## **DUBAI MILLENNIUM RETIRED**

Just vesterday Sheikh Mohammed challenged Michael Tabor to a winner-take-all match race, suggesting that each side put up \$6 million for an event that would have pitted the brilliant Dubai Millennium (GB) (Seeking the Gold--Colorado Dancer {Ire}, by Shareef Dancer) against Tabor's star Montieu (Ire). But there will be no match race. Dubai Millennium suffered a lateral condylar fracture of his right hind cannon bone while working on the Limekilns at Newmarket yesterday morning and will be retired to stud. The four-yearold, beaten only once in 10 career starts, will require surgery to repair the injury. He will stand at Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud next year. Originally named Yaazer, he had the name changed before his first race as his owner already had the 2000 Dubai World Cup in mind. The colt ran only once at two, winning a maiden race at Yarmouth. After two winning preps, he went off at 5-1 in the G1 Epsom Derby, but failed to handle the 12 furlongs and finished ninth. It was his only defeat. Dubai Millennium came back to take the July 18 G2 Prix Eugene Adam, the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois and the Sept. 26 G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. But it was in the 2000 G1 Dubai World Cup that he caught the attention and imagination of the racing world, romping to the easiest kind of victory, dusting Behrens by six lengths. His last start was an eight-length laugher in the June 21 G1 Prince of Wales's S. Sheikh Mohammed once described his star, saying, "You can wait 20 years and never get a horse like this. I have never seen or owned a horse like him--the way he trains, the way he looks. He is quite outstanding." His regular rider, Frankie Dettori, vesterday told Sporting Life on-line, "I'll always remember him as the best horse I've ridden. Hopefully his offspring will be as good as him." Dubai Millennium retires with earnings of £2,752,610.

## CRIMPLENE TAKES NASSAU

Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern), already very successful at a mile this season with victories in the May 7 G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas), the May 28 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, and the June 23 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, stretched out to earn the third Group 1 win of her career yesterday with a 1 3/4-length triumph in the Vodafone Nassau S. at Goodwood, England. Although jockey Philip Robinson was keen to get Crimplene to the front early, Michael Roberts on Ela Athena (GB) (Ezzoud {Ire}) had other ideas, and his close proximity to Crimplene caused the favourite to be keen. While Robinson took a pull, Roberts continued to hassle the pair, and this lasted until the top of the hill where Robinson let his filly go to the front. Crimplene settled instantly and quickly put distance between herself and the rest of the field, so that by the turn into the straight she had her rivals stretched. Keeping on the relentless gallop, she piled on the pressure, which cracked High Walden (El Gran Senor) first, and then Princess Ellen (GB) (Tirol {Ire}), doomed to chase her tail again. As Ela Athena found another gear to take second, the winner was safe and clear. Trainer Clive Brittain said, "People doubted her running over 10 furlongs, but when you have an animal of class you can go distances. She did look to be tying up in the final 100 yards, but she did the same at Ascot. I've not discussed plans but perhaps it will be a prep race and then the Breeders' Cup."

Three races back, Graeme Hall won the Apr. 15 Gll Arkansas Derby by a comfortable 3 3/4 lengths, prompting his connections to send him on to the Triple Crown. After flipping his palate and being eased in the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby, the Kentucky-bred colt was shelved until his latest outing, Monmouth's Long Branch S. July 16. There he ran step for step with winner Thistyranthasclass, lost his whip in the stretch and tired to finish second by 1 3/4 lengths. Breaking from post position three in this outing, the Todd Pletcher-trained chestnut pressed the early speed, heading Albert The Great (Go For Gin) after a half mile in :46.11. Those two rivals rallied out on the lead alone, but Graeme Hall took command turning for home, responded to the urging of jockey Jerry Bailey and held off challenging Curule and late-closing Unshaded for the full-hearted win. "You've got to give the horse a lot of credit," Pletcher said. "He ran every step of the way. He took it to Albert the Great and kept going. Obviously, when you win the Jim Dandy, the Travers is the race you're pointing for and so as long as he comes out of it in good shape, that's where we're heading," he said. In response to Albert the Great's last-place finish, trainer Nick Zito said, "I'm at a loss for words. Maybe the pace was too fast, but I have no excuse. I thought we were just going to gallop out to the lead and make the move, but we didn't. He's better than that."

The team that was successful last year with Diktat (GB) is represented this time by Lend a Hand, and this could be the perfect opportunity for Godolphin to pick up another Group 1 sprinting success with this horse. A winner at this level in the 1997 Gran Criterium at Milan, he was second in both the 1998 G1 2000 Guineas and Sussex S. over a mile to add weight to his reputation. Reverted to sprinting this year, he was an impressive winner of the G3 Duke Of York S. May 18 before being a luckless also-ran in the G1 July Cup July 13. Here he has what looks the ideal distance of six-and-a-half furlongs. Opposition comes in the form of Bluemamba, who is dropped back in distance after finding the mile at Royal Ascot in the June 23 G1 Coronation S. too far. Earlier she showed speed when holding all challengers in a thrilling finish to the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 14. If she can use that tactic here she will figure in the finish. Henry Candy's evergreen sprinter Gorse holds the German challenger Tertullian on last year's form, comprehensively beating him in the G3 Holsten Trophy at Hamburg and then taking second place from him in the G2 Jacobs Goldene Peitsche at Baden-Baden in September. Last time he took the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis here July 11.
