"PIONEER" STRIKES GOLD

Claimed for \$62,500 from Mr. and Mrs. John C. Mabee back in October of 1998, Early Pioneer (Rahy) came back to haunt his breeders, besting the Mabee's 7-5 favorite General Challenge (General Meeting) by a length in the \$1 million GI Hollywood Gold Cup yesterday afternoon. "I had so much confidence today that I dyed my hair gold," winning jockey Victor Espinoza, who was aboard the five-year-old for the first time, said. "This is the first time I've ridden in this race, and I had such a good feeling that I was going to win." The bettors didn't feel the same way, making Early Pioneer the longest shot in the race at 24-1. But the former claimer had proved himself in graded-stakes competition this year, winning the GII San Bernardino H. at Santa Anita in April before finishing second by a half length to Out Of Mind (Brz) (Sestero {Brz}) (fourth at 9-2) in the May 13 GII Mervyn LeRoy H. and second again to Big Ten (Chi) (Barkerville) (eighth at 14-1) in the June 11 GII Californian S. Stretching out to 10 furlongs for the first time, Early Pioneer rated off the pace as David (Mt. Livermore) went a half in :46.41 and six furlongs in 1:10.14. He launched his bid while three deep on the far turn and drove to the front in the final furlong for the upset victory. "[Owner David Wilson] picked this horse out," trainer Vladimir Cerin said. "He's an unusual-looking horse...he has these huge ankles, but he is 100percent sound." As for what's next, Cerin said, "We'll wait four or five days before we make any decision." General Challenge, winner of the GII Strub S. and GI Santa Anita H. this year but unraced since finishing third in the San Bernardino, will point for the Aug. 26 Gl Pacific Classic. "Lacking a recent race, that might have been a factor," trainer Bob Baffert said. "I thought when he turned for home that he looked like a winner, but he got a little late in the final furlong. But the horse is back, that's the main thing." Out of Mind, the second choice, came with a mild late bid to be fourth. "He wasn't as relaxed as I'd have liked him to be so that he could kick," jockey Eddie Delahoussaye said. "He just went kind of even the last mile." (Gold Cup chart, p2)

HE IS THE GREATEST

Making his stakes debut after three consecutive frontrunning victories, Albert The Great (Go for Gin) found himself facing the winners of two-thirds of the Triple Crown in yesterday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park, but he was unfazed by the task. Sent right to the front once again, the Nick Zito trainee cruised through the first quarter in :24.15, zipped the next :22.48 and got the six furlongs in 1:10.51, then shook off a challenge from More Than Ready (Southern Halo) down the lane and drew off to best that rival by three lengths despite drifting in late. It was another 1 3/4 lengths back to GI Preakness hero Red Bullet (Unbridled), with GI Belmont S. winner Commendable (Gone West) a half-length behind in fourth. "He went slow the first quarter, then extremely fast the second quarter and I think that's where he won the race," Zito said. "[Jockey Richie Migliore] rode a masterful race." John Velazquez, who tried to rally More Than Ready up the rail in the stretch, claimed foul, but the claim was disallowed. "The winner came over on More Than Ready, but he didn't make contact and he was clear," trainer Todd Pletcher said, adding, "For not having raced in two months, that was a good race for him." Red Bullet reared in the gate, then flattened out when asked for his run. "Obviously, I'm disappointed," trainer Joe Orseno said. "He's never tried anything like that in the gate before and he was totally flat. [Jockey Jerry Bailey] didn't have an explanation for it. We'll have to re-think our plans."

Giving jockey Victor Espinoza a graded-stakes double on the afternoon, Elaborate came with a four-wide sweep to catch Cliquot inside the sixteenth pole and draw clear. "I've never had a day like this," Espinoza, who, as with Hollywood Gold Cup winner Early Pioneer, was riding this horse for the first time, said. "I'm kinda happy." Elaborate raced twice at two, then missed his entire three-year-old campaign, but rewarded his connections for their patience by going a perfect four-forfour last year. The chestnut gelding ended the year with a win in the restricted Ack Ack S. at Santa Anita Dec. 27 but, after opening 2000 with a third in the Feb. 6 GII San Antonio H., had been off the board in his last four appearances. He tried turf in his most recent outings, running fourth in a Hollywood allowance May 20 and sixth in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile last time out June 28, but returned to the dirt with success here. "This horse is a sprinter, and that's what I've always thought," trainer Paco Gonzalez said. "At least today we got him back in the right race." Big Jag (Kleven), the 7-5 favorite, was well back through fast early splits and failed to threaten in the stretch, finishing seventh. "He didn't run at all today," jockey Alex Solis said. "I don't know what's the matter with him...he never really got in gear." Added trainer Tim Pinfield, "We'll have to check him out thoroughly and hope everything's OK."



GI Santa Monica H. winner Honest Lady shipped out of town after that score, winning the Mar. 25 GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct before finishing second in the May 6 GII Humana Distaff at Churchill Downs. The dark bay filly faced the boys in a tough test last time, but ran second again, finishing second by 4 3/4 lengths to Yankee Victor in the May 29 Gl Met Mile. The 7-10 chalk this time, the Juddmonte homebred was last after a quarter in :21.36 and had just one behind her after a half in :43.83, but flew up the rail on the far turn to take command nearing the eighth pole and pulled away as much the best. "She's really an awesome filly," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "She's got an awesome turn of foot. All of a sudden, she's right there." The filly will return to New York for her next start, the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga Aug. 20.

