#### SHOPPING FOR GLORY IN BEVERLY HILLS

Astra (Theatrical {Ire}) and Happyanunoit (NZ) (Yachtie {Aus}), the one-two finishers in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup Handicap, will clash again in today's GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood Park to determine the top female turf runner in the West. Sparingly raced Astra, once-beaten in her seven career starts, was fully extended to upset heavily favored Happyanunoit by a half-length in the Gamely while receiving four pounds. She gets only one today. "It was the first race in my opinion that she had to put out 100 percent," trainer Simon Bray said of the fouryear-old. "I was a little worried how that would affect her, but believe me, she's training so good now. If it took anything out of her, it isn't apparent." In her only other start this year and her first try at graded stakes company, Astra won the GIII Jenny Wiley at Keenland off a five-month layoff. Happyanunoit, one of two Bobby Frankel-trained, Grade -winnning mares along in the field along with Spanish Fern (El Gran Senor), won the GI Matriarch S. last November after skipping the Breeders' Cup. She finished second in her fiveyear-old return in the GII Santa Barbara Apr. 22 before being beaten by Astra last out. Spanish Fern returns to her preferred surface after trying Grade I competition on the dirt in the May 26 Milady Breeders' Cup H., finishing last of six behind Riboletta (Brz). Spanish Fern won the GI Yellow Ribbon S. last October and took the Mar. 26 GII Santa Ana H. this year. Polaire (Ire) (Polish Patriot) captured the G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh last season and finished second to the ever-improving Colstar in the GIII Martha Washington at Laurel in October. The bay filly rallied up the rail when defeating Dianehill in a Hollywood allowance May 11.

#### **CEMENTING HER STATUS**

Utilizing her stamina-laden pedigree and a groundsaving ride from jockey Pat Day, Secret Status (A.P. Indy) confirmed her status as the best three-year-old filly in training with a 2 1/4-length victory in yesterday's GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont Park. With just one loss in her 2000 campaign--a third in the GII Davona Dale at Gulfstream--the chestnut took the GIII Florida Oaks before romping home by 6 3/4 lengths in the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill May 5. Off since then, she tuned up for this effort with a bullet :59 4/5 for five furlongs at Belmont Monday and was sent off as the 3-5 public choice. As Jostle (Brocco) and Heavens Above (St. Jovite) carved out demanding fractions of :23 and :45 3/5, Secret Status was positioned between horses about four lengths off the lead. Advancing along the inside, she angled out approaching the stretch and caught Jostle at the furlong pole before kicking clear. "I rode her with confidence; she deserves to be ridden that way," Day said. "I had the other fillies measured, but once we straightened away, she didn't seem too concerned about putting Jostle away. I gave her a couple of taps, and inside the sixteenth pole she really took off. This was a real great performance, considering she hasn't run in eight weeks." Next up for Secret Status is the GI Coaching Club American Oaks (Belmont, 7-22, 12f, \$350K), followed by the GI Alabama (Saratoga, 8-19, 10f, \$750K).

CLASH OF THE TITANS With both French Derby hero Holding Court, supplemented at a cost of Ir£85,000, and Epsom Derby winner Sinndar eligible for Budweiser's \$1 million bonus for a colt completing a Derby double, ground conditions may be the determining factor as to who may win the large prize. Trainer John Oxx played down talk of the bonus saying, "The bonus hasn't been on my mind or on the mind of the Aga Khan. The race is enough in itself. We were going to run here anyway, but I suppose it might have influenced Holding Court running and it has probably ensured a very competitive race." That the race appears a competitive affair is largely the responsibility of Oxx and Aidan O'Brien, who each supply four runners, the joint largest individual representation since Vincent O'Brien saddled five in 1969. The going is currently described as good to firm which would suit Sinndar more than it would Holding Court, but trainer Michael Jarvis moved to dispel any fears for the latter's supporters, saying, "Holding Court is very effective on soft ground. When he won the French Derby trial [G3 Prix La Force] at Longchamp [May 18], the ground was fast and he acted perfectly well on it. I will however leave the tactics to the jockey."

KINANE ON THE FENCE Michael Kinane, set to partner Ciro, will have to pass a medical this morning in order to fulfill his riding engagement. Kinane tweaked a muscle when riding The Queen's Spinning Top (GB) in the G2 Hunston Financial Planning Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh yesterday afternoon and faces a battle to be fit in time. Trainer Aidan O'Brien is already in need of a replacement jockey for Shoal Creek, as Paul Scallan was ruled out of the race when suffering concussion in a fall from Pip'N Judy (Ire) in the Waterford Crystal Celebra-

Runner-up in the GI Canadian International in 1997, Down The Aisle missed the entire 1998 campaign and started only three times last year, winning a pair of allowance races, but appears to be back on top of his game this season after this record-breaking performance. The gray shattered the course record, going the 1 3/8 miles in 2:13.63, more than two full seconds faster than the old mark of 2:16 set in 1990 and tied by the Bill Mott-trained Yagli in last year's United Nations. Winner of the GIII Bougainvillea H. at Gulfstream Park in March, Down The Aisle finished a troubled third behind U.N. rivals Monkey Puzzle (Country Pine) and Honor Glide in the GII Hialeah Turf Cup Apr. 22. He came back in the GII Brooklyn H. on the main track at Belmont Park and finished third again, but responded with a return to the turf yesterday. With jockey Robbie Davis in the irons, the gray was rated off an easy early pace set by 1998 Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up Aly's Alley, but sprinted down the stretch to catch the front runner in the final vards. "He was flying," Davis said. "It reminded me of my days with the quarter horses. He is a dream to ride. He knows what he has to do, and he does it. Anybody could have ridden him." As for the future, Mott assistant Seth Benzel said, "The Breeders' Cup is a possibility, but this is a big horse and he has had his aches and pains. He is the kind of horse you have to take your time with, so we'll just take it one race at a time."

