ALL-AMERICAN GIRLS

The 84th renewal of today's GI Coaching Club American Oaks offers sophomore fillies their lone opportunity to travel the entire circuit of the Belmont oval. Secret Status (A.P. Indv) has stormed to the front of the division on the strength of her three-race winning streak. After winning the GIII Florida Oaks, the chestnut took the GI Kentucky Oaks by 6 3/4 lengths and comes into this 12-furlong affair fresh from her victory in the GI Mother Goose at Belmont July 1. "She had some things to overcome in the Mother Goose and she did," said trainer Neil Howard. "I think she settles a lot better around two turns." Jockey Pat Day, who rode Commendable to victory in the GI Belmont S., will be aboard. "With Pat riding, you always feel like you have an edge," Howard added. The only chink in the laterunning filly's armor may be the pace of the race, which will likely by dictated by Jostle (Brocco). That filly, a winner of the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico two back, disputed a sharp pace of :45 3/5 and 1:09 4/5 when second in the Mother Goose and should be able to set softer fractions here. "I think the Mother Goose was her best race to date," remarked trainer John Servis. "She never got a breather. When Secret Status ran up to her, she dug in. She had every opportunity to chuck it and she didn't." Making her graded stakes debut for trainer Shug McGaughey is Resort (Pleasant Colony), who has won three of her last four starts against her elders in allowance company. Fourth in the Go For Wand S. at Delaware May 7 in her lone stakes try, she should appreciate the added distance here.

505 DISPERSAL STARTS TODAY

The first session of the complete dispersal of Marshall Naify's 505 Farms, under the auspices of Barretts Equine Ltd., will be held this evening at the Hinds Pavilion in Pomona, California, Part I of the dispersal offers 104 lots: 31 broodmares, including 14 with foals at their sides; two stallions; 56 horses of racing age; and 15 yearlings. Sure to attract the most interest is hip 58. MGISW Manistique (Unbridled--Astaire Step, by Nureyev). The five-year-old mare won 11 of her 15 starts, including the GI Vanity H. and GI Santa Margarita H. at four and the GI Santa Maria H. in her only start before being retired this year. She earned \$1,311,800. Also in the catalogue are: the four-year-old gelding Cliquot (Bertrando), a graded-stakes winner of \$480,540; the three-year-old colt David Copperfield (Halo), who has three wins in five starts including the GIII Cinema H.; the three-year-old colt I'm Persuaded (Deputy Minister), a \$1.1 million Keeneland April juvenile who broke his maiden this April at Hollywood; the unraced three-year-old filly Kanerrerr (Danzig), an \$825,000 Keeneland July yearling; Malabar Gold (Unbridled), a \$1 million Keeneland September yearling who was fourth in the Feb. 5 GII San Vicente S. last time out; graded-stakes winner Swept Overboard (End Sweep); and Revenescent (Mr. Prospector), an unraced two-year-old colt who was bred by Naify. Bidding begins at 6:30 p.m. PDT. Part II of the dispersal will be held by the Washington Thoroughbred Breeders Association at Emerald Downs on Tuesday, Sept. 5.

A SEPTEMBER PREVIEW?

Keeneland's July Sale is highly select stuff, as we know, whereas Fasig-Tipton's is more the equivalent of a September Book 2-3; "a September preview sale," somebody called it. These two distinct tiers of the Thoroughbred marketplace had one very important factor in common this week--buyers at both sales were pretty picky. The marginal individual was friendless...how else can we explain Fasig's massive 35-percent buy-back rate...but there was big money available for The Genuine Article.

It is certainly true that the buyers were more discriminating than in the last runaway bull market of 1983-85. Or perhaps there are a couple of other factors as well. Much of the trade in this business qualifies as "preaching to the converted," or trading among ourselves, and replenishing the stock of already existing owners.

The two-year-old pinhookers had one of those periodic stings they experience at this year's two-year-old sales, and were markedly not as much in evidence as in the past couple of years; that certainly jerked one collective big player off the floor.

The Need for New Owners...

And there is this continuing question of generating new owners. The NTRA now seems to have satisfied most of its critics and is turning its attention and resources to the problem, but that's not going to produce instant solutions.

There's a real long-term problem, and we've known about it for a long time--within the last 50 years, horse racing has lost its exclusive franchise on legalized gambling. The country's entire social configuration and attention have likewise also changed, and horse racing is no longer the glamor attraction--for fans and owners alike--we once were. And even though the industry's economy has recovered dramatically from the lows of 1992-95, there's growing evidence that horse racing is failing to attract the new generation of tech zillionaires.

Expanding the audience for horse racing as the whole audience itself continues to expand is really essential, and this week's results, in a somewhat odd way, only amplify that message. Continuing domestic recruitment of new players at every level of the industry, especially new owners/buyers, is a clear objective.

More on the Menu, Please...

