CHAMP VICTORIOUS, SEEKING GOLD

Round One went to Heritage of Gold when that one caught a returning Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) in the GI Apple Blossom, but an authoritative victory in yesterday's GI Hempstead H. at Belmont sets up the Eclipse Award winner for Saratoga showdown with her rival in the GI Go For Wand July 30. A nondescript fifth at Oaklawn in April, the five-year-old returned to Elmont to score an easy 6 3/4-length victory in the GII Shuvee H. in her last effort May 20 and was the prohibitive favorite to run her local record to four-for-six lifetime. Sent immediately to the front, Beautiful Pleasure carved out strong fractions of :23, :45 3/5 and 1:09 3/5 as second choice Roza Robata (Fire Maker) chased in vain. The bay was seven lengths clear with an eighth of a mile to run and was eased down the final sixteenth to win with something left in the tank--for Saratoga. "I was extremely impressed with the strength she showed at the top of the stretch. This is an unbelievable improvement over where she was at this time last year," commented trainer John Ward. Winning jockey Jorge Chavez echoed the sentiments of the racing world. "I hope she and Heritage of Gold stay healthy. I want to run against her."

WHO'S THE FAIREST OF THEM ALL?

While the distaff division on the East Coast readies itself for a potential clash of the titans, West Coastbased Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) has quietly established herself as the queen of the West Coast. Unbeaten in her last three dirt starts, the bay will try to sweep Hollywood Park's series for older fillies and mares, which consists of the GII Hawthorne H., the GI Milady Breeders' Cup and the GI Vanity. In the Milady May 28, the five-year-old set a pressured pace, but shook off all challengers and coasted home under a hand ride to win by 3 1/4 lengths, accounting for Bordelaise (Arg) (Espacial {Arg}) and Excellent Meeting (General Meeting), "She was hooked from all sides and they went very fast up front," said trainer Eduardo Inda of Riboletta. "But she still drew off in the stretch. It takes a very good horse to win like she did." Excellent Meeting finished third in the Milady, beaten nearly five lengths, but it was only her second start off a long layoff. Fifth in last year's Kentucky Derby, Excellent Meeting has fired three straight bullets and seems to be approaching her sharp form of last year in which she won four graded stakes, including two Grade Is. Bordelaise finished second in the Milady last out after a wide move and third in the GI Apple Blossom on April 9 behind division leader Heritage of Gold. She gets a sevenpound break in the weights from Riboletta. Speaking of Time (Gilded Time), third in the Hawthorne, was fourth, just a nose behind Excellent Meeting in the Milady and has a board chance.

Queenie Belle did her best work last season against California-bred company, including a second-place finish in the CTBA S. at Del Mar July 23. Rested after a narrow defeat in Bay Meadows' Oct. 10 Courtship S., the dark bay was the runner up in the Boo La Boo S. for Cal-breds Feb. 19 before winning an open allowance at Santa Anita Mar. 23. Fourth against state-bred males in Hollywood's Snow Chief S. Apr. 30, she was tried on the grass for the first time and finished fourth, beaten five lengths in the GII Honeymoon H. May 27. Returned to the main track for this event, Queenie Belle was made the favorite over \$1,700,000 yearling Saudi Poetry and Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' winner Cash Run. among others. Queenie Belle took up a stalking position behind Annie Lil (Lil Tyler) for the opening six furlongs and put a head in front with just over two furlongs to run. Angled towards the rail, the Ben Cecil trainee was 2 1/2 lengths clear at the stretch call and proved easily best. Winning rider Brice Blanc commented, "I thought there would be more pace in the race. My filly broke like a rocket and after a sixteenth of a mile, it seemed like nobody wanted the lead. She was very comfortable and so I just let her go and tried to keep her relaxed."

Stepping into graded stakes competition for the first time, Inexplicable came from well back to win the New Hampshire Sweepstakes, setting a new course record. The chestnut horse had won consecutive allowance races earlier this winter at Gulfstream. After two months off, he returned to finished fourth behind Quiet Resolve in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 27 and a close second in a Belmont allowance a month later. Sent off the third choice, Inexplicable rated in seventh early. He rallied three-wide on the final turn, split horses and surged to battle with Where's Taylor to the wire. "I knew I won on the bob of the head," said Jose Santos. Haami, the 9-5 favorite, pulled up lame and was vanned off.