Beaten just a neck in his debut, Duality came back at Churchill Downs June 10 and broke his maiden, going wire-to-wire to win by 5 1/4 lengths. Sent off the third choice with a step up to graded-stakes company, the bay drifted in at the start, then tracked the pace from fifth while saving ground through rapid opening fractions. He swung to the outside for the stretch drive to rally between rivals and catch the front-running longshot Strait Cat in the waning yards. The 2-1 favorite Firststatedeposit (Deposit Ticket), fourth throughout, lacked a late bid.

Slip Stream made his mark at both the Group 1 and Group 2 levels last year, following a third in the G2 Dante S. at York in May with a neck second to Golden Snake in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly the following month. Those two efforts came at further than a mile, however; since then he has raced solely over eight furlongs, with his only win coming in the Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood last July. He finished down the field in the Royal Hunt Cup H. on his latest start at Royal Ascot June 21, but bounced back on his return to stakes company here with a facile success. He broke well and took command, with only Bernardon in proximity in the early stages. When jockey Paul Eddery asked him to go on, he settled it in a matter of strides to win as he liked, being eased down at the finish.

Except for Wanda came back after taking the winter off to capture an optional claimer on the dirt at Woodbine Apr. 28, but failed to fire when switched to the turf for the June 3 GIII Nassau S. Seventh in that test, she rebounded to run a creditable third in her latest, an allowance test in the slop June 18. But the dark bay had accounted for a stakes win on the turf last season and was returned to that surface for this event. Ignored at the windows, she settled in the middle of the 15-horse field for six furlongs, rallied five wide into the stretch, took over late in the lane and held on to take a tight photo from favored Only To You. "This is the biggest win of my career," trainer Bruce Smither said. "She was going into the race exceptionally well, but to win was a lovely surprise."

Scoring her first black-type success in the Listed Prix Rose de Mai at Saint-Cloud Mar. 23, Folie Danse's best career effort came when second to Reve D'Oscar (Fr) in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 21, which she followed up with a respectable fifth in the G1 Prix de Diane-Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 11. Returning to winning ways, she recorded her first group victory with a safe win from a select field. Folie Danse was settled in sixth as the German raider Ustimona (Ger) (Mondrian {Ger}) led from Flawly. The latter grabbed the lead inside the quarter-mile pole as Folie Danse and Playact made significant progress on the outside, but it was Folie Danse who led at the distance and ran on well to the line for the score. Playact kept on well for second, but allowed Folie Danse the critical first run. Flawly easily proved best of the remainder.

RECORD SPRING MEET FOR CHURCHILL

DOWNS Boosted by continued growth in national wagering and strong on-track attendance, total handle surpassed the \$500 million mark for the first time in Churchill Downs history during the 2000 Spring Meet which concluded yesterday. The final figure was an impressive \$507,477,692 for total wagering during the 53-day meet, 18 percent higher than the total for last year's 47-day season. The biggest increase came in off-track handle, which jumped 21 percent from 1999. The daily average total handle was \$9,575,051, up 4.5 percent, while daily average off-track wagering rode seven percent. Total attendance was also up, but the daily average of 14.050 was off 3.5 percent, and the daily average on-track handle was \$1,944,954, down 4.5 percent. Total purses during the meet were \$23,159,923, also a record, while the daily avergae purse distribution was \$436,980, the third highest total in the track's history. Pat Day, Churchill's all-time leading rider, picked up a record 28th title at the track, earning his 12th Spring championship with 76 wins. Dale Romans and D. Wayne Lukas tied as top trainers with 18 victories apiece. It was a first for Romans, but marked the 10th Churchill title for Lukas. Kenneth and Sarah Ramsey were leading owners with 19 winners.

Saving ground, the filly raced behind the field early, made her move on the turn and got up in the shadow of the wire for the win.

Running in behind horses at the middle of the field for most of the race, the chestnut colt found room going into the turn and took the lead. In the stretch, he gave up ground, but came back to snatch the win away from Key On Richie (Key Contender) at the wire. The winner is a 1/2 to Light Up The Town (Citidancer), SP, \$160,461; and Lavish Numbers (Polish Numbers), SW, \$105,727. Lifetime Record: 2-2-0-0, \$51,000. O-Inniscarra Stable. 

When you ride this much you've got to be fined sooner or later--vou can't do it right all the time. It is difficult out there though, as you go for the win and try your best, but the rules are there and you have to abide by them. Yesterday on Kalanisi (Ire) (in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S.) I rode him as a normal jockey would ride him, and I gave him everything, and he gave me all he could. If you hit a horse too hard they curl up on you, but they were running past the line. It depends how the stewards view it, but I'm going to give the title everything and hopefully things will start when the suspensions are over." Eddery closed yesterday on 77 winners, still three ahead of Kevin Darley with 74.
