TEST OF THE CHAMPION

Breaking one Churchill Downs track record, equaling another and winning two Grade I races in 1999 earned **Chilukki** (Cherokee Run) the Eclipse Award as top two-year-old filly, but this season didn't begin with such success. The champ looks for her first Grade I win of 2000 in today's \$250,000 Test S. at Saratoga. The Bob Baffert trainee ran second in the GIII Davona Dale S. Feb. 19 in her first start of the year, but finished a distant eighth as the 3-5 favorite in the GIII Fair Ground Oaks Mar. 11 and was given nearly four months off. She redeemed herself in her return, posting a five-length tally in the Regret S. at Monmouth July 4. **Finder's Fee** (Storm Cat), winner of the GIII Cicada S. earlier this year, also captured the GI Acorn S. at Belmont July 9. Her most recent effort was a close third in the GI Mother Goose July 1, but an excess of early speed in the Test may suit her off-the-pace style. "There are enough good fillies in there to set up a legitimate pace," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "A five- or six- or seven-horse field is not to her advantage, but with 11 [in the Test], there should be the pace she needs to run her race." Trainer Todd Pletcher looks for his third straight Test score with the entry of **Circle Of Life** (Belong to Me) and **Lucky Livi** (Mr. Greeley). Circle of Life picked up her only Grade I victory at Saratoga last summer, taking the Spinaway S. This year, the filly won a Gulfstream allowance Mar. 5 and returned a month later to finish third in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland. She has been off the board in three races since, all at a mile or longer, but the seven-furlong Spinaway suited her last year and so might the Test at the same distance.

HASSINGER LEAVES THOROUGHBRED CORP.

Trainer Alex Hassinger and Prince Ahmed Salman's The Thoroughbred Corp. have parted company. Citing a difference in philosophy, Hassinger said yesterday, "I resigned from The Thoroughbred Corp. last night. Basically, our philosophies did not parallel and therefore my future with the operation was in question. I felt it was in my best interest to move in a different direction at this time." He added, "I have no regrets and certainly no animosities toward The Thoroughbred Corp. I worked for them for almost two years and the experience, both personally and professionally, was very gratifying. Training Anees to win not only the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but the Eclipse Award as well, was the highlight of my career." Anees was Hassinger's second champion; he also guided Eliza to an Eclipse as top two-year-old filly in 1992 for Allen Paulson. As for his future, the trainer said, "I'm going to take some time off and relax down here at Del Mar." Currently, John Shirreffs is overseeing The Thoroughbred Corp. horses as interim trainer. "I don't know exactly what's going to happen at this point," said Shirreffs, who was to meet with Salman's Racing Manager Richard Mulhall yesterday. The private trainer for the late Marshall Naify's 505 Farms until that stable was designated for dispersal, Shirreffs recently opened a public stable.

WORLD-RECORD WEANLING DEBUTS

Padua Stables' **Padua's Pride (Ire)** (Caerleon), who set a world record when he sold for 2.5 million guineas, or about \$4.4 million, at the 1997 Tattersalls December Sales, will make his career debut in the first race at Saratoga tomorrow. Out of Doff The Derby (Master Derby), the three-year-old colt is a full brother to Generous (Ire), who was the champion three-year-old and Horse of the Year in Ireland and highweight three-year-old at 11-14 furlongs in both Britain and France in 1991 after winning the G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Irish Derby and G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.; he is also a half brother to Group winner Wedding Bouquet (Ire) (Kings Lake) and stakes winners Windy Triple K. (Jaklin Klugman), Osumi Tycoon (Ire) (Last Tycoon {Ire}) and Strawberry Roan (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). The bay, trained by D. Wayne Lukas and ridden by Pat Day, faces a full field of maidens going 1 1/16 miles on the turf.

His price may ensure that nobody gets rich from this contest, but the fact that no French-trained horse has won this since Pawneese in 1976 should deter those who intend to, to quote the famous line, "bet like men," on **Montjeu**. The colt stands so far in front of his rivals on all form that only the going has been offered as a realistic threat this week. A five-time Group 1 winner and multiple stakes winner at distances from 10 furlongs to a mile and a half, he mastered similar conditions last time with a sensational performance in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 2 and the realization that he may have improved from his memorable victory in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last October is gradually sinking in. The ground appears to be no less a negative factor for his main rivals, particularly for second favourite **Daliapour**. Although he fits the mold of the improving older horse capable of winning these types of races in the hands of Sir Michael Stoute, the disdain with which the French colt treated him in last year's G1 Irish Derby leaves a lasting impression. Nevertheless, he has progressed admirably this season, his finest effort coming when accounting for **Fantastic Light** last time in the G1 Coronation Cup Epsom June 9 on good-to-soft going. The prevailing fast conditions may count against him, as he has produced his best running on ground no faster than good, but his jockey, Johnny Murtagh, said, "This is perfect flat ground, and there is no jar in it. We think **Daliapour** has a good chance, and I'm looking forward to a good ride." *(Previews cont. p3)*

 Hap, who was unraced at two, ended his three-year-old season with a rallying second-place finish in the Steinlen S. over Breeders' Cup weekend at Gulfstream Park. He came back to take a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 11, then went on the shelf for 4 1/2 months before resurfacing to capture a Belmont allowance test June 30. Making his graded-stakes debut here, the Paulson-bred colt stalked the pace while under restraint, came with a three-wide bid on the far turn and outfinished **Inexplicable** to go four-for-four at the Bernard Baruch distance. "He's developing pretty nicely," trainer Bill Mott said. "He's got a great turn of foot and he's getting better with each race he runs. He never blows the field away, but he shows he has a good kick."

With the background of three domestic handicap successes under his girth, British-trained challenger Samsaam finished a good third in the G3 Queen's Vase at Royal Ascot June 20 and followed up by finishing second in the Listed Bahrain Trophy at Newmarket July 12. He was sent off with punters' confidence here and never had a moments worry, coming clear of a good field in the closing stages to record a first pattern-race win. Independence Hall (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) led in the early stages, but was upstaged by Samsaam at halfway. The winner went into a clear lead until allowing his rivals to take closer order on the home turn, but jockey Willie Supple, riding his first race in France, was only toying with his rivals and kicked on again at the quarter-mile marker. The combination were never under threat thereafter as Samsaam eased home in highly impressive style. Mister Kick came out of the pack and ran on well to be a clear second, with Le Nomade running on from the rear to take third close to home. Gary Hatfield, representing winning trainer John Dunlop, said, "The rain that fell in the last half hour before the race helped. Willie was able to give him a breather down the back straight and he stayed well. Hopefully he will stay in training next year." Supple added, "He travelled well and stretched them out all the way. The ground and the distance were just right for him."

Kona Gold hasn't raced since winning the GII Portero Grande Breeders' Cup H. Apr. 8 by 4 1/2 lengths, but has been working bullets and is at his best returning from a layoff. The runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint from came off a layoff of nearly three months to score in the GII Palos Verdes H. Jan. 29. He was beaten a nose by stablemate **Son of a Pistol** in the GII San Carlos H. Mar. 4. **Love That Red** makes his first start for the Bob Baffert stable. The Cal-bred gelding narrowly won the GI Malibu S. last December, but has started only once since, finishing third in the Apr. 22 Valiant Pete H. for state bred. Lexicon blazed the early fractions in the GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. July 9, but was caught in deep stretch and settled for third.
