MONTJEU MANHANDLES KING GEORGE FOES

Montieu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) was sent off the 1-3 favourite in vesterday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot and bested 12-1 Fantastic Light (Rahy) by 1 3/4 lengths, but the margin of victory does not begin to tell the story. Many great horses have proven themselves in this arena in the past, but not many have done so in hack-canter. The image of Nijinsky and Lester Piggott is foremost in the mind when looking for a demonstration of how to make this race look easy, but Montjeu deliverered a masterclass performance yesterday. The winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club, G1 Irish Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at three, the colt was not pressed at The Curragh on his seasonal return in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup May 28 and produced another smooth display in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud July 2. Here he was held up in last place early as Raypour (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) inserted vital pace into this potentially muddling race. As Johnny Murtagh on Daliapour (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Richard Quinn on Shiva (Jpn) (Hector Protector) sat second and third, Montjeu was restrained by Mick Kinane alongside Fantastic Light. But the crowd's choice swung around the bend and, before Kinane could curb his enthusiasm, was quickly in third on the outside with the others in top flight. As Raypour faded and Shiva capitulated, it was Daliapour who was committed by Murtagh. Then Kinane moved his hands a few inches and Montjeu put the race to sleep instantly. Daliapour, a winner at this level, gave everything he had, but the French colt just sauntered by. Not asked to do anymore, he cantered past the line with a comfortable margin over a gallant Fantastic Light, who had come away from the rest. Kinane said, "He's just so special--he's undoubtedly the best I've ridden by a long shot. Everything seems to be in slow motion and so effortless with him. He never went more than three-parts pace, but I said in the end just go and enjoy yourself; I didn't even ask him to race. There's plenty ahead." Owner Michael Tabor commented, "I spoke to Michael (Kinane) and he said I could have won on him. He was just brilliant--he's always been a special horse, and he proved it today." He pointed at the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 9 as his next target, before another tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 1. Commenting on the fact that he is likely to meet Dubai Millennium in Ireland, he added, "It's what the public would love to see." Chart p.2

GOING FOR GLORY

The much-anticipated rematch between divisional stars Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) and Heritage Of Gold (Gold Legend) will take place in today's GI Go For Wand H. at Saratoga. The five-year-olds last met in the GI Apple Blossom at Oaklawn Apr. 9, where Heritage Of Gold triumphed while Beautiful Pleasure finished fifth after a rough trip. Heritage Of Gold went on to capture her next two starts, including the GIII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill June 3 by four lengths over Silverbulletday, and is undefeated in four 2000 starts. "In terms of build-up and anticipation, this is the most exciting race that I've been involved in," remarked trainer Tom Amoss. "I've never been in a position where people are saying my mare might be the best in the country." She will have to overcome the sheer brilliance of Beautiful Pleasure, who rebounded from the Apple Blossom defeat to notch a pair of easy wins at Belmont. The defending Eclipse champion annihilated her foes in the June 24 GI Hempstead H. by 7 1/4 lengths under her own steam and will be tough to beat here. "This mare has so much raw talent it amazes me sometimes," said Donna Ward, her exercise rider. "The hard part is saving her from herself." Second to Banshee Breeze in this race last year, the Florida-bred bay tuned up for this outing with a bullet :58 2/5 at Saratoga last Sunday. The trifecta could be completed by Roza Robata (Fire Maker), winner of the GIII Pimlico Distaff May 20. A winner in her lone Saratoga start last summer, she has finished third behind the top two in each of her last two outings. Trainer Dale Romans was realistic about his charge's chances. "You know both of them [Beautiful Pleasure and Heritage Of Gold] aren't going to run bad races, but if one of does, we can be second," said Romans.

Dream Supreme fulfilled some very high expectations in winning her first black-type race, rallying up the rail to catch a courageous Big Bambu. The dark bay debuted at the Spa last August, closing with a rush to equal the 5 1/2-furlong track record of 1:03 2/5. She made one more start for trainer Linda Rice, winning a Belmont allowance, before going to the sidelines. After romping by 9 1/2 lengths in a six furlong Pimlico allowance May 19, she weakened to fourth in the one-mile GI Acorn S. June 9 and had a rough time of it when fourth in the GII Prioress July 3. Breaking a bit awkwardly from the eight hole, she was unhurried as she made her way to the inside and began to pick up horses on the turn. Catching Big Bambu inside the final furlong, she bounded past her to give trainer Bill Mott a Grade I birthday present. "I'm glad she chose today [to win]," Mott said. "She got off a little badly; she's not a good gate horse." Big Bambu, dueling from the start, could not hold off the Kinsman colorbearer, but gamely remained clear of the others. Favored Chilukki (Cherokee Run) stumbled badly at the start and finished sixth.

