CRIMPLENE'S CORONATION

Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern), sent off the 4-1 joint favourite, simply dominated yesterday's G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, drawing away in the straight to win by 2 1/2 easy lengths from Princess Ellen (GB) (Tirol {Ire}). Clive Brittain has trained some high-class fillies in his time, including Pebbles (GB), Sayyedati (GB) and User Friendly (GB), and he even handled Teggiano (Ire) last year when she won the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot before losing her to Godolphin. Brittain always said that this filly was almost as good, but she did not begin to prove him right until she returned from Dubai (after running sixth in the UAE Derby Mar. 25) this year. Her subsequent travels to Italy, Germany and Ireland provided success in the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) May 7 and the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas S. May 28, as well as a third to Xua (Ire) in the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) Apr. 30. Completing the mile in a time nearly a full second less than Tuesday's St James' Palace S., the filly claimed her second Group 1 success of the year. Although jockey Philip Robinson claimed that she slipped slightly coming from the stalls, she soon recovered and took to the front where she settled well, controlling the pace. Seazun (Ire) (Zieten) tracked her on the rail and Bluemamba (Kingmambo) and Amethyst (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) sat just off the pace, but by the entrance to the straight, it was only Princess Ellen who could attempt to go with her. The effort was fruitless, as Crimplene galloped away to establish herself in the same league as the other champions to have graced Carlburg Stables. Brittain said, "As soon as she kicked, they all flattened out. They have underestimated this filly all along. She was a little bit nervous last year, but when I took her to Dubai for three weeks it put her mentally right for the season. She's now a very serious filly, and we can go to lots of places. The idea was to give her a spell off, but she's a very difficult filly to give a holiday to. Before this my worry was that she hadn't run for two weeks. We'll go to Kentucky [for the Breeders' Cup] and believe it, we're coming to win." Robinson, enjoying only his second ever Royal Ascot success after piloting Katies (GB) to a win in this race in 1984, added, "The best is vet to come, and I wouldn't be surprised to see her go all over the world, as she thrives on racing. She is something very special." Seazun was reported to have broken a blood vessel and finished eighth of nine.

Henry Cecil last won this race in 1998 with the Thoroughbred Corporation's Royal Anthem, who went on to win last season's G1 Juddmonte International S. and claim his place amongst the best horses of a vintage year. Quite where Subtle Power stands in comparison is hard to gauge, but he turned in a display similar to his predecessor here. A winner of a Newbury maiden last month, he took a while to get the message there before coming home strongly. Last time out he was unable to catch Shamrock City (Ire) at Newmarket in the Listed Fairway S. June 11 over a mile and a quarter. With an extra two furlongs this time, he overcame inexperience and a lack of early pace to win his first stakes race impressively. Prominent early as the Godolphin pair Hatha Anna (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Roscius slowed the pace down from the front, he was travelling well enough. The pace still did not quicken noticeably until, with five furlongs remaining, the sprint was on. As Roscius went for home up the straight, Subtle Power had his measure and, taking over with two furlongs remaining, it was a case of the further they went the better he got. Forging clear inside the final furlong, he never looked likely to be caught, staying the trip well to put safe distance between him and the fast-finishing Zafonium, who took second place off Roscius. Willie Carson, racing manager for The Thoroughbred Corporation, said, "He is a horse with a future. You would never outbattle this fellow. Although he carries his head a little bit high, the further he goes the better he gets. He'a strong horse with a laid-back temperament." Cecil, finally claiming his first success at this year's meeting, commented, "They didn't go very fast, and he's bred to be a one-and-a-half mile horse, and he's very immature. I bought this for the owner in Ireland as he wanted a mile-and-a-half horse, and he got one. We'll see how we go along, but he'll progress, and that was a good effort for a big, backward horse. I'm very grateful to have a winner, and we just got by this year." Jockey Richard Quinn, recording his second win of the meeting, added, "He's a big, backward baby, and it's taken time for the penny to drop. They didn't go much of a gallop so I did ask the horse to go quite early, which you don't do at Ascot, but I had to. He will progress, and with racing a horse is going to get sharper. He'll make a lovely fourvear-old."

