UP TO THE CHALLENGE?

A deep field of nine will go postward in today's \$1 million GI Sempra Energy Hollywood Gold Cup, headed by 9-5 morning-line favorite General Challenge (General Meeting), who is in search of his third straight victory in California's \$1 million events. The winner of the GI Pacific Classic in his first start against older horses last August, the Golden Eagle homebred was impressive when besting Budroyale by 1 1/4 lengths in the March 4 Santa Anita H. Third at 1-5 in the GII San Bernadino H. Apr. 9, the chestnut underwent surgery for an entrapped epiglottis and makes a much-anticipated return this afternoon. One of two supplemental entries, Out of Mind (Sestero {Brz}) has two victories from four starts over the main track, including a 1/2-length success over Early Pioneer (Rahy) in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. over the local dirt May 13. Shipped to Boston for the GII MassCap in his most recent effort, the dark bay put in a strong late run to finish second, beaten 1 1/4 lengths by Running Stag. New York bred David (Mt. Livermore) appears to be the main speed in the field and ran well to be second by a head in the San Bernardino in his only previous West Coast appearance. The chesnut was most recently third in the MassCap. Breeders' Cup Classic winner Cat Thief (Storm Cat) figures to be with the pace from his inside post and displayed affinity for the surface when defeating General Challenge in last year's GI Swaps S. Post time for the race, part of the NTRA on FOX Champions Series, is slated for 2:40 p.m. PDT with live coverage on FOX.

GIANT'S ECLIPSE

Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat), sent off at odds of 8-1, battled well under 53-year-old rider George Duffield in yesterday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown to hold off the strong finish of Sir Michael Stoute's Kalanisi (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}). As consistent as they come, he was rated 120 pounds in the International Classifications at the end of 1999, five pounds below ill-fated stablemate Fasliyev and, after defeating older horses in the G3 Gladness S. at The Curragh Apr. 9, looked a formidable favourite for the G1 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 6. He found King's Best too good there, but put that right at Royal Ascot, where, ridden from the front, he held off Valentino (GB), having been headed before the line. Here it was almost a carbon copy of that running, with Kalanisi looking to have taken it from him before he fought back to claim his greatest prize yet. Giant's Causeway was quick away before settling in second on the rail as Sakhee (Bahri) took them along, while Godolphin's pacemaker Sun Charm (Gone West) was slowly away. As they rounded the turn and entered the straight, Sakhee guickened to the front, but finally relented the lead to Giant's Causeway over a furlong from home. Duffield used all his power up front to ensure the best finish from his mount, and as Kalanisi closed ominously, and even headed him with 100 yards to race, he had enough to lift himself back in front before the line in a pulsating finish. For jockey George Duffield, it was a memorable ride, and he was overjoyed. "This is a serious horse, and he wants to win. He just stuck his neck out and said you're not going to beat me. I'm privileged to be on him." Trainer Aidan O'Brien was enjoying his second success in Britain this year, the other having been provided by this horse at Ascot. Regarding a next start for the winner, he said, "We could go either way with him now--we can go to Goodwood [for the G1 Sussex S. Aug. 2] or York [for the G1 International S. Aug 22], as the trip is not a problem to him now. All he needs in his race is a leader. He has an unbelievable presence--he's a big strong horse, and he was that at two. He was every bit as strong at two as he is now--he developed very quickly. Winning owner Michael Tabor commented, "It is a very exciting day for us and these are the races you want to win. He is as tough as they come and just loves to get in a fight."

A handicap and conditions performer for John Dunlop in Britain, Elhayg was shipped to the U.S. this season and debuted with a third-place finish to Epistolaire (Ire) (Alzao) in an Aqueduct three-otherthan allowance May 5. Given seven weeks to recover, the bay added Lasix for a June 24 money allowance test and raced with the pace for the entirety of that 10-furlong affair to be up on the line to defeat Special Coach (Zafarrancho {Arg}) by a neck. Special Coach set a pedestrian pace early on tracked by Carpenter's Halo with Elhayq tucked neatly behind the frontrunners and saving ground from third. The five-year-old split horses at the top of the stretch and drew quickly clear from his rivals to score his first added-money victory. Yankee Dollar, who hit the gate at the start and was last for the opening mile, closed well late for the place. "I think the key was the Lasix. I didn't know he was a bleeder," commented winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He bled once in Europe. The first time we ran him, we scoped him and found some blood, so we put him on Lasix for his next start and now he's two-for-two on Lasix." The conditioner indicated that the winner is under consideration for the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga Aug. 12.

A 3 1/2-length maiden winner at first asking at Keeneland Apr. 26, Gold Mover made the transition into graded-stakes competition a successful one when defeating males in the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup May 29. The prohibitive favorite against her own sex to remain undefeated, the chestnut dueled on the front end with Princess Belle, put away that rival turning for home and was a much-the-best winner. "It surprised me she went to the lead, but nobody else seemed to want to go there," said Rob Rader, assistant to trainer Mark Hennig. "So far she's been the best filly in Kentucky; she's proven that." Added winning rider Craig Perret, "She's pretty collected she's cool and she lets you teach her what you want her to do. That's kind of half the battle."

