## TAMARISK RETURNS AT ARLINGTON

Tamarisk (Ire) (Green Desert), the highweighted European sprinter of 1998, will make his first start since October 1998 in the \$65,000 John Henry S. at Arlington today. The five-year-old, now trained by Elliott Walden for Highland Farm, will be ridden by Chris Emigh in the one-mile turf race. A winner of three of four starts at two in England, Tamarisk won the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup and finished second in the G1 July Cup at three. He last ran at Keeneland, finishing seventh in his dirt debut when conditioned by D. Wayne Lukas. The horse was training for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but was retired to Coolmore Stud in Ireland after failing to draw into the race. He was returned to training after fertility problems curtailed his stud career.

### PEDIGREE SHORTS

We've mentioned before that the Mr. Prospector/Roberto combination (which brings together the closely related Gold Digger, dam of Mr. Prospector, and Bramalea, the dam of Roberto) has not been as prolific as one might have expected. It is slowly beginning to gain momentum, however, and there was another example when Give Praise (f, 2, Pioneering--Hail Kris, by Kris S.) captured the GII Sorrento S. A first stakes winner from the first crop of her sire--a Mr. Prospector half brother to Storm Cat--Give Praise has Mr. Prospector and Roberto in the second and third generations of her pedigree.

Black Tie Affair (Ire), now standing in Japan, had a good weekend with two stakes winners. One of these, the GIII Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. winner License Fee (m, 5, Black Tie Affair {Ire}--Star Deputy, by Deputy Minister) has a rather clever pedigree. She has champion racemare High Voltage 5x4 and in both cases--Black Tie Affair's dam Hat Tab Girl and License Fee's granddam Deepstar--the High Voltage strain is combined with The Axe II. Incidentally, to underline that the formula was worth repeating, both these mares were stakes winners.

**EXCELLENT MEETING RETIRED** John and Betty Mabee's multiple Grade I winner **Excellent Meeting** (General Meeting--Fitted Crown, by Chief's Crown) has been retired and sent to the couple's Golden Eagle Farm near Ramona, Calif. Breeding plans have not yet been announced. The four-year-old filly most recently finished fifth in the Aug. 12 Gil Clement L. Hirsch H. "She's just not the same mare," trainer Bob Baffert told *The Daily Racing Form*. "Mr. and Mrs. Mabee figured she proved enough." As a two-year-old, Excellent Meeting won the GI Hollywood Starlet S. and the GI Oak Leaf S. and finished second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies behind stablemate Silverbulletday. At three, she scored Grade I wins in the Santa Anita Oaks and Las Virgenes S. and finished a troubled fifth in the Kentucky Derby before being eased in the Preakness S. Excellent Meeting underwent surgery for a chipped ankle last summer, but never regained her top form thereafter. She went winless in four starts this year with a second and two thirds. The filly retired with eight wins in 20 starts with earnings of \$1,402,396.

**TURF FESTIVAL HIGHLIGHTS HOLLYWOOD STAKES** Hollywood Park unveiled a \$4.2 million stakes schedules designed to attract world-class turf racing to the California track's 2000 Autumn Meeting. A total of 14 stakes will be run on the grass with purses exceeding \$3 million. The 10th annual Turf Festival, with six graded stakes worth \$2.1 million, has been scheduled for Thanksgiving weekend, culminating Nov. 26. Highlights of the festival are the Nov. 26 \$500,000 GI Matriarch and \$500,000 GI Early Times Hollywood Derby. The autumn meet stakes schedule includes five Grade I, three Grade II and six Grade III races. Juveniles take center stage at Hollywood in December with the Dec. 16 \$200,000 GI Hollywood Futurity and the Dec. 17 \$200,000 GI Hollywood Starlet. The other Grade I event on tap is the Dec. 2 \$400,000 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. The meet runs from Nov. 8 through Dec. 24.

**EASTERN FALL TO THREE DAYS** Fasig-Tipton Midlantic has added a third day to its Eastern Fall Yearling Sale. With more than 800 yearlings catalogued, the sale will now be conducted Oct. 2-4 at the Maryland State Fairgrounds in Timonium. The number of yearlings on offer is a record for a Fasig-Tipton auction outside the state of Kentucky. Catalogs for the sale will be available from Fasig-Tipton offices after Sept. 8.

**RACING AT GARDEN STATE PARK LIKELY OVER** Garden State Park president and general manager Richard Orbann said he does not intend to request live racing dates for the track in 2001, according to *The Blood-Horse*. "It would be my recommendation as president to the Pennwood Racing board (which currently leases the New Jersey racetrack) to not have a Thoroughbred meet and to not provide stabling facilities in 2001," Orbann explained. "They may see otherwise, but last year's meet was really an embarrassment. I don't know anybody in their right mind who would want to have another meet there. It was an economic disaster and we got zero support from horsemen."

## ☆ SARATOGA ☆

### Saratoga Worktab:

Aug. 26 GI Travers hopeful **Curule** (Go for Gin), second in the Gil Jim Dandy, breezed four furlongs yesterday in :48 3/5 over the main track. "I was pleased with the workout, since it was his first work since the Jim Dandy," said Eric Coatrieux, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "We didn't want to over do it because he is the type of horse who can get away on you. I had him clocked in 1:00 3/5 for five furlongs, but he could have probably gone in :58."...Sprint champion **Artax** (Marquetry) continued his comeback yesterday with a five-furlong breeze in 1:01 3/5. "He did get tired at the end of the work," said trainer Lou Albertrani. "But I expected that. He's happy to be back at the track and we're really looking forward to racing him again."

### Two-Year-Old Transfers:

The Shug McGaughey and Elliott Walden stables have grown richer with the acquisitions of some interesting 2-year-old prospects. **Saint Verre** (Saint Ballado), who won his first start, a 5 1/2-furlong maiden race at Philadelphia Park, in 1:02 3/5, has been purchased by Joe Allen and will race for McGaughey. "I was skeptical at first, but he looks like he's a pretty nice horse," McGaughey said. "I've been pleasantly surprised by him." McGaughey has no set plans for Saint Verre's next start. The Walden barn has picked up **One By The Knows** (Tabasco Cat), who is 3-for-4 lifetime and won the Canterbury Park Juvenile by 11 1/4 lengths in his last start. The colt was purchased by WinStar Farm and Walden is aiming him for the Aug. 19 Gill Sapling. "He reminds me of Da Hoss," said speed figure expert Jerry Brown, who was involved in the purchase.

**Pletcher's Posse:**

Trainer Todd Pletcher is lining up his troops for assaults on two Grade I races at Saratoga for three-year-olds Aug. 26, with **Impeachment** (Deputy Minister) and **Graeme Hall** (Dehere) both scheduled to run in the Travers, while **Left Bank** (French Deputy) and **More Than Ready** (Southern Halo) are both likely to go the same day in the King's Bishop. With More Than Ready aiming for the seven-furlong King's Bishop, he's expected to have a sprint campaign through the remainder of the year, leading to the Breeders' Cup Sprint. Pletcher believes that Jerry Bailey will ride Left Bank and Pat Day will be aboard More Than Ready. The only top three-year-old who will be missing that day from the Pletcher arsenal will be **Trippi** (End Sweep). Beaten at 1-2 in the GIII Amsterdam earlier in the meet, Trippi came out of the race with a bruised left front foot and will likely miss the King's Bishop. "He just needs a little more time," Pletcher said. "It looks like we'd have to make big strides in a short period of time to get him there."
