MARVELOUS MILLENNIUM

Beware Charles, there's a new Prince of Wales. Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold), sent off the 5-4 second favourite in the end here, made all to make a mockery of the expected 'match' with 11-10 favourite Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) in a majestic display of racing in vesterday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. There is not much that can be said about Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking The Gold) that has not already been proferred and exclaimed already. He is truly an exceptional racehorse, and he has built on every success to become one of the greatest to race on both dirt and turf. When he won the Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 25, he was allowed to race in the way he wanted, which was fast all the way. Jockey Frankie Dettori's tactics that evening ensured that he would annihilate a field that included Behrens. Dettori had talked to Jerry Bailey before this and advised him to do the same and the American jockey produced the horse to win this without ever being pressed. The Godolphin team planted a second string in this race, intended 'rabbit' Rhythm Band (Cozzene), but as they broke from the gate it was quickly clear that he was not going to be able to play any part as he dropped away early. After a glance back, Bailey recognised the situation and set about his own task, which was to take Sendawar along in his slipstream. By the end of the first half mile, there were three lengths back to the French horse, and a further 10 to the chasing group. Those three lengths soon became five, and as Dubai Millennium turned for home, Gerald Mosse aboard the favorite was starting to go to work. The run up the straight amounted almost to a parade, as Bailey merely used his hands and heels to ensure the margin of victory his horse deserved. German contender Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) won the race for second with a strong run as Sendawar faded to finish fourth. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum spoke afterwards. "I've said it before and I'll say it again. He is the best we've ever had, a true champion. You don't come across a horse like this in 20 years. I knew from the way he trains, and looks, that there is no horse like this horse."

A Peek Into the Future:

Sheikh Mohammed indicated that the four-year-old will go for the Emirates World Series and will be retired at the end of the year to stand at Dalham Hall Stud. Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "I think ten furlongs is his best trip and although he has been entered for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. (Ascot July 29), the only time he has been beaten was in the G1 Epsom Derby over a mile and a half. There are no plans for him at the moment, apart from the fact that his last race will be in the Breeders' Cup Classic, and he will probably not do too much travelling before that."

The Jocks Chime In:

Jerry Bailey described the experience, "With a good horse you want the pressure. One was dirt and one was grass, but he's equally impressive as Cigar, without a doubt. I haven't seen any horse on the other side of the pond that can touch him. It's a wonderful experience, but this is Frankie's horse and I just appreciate filling in." Frankie Dettori added, "There are no words to describe him--he brings tears to my eyes. In our heart of hearts we knew it was a one-horse race, but everyone was talking of Sendawar as a great champion. It shows what Dubai Millennium can do with these great champions--he just kills them. He is a great champion."

Observatory is still lightly raced following a fairly lowkey two-year-old career. Too keen on his only attempt at pattern company when fourth in the G2 Mill Reef S. behind Primo Valentino (GB) last September, he was a subsequent winner in a Yarmouth conditions race a month later. He returned to run Shibboleth to a 1 1/4 lengths in the Listed King Charles II S. at Newmarket June 3. When that horse went on to run a close fourth in Tuesday's G1 St James' Palace S., the omens were good, and Observatory proved that to be the case with a strong run to claim his first stakes success. Although Darley did not jump too quickly, his mount soon made up the ground to achieve a prominent position after a furlong, and from there he was allowed to settle, tracking Three Points (GB) (Bering {GB}). As the pace increased at the halfway stage, he was finding more and moved to the front with a furlong remaining before going away under a strong drive to hold the challengers. John Gosden, who narrowly missed out when second with Valentino (GB) in Tuesday's St James' Palace S., was pleased that he had gone one better here. "Last year, he ran off in the Mill Reef, so the idea was to get him to switch off and settle him," Gosden said. "He may step up to a mile now, but mentally he's a little bit insecure. Darley added, "He's a nice horse, and he's proved he is a horse on the upgrade. I got a nice lead and once I committed him and put him there he just pricked his ears and was only doing enough. That winning post seems to get further and further away every time I ride here!"