Spain had developed a reputation as a bridesmaid, finishing second in the GI Del Mar Debutante and the GI Las Virgenes, but has now won two of three starts since joining the D. Wayne Lukas stable. After finishing seventh in the May 5 GI Kentucky Oaks, her last start for trainer Jeff Bonde, the filly finished sixth in the GIII Dogwood S. in the slop for Lukas. She returned in a one-mile allowance July 12 at Belmont and gained her confidence back with a front-running 6 1/4-length victory. After some anxious moments in the paddock yesterday, where she reared up before being saddled, Spain was sent to post as the the second choice. She stalked pacesetting Prized Stamp, bid outside of her entering the stretch, seized the lead at the eighth pole and pulled away to win comfortably. March Magic, the 2-1 favorite, finished a non-threatening fifth. "For a while I wasn't sure if I'd get there," said winning jockey Jose Velez. "It looked like the speed might have gotten away from me, but when I angled out turning for home she took off." Assistant trainer Barry Knight indicated that the switch to the Lukas feed program may be the force behind in Spain's recent success. "I don't know where we will go with her next, but I think the [GI Aug. 16] Alabama might be a possibility."

Kona Gold confirmed his status as one of the nation's top sprinters with this game victory. The lightly raced six-year-old had captured two of his previous three starts this year, finishing second by a nose to stable-mate Son of a Pistol (Big Pistol) in the other. Given a brief freshening following his devastating 4 1/2-length victory in the GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. at

Santa Anita Apr. 8, the Bruce Headley trainee drilled three straight bullets for his return, including a :59 1/5 five-panel breeze July 24 over this surface. As Levelled (GB) (Beveled) and Lexicon duked it out in front, Kona Gold sat just off that pair to the turn, where he revved his motor and moved to take the lead. With Love That Red looming boldly at the top of the stretch, Kona Gold appeared to brush that rival slightly, but edged away slightly after a stretch-long duel. "When I asked him, he showed his class," said winning jockey Alex Solis. "It's fun to ride a horse like this. He's a warrior, a laid-back warrior." The winner, third in the 1998 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and second in last year's renewal, remained unbeaten in four Del Mar outings.

Northern Quest unleashed a powerful stretch rally in garnering his first stakes victory. Having started his career in France for trainer Andre Fabre, the dark bay finished fifth behind Dark Moondancer (GB) in the G1 Prix Ganay and closed out his campaign with a fifth in a French Listed event at Nantes in November. Shipped stateside, he finished third in the Dallas Turf Cup at Lone Star June 17 and was sent off as the favorite here. Saving ground early as Exciting Fanfare (Quintillion {Ire}) opened up seven lengths on the field, he swung wide nearing the stretch and closed stoutly over the soft going. "I was going to take him back, but he got shuffled back anyway," admitted winning jockey Robby Albarado. "He was kind of cranky about that, but then he settled down and relaxed."

Unbeaten in three starts before this, Rolly Polly boasted two conditions wins and the G3 Premio Primi Passi at Milan June 25 on her roll of honour. She retained her perfect record in tremendous style, pouncing late to secure the win. The filly was slowest from the gate, but was soon in midfield as Bram Stoker disputed the lead with Distinctly Dancer (Ire) (Distinctly North) ahead of Iron Mask. Iron Mask hit the front approaching the final furlong, but was immediately tackled by Rolly Polly. The two hooked up for a duel, with the latter seizing the initiative in the last half furlong and running on well for a deserved win. Iron Mask, a consistent vardstick, kept on well but again found one too good. Bram Stoker kept on at the same pace in the final furlong, but had enough in reserve to just hold Cupercoy (Fr) (Crack Regiment) for third. Winning trainer Bruno Grizzetti, with wife Nicole acting as interpreter, said, "She doesn't normally break that slowly. She ran a very fast time in her last race and I was confident she would run well. All being well, I will bring her back to France for the G1 Prix Morny (Deauville, Aug. 20)."

Enthused looked to have hit the front almost too soon in her two races previous to this, managing to just hold on in a Newmarket maiden first time out before being caught near the line by Dora Carrington (Ire) in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at the same course July 11. Here she was ridden to perfection by Johnny Murtagh, deputizing again for the injured Kieren Fallon and the suspended Pat Eddery, to claim her first stakes success. Held up at the rear of the field early as Zaheemah (El Prado {Ire}) blazed the trail, she was eased through the gap that appeared in front as the horses started to tire from the fast pace. As Autumnal went away, Murtagh was cruising, and when he asked his mount to quicken, she responded with enthusiasm to go clear. From there she never looked like stopping as she spreadeagled a competitive field. Alan Cooper, racing manager to the owners, the Niarchos family, said, "I think she's more mature than last time, and she had more racing experience. She did it very nicely and Johnny (Murtagh) liked her a lot, so we'll get to work with Michael (Stoute) and see where she'll go. There are lots of options, such as York (G2 Lowther S., Aug. 24), and others later on. The dam won the G1 Coronation S. over a mile here, so we're hoping she will get the mile." Murtagh added, "She didn't seem to get home at Newmarket last time, but I got a beautiful run and she quickened up very well."
