SOPHS CLASH IN SWAPS

A compact field of six three-year-olds face the starter this afternoon in Hollywood Park's final Grade I event of the meeting, the 27th running of the Swaps. Triple Crown veteran Captain Steve (Fly So Free), eighth in the Kentucky Derby and fourth in the Preakness, tallied his first victory of 2000 when coasting home a 1 3/4-length winner of the Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows July 3. The millionaire, who was victorious in this track's GI Hollywood Futurity last year, will have jockey Corey Nakatani aloft for the first time. The chestnut tuned up for today's heat with a bullet five panels July 18 in :58 4/5. The prime competition could come from the rival drawn on the rail, Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy), a full brother to the crack handicapper Budroyale. Second in his first try at a distance of ground May 11, the bay broke his maiden by 8 1/2 two back and earned black type when he bested Dixie Union by a neck in the GIII Affirmed H. July 1. Fellow California bred Spacelink (Mane Minister), from team Toffan/McCaffery/Gonzalez won the Cal Cup Juvenile in his second and final start at two and resurfaced with a third-place finish against his elders June 23. The homebred adds Lasix for the first time and can factor with an off-the-pace try. Spicy Stuff (Tabasco Cat) stretched to two turns for the first time May 13 and crossed the line a neck better than Tiznow. Supplemented to this event for \$15,000, the dark bay was a courageous winner of an entry-level allowance test June 23, accounting for Spacelink in third. Millencolin (Dehere), who won the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile as a two-year-old, has one win from two starts this season and was third, beaten 2 1/2 lengths in the Affirmed. Grey Memo (Memo {Chi}) is two for three over the local main track, including a 1 1/4-length success in the valuable Snow Chief S. Apr. 30.

JOSTLE HUSTLES TO CCA GLORY

Under a well-managed ride by jockey Mike Smith, Jostle (Brocco) atoned for her runner-up finish behind Secret Status (A.P. Indy) in the GI Mother Goose July 1 by scoring a front-running victory in yesterday's GI Coaching Club American Oaks on the penultimate day of summer racing at Belmont Park in New York. Following a pair of indifferent runs in Fair Grounds' stakes company over the winter, the dark bay was second in the GIII Comely S. in the Aqueduct mud Apr. 21. Shipped to Baltimore, Jostle came from just off the pace to register a 2 1/2-length victory in Pimlico's GII Black-Eyed Susans S. May 19 prior to her Mother Goose effort. Sent to the early lead, Smith coaxed the John Servis trainee through three quarters in 1:15 as Secret Status raced just off her flank. Resort (Pleasant Colony) was asked to quicken rounding the far turn, overtook and discouraged the race favorite, but could not get past the leader, who had plenty in reserve to win going away for her first Grade I success. "She's got a lot of grit and I'm happy to be part of the team," Smith commented. "She really dug in and showed she wanted to win." Of the third-place finisher, trainer Neil Howard said, "This was a tricky race. Our filly was close to the pace, but not out of her game. I wasn't worried about the distance going in. Our filly didn't run to her full capability." Winning conditioner John Servis, saddling his first Grade I winner, said that the filly could rematch with her two rivals in the GI Alabama at Saratoga Aug. 19.

Blazing Sword began the year with a victory against Gulfstream money-allowance types in January before testing the waters of the GIII Widener H. Mar. 18. After a slow start, the gelding circled seven wide into contention and finished second by two lengths to Lemon Drop Kid, but was promoted to the victory when that one swerved during the stretch run. Following a pair of fifthplace finishes, the gelding crossed the million-dollar threshold when prevailing by a length in the Suave Prospect overnight handicap at Calder June 19. Rated along toward the rear in the early going, jockey Jose Rivera asked "the Sword" to pick it up around the far turn, shifted to the rail for the stretch drive and picked off favored Mula Gula and Nite Dreamer for the victory. "He'll do anything you ask him to, but you have to ask him for it," commented winning trainer Kathleen O'Connell. "The last was quite credible and the timing was right for this one."