Colstar could well be the Rodney Dangerfield of the filly/mare turf division. All she had done coming into this event was win six of nine lifetime and three in a row, including a 2 1/2-length victory in Pimlico's GIII Gallorette H. May 19. Despite those lofty accomplishments, the Churchill faithful sent the four-year-old away as the fourht choice in the field of six. Perfectly positioned in third as Pricearose and Stars Games (Rahv) set a good pace, Maryland-based jockey Alberto Delgado asked the four-year-old for run three deep rounding the far turn, responded to run up alongside Pricearose at the eighth pole and drew away to another clear-cut victory. The victory was the first in a Churchill stakes for Delgado. "She's just now learning how to run. When I saw those two horses going out to the lead, I thought this was beautiful. I just sat back and waited." Winning trainer Paul Fout said, "The bettors didn't give us any respect, but who cares, as long as you win." Fout indicated that the GII New York H. at Belmont July 15 is under consideration for Colstar.

The winner of the Bobby Hale S. at Timonium in his two-year-old finale last Aug. 28, Disco Rico danced his way to a 4 1/2-length victory in a May 12 Pimlico optional claiming event, before hooking Max's Pal in his last, falling 3/4 of a length shy when second in Delaware's Legal Light S. June 3. Breaking from the outside post in the field of six, the normally speedy Disco Rico was super quick away from the gate to lead through remarkable splits of :21 1/5 for the quarter and :43 2/5 after four furlongs. With slight favorite Max's Pal alongside down the lane, the bay dug deep and found just enough to withstand a late bid from Max's Pal to score his first graded-stakes victory.

T.M. Opera-Oh, last year's Japanese 2000 Guineas winner, is riding a three-race winning streak into the Takarazuka Memorial. The four-year-old colt is undefeated at Hashin in three starts. Regular jockey Ryuju Wada said the Japan Cup could be on the colt's schedule if he keeps on his winning ways. The main competition will be the American-bred Grass Wonder who is trying to recaputure his sharp form of last year. The five-year-old finished sixth in the GII Nikkei Sho on Mar. 26 and ninth in the GII Keio Hai Spring Cup on May 14. Said trainer Mitsuhiro Ogata, "I spoke to his owner and we have made a decision that he will be retired if he loses this race."

Beat Hollow will bid to win his first Group 1 race and live up to his trainer's lofty expectations here. Long-time ante-post favourite for the G1 Epsom Derby, his chance was undermined in the build-up to that Classic by illness in mid-May. The fact that he finished third there, beaten only six lengths in only his third start, speaks volumes for his natural ability. He had hinted at it previously in the Listed Newmarket S. May 5, beating stablemate Sandmason (GB) easily. Epsom Derby form is also represented by Godolphin's Best Of The Bests, who was a further four lengths behind today's rival in fourth, having been ridden from the front for most of the way, a circumstance which connections had not planned for. He had smart two-year-old form, having been narrowly beaten by Royal Kingdom (Ire) in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot in September, and he will go close to reversing the form if he is at his best. The French defence looks vulnerable, but one horse who could put up a bold show is Crimson Quest, who found Lord Flasheart a nose too good in the G2 Prix d'Hocquart at Chantilly May 8. Andre Fabre took seven renewals of this race in the last decade, including the last three years with Slickly (Fr), Peintre Celebre and Grape Tree Road (GB), so Crimson Quest must command respect. Rhenium benefitted from the interference caused by Aristotle (Ire) to Boutron in the G2 Prix Greffulhe, but he will have to improve to figure here.

Trainer Criquette Head has already taken this year's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) with Egyptband and she puts forward another useful filly here in America. She created an impression when running away with the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp Apr. 30 from Hidalguia (Ire), but disappointed next time in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 21 when sixth behind Reve d'Oscar (Fr), but as Hidalguia (Ire) was third that day, it may have been an aberration. The stable is also represented by G3 Prix de Royaumont (Chantilly June 3) winner Sadler's Flag, which was an improved effort on her previous runs this season. CRIMPLENE'S NEW COURSE

Clive Brittain, said that his star filly filly Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern {USA}) would step up in trip now after excelling over a mile. The chestnut won the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf May 7 and G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 28 before annexing the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot on Friday. Brittain was not unhappy to compare this filly with past stars of his stable such as Pebbles (GB) and User Friendly (GB): "I think she's going that way. I think she'll get the mile-and-a-quarter, and like Pebbles, maybe even a mile-and-a-half. It's hard to give a filly like this a rest, because she just loves it, but she'll probably go for the G1 Nassau S. [Goodwood, Aug 5] next, and her target will be the Breeders' Cup Distaff [Churchill Downs, Nov. 4]."

