## SILIC SOLID IN SHOEMAKER

Trainer Julio Canani was holding a pair of aces for yesterday's GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile at the Hollywood Park and the talented duo of Silic (Fr) (Sillery) and Ladies Din (Din's Dancer) battled to the wire for a one-two finish. Silic, off since winning last year's Breeders' Cup Mile, had been training superbly for his return to the races. The five-year-old French-bred enjoyed a ground-saving trip just behind the early leaders before splitting rivals into the stretch. He kicked clear down the lane and then gamely held off the late rush of his stablemate. Ladies Din, bumped in the early going, raced three wide, was fanned six wide turning for home and was mowing rivals down in the stretch to come up half length short at the wire. "Our trip was just great," admitted winning rider Corey Nakatani. "He was going nice and relaxed into the bridle. When I called on him, he was there. I got the right trip with the right horse." Canani, speaking of the winner, said, "This horse is very special. He's a great horse, an unbelievable horse." Asked about the runner-up, Canani added, "If you watch the race, and I don't want to take anything away from anybody, but he might have been the best horse today because that poor sucker was 11 wide today. I mean, turning for home, he was in the Forum parking lot." The first two runners could meet again in the Sept. 10 GI Atto Mile at Woodbine.

### EASY WIN FOR ENDLESS HALL

Endless Hall (GB) (Saddler's Hall {Ire}) was ineffective in two early season starts, but made amends yesterday with an easy victory in the G1 Gran Premio Di Milano in Milan, Italy. Trained in Newmarket by Luca Cumani, Endless Hall does most of his racing in Italy. He gave the previous best performance of his career in Milan last July, defeating Timboroa (GB) (Salse) and Sumati (GB) (Warning {GB}) in the Listed Gran Premio d'Italia. This year, he had failed to make an impact in two efforts in listed company, but he improved on those efforts with a highly impressive all-the-way success. Jockey Fernando Jovine, looking for his third stakes win of the afternoon, showed expert judging of the pace to control the race from the front, pushing the four-year-old clear in the straight to win unchallenged from the German invader Catella (Ger) (Generous {Ire}). Fellow Germantrained Caitano (GB) (Niniski) was held up at the back of the field early, but when he delivered his run, the race was already won. He lost third place near the line to the French challenger Spendent (GB) (Generous {Ire}). Cumani was delighted with the winner, commenting, "He loves firm ground and the trip. He'll have a rest now and we'll see about the future."

Gaviola took her first graded stakes Mar. 1 in the GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream, managing to overcome bumping at the start to lead the field wire to wire. Returning in a May 4 Aqueduct allowance, the filly won again, taking the lead right out of the gate, setting the pace and drawing away to a four-length win as the 6-5 crowd's choice. Pressing the pace here, the three-year-old was rated in second position before she was allowed to take the lead with 3/8 of a mile to go. In the stretch, the favorite cleared away to a fourth straight success. "She just keeps on performing well," said trainer Billy Turner. "She's relaxing more in her races. I was glad to see that she was able to sit off the speed today."

Sailing chased home subsequent G1 Epsom Oaks S. winner Love Divine (GB) when fourth, beaten seven lengths last time in the Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood May 24, form which looks very useful in hindsight. That ensured support for her here, although she was the second choice in the market behind the German challenger Dangerous Mind. Tracking in second early on as Nicole Dillon (GB) (Inchinor {GB}) took them along, she was asked to quicken in the straight, and she did so with enthusiasm, only being ridden with hands and heels to win going away impressively from Dangerous Mind, who stayed on well but had no chance with the winner. Super Tassa could not quicken at a crucial time and would have done well to trouble Sailing, who won with plenty in hand.

Having made a valiant attempt to lead all the way when second to Kingsalsa in the G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly May 30, Banyumanik gained some degree of consolation to take this Group 3 event on home soil. Humabo broke fast, but Banyumanik was quick to snatch the lead. Elle Danzig settled in second place, closely followed by Huambo, Kalatos (Ger) (Big Shuffle), Faberger (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}) and the three-year-old Bear King (Mujtahid). Once into the straight, Banyumanik increased the pace and kept on resolutely to win having made all. Elle Danzig tried to follow the leader in her run but clearly found the trip on the short side. Conversely, Huambo would have preferred a shorter trip but maintained third place.

Grundlefoot, who was briefly on the Triple Crown trail earlier this year, came from behind to score his first stakes victory. He finished third in the GIII Laurel Futurity last November, but was well-beaten in the GIII Holy Bull and the Tampa Bay Derby this year. He came into the Leonard Richards off a pair of second-place finishes at Pimlico in the Apr. 22 Federico Tesio and May 20 Sir Barton S. Wearing blinkers for the first time here, the bay colt was squeezed and bumped at the break by Snuck In (Montbrook). Grundlefoot then recovered and rated kindly for six furlongs, swung five wide into the stretch and ran down the leaders. "The blinkers probably helped him go right by them," said trainer Gary Capuano. Snuck In, fifth in the GI Preakness, was bet to 3-5 and dueled for the lead before tiring to finish fourth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths. "Turning for home, I just ran out of juice," said jockey Cash Asmussen.

## THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

June 19, 1867...The inaugural Belmont S. was run at Jerome Park in the Bronx and was won the filly Ruthless, who defeated colts and earned \$1,850 for her victory. Ruthless was one of a group of fillies known as the "Barbarous Battalion," daughters of the mare Barbarity owned by Francis Morris. The other "battalion" members--all full sisters by \*Eclipse--were Remorseless, Relentless, Regardless and Merciless.

June 20, 1908...With his final victory in the Tidal Stakes at Sheepshead Bay, Colin retired undefeated after 15 starts. No major American racehorse approached this record until 1988, when Personal Ensign retired with a perfect 13-for-13 career.

June 20, 1996...Emerald Downs in Auburn, Washington opened for its inaugural Thoroughbred meeting.

June 22, 1935...Seabiscuit, competing at Rhode Island's Narragansett Park, won his first race.

June 23, 1985...With his victory aboard Greinton in the Hollywood Gold Cup, Laffit Pincay Jr. became the second jockey in history to surpass \$100 million in career earnings.

June 24, 1893...The field for the American Derby at Washington Park was held at the post for 1 hour and 40 minutes, the longest pre-race delay in history. Boundless, with "Snapper" Garrison aboard, won the \$49,500 race, which was witnessed by a crowd of 48,000. Garrison and three other riders were each fined \$250 for bad conduct at the start.

June 24, 1952...Jockey Eddie Arcaro rode his 3000th career winner at Arlington Park, becoming the first American-born rider to reach the mark.

June 24, 1973...Charlie Whittingham swept the top three spots in the Hollywood Gold Cup Invitational Handicap when his trainees Kennedy Road, Quack and Cougar II finished first, second and third, respectively.

June 24, 1977...Alydar, at odds of 2.10-1, broke his maiden by 6 3/4-lengths at Belmont Park.

June 24, 1979...Affirmed, ridden by Laffit Pincay Jr., became the first horse to top \$2 million in earnings after he won the Hollywood Gold Cup.

June 24, 1990...Criminal Type became the first horse to win consecutive \$1 million races after capturing the Hollywood Gold Cup. He had previously won the \$1 million Pimlico Special May 12.
