KEENELAND JULY STARTS TODAY

Tonight at 7:30 p.m., auctioneer Tom Caldwell will slam his hammer and it will be time to "Play Ball," as Keeneland hosts the first session of its 57th July Selected Yearling Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. A total of 208 yearlings are catalogued for this year's two-day, three-session event. The first of two Tuesday sessions begins at 10 a.m. and the second, the sale's final session, will begin at 7:30 p.m. "The success of our past July sale graduates speaks volumes about the quality of horses in this sale," said W.B. Rogers Beasley, Keeneland's director of sales. "The caliber of horses that have gone through our ring is a real credit to our consignors. In 1999 and 2000 to date, we've had 17 July Sale graduates who have won 26 Grade I or Group 1 stakes. And we believe the quality of horses in this year's sale rivals the quality of recent years." The Who's Who list of sires represented at the auction, includes offspring by such great stallions as the late Mr. Prospector, A.P. Indy, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Nurevey, Sadler's Wells, Seattle Slew and Unbridled. Mr. Prospector is represented by five colts and three fillies in this year's event. Buyers will have their first opportunity to purchase yearlings by such promising young stallions as Atticus, Boston Harbor, Pulpit, Siphon and Spinning World. Recent graduates of the July sale include Grade/Group I winners Agnes World, Banshee Breeze, Behrens, Black Hawk, Cash Run, Catinca, Commendable, Eagle Cafe, Fasliyev, Forestry, Fusaichi Pegasus, Gracioso, High Yield, Stephen Got Even, Stravinsky, Tranquility Lake, and Vicar. "I think people that come to the July Selected Yearling Sale are really looking for that Classic, that special horse," said Duncan Taylor, who oversees Taylor Made Farm and who has consigned over 25 horses to the Keeneland auction. "We try to raise a horse for them and we hope that we have one." All three sessions of the sale can be seen live on ESPN.com.

PETRUSHKA ADDS A CLASSIC

Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain), at odds of 11-2, produced an emphatic performance to take her first Classic, handing a five-and-a-half length beating to 2-1 favorite Melikah (Ire) (Lammtarra) and record a memorable Irish Derby and Oaks double for jockey Johnny Murtagh. She was brilliant in her first start this year, winning the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket Apr. 18, but failed to shine when a one-paced third behind Lahan (GB) in the G1 1000 Guineas S. at the same course May 7. When she had to come from a long way back at her next attempt at a Classic in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 9, she did well to finish fourth behind Love Divine (GB). The feeling entering this race was that she had yet to recapture the form of her seasonal return and the hope was that she could finally show her mettle in this company. She turned those hopes to hard reality here with a powerful display in the straight under a suitably confident ride from Murtagh to make history as the first syndicateowned horse to win a Classic. She settled in fourth on the rail early as Littlepacepaddocks (Ire) (Accordion {Ire}) set out to make it a true test of stamina. As they swung off the turn into the straight, Murtagh kept his head and waited for the gap to appear on the rail. When the leader veered off in front, he had his opening and he went for it, taking her to the front with one and a half furlongs remaining before bursting clear and settling the result in a matter of strides. The further she went, the more she turned this competitive Classic into a procession, powering away to comprehensively reverse Epsom placings. While Melikah stayed on well for a clear second, Richard Fahey's Inforagenny (GB) (Deploy {GB}) ran on to claim third place at a mighty 100-1. Tim Jones, speaking for the Highclere Thoroughbred Racing Syndicate, said afterwards, "We're thrilled to bits; she was awesome. The mood here is ecstatic, as it is our first Classic glory, and it's something you dream can happen, but never dare to imagine. It's easy in hindsight to say this, but we came here with that confidence because she had done everything right since Epsom. She's at least turned the tables on two of the three that beat her at Epsom, and without wishing to be too cocky, it would be nice to have the opportunity to have a go at the other one (Love Divine) now." Trainer Michael Stoute added, "The G1 Yorkshire Oaks (York, Aug. 23) would be the obvious target, but I would like to take plenty of time to think about it. She is very well entered up and there are lots of opportunities for her."

War Game showed promise with a half length second to Super Tassa (Ire) in the G3 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud May 17 last time out and a win in the Listed Prix de la Pepiniere at Longchamp Apr. 20 in her second start. Here she was ridden with utmost confidence by Olivier Peslier to record her first graded stakes success. Peslier was content to let Mayaro (Fr) (Saumarez {GB}) put 10 lengths between him and his filly with a mile to race. That decision proved decisive, as Mayaro came back to War Game and Lucky Dream turning into the straight. Cruising with three furlongs remaining, she quickened to lead shortly after and only had to be kept to her work to hold off the spirited challenge of Herculano and win comfortably in the end. Ben Ewar (GB) (Old Vic {GB}) was pulled up midway through the race after hemorrhaging badly and falling before jockey Davy Bonilla could get him to a complete stop.

He won his only start as a two-year old last August at Saratoga and returned off a long layoff in April to finish a close fourth in a Keeneland allowance. Shipping north to Belmont, the bay narrowly won an allowance May 11. He made his stakes debut in the GII Hill Prince S. June 17, missing by a half length. As the heavy favorite over the boggy going, Rob's Spirit raced up closed to the early pace, rallied on the final turn and drew away when roused to earn his first graded stakes victory. "He's got great cruising speed and he lets you sit him where you need to," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "The turf didn't seem all that soft to me, but he handled the going great anyway."