Notable Career took the first steps in living up to her name in collecting her first graded-stakes victory. After missing by a nose going 4 1/2 furlongs May 3, the dark bay filly came back to demolish her rivals by 12 lengths on Memorial Day at Hollywood. Breaking alertly from the rail, the favorite dueled with Magic Madam (You and I) through quick splits of :21 2/5 and :44 4/5, inching away from that rival just past the quarter pole. Urged on by jockey Corey Nakatani, she opened up on the field for another daylight score. "She's a special filly," remarked Nakatani. "She has a big, long stride and I really believe she's going to be very tough in the longer races." The Cal-bred's next start will be the CTBA S. at Del Mar July 28.

A serious competitor at two in her native Ireland, Buffalo Berry captured the Listed Cork S. before running third to champion and stablemate Fasliyev in the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. to close out her juvenile campaign. Winner of the Bal Harbour S. at Gulfstream in April in her U.S. debut, she could do no better fourth, just behind Laurica (second) and Mi Moochie (third) in the Revidere S. over this course Memorial Day. Rating comfortably early on, she launched her bid while four wide on the far turn and held sway. "After that [the start] I just got her to settle," said winning jockey Aaron Gryder. "My horse just proved to have the best late kick in the race and that's what won it."

Ela Athena improved fast last year, and followed a promising win in the Listed Golden Daffodil S. at Cheptow in July with a game second to Ramruma in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks a month later. There she only went down by one-and-a-quarter lengths to the best middle distance three-year-old filly in Europe. This year she was disappointing on her return when last in the G2 Jockey Club S. Newmarket May 5, but looked to be returning to form last Saturday when fourth to Lady Upstage (Ire) in the G2 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. Here she was prominent early as Fame At Last (Quest For Fame {GB}) made the running. As they turned into the straight iockey Philip Robinson made his decisive move which turned out to be a master stroke. Taking her wide of the rest of the field for the better ground, she quickly went three lengths clear and mainatined her advantage all the way up the straight, never wavering as the rest of the field, headed by Solaia, struggled to close the gap. At the line she had claimed her first Group race comfortably. Robinson explained his tactics. "It was a good pace, a proper pace early, but we had already made the decision to come wide, as she's a big filly and we wanted to give her plenty of room, and send her for home with four furlongs to go. She quickened up really well and all I had to do was keep her going." Trainer Michael Jarvis added, "She is in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood (Aug. 5), but I don't know if that track would suit her, We could go for the G1 Yorkshire Oaks (York Aug. 23) with her."

With only one win and a smattering of modest stakes performances in fifteen previous starts, it was no surprise that the German-trained challenger Faberger started at very long odds. What was surprising was the manner in which he caused a huge upset to beat a highclass field by finishing in tremendous style to take his first group win in the last stride. He was settled in a patient fifth, ahead of Kingsalsa, as the favourite Trans Island led from Cayoke (Fr) (Always Fair) and Chelsea Manor. The race began in earnest once inside the final quarter mile where Kingsalsa was positioned wide to make his challenge along with Chelsea Manor on his inside. That pair disputed the lead from just inside the furlong marker with Chelsea Manor asserting with 100 yards to go. Chelsea Manor looked set fair for victory but jockey Lennart Hammer-Hansen conjured a strong burst from Faberger, lunging fast and late to snatch victory on the line.

The Dwyer has attracted the winners of two of the three Triple Crown events, headed by Preakness winner Red Bullet, who has been carefully managed by trainer Joe Orseno and is unraced since the May 20 Classic. "I didn't expect this race to come up as tough as it came up, but we've had it marked on our schedule for some time," Orseno said. "He's fresh and has grown physically since the Preakness. He's always been tough mentally and he loves what he does." He will need to be at his mental and physical best to tackle More Than Ready. Freshened since his fourth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, the dark bay silenced at least some of his critics with his bang-up second-place finish in the GI Blue Grass prior to his Derby performance and has fired three straight bullets in preparation for this. Belmont winner Commendable has remained in New York since his upset victory and has continued to train forwardly. He loses jockey Pat Day, who has opted to ride Cat Thief in the Hollywood Gold Cup. Albert The Great has won three in a row since the addition of blinkers, but gets a big test for class this afternoon.

Having taken the race in 1999 with Stravinsky (USA), Aidan O'Brien will bid to follow up with any of his four entries, Bernstein (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}), a 10-1 shot, Monashee Mountain (USA) (Danzig {USA}), Rossini (USA) (Miswaki {USA}) and Warrior Queen (USA) (Quiet American {USA}). It is hoped that Michael Kinane will be back to ride for the stable next week, following his muscle problems. He missed the ride on G1 Eclipse S. winner Giant's Causeway (USA) vesterday, but his agent John Hanmer described his decision as "cautious".

EDDERY IN THE WARS

Pat Eddery, banned for four days on Friday afternoon for careless riding, compounded his misery on the evening when he was found guilty of excessive use of the whip at Salisbury.