King Cugat, the lone stakes winner in the field, was hammered down to 1-20 and did not disappoint his backers here. Hailed as the best three-year-old on grass following a dominating 6 1/4-length triumph in the Jefferson Cup at Churchill June 10, the bay colt shipped to Chicago for this outing. Settling off the pace, he picked it up on the far turn and wrested command from a tiring Bolt (Pine Bluff), coming home clear under a hand ride. "The only reason I even handled him was because he loafed a little bit turning for home," said winning rider Robby Albarado. "That's a good sign. It means he's still got a lot to learn." A scary proposition for his next start, which could be the GII American Derby (Arlington, 7-23). The colt's main objective will be the GI Secretariat (Arlington, 8-19).

Lady Upstage was well beaten by Preseli in last year's G1 Moyglare Stud S., but gained handsome revenge here. Winner of the Listed Masaka S. at Kempton in April, the filly ran a fine race to be beaten only a head by Kalypso Katie (Ire) in the G3 Musidora S. at York May 16 and then appeared to find the mile and a half of the Vodafone Oaks at Epsom June 9 too far when finishing fifth behind Love Divine (GB) and Kalypso Katie (Ire). Lady In Waiting (GB) (Kylian) set a fast pace here, going several lengths clear. Lady Upstage, always close to the front of the pursuing pack, shot past the leader early in the straight and looked set to win comfortably, but Preseli, returning to her best form, made up ground rapidly inside the final furlong and the winner had to be hard ridden to hold her off. Trainer Barry Hills said, "That was a close call in the end. I thought she was going to win easily. I wouldn't think she will run in the [July 16 G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks], but is more likely to go for the [G1] Nassau S. at Goodwood [Aug. 5]." Barry's son Michael, who rode the winner, added, "She got to the front a bit quick and idled once she got there. I'm glad Preseli made a run at her because it made her race. She's a tough, honest and improving filly."

Tiznow made quick work of his conditions, entering the gate as a maiden winner and crossing the wire as a graded stakes hero. Beaten a neck in his first route attempt, Budroyale's baby brother romped home by 8 1/2 lengths in his next out May 31. Saving ground early, the bay colt was shuffled back on the far turn, but found room along the rail and outfought favored highweight Dixie Union to the finish. "He's very game," said winning jockey Victor Espinoza. "He was very tough and he dug back against [Dixie Union]." The winner will now be pointed for the GI Swaps at Hollywood July 23. "I've always had a lot of confidence in this horse; he's got a lot of ability," said winning trainer Jay Robbins, who briefly trained Budroyale in 1995. "He covers a ton of ground and he really likes competition. But the weight concession was a big thing too. That other horse gave away a lot of weight today."

## ★ AUSTRALIA ★

#### **EIGHT-HORSE SPILL AT IPSWICH**

Jockeys Justin Sheehan and Matthew Paget were in serious condition in hospital last night following an eight-horse spill in yesterday's G3 lpswich Cup at Ipswich. Fellow rider Matthew Privato is also under observation in hospital while Darren Beadman, who initially walked away from the fall saying he was all right, later complained of stomach pains and sought medical assistance. The accident occurred when eight-year-old Mushtak (Aus) (Zabeel {NZ}), ridden by Sheehan, broke both front legs at the 900-meter mark while racing one off the lead and fell, creating a domino effect. Sheehan, who only recently made a comeback from a car accident and has valiantly fought his weight throughout his career, was unconscious for several minutes after receiving a blow to the head and a deep cut to his scalp. He also has serious rib injuries and possible internal injuries to his lungs and liver. Five other riders-- Beadman, Michael Cahill, Jason Taylor, Nathan Day and Justin Stanley--walked back to scale to applause from racegoers. Cahill declared that his protective riding vest, made compulsory this year, had saved him from a more serious injury. "I was hit in front and on my back and I truly believe the vest saved me," he said. "I had a look at what was left of Justin's vest and it was ripped to shreds." Jockey Glen Colless, who rode Cruzeiro (Aus) into fourth placing in the Cup, said, "It was mayhem out there. I could see what was happening in front of me, but there was nowhere to go. I've never been involved in anything as bad as that." Mushtak and two other horses had to be put down. Chief Steward Steve Railton ruled the last race on the card be abandoned. Ipswich Turf Club also cancelled the Cup presentation to connections of 20-1 winner I Reign Supreme (Aus) (His Royal Highness {Aus}), trained by Kaye Tinsley at the Gold Coast.
