MANISTIQUE TOPS 505 FARMS DISPERSAL Manistique (Unbridled), unraced since a win in the GI Santa Maria H. at Santa Anita Feb. 19, topped Saturday night's 505 Farms dispersal sale at Barretts in Pomona, California as expected, bringing home a bid of \$3 million from Aaron and Marie Jones. The sale, held to disperse the holdings of the late Marshall Naify's 505 Farms, generated \$18,238,500 for 93 horses, including 29 horses of racing age, 25 two-year-olds, 25 broodmares, 12 yearlings and two stallions. The second-highest price of the evening was the \$2.6 million sent in for David Copperfield (Halo), a three-year-old colt who defeated eventual Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus in their respective career debuts Dec. 11 at Hollywood, and who went on to win the GIII Cinema H. at Hollywood June 10. An air of mystery surrounded the sale, as Barretts declined to identify the members of the buying group who took home David Copperfield and two others; the group signed the tickets as 'Visionary Corp.' "These are people who've been here before," Barretts president Gerry McMahon told Thoroughbred Times. "You'll see who they are when these horses are entered in the races." In all, the group spent \$3.56 million on the day, the most of any buyers, also taking home Cliquot (Bertrando), the 1999 GIII El Camino Real Derby winner for \$450,000; and Minstinguette (Devil's Bag), an unraced two-year-old filly, for \$510,000. Naify's remaining holdings will be dispersed at a Washington Thoroughbred Breeders Association sale at Emerald

The winner of three graded stakes at two, the GII Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland, the GII Kentucky Jockey Club at Churchill and the GI Hollywood Futurity to close out his year, Captain Steve was expected to be one of the most promising stars on the Triple Crown trail this spring. After four straight losses in graded preps were followed by an eighth in the Kentucky Derby and a fourth in the Preakness, however, he took a month and a half off and was sent to the lowa Derby, his first non-graded effort in 11 starts since breaking his maiden. He parlayed a win in lowa with this win here, and suddenly seems to be fulfilling his early promise in the second half of the year. Forcing the early pace here, he took over on the turn and kicked clear in the stretch as the odds-on choice. "I knew the trip to lowa was really going to help," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "He needed a confidence builder. I needed to get a win under his belt. You could tell he was a different horse after that." Baffert said he would consider a number of options for the colt's next start, including the Aug. 5 GII Jim Dandy, the Aug. 6 Gl Haskell and the Aug. 26 Gl Travers. Corey Nakatani, aboard the colt for the first time, was impressed. "I think he's going to be a serious horse down the road," he said. Tiznow, a neck winner of the GIII Affirmed H. in his last start July 1, closed for second but could not advance further on the winner. "He got rank big time on me down the backstretch," said jockey Victor Espinoza. "But when he learns, he's going to be a very, very nice horse."

SUANCES UNDERGOES SURGERY Suances (GB) (Most Welcome {GB}), the G1 Prix Jean Prat winner who was scratched from yesterday's GII American Derby at Arlington International due to an injury suffered while schooling in the Arlington paddock, underwent surgery to repair a partially severed extensor tendon on his right hind leg. The horse was treated immediately by Dr. John Whittaker, the horse's private veterinarian, but it was later decided to send the colt to the Illinois Equine Hospital in nearby Naperville for surgery. The procedure is said to have gone well and Suances is expected to return to Arlington within a day or so. Prognosis for a full recovery is good.

Winner of both the G1 Doncaster St Leger and the G2 King Edward VII S. at Ascot last year, Mutafaweg began this campaign with a third to Montjeu (Ire), beaten three lengths, in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28 before running a disappointing seventh to Fruits Of Love in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Ascot June 23. The four-year-old raced alongside Catella and Yavana's Pace (Ire) (Accordion {Ire}) early on as Quezon City led from Flamingo Road (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}). The frontrunner disposed of challenges from Catella and Flamingo Road at the top of the straight, but Mutafaweq quickened brilliantly just over a furlong out from the pack and was soon on terms with Quezon City. The Godolphin runner asserted his superiority close home, thus maintaining his owner's 100-percent strike rate in Germany this season. Quezon City held on well for second from Catella, who just got the better of Flamingo Road for third.

A Grade 3 winner and Grade 1-placed in France, Bienamado came to North America last fall, making his debut in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine in October, where he was fifth. He found a much easier spot for his 2000 debut when a seven-length winner of the Jim Murray Memorial H. at Hollywood June 24 in his last going a mile and a quarter on the turf. Self Feeder (Ire) (Lycius) opened up a seven-length lead early on, but Bienamado, part of the 1-5 Paco Gonzalez entry, had narrowed that to just a half-length after six furlongs and took over on the turn, drawing away for the win. Entrymate Single Empire, second in his last three, all graded stakes, looked for his first win since the '99 San Juan Capistrano, but had to settle for third. Bienamado will now be pointed to the Aug. 19 GI Arlington Million.

