LOVE-LESS OAKS STILL DIVINE

Although G1 Epsom Oaks winner Love Divine (GB) has been forced to miss this chance of an Oaks double, the strength-in-depth of today's G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks at The Curragh is still evident. While foreign invaders (mainly English) had the edge to start the last decade, three back-to-back Irish winners arrested that trend from 1996-1998. The Brits were back on top last season, with dual Oaks heroine Ramruma winning both the English and Irish versions. There is no doubt that solid form at Epsom stands any challenger in good stead here, with three fillies in the 1990s having succeeded here after taking prizemoney in the English Classic. Both Knight's Baroness (GB) and Pure Grain (GB) were third at Epsom before winning this, which brings in Godolphin's Melikah (Ire) (Lammtarra). A daughter of the brilliant middle-distance performer, she showed his characteristic style of running when staying on stronger than most of the field at Epsom, showing dramatic improvement from her debut success in the Listed Pretty Polly S. at Newmarket May 7. She must get past Kalypso Katie (Ire) (Fairy King), who followed her win in the May 16 G2 Musidora S. at York with a fine second at Epsom, where she was unable to catch the impressive winner. She is another lightly raced filly who has answered the questions put to her in the highest class so far. The fourth that day, Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain), completes the picture, having been shuffled back early before staying on well in the straight last time out. She has plenty of speed, as she showed when winning the G3 Nell Gwyn S. in impressive fashion at Newmarket Apr. 18 and again when third behind Lahan (GB) in the G1 1000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 7. Miletrian (Ire) (Marju (Ire)) was last at Epsom, but bounced back to take the June 22 G2 Ribblesdale S. during the Royal Ascot meeting. She beat Godolphin's other Irish Oaks runner, Teggiano (Ire) (Mujtahid), in that test, and bids to follow in the footsteps of Bolas (GB), who in 1994 became the last filly to complete the Ribblesdale-Irish Oaks double. Preseli (Ire) (Caerleon) looks to have the strongest claims of the home defense, having narrowly failed to catch Lady Upstage (Ire) in the G2 Pretty Polly S. here July 1. Her juvenile form, which saw her rated the joint-top filly in Europe in the International Classifications, stand up to the closest inspection. (Irish Oaks field, p2)

OFF THE SCALE

Maybe it was the nasal strip. Richter Scale (Habitony {GB}), getting a change of equipment for yesterday's GI Frank J. DeFrancis Dash at Laurel Park, did indeed dash down the stretch to win by 1 3/4 lengths in the time of 1:07.95, breaking the track record by a tick in the process. "He's the best pure sprinter I've ever been around," jockey Richie Migliore said. "I had a lot of confidence in him and I thought 1:07 4/5 or 1:08 was really within his grasp." The six-year-old battled Falkenburg (Storm Bird) through a half in :44.46, opened up on his three rivals as they came into the stretch and easily held Just Call Me Carl (Strawberry Road {Aus}) safe to the wire. The bay, who was tried on the turf last summer with limited success, had won four straight stakes since returning to sprint races. The streak started with the Oct. 16 Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. and the Nov. 25 GII Fall Highweight H.--both at six furlongs--last season and continued in the Mar. 10 GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Championship H. and the Apr. 16 GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S., both at seven furlongs, but ended with a sixth-place finish in the May 29 GI Met Mile. Dropping back to six furlongs, the Cal-bred returned to the winner's circle and pushed his career earnings over the \$1 million mark. Future plans are up in the air, but Richter Scale will be pointed to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill in November.

Canadian invader Milwaukee Brew arrived in Ohio looking for his fourth straight. Nominated to the Triple Crown, the bay didn't break his maiden until posting a 10-length score in his first two-turn try at Gulfstream Mar. 25, then came back a month later to win a Woodbine allowance by eight lengths. Looking to go three-forthree since stretching out, the colt captured the 1 1/16-mile GIII Marine S. in his latest try May 21. Adding a bit of ground with a return to the U.S., he settled near the back of the pack through honest early splits, swept six wide around the far turn and kept coming down the lane to catch Brave Quest at the wire for a narrow score. The runner-up suffered his first loss in his stakes debut.

