#### AN ORIENTAL INVASION

While French championship races are becoming almost routine pickings now for Japanese-based horses, today's G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket could mark another watershed in Japanese racing history if Agnes World (Danzig) is first home. Seeking the Pearl became the first Japanese-trained horse to win a Group One race in Europe when taking the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest on August 9, 1998, but the island country still does not boast a winner in England. The winner of the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp last season, Agnes World returned this year with a creditable second to Nuclear Debate in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 20 and has been kept in Newmarket since to acclimatise and prepare. As usual, Godolphin uphold the home defence with Lend A Hand (Great Commotion) and Bertolini (Danzig) in their quest to win this for the first time. The former took the G2 Duke of York S. May 18, before finishing third to Superior Premium (GB) in the G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot June 22, while the latter finished best of his racing group, but only third overall in the G2 King's Stand S. Michael Jarvis' Lincoln Dancer (Turtle Island {Ire}) was impressive when running away with the Listed Sandy Lane S. at Haydock May 27 on soft going, and the easing in the ground will benefit him here. Aidan O'Brien, successful last year with Stravinsky, relies on both Monashee Mountain (Danzig) and Rossini (Miswaki). While both had twoyear-old form which placed them amongst the best of their generation, they have been relatively disappointing in their efforts so far this season.

#### A NOT-SO SHOCKING FALMOUTH

An excellent third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 14, Alshakr (Bahri) made good on generous odds given her liking for the prevalent track condition to score a first group victory in yesterday's Falmouth S. at Newmarket. With a distinct lack of early pace, jockey Richard Hills sent Alshakr to the front within the first furlong as Croeso Cariad (Most Welcome (GB)) was settled in midfield with Danceabout (Shareef Dancer) in rear. Challenged by a pair of rivals at the quarter-mile marker, she repelled those bids professionally and entered the final furlong with a one-length advantage. That was to prove enough as Alshakr, racing on the heavily favoured stands rail, ran on impressively for the victory with a little more in hand than the winning margin indicates. Winning trainer Ben Hanbury said, "Sheikh Hamdan told (jockey) Richard (Hills) before the race that if there was no pace to make the running and he had the guts to go and do it. He rode a brilliant race." Of future plans, racing manager Angus Gold added, "I think she will stay at a mile for the time being. If she does step up it will be in the (9 furlong 192 yards) G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood (Aug. 5). With her the ground is crucial; she needs soft ground."



Emulating last year's success of City On A Hill for owner and trainer, Noverre showed a willingness to battle by regaining the lead in a driving finish to deny the equally tenacious Media Mogul. Noverre retained his unbeaten record having already secured wins in a conditions event at Chantilly May 30, and the Listed Prix La Fleche at Maisons-Laffitte June 14. Unlike in his previous races, Noverre did not set the pace but was settled in third ahead of Bram Stoker and Media Mogul as Bravado (GB) (Zafonic) led. The field as a whole came under pressure to maintain their positions at the quarter-mile marker, but it was Noverre who led approaching the final furlong. Media Mogul emerged from the pack as the main danger soon after and led briefly inside the final furlong, but jockey Jimmy Fortune urged for further effort from Noverre and got the required response as his mount regained the lead close home for a hard-fought win. Bram Stoker kept on well for third without striking a serious blow. Noverre now has alternative options and will point to either the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 29, or the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood Aug. 3. Winning trainer David Loder said, "In France he has had to make his own running which hasn't suited him and here he got to the front plenty early enough. He is tough, he loves racing, but is very idle and I don't think he will ever be a ten-length wonder."

PREAKNESS WINNER RECOVERING Tests taken on Red Bullet (Unbridled) following his disappointing third-place finish in Sunday's Gll Dwyer S. revealed a high white blood cell count, indicating an infection, trainer Joe Orseno said yesterday. "It was a pretty good infection," Orseno said. "We never pinpointed it and he never spiked a temperature or was out of his feed tub. He's on anti-biotics and has already started to spark up. The bottom line is that there was an infection and that's why he was dehydrated after the race and blowing so hard." Orseno said the setback is a minor one and Red Bullet remains on course to start in the Aug. 6 Gl Haskell at Monmouth Park. He cautioned, though, that Red Bullet will run only if he is training sharply, the way he did prior to winning the Preakness.

KNOWN FACT DIES Known Fact (In Reality-Tamerett, by Tim Tam), the first stallion to ever stand at
Prince Khalid Abdullah's Juddmonte Farms near
Lexington, Kentucky, passed away Monday at the age
of 23. The winner of the G1 Middle Park S. as a twoyear-old, Known Fact won the G1 English 2000 Guineas, G2 Waterford Crystal Mile and G2 Queen Elizabeth
II at three en route to being named the champion miler
in Europe in 1980. Top offspring of the stallion include
the champions Warning (GB) and Markofdistinction.
Known Fact cover 20 mares this year, but recently
became ill and was buried Tuesday on the farm.

YAGLI TO FORENAGHTS STUD Yagli (Jade Hunter--Nijinsky's Best, by Nijinsky II), recently retired due to a breathing problem, will stand the 2001 breeding season at the Smurfit family's Forenaghts Stud in County Kildare, Ireland for a yet-to-be-determined stud fee. The seven-year-old, a three-time Grade I winner in 1999, was winless in three starts in 2000. Madeleine Paulson, wife of owner Allen Paulson, told England's Racing Post that they had received many offers to stand the chestnut, but settled on Forenaghts because she is "friends with Michael Smurfit and wanted to make sure Yagli had a good home."

Springs (El Gran Senor--Population {Ire}, by General Assembly), one of the top European juveniles of 1997, will stand stud in France at Haras du Mezeray for a fee of FF40,000 (approximately \$5,800). The five-year-old parlayed success in the G3 Beresford S. in Ireland into a victory in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster as a juvenile. He carried over his strong form to his three-year-old campaign, where he defeated eventual G1 St James's Palace S. winner Dr Fong in the G2 Dante S. The stallion will stand the Southern Hemisphere season at Milluna Stud in Australia before taking up his duties at the French stud next year.

**SMITH EARNS DOMINION AWARD** Katherine Todd Smith, known throughout the Thoroughbred community in Ocala, Florida, as Saint Katherine, has been named the winner of the 2000 Dogwood Dominion Award. The award is presented annually to honor an unsung hero in the Thoroughbred industry. Smith, an Ocala-based horse identifier, has rescued and found homes for 17 neglected Thoroughbreds and is known for her generosity and compassion. One of her nominators was (Ocala) Star-Banner columnist Lucy Tobias, who wrote, "She listens well to people, not just what they need for their horse work, but to what they are saying about their lives and their problems. She is a helper, facilitator, a person looking for solutions." Selected from 30 nominations by judges Anne Campbell, Penny Chenery and Pat Day, Smith, will receive \$5,000 and a bronze statue of the Dogwood colorbearer Dominion at a luncheon at the Saratoga Reading Room on Aug. 2.
