SINNDAR SUPREME

Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge) etched his name in history with another scintillating performance, adding yesterday's G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh to his game win in the June 10 G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom. The colt is only the 14th horse to successfully complete the Epsom-Irish Derby double and the first since Commander In Chief (GB) in 1993. He also provided trainer John Oxx and jockey Johnny Murtagh with their first win in the race. History was certainly on Sinndar's side as His Highness the Aga Khan's three previous homebred winners of the race had also completed the Epsom-Curragh double and Sinndar duly obliged at odds of 11-10. The win was embellished with the \$1 million bonus offered by Budweiser to any horse completing a European Derby double at The Curragh. Sinndar's lieutenants Raypour (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) and Takali (Ire) (Kris {GB}) went to the front from the outset, ensuring that G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Holding Court (GB) (Hernando (Fr)) was not allowed to dictate the pace. Holding Court was settled in third on the outside as Murtagh maintained a watching brief aboard Sinndar in fifth. The strong pace certainly had its effect on the hopefuls with all bar Raypour under pressure before reaching the home turn. Raypour completed his pacemaking task at the quarter-mile marker as Sinndar was produced on the outside to take the lead. With Murtagh in the drive position Sinndar simply galloped away from his opponents in awesome style. Oxx was quick to nominate the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 1, as Sinndar's main target. "That was terrific," Oxx said of yesterday's race. "My other horses did their job well. Johnny was scrubbing him along but he said he always knew he had plenty left in the tank. He has probably improved again since Epsom and looks to be still on the upgrade. The Arc is the obvious target for him now. Three-year-olds who win two Derbys deserve a little break. He will need to have a prep race and we will talk to His Highness about that." The race was marred when King's Best (USA) (Kingmambo) suffered a suspected fractured cannon bone in his right front leg and was pulled up before halfway. Racecourse veterinary officer John Byrne said, "He's not in pain and has been taken for X-rays but we suspect a fracture of the off-fore cannon bone or fetlock joint." The colt is said to be facing retirement.

HAPPY IN BEVERLY HILLS

With two straight losses as the favorite on the top of her resume, the pride of New Zealand, Happyanuoit (NZ) (Yachtie {Aus}), came into yesterday's Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood looking for not just her first win of the year, but for a little bit of redemtion. She found it, but the expected showdown with Astra (Theatrical {Ire}), who gave her a run for her money as the West's top turf mare when she handed her a defeat in the June 4 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood, never materialized. Happyanunoit saved ground behind Astra's pace early on, took over on the backstretch, shook off her rival leaving the turn and drew clear. Astra, who finished fourth, drifted out through the lane, impeding Sweet Life (Kris S.), and was placed fifth through disqualification. Trainer Bobby Frankel said either the Aug. 19 GI Beverly D. at Arlington or the September 9 GI Ramona H. at Del Mar would be next, with the former the probable target. "Today, it was an easy pace," said Frankel. "She just went easy all the way around, then she started kicking in." Said jockey Brice Blanc, "She was definitely back to her old self today. She showed she's on the way back up to the top and I think she's going to get better still." Happyanunoit is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup, but, said owner John Amerman, "If she continues to run well, obviously (we will supplement her)."

Montjeu proved he was as good as ever with a highly impressive win in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28, and he did nothing to change that yesterday when he added a fifth Group 1 victory to his resume. He easily accounted for his three rivals in the driving rain in what the race caller termed "an exhibition gallop." Montjeu was settled at the rear as stablemate Stop By (Ire) (Be My Guest) set a sensible pace from Sagamix and Daring Miss. Turning into the straight, Sagamix took over at the head of affairs but Montjeu was positioned on the outside ready to strike at will. Cash Asmussen only had to press the button once and the reaction was immediate as Montjeu settled the contest in an instant. He eased clear of his toiling rivals inside the final furlong without being extended. Daring Miss ran on well to take second but, in truth, was leagues behind Montjeu. Sagamix kept on well for third but was clearly outclassed. Cash Asmussen said, "He accelerated really well in the straight and he is much stronger than when I last rode him a year ago (in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby)." Montjeu will now point to the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 29, and winning trainer John Hammond commented, "This horse can really quicken, and he proved that in Ireland last time out. Everything is going to plan and his next run will definitely be in the King George and Michael Kinane will most definitely get the ride for that race." Of the runner-up, Khalid Abdullah's racing manager Teddy Beckett added, "She is a very brave filly and ran an excellent race, but the winner is just an exceptional horse. She is now a Group 2 winner and Group 1 placed so we will try to find a Group 1 race for her to win."