Sixth in the inaugural GI Breeders' Cup "Distaff Turf" to end last year's campaign, Perfect Sting took the winter off and has lived up to her name this season. The bay returned after a six-month layoff to take the May 7 GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct and got up for a nose score in the June 10 GIII Just A Game Breeders' Cup H. last time out. The crowd's choice to make it three in a row, she sat sixth for a half, moved up as they raced around the far turn and rallied down the lane to catch front-running Snow Polina in the final strides. "In the last eighth of a mile, she showed how good she really is," trainer Joe Orseno said. "She dug in and she knew where the wire was. She has a lot of heart." Added jockey Jerry Bailey, "The real great ones always find a way to win." As for the future, Orseno said, "We're going to give her a short breather and get ready for the Diana [GII, \$500,000 at Saratoga Sept. 4]."

Giving owner Frank Stronach his third graded-stakes win of the afternoon, Euchre dueled on the front end from the start and held off Sultry Substitute down the lane to land his first graded-stakes score. The bay, third in two-thirds of Canada's Triple Crown--the Queen's Plate and the Prince Of Wales S.--last year, ended 1999 with a seventh-place allowance finish trying turf for the first time. He came back in a Santa Anita allowance on the main track Mar. 12 and ran second, then put together back-to-back wins Mar. 29 and May 11, besting Sultry Substitute by a head in his latest try. Returning to the stakes ranks as an outsider, the gelding engineered a repeat of his latest effort, but this time adding to the margin of victory. "This is a nice horse, but we've had some problems with quarter cracks," Humberto Ascanio, assistant to trainer Bobby Frankel, said. "That's why you see all of the gaps between his races. But we've always liked him a lot and he showed today how tough he is. This horse, he's good enough to be a contender with some really good horses." The 13-10 favorite River Keen, who also suffers from foot problems and was making his first start since an 11th-place finish in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, closed to be third. "He lost a lot of ground when he stumbled at the start," trainer Bob Baffert said. "And I lost some time--we just have to keep battling his quarter cracks. But I thought he ran well. It was a good start."

The winner by a nose in the GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream in January, Hurricane Bertie picked up checks in a couple more Florida stakes before getting back to the winner's circle after the Mar. 25 Queen S. at Turfway Park. She tried turf in her next outing, the Apr. 22 Stravinsky S. at Keeneland, and finished fourth, then went to the bench for a couple of months. The chestnut returned to be second after setting the pace in the June 17 GIII Vagrancy H. at Belmont Park. Back in the Sunshine State, she stalked favored Show Me The Stage (Slew the Surgeon) through solid fractions, rallied to take the lead at the eighth pole and drew clear. "We know she'll come from behind--she's done it before," trainer Bernie Flint, who also saddled Swept Away to win the GIII Azalea Breeders' Cup S. earlier on the card, said. As for what's next, he said, "She ran good in the Ballerina [GI, Aug. 20] at Saratoga last year and we'll consider that race."

An impressive allowance winner in her lone previous start over this track last December, Swept Away went on to win a pair of sprint stakes at Gulfstream over the winter. Second as the 13-10 choice in the Apr. 21 Gll Beaumont S. at Keeneland, she had not been out since running third in the Ms. Preakness S. May 18. Bumped a bit at the break, she recovered to sit just off the pace before surging to the front on the far turn and drawing off to give jockey Pat Day his third of fourth winners of the afternoon. The winner could make her next start in the Gl Test S. at Saratoga July 29.

