FUSAICHI PEGASUS TO COOLMORE?

Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector--Angel Fever, by Danzig) has reportedly been sold to Coolmore Stud. The three-year-old has been the subject of a furious bidding war, with Rich Decker, president of WinStar Farm in Kentucky, telling the Lexington Herald-Leader, "I've heard [the bidding] is as high as \$60 million." Craig Bandoroff, president of Denali Stud, was quoted as saying, "The last I heard, Ashford [Coolmore's Kentucky division] kind of had it locked up." Richard Henry, representative of Coolmore, would not confirm or deny that the deal had been signed when reached in Ireland last night, and would say only, "In any deal of this nature, the horse would have to pass the vet first." Second in the May 20 GI Preakness is his latest start, Fusaichi Pegasus suffered a slight hoof injury which kept him out of the June 10 Belmont S. and plans for his racing future remain up in the air.

UNBEATABLE IN GRAND PRIX DE PARIS

Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells) has always been considered of the highest class, even when all he had on his resume was a Yarmouth maiden win, and he confirmed that assessment with a one-length win over Premier Pas (Fr) (Sillery) in yesterday's G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp. Rested after his maiden score, the colt made his reappearance in the Listed Newmarket S. May 5 and struck a lasting impression as he quickened away to win with ease and book his Derby ticket. When illness hit the Henry Cecil yard in May he was one of those to go down, but he quickly returned to good health to stake his claim at Epsom June 10. Coltish in the paddock, he nevertheless belied his inexperience to run third behind the more battle-hardened Sinndar (Ire), but Cecil reported that he did not feel that he stayed and therefore decided to bring him back in trip here. Restrained in fourth early as Godolphin's Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian) made the running, Beat Hollow was inclined to pull for his head off an easy pace, but jockey Richard Quinn soon had him settled. Third approaching the final turn, he drew on even terms with the Godolphin challenger at the quarter-mile marker and lengthened away to the victory. Cecil said, "I was very pleased, as this horse is still a baby and has a lot to learn. The experience will do him a lot of good. I don't know where he will go yet--we'll have to see."

EGO TRIP FOR RIBOLETTA

Sent off the 3-5 favorite in yesterday's GI Vanity H. at Hollywood Park, Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) made herself look good, sitting second for a half before cruising to the lead and a 5 1/2-length victory over 30-1 Speaking Of Time (Gilded Time). It was the third straight graded win for the five-year-old mare, who came home seven lengths to the good in the May 7 GII Hawthorne H. and wired the field in the May 28 GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. last time out to sweep the Hollywood series for older distaffers. "She was obviously just the best horse in the race," jockey Chris McCarron said. "She's very good. It takes a very good horse to sweep the series, and she showed she's a top-class mare." A Group 1 winner in Brazil, the bay won only one of her first eight starts in the U.S., but opened eyes with a win in the Mar. 5 GI Santa Margarita H. and, after a distant third trying turf in the Miss America H. at Golden Gate, started her current streak. As for where she'll head in search of her fourth in a row, trainer Eduardo Inda said, "We have to keep her fresh. I think she runs good fresh. We'll give her two or three races before the Breeders' Cup." The mare will have to be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Distaff.

Last year's Japanese 2000 Guineas winner rated far back early and rallied outside on the final turn of the right-handed course. The heavy favorite got his third Group 1 win when he surged to the front in the final furlong and prevailed in a blanket finish.

America bounced back here from a disappointing display in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary Longchamp May 21 when only sixth and showed the sort of form that had impressed when winning the G3 Prix Vanteaux Longchamp Apr. 30. She is clearly a filly with a fine turn of foot, and her jockey utilized that here to full effect to place America back into contention for the major races later in the season. The crowd's choice, she settled in third early as Music Park (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) cut out the early running, but the lack of real pace ensured an imminent sprint. With this in mind, jockey Olivier Doleuze had her close to the leader; he angled her out with two furlongs remaining and asked her to quicken. Her response was instant, and with one slap of the whip she quickly took to the head of affairs with a furlong to race. From there she had too much pace, and as Polar Charge and Sadler's Flag appeared on either side of her tail, she provided a final burst of speed to make the race safe. Trainer Criquette Head commented, "I always thought that she was a nice filly, and she was the one I had in mind for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 3, but I had to let her down a bit after the G1 Prix Saint-Alary as she was not well afterwards. I gave her some time to come around again, and she proved all her quality today. She will now have a rest and come back to race in the autumn." Stakes Results cont. p3