The winner of the GI Atto Mile last fall, Quiet Resolve ended his year with a 14th and last-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Gulfstream. The five-year-old has been on fire this year, though, winning an Apr. 27 Keeneland allowance in his 2000 debut and the GII Dixie H. at Pimlico May 20 before finishing second last out in the June 11 GII King Edward Breeders' Cup at Woodbine. The favorite here, he vied for the early lead three wide, took over after a mile and drew off under a strong hand ride. "He showed all the signs in the post parade and warming up to the gate that he wanted to do it today," said jockey Robby Albarado. "He was primed and tugging. He was first-class today."

Campaigned strictly in Ireland to date, Pine Dance came into this race wtih just a maiden and a handicap win to his credit from six starts. In against just three others here, he was established the outside choice by the Arlington crowd, but came from last with a half-mile to run to slip through on the rail and draw off for a driving finish. "I had plenty of horse underneath me and I had the option to either go around them or go up the rail," said winning jockey Eddie Ahern, riding his first race in America. "The option came for the rail so I took it. He was well within himself and he handled the ground well." Trainer Dermot Weld admitted he had a score to settle. "I've won on every track in America that I've sent a horse on except Arlington, so I had to rectify it," said Weld. "We hope to have him for the (Aug. 19, GI) Secretariat."

Lu Ravi came into this race looking for her third consecutive graded stakes win, but those p.p.s weren't good enough to make her the favorite, despite the fact that she edged out the choice, Silverbulletday, in the GII Molly Pitcher H. at Monmouth July 4. The latter was just one-for-four in 2000, taking the Doubledogdare S. at Keeneland Apr. 19, and was coming off three straight losses. Lu Ravi went to the lead while Silverbulletday moved into second after a half-mile and looked to make a race of it, but began to drift out in the lane and was no match for the winner. Tap to Music, between the first two, was bumped at the start, boxed in, and, once clear, closed ground, but coudn't get to the winner. "I was just trying to be a good passenger, not try to upset her or interfere with her action," said Pat Day. "Silverbulletday was in the race early. At the half-mile pole, I thought she was going to hold her position and make a race of it. Then she faded." Shane Sellers, aboard the favorite, said, "I just couldn't keep with him. I nudged on my filly and there was not a lot there."

Shipping up from Churchill Downs, Three Wonders benefitted from a perfect stalking trip to earn his first graded stakes victory. He broke his maiden last summer at Monmouth on the dirt, but showed a preference for grass two races later with a third in a Keeneland allowance in October. Returning from a seven-month layoff in a Churchill turf allowance June 15, the bay colt finished second, beaten a length. He got his first turf victory July 2 with an easy two-length score 2 at Churchill. The expensive two-year-old purchase saved ground here behind Field Cat, who had stepped out to a four-length early lead. Three Wonders gained around along the rail on the turn, angled outside Field Cat for the drive and surged to victory in deep stretch.

The winner of a May 5 maiden special weight, the May 29 W L Proctor Memorial S. and the June 25 Haggin S., all at Hollywood, he was sent away the 2-5 choice and acted the part, leading throughout through speedy fractions to win by daylight while clearly best. "He's improving every race," said winning trainer Joe Garcia Jr. "Laffit says he acts like an older horse--very professional." The trainer said this win game him Breeders' Cup aspirations. "He's by Marquetry out of a Lost Code mare, so he's bred to get a longer distance," he said.

Numbers Fall at Belmont

Two weeks of bad weather at the beginning of Belmont Park's spring-summer meet and lack of a Triple Crown candidate are blamed for a drop in attendence and handle. Slipping five percent, this year's on-track attendance fell to 468,618 from 1999's 493,155, with the on-track handle seeing a 5.5 percent loss, decreasing from last year's \$112,297,742 to this season's \$106,216,772. "While we certainly like to see gains across the board," said Terry Meyocks, NYRA president and COO, " we were very encouraged by the rebound during the second half of the meet." Even without the possibility of a Triple Crown winner this year, Belmont still did well for attendance on Belmont S. day. "We were able to set a record for a non-Triple Crown Belmont with almost 68,000 people on hand," Meyocks said. "When you look inside the numbers, though, you can see where and why the numbers for the meet came up short."

Scale of Weights Adjusted

The New York Racing Association has adjusted the scale of weights used in weighting races at their three tracks, in many cases narrowing the spread between three-year-olds and older horses, particularly earlier in the calendar year. Four-year-olds and older horses will be weighted at 126 at all distances throughout the year. "We think it will be better for jockeys while at the same time not putting horses at a competitive disadvantage," said Mike Lakow, NYRA racing secretary.