Trainer Bill Perry thought about leaving North East Bound in the barn when this race was switched from the grass to the sloppy main track, but decided to give the gelding a shot and the call proved to be correct as the 4-1 shot led every step en route to a decisive win. "I had run North East Bound on a sloppy track once before and he didn't run well," Perry said. "But sloppy tracks can de very different. I talked it over with [jockey Jose Velez Jr.] and we decided to leave him in, but if he hadn't handled the going, Jose wasn't going to get after him." As it turned out, Velez didn't have to push his horse. The dark bay went right to the front, turned back a challenge after a half mile, then opened up on the field and cruised home an easy winner. "He felt great," Velez said. "He handled the track well. He was just galloping along and, when I asked him at the quarter pole, he was full of run. Everything worked out very well." Off the board in the Nov. 7 Steinlen S. at Gulfstream Park in his 1999 finale, the dark bay came back to win the Charlie Eckman Mile S. at Pimlico May 7, but tired to be seventh in the GIII Red Bank H. over this course last time out May 29. He bounced back to pick up his fifth stakes victory here, but his first on the dirt. Will he try the main track again in his next start? "No, we'll put him back on the turf," Perry said. "He's nominated for the Bernard Baruch H. [at Saratoga July 28]. But at least we know he can run on the dirt if he has to."

Although Mayaro finished unplaced in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville at Longchamp Apr. 27, he had looked formidable when destroying his field with a front-running display previously in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour at the same course Mar. 30. If he reproduces that effort here, he will be hard to catch. One that could trouble him is Lucky Dream, who won this last year when Ben Ewar was a close fourth. Fifth in both the G2 Vicomtesse Vigier at Longchamp May 21 and the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 11, Lucky Dream returned to winning ways in the Listed Prix Moskowa at Chantilly June 30, taking that race for the second time. Ben Ewar finished in front of Lucky Dream when third in the Grand Prix de Chantilly last time out and must be respected. Andre Fabre's lightly raced War Game was second in the G3 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud May 17 last time and, if she has progressed, could go close.

Although he missed the kick slightly, that was a blessing, as Repertory (GB) (Anshan {GB}) and Rosselli took each other on in front at breakneck speed. As they rounded the turn into the short straight, jockey Tony Culhane was threading Indian Spark through on the rail. Switched to the outside, the six-year-old had plenty left to grab the lead with 150 yards remaining, before going away to win impressively in the end. Connections are now eyeing the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct 1. "We were confident he would run into a place today," Culhane said. "As silly as it sounds, he's only got to improve that one more step, and in the Prix de l'Abbave, there'll be soft ground, and thev'll go flat out, and he'll come through at the end."

Eminence Grise has so far failed to win at this level, having put in some fair efforts in handicaps, but he found the opportunity to win his first stakes race. Settled in fourth on the rail, he was always travelling easily under jockey Richard Quinn. As they entered the home straight, he was asked for his effort, and responded well to close on the leader, but they had unwelcome attention from Musician, Bay Of Islands and Mowbray (USA) (Opening Verse {USA}) on the far side. As these four dived toward the line, the blanket finish could only be deciphered by a photograph, but in the end it was Eminence Grise's last plunge 50 yards from the finish which proved decisive. Quinn was relieved: "They went a nice pace, and he was relaxed--I had the run of the race, so I didn't have to take a pull or anything, and in the end he's won well. I thought I'd won--it's an instinct."

'POWER' STILL MIGHTY

"It's like trying to hold a train," Brett Grant, regular trackrider of Might and Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), said after an exhibition canter at Rosehill yesterday almost turned into a full scale gallop."He knows what he wants to do. He's a racehorse." The dual Horse of the Year has not raced since November 1998, when he was found to have a tendon injury after he won the Queen Elizabeth Stakes at Flemington. Owner Nick Moraitis said although the injury appeared to have completely healed, no risks would be taken with the seven-time Group 1 winner. "The Cox Plate is the race we are aiming at with him, but if anything goes wrong he will be retired immediately," Moraitis said. "He is a day-byday proposition. There is no set program and we still haven't decided when he will have his first start back." Might and Power's Group 1 wins include the 1997 Caulfield-Melbourne Cups double and 1998 Cox Plate, and he is currently the fourth highest stakes earner in Australasia behind Octagonal (NZ), Super Impose (NZ) and Tie The Knot (Aus). Moraitis confirmed that Jim Cassidy would be returning to Australia from Singapore to ride Might and Power throughout his campaign.
