LUCIEN LAURIN DEAD AT 88

Lucien Laurin, the Hall of Fame trainer who conditioned Triple Crown hero Secretariat, Riva Ridge and several other top horses, died yesterday. He was 88. Laurin broke his hip in a fall last week and passed away from complications resulting from surgery to repair the hip. "It's very hard to lose a friend who was so important to me and Secretariat," said Secretariat's owner Penny Chenery. "We went through very trying and very triumphant times together. Lucien's methods and his approach to training a race horse worked with Secretariat. He was hard on a horse, but Secretariat was so strong and had so much energy that if he hadn't been challenged by Lucien the way he was, I'm not sure we would have seen the great horse Secretariat come to be." Added former jockey Ron Turcotte, Secretariat's regular rider, "It's like he was part of the family. He wasn't like a boss...he was more of a friend to me. We worked real good as a team." Laurin, of French Canadian descent, began his career in racing as a jockey, winning 161 races before moving on to training. He began his new career in 1942 on the New England circuit, training his first champion, top two-year-old filly Quill, in 1958. But it was with Meadow Stable that he made his mark. He took over the Meadow Stable string in 1971 and developed that year's two-year-old champion, Riva Ridge, who won the Kentucky Derby and Belmont the following year. In 1973, Laurin swept the Triple Crown with two-time Horse of the Year Secretariat. The white-haired horseman retired in 1976, making only a brief comeback in 1983. He joined racing's Hall of Fame in 1977. "I can't say I was surprised," Turcotte said of Laurin's death. "When I spoke to him for the last time, which was a couple of months ago, he said that he was feeling fine, but he didn't sound too good." Laurin is survived by his wife Juliette and son Roger. Funeral arrangements are pending.

History often repeats itself, but not usually this quickly. Mr. Prospector sired his second Classic winner of the season when Scatter the Gold captured Canada's premier three-year-old contest, the Queen's Plate. A member of Mr. Prospector's 22nd crop, as is this year's GI Kentucky Derby victor Fusaichi Pegasus, Scatter the Gold is, like Fusaichi Pegasus, out of a Danzig mare. What's more, the second dams of both horses are by grandsons of Turn-to.

Scatter the Gold, who raced in the colors of his breeder, Sam-Son Farm, was a reminder of the achievements of Sam-Son's owner, the late Ernie Samuels, who died exactly one month prior to Scatter the Gold's victory.

Scatter the Gold is a descendent of No Class, a Sam-Son Farm foundation mare, and a mare whose offspring have cut a wide swathe through Canadian and North American racing. A stakes placed daughter of Nodouble out of Classy Quillo, by Princequillo, she was purchased by Samuels for \$25,000 at the 1975 CTHS Yearling Sales.

No Class was not the most consistent producer, in numerical terms at least. After producing two foals in her first two years at stud, she never again had offspring in consecutive years. In fact, 14 breeding seasons yielded just eight live offspring. Still, whatever shortfall there was in quantity was more than made up for in quality. No Class's second, third and fourth foals were all champions, the filly Classy 'n Smart (Smarten) being followed the colts Grey Classic (Grey Dawn II), Regal Classic (Vice Regent) and Sky Classic (Nijinsky II), who was also a Champion Turf Horse in the U.S.

The skein was snapped in 1988 by the unraced Seattle Slew filly Classic Slew. The only non-winner among No Class's foals, Classic Slew has already produced Comet Kris, who took third in the Breeders' S.

Subsequently, No Class produced just two more foals, Classic Reign, a multiple stakes- winning filly by Vice Regent, and, after a hiatus of three years, the GI Early Times Turf Classic victor Always A Classic.

No Class's first daughter, Classy 'n Smart, has added considerably to the family's Classic luster. Herself heroine of the Canadian Oaks, she produced a truly exceptional filly in Dance Smartly (Danzig), winner of 12 of 17 starts, including all three legs of the Canadian Triple Crown, the Canadian Oaks, and the Breeders' Cup Distaff. In addition to Canadian Horse of the Year honors, Dance Smartly also carried off an Eclipse Award as Champion Three-Year-Old Filly, and Sovereign Awards as Canada's Champion Two- and Three-Year-Old Filly.

Four years after Dance Smartly, Classy 'n Smart produced the Mr. Prospector colt Smart Strike. His career was interrupted, and final terminated, by injury problems, but not before he won six of eight starts, including the GII Philip H. Iselin H. and GIII Salvator Mile H.

Given the ability of Smart Strike and the success of the Mr. Prospector/Northern Dancer cross, the decision to send Dance Smartly to Mr. Prospector must have been a very easy one to make. The first product of the mating was Dance Brightly, who won a maiden race at Woodbine in impressive style and finished second in the Coronation Futurity, his only two starts before injury ended his career.