Unlimited happiness and a good amount of sadness at the same time came together when Stall Blankenese's three-year-old colt Samum thundered home five lengths the best. For his overjoyed owner Franz-Gunther von Gaertner, Hamburg's leading racecourse official, a lifetime dream came true, but legendary German trainer Bruno Schutz, who died last Thursday, did not live to witness the greatest triumph of the horse he selected at the Baden Baden Yearling Sale two years ago. Bred by Gestut Karlshof, who also bred the third-placed Acamani, Samum was knocked down to Schutz for DM60,000. Samum, twice a winner at two, battled down Indian Ruby in the G3 Preis des Gestuts Wiesenhof at Krefeld Apr. 16 to win his 2000 debut. He followed that up with a runaway victory in the G2 Grosser Muller Brot-Preis at Munich May 21. In the stretch here, Acamani came flying on the outside, but it was Samum who emerged from the pack two furlongs from home and drew clear in a matter of strides, winning easily by five lengths from the fighting pack. Baron Georg von Ullmann's Subiaco, like his sire in 1993 in the same colours, finished second by a nose. Young trainer Andreas Schutz not only saddled his second Derby winner following Robertico in 1998, but the first three home all came from his yard. The last German trainer of only two in history to achieve this feat was the 31-time champion trainer Heinz Jentzsch in 1985 when Acatenango scored from Bismarck and Lirung.

A nine-length win in his last, the June 10 GII Riva Ridge at Belmont, helped Trippi atone for his lone defeat, the May 6 Kentucky Derby, in which he finished 11th. To that point, the colt sported wins in four straight, all in 2000, including Grade III wins in the Swale S. and Flamingo S. at Gulfstream. The 4-5 choice in a six-horse field, he showed speed right out of the gate, setting down quick fractions of 22.14, 44.57 and 1:08.82. He had drawn clear by the turn and maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire under a driving Jerry Bailey finish. "He keeps getting better with every race," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "We still have a lot of options with him. He handled older horses today. The (GI, seven-furlong, Aug. 26) King's Bishop (at Saratoga) has kind of been our mid-summer goal. As to whether or not we'll run him between now and then, that's something I'll discuss with the owner."

Zabeel Colt to Sell in Japan:

The first of two-time Australian champion sire Zabeel (NZ)'s progeny to go through a northern hemisphere sale ring will be sold in Japan later this month. A colt out of the Danehill (USA) mare Skyrocket is being auctioned at the Japan Racing Horse Association select foal sale, Japan's premier Thoroughbred sale, in Hokkaido on July 10 and 11. The youngster is from Zabeel's first crop bred to northern hemisphere time in 1999. Cambridge Stud proprietor Sir Patrick Hogan said he was looking forward to seeing what the demand would be like. "I believe two or three of the mares Zabeel served here in 1999 were due to go to Japan, and it's interesting to see a foal from one of them in this sale." he said.

Seven Jockeys Hurt in Spills:

Two horrific spills at Ipswich Saturday landed seven jockeys in the hospital and left three horses dead. Queensland jockey Gary Doughty was listed in serious condition in Brisbane's Princess Alexandra hospital last night with brain hemorrhaging and a fractured skull and eye socket. The same spill hospitalized jockey Matthew Paget with a dislocated hip. Doughty's wife Kelly said her husband would be examined by a neurosurgeon after regaining consciousness 24 hours after the fall. Five other riders including jockey Darren Beadman were discharged from hospital Saturday night and Sunday morning in the wake of one of the blackest days in Australian racing history. Two horses fell in the Eye Liner S. at Ipswich, south of Brisbane, including Doughty's mount River Fall, who clipped heals and came down heavily just before the home turn. Shifting, ridden by Jamie Innes, also fell, but the jockey was not injured. Innes's luck held later in the day when he miraculously avoided catastrophe in an eight horse pile-up in the Ipswich Cup just 40 minutes later. That second spill happened when rising eight-year-old gelding Mushtak, who was setting the pace with Justin Sheehan aboard, fractured both forelegs at the 900m, causing seven others to fall. Sheehan suffered fractured ribs and head injuries. Mushtak, Arctic Venture and Bludash were destroyed after the Ipswich Cup accident. John O'Shea was devestated by the loss of Mushtak, who had propelled the young Warwick Farm trainer into the spotlight, but relieved Sheehan's injuries were not life-threatening.

In Melbourne, 24-year-old Brett Prebble broke Damien Oliver's record of 90 1/2 wins for the season with a double at Sandown landing him on 92 1/2 and in reach of 100 wins before the season ends on July 31. Prebble gave his partner, fellow rider Maree Payne, credit for his achievement as she talked him out of a holiday and insisted he remain focused on his goal. "The wins came quickly between 60 and 80 and I knew then that I was on track for the record," said Prebble, adding the secret of his success was staying out of trouble with stewards--he hasn't been suspended since March 1998. Prebble's aim in the next racing year is to become Australia's leading Group 1 winning rider. This season he finished third with five Group 1 wins.