Another area of expansion could be the menu for existing horseplayers. Here I have in mind this idea of 24-hour broadcasting of racing, and exporting American racing signals as much as importing them.

There can be little doubt that simulcasting has pretty much saved American racing to this point, so we know the concept of sending racing to new markets of already-existing horseplayers works. This is in many ways a business without borders anyway so, having transcended state borders, we just need to expand the concept to transcend national borders now.

But delivery of comprehensible past performance information is almost as importance as the delivery of live pictures and audio; previous experience should have demonstrated that people bet a lot more on races in other countries when they have understandable past performance lines to work from. I know I do, and plenty of gamblers I know have said the same to me.

Stallion Summary...

It's probably significant that of the top 12 sires on average at this week's sales--most of these numbers established at Keeneland, of course, which had 52 of the 53 "six-and-a-half" figure (\$500,000+) yearlings sold--the youngest is Kingmambo, whose oldest foals are five this year.

This week's significant new arrival in the top 12 is Saint Ballado, formerly known as Devil's Bag's little brother. With a \$1.4-million colt at Keeneland joining the Godolphin team and a \$475,000 colt at Fasig, Saint Ballado's five yearlings sold this week (from eight offered) averaged an impressive \$579,000.

The Taylor Made import from Florida even had his first dual Classic-placed son, Captain Bodgit, represented by his first yearlings at Fasig (seven, averaged \$45,867).

As the oldest foals by Saint Ballado himself are just six-year-olds this year, he's a horse showing all he signs of turning into a big-time sire.

The highest-ranked younger stallion was Claiborne's Pulpit, who came in 13th overall, with six yearlings (of seven offered) averaging \$550,833.

The leading second-crop sire, Taylor Made's Unbridled's Song, was two places further back, also with six selling (of eight), which averaged \$495,333.

As mentioned earlier in the week, the two leading Coolmore/Ashford stallions from the same sire groups, Spinning World (seven/nine, \$242,857) and Hennessy (just six/15, \$237,833), both retained second rankings in the respective lists, but didn't really have big weeks. Still, it's seven weeks until September, when the numbers offered will of course be much bigger, and the likelihood is these particular gaps will close.

Second-crop yearling sires are, of course, pretty much at the mercy of last week's first-crop results at any yearling sale the year their first two-year-olds run, and it probably doesn't pay to read too much into the results. One horse in that category who I thought really did sell well is Lord Carson, whose four sold at Fasig (of seven offered) averaged \$145,500 (including a \$350,000 filly), ranking him third behind Unbridled's Song and Hennessy among sires with their first two-year-olds. He has gotten off to a good start, to be sure, but even so, this looked a good commercial performance.

Among the sires with their first yearlings, three horses head into Saratoga and September looking like they will fill out the top five of their group commercially, behind Pulpit and Spinning World. They all had similar profiles this week, collectively having 82 percent sold from offered, and all three averaging in a \$20,000 band.

These three were: Airdrie's Siphon (nine/11, \$165,556); Three Chimney's Atticus (three/four, \$163,333); and Overbrook's Boston Harbor (six/seven, \$147,500).

There were also a few impressive single sales for the likes of Geri (\$210,000) and Gold Case (\$132,000) at Fasig. And we'll be seeing a lot more in September from quite a few who were represented at Fasig: Ashford's Victory Speech (two/seven, \$78,500) and Louis Quatorze (six/eight, \$77,167); Gainesway's Smoke Glacken (nine/12, \$68,333) and Sir Cat (five/seven, \$45,600); Vinery's Langfuhr (three/seven, \$56,667) and Sandpit (four/six, \$55,500).

Airdrie's Cat's Career quietly did well (five/seven, \$54,400), and Margaux's Captain Bodgit (seven/10, \$45,857) rounds out a group we're likely to be seeing a lot more of over the next couple of months.

Bright Valour looked like a Classic prospect after his juvenile season in which he won two of three starts and finished second to Prime Timber by 3/4 of a length in the other, but sat out 1999 with various injuries. The four-year-old has returned strongly this season, winning the Dr. Fager H. over this track June 4 before finishing second to Yankee Victor in the GIII Hanshin H. at Arlington June 25. Training smartly over this surface, the bay breezed a bullet five furlongs in 1:00 July 15 in preparation for this outing. Mula Gula, a multiple gradedstakes winner on the lawn at three, opened 2000 with a sharp effort on the Churchill main, finishing second by a head to Straight Man in the GII Winnercomm H. in a swiftly run 1:21 2/5. Graded stakes-winner Nite Dreamer took the Sportsman's Park Breeders' Cup H. in April, but needs to rebound from a fifth to Sir Bear in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. July 5.

Kumari Continent, second in the GI Santa Anita Oaks in March, finished ninth in the May 5 Kentucky Oaks. She returned in the May 27 GII Honeymoon H. on turf, finishing second after dueling for the lead.