Kumari Continent broke her maiden at her first try around two turns Feb. 3 and was thought highly enough by connections to give the GI Santa Anita Oaks a try. The dark bay was never out of contention that Mar. 12 afternoon and gave then divisional leader Surfside everything she could handle before succumbing late to finish second by three parts of a length. The winner of the restricted Providencia over the Arcadia lawn in her next start, Kumari Continent was a lackluster ninth as the 4.70-1 favorite in the GI Kentucky Oaks two back. The runner up by 3/4 of a length in the GII Honeymoon H. over the local lawn May 27, the Paco Gonzalez pupil was the clear favorite. Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' winner Cash Run (Seeking the Gold) broke alertly and set the pace as expected, but jockey Kent Desormeaux kept Kumari Continent within one length as the pair raced to the far turn. Joined turning for home by Queenie Belle, the Toffan and McCaffery colorbearer, overtaken at the eighth pole by Queenie Belle, dug in gamely and wore down her rival to score the narrow victory. "Things worked out well for us, we had a great trip," Desormeaux explained. "She accepted the fact that there was a horse in front of her and consequently she relaxed very well. It allowed me to assess the field and see what was going on and that helped us too. The most important thing, though, is that she is a very talented horse."

Sincerely, never far from the front, battled gamely in the stretch to record her first graded score. She had traded decisions with Valleydar in her last two starts, winning the Go For Wand May 7 (in which CCA Oaks second Resort was fourth) and finishing second to her rival in the Susan's Girl June 10. Neither filly was favored here, however, due to the presence of Kentucky shippers Trip and Lady Melesi. Sincerely pressed Valleydar through fractions of :23 and :46 1/5, drawing even at the three-eighths pole. Under heavy urging, she edged away and held off the late charge of favored Trip. "It's unlike me, but I felt quietly confident today," said winning conditioner H. Graham Motion. "I think you have a huge edge when you are stabled here. We knew she could handle the track and that's a big part of it." Added winning rider Mike McCarthy, "I rode her very confidently. I moved when I had to and went to her early. I did what I thought was the right in putting her (Valleydar) away early and then to hope that we did not get beat at the finish." Motion did not mention a specific next race for the winner, but said that "we could consider Saratoga."

A quarter mile out, Tertullian struck the front, with Arc Royal and Sunderland close up and those three dueled to the line, with Sunderland just gaining the verdict on the line.

A quality field has assembled for the season's first German Group 1 race for three-year-olds and upwards. Domestic hopes will mainly rest on the proven Caitano, with champion jockey Andrasch Starke in the saddle, and Silvano, who did not like the heavy going at Hamburg when Flamingo Road made all to easily win the G2 IDEE Hansa-Preis June 25. Catella, however, is the one horse who can beat them all. She finished ahead of Caitano in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano at Milan June 18 and she has a top class rider, Terry Hellier, to give her guidance. The two English runners, Mutafaweq and the extremely consistent Yavana's Pace, should acquit themselves well. The former won last season's G1 St Leger and reappeared this year with a commendable third to Montjeu (Ire) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28. He does have a bit to find with Yavana's Pace on their running in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 23, the pair finishing seventh and second, respectively.

Always highly regarded, Bienamado won the G3 Prix de Conde as a juvenile and made only four starts last year, including a head second to subsequent Arc de Triomphe winner Montjeu in the G2 Prix Niel. Fifth in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine in his North American debut last October, the chestnut could hardly have been more impressive when rolling home a sevenlength winner of the restricted Jim Murray H. June 25. Self Feeder, second by a neck in the 10-furlong GI Charlie Whittingham H. two starts back, shipped to Lone Star Park for the June 17 Dallas Turf Cup, but faded to be sixth as the 8-5 favorite. The six-year-old should appreciate the stretch back out in distance. Single Empire is part of a formidable entry with Bienamado and will try to end a string of three-straight runner-up finishes. He most recently filled that spot in the GIII Golden Gate H. June 17.

The richest race this afternoon belongs to Delaware Park and features a rematch of the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup, in which Lu Ravi got to the wire a head in front of multiple champion Silverbulletday. The winner of the GIII Sixty Sails H. at Sportsman's Park in her previous start, Lu Ravi looks to make it three straight today. Silverbulletday, winner of Keeneland's Doubledogdare in her seasonal debut, was twice second to Heritage of Gold in a pair of Churchill Downs stakes this spring. A win today from the Bob Baffert filly would eclipse the filly/mare career earnings record currently held by Serena's Song. Defending champion Tap To Music is back to defend her Del 'Cap crown off a fifth in the Molly Pitcher.