Flamingo Road, winner of last year's G2 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) at Mulheim, is used to mixing it with the colts, having been third in the G1 Deutsches Derby here last July and in the G1 E.L.E. Pokal-Grosser Erdgas-Preis at Gelsenkirchen a month later. She was runner-up in the G1 Mercedes-Benz-Grosser Preis Von Baden at Baden Baden in September to Tiger Hill (Ire), form which proved she was good enough for a crack at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Longchamp in October, where she finished a respectable 10th. She has been relatively disappointing so far this year, last time finishing 8 1/2 lengths behind Silvano when third in the G2 Emirates-Grosser Preis der Wirtschaft June 4. She bounced back here with a fine front-running display to readily reverse that form and put herself back in the top league. Although she set a moderate pace in front, Silvano was struggling by halfway and by the time they turned into the straight, the filly was clear and looked in no danger from her old adversary. It was Albaran who loomed, but Flamingo Road shook off her nearest challenger with a furlong to race, going clear to win in style. Sunday, Woodbine

Returning from a layoff of nearly seven months, Kahal closed from last to win the Nearctic H. over a boggy turf course. The six-year-old had tried turf sprinting just once in North America last year and was successful, winning the GIII Morvich H. at Santa Anita on Nov. 6. He tried stretching out in his only start this year, the Jan. 1 GII San Gabriel H., but finished a well-beaten sixth behind Brave Act (GB). Neil Drysdale prepared Kahal with a string of six-furlong turf workouts at Hollywood, and the horse was in top shape. Tenth early, the homebred moved up on the turn while saving ground, split horses four wide in upper stretch and outkicked Gone Fishin, the favorite, who also closed swiftly from well behind.

Yankee Victor, unbeaten since losing a testicle to the surgeon's knife, was coming off an impressive 4 3/4-length triumph in the May 29 GI Met Mile and faced a much softer field here. Looking for his fourth straight, all at a mile, the dark bay went right to the front, cruised through a half in :46 2/5, shook off a minor challenge from Bright Valour after six furlongs in 1:10 2/5 and drew off again as much the best. "He did it very easy," jockey Herbie Castillo Jr. said. "After his effort last time, he just came in and took to the track. Once he got a clear break, he got the first quarter pretty easy and at the top of the stretch he just took over." As for the future, trainer Carlos Morales said, "Right now, our main goal is the Whitney at Saratoga [GI, Aug. 6]. I'll sit down with the owners and decide what to do before then. We'll look at the [July 22, GII] Washington Park H. at Arlington and the [July 22, GIII] Salvator Mile at Monmouth Park."

Josr Algarhoud had won the G2 Gimcrack S. at York in his two-year-old year when trained by Mick Channon, who always considered him one of the best he had handled. Still lightly raced despite being a four-year-old, he produced two fair efforts in Group 2 company last year when second in the Celebration Mile at Goodwood Aug. 28 and third in the Challenge S. at Newmarket Oct. 16. He made his 2000 bow here, having been supplemented, with an encouraging success to beat horses with the benefit of racecourse experience already this season. Racing in mid-division early as Diableneyev (Nurevev) took over from Tumbleweed Ridge, Josr Algarhoud was travelling well. As the pace was picked up at halfway, he loomed closer to the leaders on the outside and as they entered the straight, he was positioned in the slipstream of Diableneyev and Tumblweed Ridge. He responded gamely when asked to deliver a run which saw him hit the front with 150 yards remaining before holding off the late challenge of Cap Coz, who had threaded her way through the field on the rail. The result represented a unique one-two for the broodmare Pont Aven (Ire), and for Kilfrush Stud Ltd., who also bred the third in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris, Rhenium (Ire).