Fruits Of Love was nearly retired at the end of last year due to an injured suspensory ligament. He went from being third in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. to second in the GI Canadian International before finishing ninth in the G1 Japan Cup in November. But he won this race last year, defeating Royal Anthem in fine style under an expert ride from Olivier Peslier. Here it was a case of history repeating itself, with Peslier getting a tune out of the talented horse to bring him home in front of his stablemate, the game and progressive Yavana's Pace. These two dominated the entire race, with the winner settled just in behind the eight-year-old, who made it a true test of stamina. Last year Peslier was at the back of the field, but this year he decided to be nearer to the pace and the tactic was working as they swung into the straight, with Yavana's Pace committed and stretching for home. Peslier switched his mount to the outside with two furlongs remaining and, under a strong drive, eventually collared the runner-up with just over a furlong remaining. Trainer Mark Johnston was overjoyed, saying, "All the plans went out of the window as Peslier was supposed to be at the back, but they've still done it. Olivier said it was so easy--he just used hands and heels and away he went. Last year everything went wrong in the King George, but I said back in 1997, when he was working with Lend A Hand (GB), that he was top class, and I always thought he could worry the big guns. The vet reports told me to retire him this year, and most said he wouldn't come back, but I knew he would. Next is the G1 King George & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. (Ascot July 29), then Canada (GI Canadian International at Woodbine, Oct. 15)) and Japan (G1 Japan Cup, Nov. 26)."

Record Attendance at Royal Ascot

Yesterday's attendance was a record for the Friday of Royal Ascot, with 58,336 on hand, up 4.8 percent from the mark of 55,662 set last year. Total attendance stood at 237,254, an increase of 5.2 percent compared with the four-day total of 225,591 in 1999. Douglas Erskine-Crum, chief executive of Ascot Racecourse, said, "We had record crowds on the Tuesday and today, and racegoers have enjoyed outstanding racing all week."

Fallon Leads the Field

Jockey Kieren Fallon, still in hospital on the last day of Royal Ascot, took the London Clubs Charity Trophy for riding the most winners at this year's meeting. The four winners he rode on Tuesday and Wednesday were enough to hold off Johnny Murtagh and Richard Quinn, who rode three apiece. Quinn's three winners have earned £1,200 for Ascot's Charity Appeal, as Coral Bookmakers' Internet betting service, Eurobet, agreed to donate £400 for every Ascot winner ridden by Quinn from the start of the Royal meeting until the end of the season.

ALLEGED DEAD Alleged (Hoist the Flag), two-time winner of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, died yesterday and was laid to rest at Walmac International in Lexington, Kentucky. The 26-year-old stallion, pensioned in 1997, succumbed to the infirmities of old age. The champion three-year-old in England and France and champion older horse in France, Alleged captured the 1977 and 1978 Arcs. He ran second in the G1 English St. Leger, in the only loss of his 10-race career. "In every way, Alleged was a champion," said Walmac owner John T. L. Jones. "Few stallions come along that prove to be great sires and broodmare sires and continue to influence the breed for decades after their lifetime. It appears Alleged is one of those stalwarts of the turf. He will truly be missed." Alleged sired champions Law Society, Miss Alleged, Sir Harry Lewis, Midway Lady, Legal Case, Strategic Choice, Shantou and Muhtarram, as well as 154 stakes horses, 98 stakes winners and earners of more than \$38 million.

KINGMAMBO RECOVERING Leading sire Kingmambo (Mr. Prospector) has bounced back from a stomach infection, but will not breed any more mares this season, sources reported yesterday. The 10-year-old stallion had already covered 125 mares before being diagnosed with enteritis. Treated at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington, he has returned to Lane's End. In addition to Japanese Horse of the Year El Condor Pasa and Belmont winner Lemon Drop Kid, Kingmambo has sired 2000 classic winners King's Best and Bluemamba.

ARLINGTON/CHURCHILL DEAL OFFICIAL

Churchill Downs Inc. and Duchossois Industries Inc. have signed a definitive agreement which will merge Arlington International Racecourse Inc., Arlington Management Services, Inc. and Turf Club of Illinois Inc., with subsidiaries of CDI. Under the terms of the agreement, upon closing CDI will issue 3.15 million shares of its common stock to DII. Richard Duchossois, chairman of DII, will serve as a CDI director, as a member of the board's executive committee and as chairman of Arlington's operating board. DII will be entitled initially to designate three members of the CDI board of directors, which will expand to 15 members. "The horse racing industry is consolidating in response to a changing market and new distribution systems," said Thomas Meeker, CDI's president and chief executive officer. "Our merger with Arlington is the beginning of a strategic relationship that will enable us to combine resources with a world-class operation that is committed to quality live racing, positioning both companies for future growth in this changing industry." CDI currently operates Ellis Park, Calder Race Course and Hollywood Park. Duchossois commented, "We believe this merger will allow us to complement the Arlington brand of excellence with that of Churchill Downs, the best-known brand in horse racing."

SURGERY FOR ARISTOTLE Aristotle (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), winner of the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster last September, has been found to have cysts on his epiglottis, which may explain his disappointing 10th-placed effort in the G1 Epsom Derby June 10. He is due to have the cysts surgically removed. "I knew his run in the Derby was too bad to be true and Michael Kinane said that he stopped so quickly that there must be something wrong," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "Dr Paul Thorpe is flying from America to perform the procedure and all going well he should be back in work before the end of the year."