Romantic Myth, from the stable of Tim Easterby, arrived on the scene in a Ripon maiden Apr. 5, and followed up success there with a win a conditions race at Chester May 9. Here she was ridden to perfection by Kevin Darley to maintain her unbeaten record whilst collecting an impressive first stakes success. She broke well and raced prominently in fourth early while travelling easily, and was moved up by Darley to take command with over a furlong remaining. As the others lined up to challenge, she was gone, and her turn of foot was telling as she left Al Ihsas (Ire) for dead, rushing to the line and extending under Darley to win going away. Owner and breeder Terry Holdcroft, who stands the sire Mind Games (GB), said, "It's marvellous--really thrilling. We're over the moon. I've always wanted to win this race since I started breeding 25 years ago, but I've never had anything good enough to run in it before. I'm particularly delighted as we stand the sire (at Bearstone Stud)." Darley, recording a quick double with this win, commented, "From day one she's been outstanding, and the big plus about her is she is so laid back about her job. She was a bit keen early and was running into daylight, but when I gave her the office she pricked her ears but every time I asked her she kept finding." The winner could resurface in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 24.

When Mark Johnston stated earlier in the week that Celtic Silence was the most exciting two-year-old he had had at Kingsley House for a while, it paid to take notice as he has handled such horses as Lend A Hand (GB), Mister Baileys (GB) and Bijou d'Inde (GB) thus far. The horse in question looked impressive in an Ayr maiden June 2, winning with authority, and he came into this race as favourite to prove his trainer right. He raced in mid-division in the centre of the track early as Celtic Island (GB) (Celtic Swing {GB}) took them along at a steady pace, which saw Baaridd suffer as he pulled for his head. Fallon was busy riding at halfway and it looked for a while as if he would not get there, but Celtic Silence kept responding to his rider's urgings and wrested the lead from Baaridd with 100 yards remaining before going away at the line to put safe distance between them. Mark Johnston said that the winner will now go for either the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot Sept. 24 or the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster Oct. 21.

The stage is set for Kayf Tara to reaffirm his position as the leading European stayer. Having missed last season's G1 Melbourne Cup due to injury, he reappeared as well as ever when easily taking the G2 Merewood Homes Yorkshire Cup at York May 18. He will start as strong favourite and if repeating the form of his York win can justify that status. The Godolphin hopeful won this race in 1998 and will be opposed by 1999 winner Enzeli and 1997 hero Celeric. Enzeli was a thoroughly deserving winner last year and will appreciate this extreme test of stamina. He showed his wellbeing when just touched off by Royal Rebel (GB) in the Listed Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown May 24. Celeric, on the other hand, still exudes class, but is not the force he once was. The prevalent fast ground will be in his favour, but he will do well to trouble the judge. Endorsement, returns after an absence of 326 days, is an undoubted stayer and was successful at this meeting last year as the winner of the G3 Queen's Vase.

A consolation prize for the G1 Vodafone Oaks vanquished, yet a classy event in its own right is the G2 Ribblesdale. Kalypso Katie is something of an obvious choice, but has an outstanding chance to gain compensation for her two-length second to Love Divine (GB) in the Oaks at Epsom June 9. She was experiencing defeat for the first time in three starts on that occasion and will start at short odds to return to winning ways. She should comfortably confirm Oaks form with Clipper, Whitefoot and Miletrian. Godolphin have won the two latest renewals of this event and are represented by the hitherto-unraced-this-season Teggiano. She makes her first start since courageously winning the G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile, under the care of Clive Brittain, at Ascot last September. The Queen's TDN Dark Horse Interlude overcame a variety of problems to be successful on her only juvenile start when scoring in a mile Doncaster maiden in October. Despite a slow start and enduring traffic problems during the race, she eventually won in good style. Unraced since, she has the potential to make the step up in grade.

Former champion jockey Lester Piggott is one of the part-owners of the Willie Haggas-trained filly and he has sound reason to be optimistic. The doctor at the scene said that the jockey was complaining of pain in his left shoulder, which was becoming swollen all the time. He was totally conscious throughout and more will be known when the x-rays are carried out. The other jockeys escaped without incident, but Seamus Heffernan said, "I am fine, but Kieren's arm does not look very good."
