ALLEN PAULSON DEAD

Allen Paulson, the owner and breeder of Cigar, died Wednesday night at Scripps Hospital in La Jolla, California after a long battle with cancer. He was 78. Paulson earned four Eclipse Awards during his distinguished career in racing, but it was two-time Horse of the Year Cigar that brought him the most glory. The brilliant bay tied an American record when he won 16 straight races in 1995-96, capturing the \$3 million Breeders' Cup Classic and the \$4 million Dubai World Cup during the streak. Cigar retired as America's leading money winner with \$9,999,813 in purses, but he never had a chance at a stud career, proving infertile. Born in Iowa in 1922, Paulson served in the Army Air Corps during World War II. He later made a career in aviation, climbing the ladder from flight engineer to test pilot to commercial pilot for TWA before creating his first company in 1951. The entrepreneur eventually moved into the business of aircraft design and production, creating Gulfstream Aerospace Corp in 1978. An award-winning pilot, he flew his Gulfstream VI jets on record-setting around-the-world flights twice. Paulson became involved in racing in the 1960s as the owner of a small claiming stable, but later said, "I figured unless you really get into it, it's no sense. It's like owning an oil well--you have to go all the way." Paulson would go all the way to the top of the sport, racing eight champions: Ajina, Arazi, Blushing John, Cigar, Eliza, Escena, Estrapade and Theatrical (Ire). Paulson never won an American Classic, but his Zagreb took the Irish Derby in 1996. The most prolific Breeders' Cup owner in the event's history, Paulson had 32 Breeders' Cup runners, accounting for six wins, two seconds and seven thirds and earnings of more than \$7.5 million. He also owned 1991 Juvenile hero Arazi in partnership with Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum. "From any perspective, Allen Paulson was one of those rare individuals who succeeded in creating a racing and breeding dynasty in his own lifetime," said Breeders' Cup Ltd. President D.G. Van Clief. "If you look at what he accomplished, he did it from every perspective--he was an owner, a breeder, a buyer and a seller, and he made indelible marks on the industry in each of those capacities. His loss is a very sad one, not only to family and friends, but to the entire business." Paulson is survived by his wife Madeleine, three sons and a step-daughter. There will be a private family funeral, with a memorial to be held in Rancho Santa Fe, California.

UNBRIDLED COLT TOPS FASIG FINALE

A colt by Kentucky Derby winner Unbridled brought a final bid of \$525,000 yesterday to top Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky Selected Yearling Sale in Lexington. Out of the Alleged mare Tom's a la Mode, the chestnut yearling was purchased by Richard Mulhall on behalf of Cimmarron Stables. "I just loved his color and when he walked by, he winked at me," Mulhall said of the colt. "We just look for conformation. I'm not sure yet where we'll send him now, because we send horses to so many places, but he will be trained by Bob Baffert." Eugene Melnyk paid \$400,000 for hip number 465, the co-highest priced filly of the sale's final session. The bay yearling is by Phone Trick--Heavenly Note, by Sunny's Halo and was consigned by Beth Bayer, Agent V. "I have had my eye on that filly for some time," Melnyk admitted. "She is the best filly in the sale and we were going to do everything in our power to buy her." Also bringing \$400,000, was hip number 365, a daughter of Is It True--Clever Monique, by Clever Trick. The bay filly, a full sister to graded stakes winner Is It True, was consigned by Lakland LLC, agent and purchased by Win Star Farm. "Overall we're pleased with the increase in the numbers," commented Walt Robertson, president of Fasig-Tipton. When asked about the tepid bidding during Wednesday's opening session, Robertson added, "That was just the way the horses fell yesterday. Bottom line is, if the horses are there, the buyers will also be there." For the two-day sale, the average increased 3.7 percent over 1999. A total of 181 horses were reported not sold.

CAPE CANAVERAL RETIRED Graded stakes winner **Cape Canaveral** (Mr. Prospector--Seaside Attraction, by Seattle Slew) has been officially retired from racing, the colt's owner and breeder Overbrook Farm announced yesterday. The four-year-old, a full brother to champion filly Golden Attraction, won the 1999 GIII San Miguel in only his second career outing, but was sidelined nearly a year with a condylar fracture. Cape Canaveral suffered the first defeat of his career when third in his return to the races, but rebounded with a three-length win in a Jan. 15 optional claimer at Santa Anita. He was scratched from the Feb. 6 GII Strub with an ankle injury. Cape Canaveral retires with three wins in four starts and earnings of \$128,640. He will stand next season at Overbrook for a fee of \$10,000 live foal guaranteed.

"We submitted a proposal to lease Benny the Dip for two years," said Chris Richardson, general manager of Cheveley Park Stud. "This has been submitted to the syndicate and we now await a decision. We have a horse from Australia and a horse from Japan, and we'd love having one from America."

FALLON EYES RETURN

Current British champion jockey Kieren Fallon has announced that he is looking at an earlier-than-expected return to the saddle following serious injury in a fall at Ascot's Royal meeting. Commenting on the Victor Chandler International website, Fallon said: "I am having the protective sleeve taken off my arm in two weeks and will then have physio [physical therapy]. COOLMORE CONTINGENT DOMINATE RATINGS

Champion Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien and Coolmore stallion Danehill (USA) dominate *Turform's* latest set of ratings for Irish juveniles. Ballydoyle boss O'Brien has yet to reach the heights of last season, but has eight of the top 10 rated two-year-olds (including the top six) and the platform is in place for another landmark season. Danehill, set for another shuttle season in Australia, also plays a highly prominent role, being responsible for four of Ireland's top six. Joint highest rated juveniles are Honours List (Ire) (Danehill {USA}) and Modigliani (USA) (Danzig {USA}); the highest-rated filly is Little Firefly (Ire) (Danehill {USA}). O'Brien is also represented by six of the top 10 in the three-year-olds category, including G1 St James's Palace S. and G1 Coral-Eclipse winner Giant's Causeway (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}). The highest-rated sophomore, however, is G1 Vodafone Derby and G1 Budweiser Irish Derby hero Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA}) who is rated eight pounds clear at the top and currently enjoys the status of Ireland's highest rated horse. Sinndar's connections, owner His Highness the Aga Khan and trainer John Oxx, also enjoy top spot in the older horses division with top stayer and winner of last season's G1 Ascot Gold Cup Enzeli (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) rated best at 118.
