YANKEE VICTOR RETIRED

Grade I winner Yankee Victor (Saint Ballado--Highest Carol, by Caro {Ire}) has been retired from racing after suffering an ankle injury while winning Sunday's GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington Park. "He came out of the race with a little problem in his right front ankle," confirmed trainer Carlos Morales. "We could give him some time off and try to bring him back, but he is already a four-year-old and he is not Breeders' Cup eligible. There is also no guarantee he would come back 100 percent. He's been good to me and I want to do what's right for him. I am very fortunate to have had the opportunity to train such a terrific horse." Yankee Victor was a dominant 4 3/4-length winner of the May 29 GI Metropolitan H. He retires with nine wins in 19 starts and earnings of \$893,806. Stud plans have not been finalized.

CETEWAYO RETURNS IN U.N.

Cetewayo (His Majesty), winner of the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga in 1998, has not been to the starting gate since taking the Riggs H. at Pimlico more than 13 months ago, but will return to action in tomorrow's GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park. "He had a few niggling problems last year, so we finally quit on him in the fall," trainer Michael Dickinson explained. "We started him back into training in January and he seems to be doing satisfactorily. He has never been a good morning horse, he has never been impressive in his morning workouts, so he's hard to gauge. But he is a good-winded horse and if he is back to his best, he has a chance. We are hopeful, but not overconfident."

ON-LINE ENTRIES FOR KEENELAND

NOVEMBER Keeneland will provide for on-line entries in time for its November Breeding Stock Sale. Entries for the sale close August 1. "This new on-line entry process will help all consignors from the largest to the smallest," said Keeneland's director of sales Rogers Beasley. The optional on-line entry system can be accessed at Keeneland's home page on the Internet--keeneland.com--starting in mid-July. Keeneland will also add an on-line Reserve Not Attained sale in conjunction with its September Yearling Sale. "If the marketplace utilizes the online option, it is our plan to make it a standard feature for all Keeneland sales," said Keeneland president Nick Nicholson. Of future on-line yearling, broodmare, foal, horses in training and stallion shares and seasons auctions, Beasley concluded, "The details of the daily, yearround auctions need to be developed by working with the industry but the technology and software are ready now."

MIGHTY BACK ON TRACK

Mighty (Lord at War {Arg}), winner of the GII Louisiana Derby and a leading candidate for this year's Kentucky Derby before sidelined by injury, is back in training for a fall campaign. The colt was knocked out of the Derby with a minor strain of the carpal tunnel behind the knee on his right front leg. "He'd been jogging, hobby horsing and light galloping in the (one-mile) chute and now he's galloping on the main track," said trainer Frank Brothers. "I think that in a couple of weeks we could breeze him. That would give him six weeks of riding." Unraced since finishing seventh in the Apr. 15 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, Mighty has been on the board in nine of 11 starts with three victories and earnings of \$699,848.

Woodbine Shortens Meet:

The 2000 live race meeting at Woodbine will be shortened by one week to allow for the replacement of the dirt track. Racing will now conclude Nov. 26. "The best time for doing this work is towards the end of the meet, when the weather is still reasonably good to lay cushion and when there is ample time for it to settle and compact itself before horses race over it," explained Hugh Mitchell, the Ontario Jockey Club's senior vice president of racing. "As well, replacing the cushion in early December will disrupt our race schedule the least and we recognize how critical race opportunities are to horse people."

COCHRANE FIXES NEWMARKET RETURN

Jockey Ray Cochrane is eying the beginning of July's meeting at Newmarket for his first ride since receiving multiple injuries in a plane crash that killed pilot Patrick Mackey and injured fellow jockey Frankie Dettori four weeks ago, according to *Sporting Life* on-line. Predicting a two month layoff, Cochrane has recovered faster than he expected and with Newmarket set to open in two weeks, getting back in shape is his main priority. "I've been feeling a lot better in the last week," Cochrane told *PA Sport*. "I've started jogging and I'll build up my fitness regime over the next two weeks. I'll play it by ear--I just want to get back to work."

ENRIQUE TO BE SYNDICATED Group winner Enrique (GB) (Barathea {Ire}--Gwydion {USA}, by Raise a Cup {USA}) is in the process of being syndicated for stud duty by Eruc Puerari, it was announced yesterday. The four-year-old, runner-up in both the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas last year, will stand at Haras de la Tuilerie in France. Unraced since finishing fifth in the G1 Champagne S. last July, the bay was first or second in six of his eight career starts and earned \$273,835.

1997 GOLD CUP VICTOR CELERIC RETIRED

Eight-year-old Celeric (GB) (Mtoto {GB}), winner of the 1997 G1 Ascot Gold Cup with career earnings of \$743,134, has been retired following a ninth-place finish in this year's Gold Cup June 22, according to Sporting Life on-line. Out of the winner's circle since his success in the G3 Weatherby's Insurance Lonsdale S. at York Aug. 17, the Christopher Spenceowned gelding hadn't finished better than third this season, a circumstance his trainer, John Dunlop attributes to a loss of racing zeal. "I think maybe he has lost a bit of his enthusiasm, and it's sensible to retire him," Dunlop told the Racing Post. Seeing his last trip to the post as a tell-all sign, Spence, who is also the Jockey Club's senior steward, said to the Racing Post, "Celeric has been wonderful and is very well in himself, but in the Gold Cup he was giving us the message he had raced enough."

LEVY BOARD FUNDS GOING METER TRIALS

The introduction of a going meter for British racing draws another step closer following the decision by the Levy Board to provide a £90,000 grant to complete trials. The Jockey Club requested the grant and Tony Goodhew, the Club's director of racecourse services, said: "There remains an industry-wide demand for an accurate and effective method of measuring the going. Over the last year we have made good progress with a prototype going meter designed by ADAS. They own the intellectual property rights to the going meter and have so far met the costs themselves for the significant investment into research and development. We are delighted that the Levy Board has agreed to fund the next stage of development, which will enable the device to undergo extensive trials around the country." Richard Linley, the Club's senior inspector of courses, has been testing the latest ADAS prototype since last year in order to verify the consistency of the device's readings on different soil types and under contrasting conditions. A second prototype will be operated by United Racecourses from August, while the first six production going meters will be used at six courses from September for a year as the final user-acceptance stage. If all goes well, the meters will become available to Britain's 59 racecourses in 2002.