FALLON FACES LENGTHY ABSENCE

Although it was first thought that Kieren Fallon's injuries as a result of the pile-up at Royal Ascot on Wednesday were not too serious, it seems that they are serious enough to ensure that the champion jockey will be missing from action for some time. He underwent major surgery on his shoulder at the National Orthopaedic Hospital in Stanmore, Middlesex on Thursday night to restore the nerves and to graft on new ones. "It is a serious operation and he will be out of action for a long time," trainer Sir Michael Stoute told the *Daily Mail*. His absence from race-riding could jeopardise his bid for his fourth consecutive season riding over 200 winners. He took the London Clubs Trophy as top jockey at the Royal meeting despite mising the last two days.

GODOLPHIN MOVE TO STANLEY HOUSE

Godolphin announced yesterday that they will be moving their two-year-old operation from Evry, France to the vacant Stanley House Stables at Newmarket, previously occupied by John Gosden until he took to Manton last year. Formerly Newmarket-based, David Loder is set to return to continue his training of the Godolphin juveniles, which will approximately number 100. According to Godolphin's website, "Godolphin's European two-year-old operation was established at the former Evry Racecourse in France in late 1998, in time for the 1999 season. At that time Stanley House Stables was not available and the French site, which is leased, was the most suitable for a private training operation."

KING'S BEST MAY GO TO THE CURRAGH

G1 2000 Guineas winner King's Best (USA) (Kingmambo {USA}) may take his chance in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh next Sunday after pleasing connections in a spin yesterday morning on the Newmarket Heath. If he does so, he will have to face G1 Epsom Derby winner Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA} and G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Holding Court (GB) (Hernando {Fr}). It was Pat Eddery who partnered the colt on the gallops, as Fallon is injured, and all were pleased with what they saw. Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Saeed Suhail, said: "King's Best went very nicely, just as we expected him to go. It was a nice bit of work over roughly a mile or nine furlongs with Pat Eddery in the saddle. It's up to the owner to make a decision in the next day or so. It will be a cracking race at the Curragh if he participates." Eddery will take the ride in Ireland should the horse take his chance.

With the favourite High Walden refusing to enter the stalls, the race was opened up slightly as an opportunity for the rest of the field. It was Port Vila who stepped forward to claim his first stakes success as a result, providing a one-two for owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum as he fought out the finish with Rasm. Port Vila took part in the G1 Dewhurst S. last season, and although he was fourth of five, he was only beaten 5 1/2 lengths by Distant Music (USA). He returned to be third behind Shamrock City (Ire) and Subtle Power (Ire) in the Listed Fairway S. Newmarket June 11, the form of which was boosted by the latter's win in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot on Friday. Port Vila was held up in last place early here as Merry Merlin (GB) (Polar Falcon {USA}) took no prisoners in front. Richard Hills waited until the turn into the straight to make his move, and when he asked him to quicken he did so to unleash his turn-of-foot up the rail. As Hills had him in top flight, he had to go in pursuit of Rasm, who looked the winner a furlong out. Catching that horse with 100 yards remaining, he maintained his momentum all the way to the line to win in style. He may now head for the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Deauville July 14.

Lot one is an Ascot Knight (CAN) half-brother to Gr.1 Caulfield Guineas winner Kenwood Melody (Royal Academy {USA}) out of Bletchingly mare Egrette. Among the broodmares, the rising 20-year-old Vin D'Etoile (Ruling {USA}) (Lot 313) could be among the top-priced mares as she is the dam of Group One placed Delinquent and she is a half-sister to the mighty Eau D'Etoile (Sir Tristram {IRE}). Eau D'Etoile is the well-known dam of Group One stars Filante, Bint Marscay and Kenny's Best Pal. Vin D'Etoile has a rising two-vear-old called Thunder Zone (Prized {USA}) as her last foal and is not currently in foal. Both the Ascot Knight weanling and Vin D'Etoile will be offered by Eliza Park Stud. "I think it is fair to say that while once vendors tended to sell horses they didn't want as weanlings, the market has changed and is now very viable," said Inglis Melbourne chief Peter Heagney. "Now vendors are sending well conformed, good quality weanlings. And of course it is great for studs to offer weanlings by first crop sires and create an awareness of their stallion's progeny." Several individual buyers have had boom results in recent years pinhooking weanlings. "This year that weanlings by commercial horses such as Danzero (Aus) and Canny Lad (Aus) will be sought after," said Heagney. Last year's average was \$6,585 for weanlings at a sale were 190 were sold for a gross of \$1,252,000 with a top price of \$38,000 for a youngster by Grand Lodge.
