18th running of the Breeders' Cup Championship will be held Saturday, Oct. 27, 2001 at Belmont Park, it was announced yesterday. This marks the fourth time a New York track will host the Breeders' Cup, which was run at Belmont in 1990 and '95 and at Aqueduct in 1985. The '95 edition attracted the smallest attendance in the event's history, with a crowd of only 37,246, but the 1990 Breeders' Cup drew 51,236 despite temperatures in the 40s. The eight Grade I races, worth a total of \$13 million in purses, will be televised live on NBC. "We are very pleased to bring the Breeders' Cup back to New York and back to Belmont Park," D.G. Van Clief, Jr., president of Breeders' Cup Ltd., said. "Over the course of the last century, Belmont Park has been home to the greatest horses and horsemen who have ever participated in Thoroughbred racing."

ANSWER LIVELY RETIRED Answer Lively (Lively One--Twosies Answer, by Two's A Plenty) the champion two-year-old colt of 1998, has been retired after suffering a hairline fracture to his left front sesamoid. "Dr. [Larry] Bramlage said it wasn't career ending, but it probably would compromise his ability," his owner and breeder, John Franks, told the Daily Racing Form. "It would have taken surgery with two or three screws. We decided it was better to retire him." Now four, the colt was four-for-seven at two, capturing the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and finishing second in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, but was winless in seven starts last season. The bay was runner-up in both the GII Louisiana Derby and GIII Remington Park Derby before ending his career with a sixth-place finish behind Ecton Park in the Oct. 2 GI Super Derby. He retires with four wins and four seconds from 14 starts and earnings of \$938,296. Stud plans have not vet been finalized.

TVG TO TELEVISE ROYAL ASCOT RACES TVG announced yesterday that it has reached an agreement with Ascot Racecourse and the BBC to broadcast live coverage during the second day of the 2000 Royal Ascot meet. The TVG network, currently available to five million cable and satellite t.v. subscribers, will televise four races, including the G1 Prince Of Wales's S.--which will feature G1 Dubai World Cup winner Dubai Millennium (GB)--on Wednesday, June 21 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. EDT.