Dance Smartly then visited Mr. Prospector's son, Seeking the Gold (producing the moderate colt Seek Smartly) before returning to Mr. Prospector for the mating which resulted in Scatter the Gold. She returned to Mr. Prospector the following year, producing a filly, now named Dancethruthedawn.

Scatter the Gold was not as precocious as his brother Dance Brightly, and the 10-furlong Queen's Plate was actually his first victory in five starts.

Oddly enough, until the appearance of Fusaichi Pegasus and Scatter the Gold, the direct cross of Danzig over Mr. Prospector had produced just one other minor stakes winner from a total of 24 foals bred on the cross. That said, Mr. Prospector-line stallions have been responsible for about a third of all unrestricted stakes winners produced by Danzig mares.

There is another surprising aspect to this story. The cross of Mr. Prospector over Danzig might have been perceived as likely to beget pure speed, but in addition to the 10-furlong Classic winners Fusaichi Pegasus and Scatter the Gold, it has also come up with G1 Dubai World Cup hero Almutwakel; Golden Jack, who took the Japanese Oaks Trial over 10 furlongs; and Ecton Park, winner of the nine-furlong GI Super Derby.

JOHN R. GAINES THOROUGHBREDS SOLD John R. Gaines has sold a 100-percent interest in his John R. Gaines Thoroughbreds to Olin B. Gentry and partners. The terms of the sale were not released. "With this transaction we have acquired all of the assets of John R. Gaines Thoroughbreds: broodmares, yearlings, foals and stallion interests," Gentry said. "The broodmare band consists of 110 mares and is unquestionably one of the premier commercial bands...in the world. The mares and their progeny have earned \$70 million, won or placed in 243 Grade I races and produced 15 champion performers." He added, "We will continue our policy of selling our foal crop as weanlings each year. This year's crop will include five foals by Storm Cat, four by Sadler's Wells, four by Theatrical (Ire), two by Nureyev, two by Seattle Slew, two by Red Ransom and one each by A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, Unbridled, Kris S. and Silver Hawk." Gaines said, "There comes a time when the torch must be passed on to a new younger generation, and I am not involved in the company in any capacity. However, I will continue my involvement in various industry organizations. I recently returned to the Board of Directors of the Breeders' Cup and to the Kentucky State Horse Park, organizations that I founded."

Arlington-Churchill Merger Questioned:

An Illinois state legislator has requested an investigation into the merger between Arlington International Racecourse and Churchill Downs, according to the *Thoroughbred Times*. State Representative Jeff Schoenberg (D) has questioned whether the state tax breaks and additional financial assistance which were given to Arlington when it reopened this year were used to increase the value of the track and make it more attractive to buyers, and also asked if the subsidies Arlington received can be taken back if it is found that the track was discussing merger plans with Churchill as the legislation which provided the financial relief was in the process of being passed last year. Thom Serafin, a spokesman for Arlington's owner Dick Duchossois, told the *Chicago Tribune* that the discussions "were recent." He also said that there wouldn't have been anything to discuss prior to the track's reopening because, "you can't talk business when there is no business." Schoenberg has requested that the investigation be completed before the Illinois Racing Board rules on the merger at its August meeting.

Having broken the A\$1 million stakes mark, she will go to Danehill (USA) this season. She won the G3 Winter S. at Eagle Farm on Saturday as the 9-4 favorite, storming down the centre of the track to down Crestfallen (Aus) by two lengths with Sydney filly Stella Maree (Aus) a further length away third. Bonanova was bred by former leading trainer Neville Beg, who sold her last July for a reported \$1 million to boutique breeder Jim Fleming of Tyreel Stud. Bonanova, trained by Begg's son Grahame, won the G1 Emirates S. last spring in Melbourne. "It's a very fitting way for her to go out," the younger Begg said. "I'm sorry to lose her and she'll be very hard to replace. Who knows, when she goes to stud we might even get a Group 1 winner out of her."

MEDAALY TO INVERNESS STUD

Charnwood Forest (Ire)'s six individual winners to date have not gone unnoticed in Australasia and now his half brother Medaaly (GB) (Highest Honour {Fr}--Dance Of Leaves {GB}, by Sadler's Wells {USA}) will stand at Inverness Stud in the NSW southern highlands. G1 Racing Post trophy winner Medaaly reportedly covered 111 mares in his first season at stud in France in 1999 and he'll stand at A\$8,800. Dr Jack and Sue Wooldridge's Inverness Stud is the home of Sunline (NZ)'s dam Songline (NZ), who is in foal to Danehill (USA).
