EIGHT SET FOR ECLIPSE

The G1 Epsom Derby form is usually vital in the Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown, with five horses coming from that Classic to an Eclipse victory since 1986. Sakhee (Bahri) looked the winner at Epsom June 10 until the last half furlong, when Sinnidar (Ire) loomed up with his irresistible challenge. Sakhee has the advantage of being able to go on any ground, from the lightning fast of York in the G2 Dante S. May 17 to the heavy when winning here over the distance in the G3 Classic Trial April 29. Add to that the fact that he has improved markedly with each race this year and he looks to have a solid chance. He may have most to contend with from Henry Cecil's talented Shiva (Jpn) (Hector Protector), who has looked brilliant when conditions are in her favour, never more so than when recording a facile success in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. here on heavy ground May 30. She clearly dislikes fast conditions, as she demonstrated with her worst career showing in last year's G2 Prince Of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot. Any further rain will help, with thunder showers predicted for this morning. Godolphin will attempt to pick up the winning thread here with **Fantastic Light** (Rahy), who was runner-up in this last year when trained by Sir Michael Stoute and who looked impressive when taking the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 25. He did not look as if he appreciated the camber last time out in the G1 Coronation Cup, where he was second to Daliapour (Ire), and may put up a bold show on this more favoured terrain. It is impossible to ignore the merits of Aidan O'Brien's **Giant's Causeway** (Storm Cat), as he won a highly competitive G1 St James' Palace S. June 20, creating the impression for connections that he may appreciate a further trip in future. If he improves for the extra distance, he should figure in the finish.

A multiple group winner in France, **Epistolaire** opened his stateside career with a close second in a Gulfstream allowance race back in February. Stepped up for the GII Pan American H. Mar. 4 in the five-year-old bay horse's next outing, he placed fourth, but came back on May 5 to take an Aqueduct allowance in the last few strides before the wire. Up to give Epistolaire his greatest challenge will be **Drama Critic**. With back-to-back wins in Gulfstream allowances last February, Drama Critic went on to Keeneland, placing second in his next race, but winning his first graded stakes, the GIII Elkhorn S., Apr. 26 next time out. In his latest trip to the post, the four-year-old was taken eight wide and wound up placing fourth in the Louisville H. June 11 at Churchill. Shadwell colorbearer **Elhayq** finished sixth in his U.S. bow May 5, just 2 3/4 lengths behind Epistolaire, then outgamed **Special Coach** by a neck in a money allowance over this course June 24. Coming down from Woodbine is the seven-year-old **Incitatus**, a veteran graded-stakes competitor. On the board for two out of five graded stakes he ran last year, the chestnut came off a seventh-place season opener to finish third in the GII Connaught Cup S. two races back May 27. Two weeks later, Incitatus went on to win the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. in his last race.

\$5 MILLION UP FOR GRABS AT OAK TREE The 32nd Oak Tree at Santa Anita meeting will open Oct. 4 and offer 29 stakes worth \$5 million. The meet's \$300,000 GI Oak Tree Championship has been renamed the Clement L. Hirsch Memorial Turf Championship in memory of Oak Tree's late co-founder and first president, who passed away in March. "We believe renaming one of Oak Tree's most important races in his memory is a fitting tribute to Clement Hirsch, who did so much to make this meeting as successful as it has become," said Dr. Jack K. Robbins, who succeeded Hirsch as Oak Tree president in May. A total of 13 graded stakes will be run during the 27-day meet, three of which are Grade I events. The \$500,000 GI Yellow Ribbon will be run Oct. 7 and the \$200,000 GI Oak Leaf S. and the Hirsch Memorial will be run Oct. 8. The 11th renewal of California Cup Day will be Oct. 28. The day features 10 stakes worth \$1,275,000 in purses for state-bred horses. The meet concludes Nov. 6.

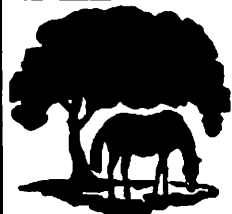

ROYAL ASCOT FALL COULD HAVE COST

FALLON AN ARM Jockey Kieren Fallon, injured in a four-horse pile-up at Royal Ascot, yesterday recounted during an interview on the Victor Chandler International website how lucky he was to keep the use of his left arm. Fallon suffered severe nerve damage in his left shoulder and said yesterday, "If it hadn't been for some very quick-thinking doctors, I might not have a career to come back to. I now know just how serious the damage to my left shoulder was and that I was literally minutes away from losing the use of my left arm. If the right decisions hadn't been made very quickly, I would be in a lot of trouble now." Fallon was taken to Wexham Park Hospital after the accident. "Because I'd lost the power of my left hand, [the doctors at Wexham Park] thought it was due to the massive bruising which was pressing on my nerves and stopping circulation. Thank God one of them said that it would be taking a big chance waiting for the swelling to go down before operating because if the nerves were severed, they'd be dead soon and lost forever. They rushed me to the Royal Orthopaedic Hospital, where I saw one of the best neurosurgeons in the world, Dr Birch. Within 10 minutes of seeing me he said he'd be operating immediately...when he got in he found that the nerves were severed. That meant he had to take a nerve from lower down my arm and graft it into the shoulder." The arm still causes the rider a lot of pain. "It's OK when I'm standing or sitting, but when I lay down it's excruciating and I'm up at all hours making tea and watching anything that's on the telly." As for the future, Fallon said, "People have asked me how long I will be out and I can tell you honestly that I don't know. I've got complete movement in the hand and it's only a matter of time before everything heals properly."
