'KID' AT THE HEAD OF THE CLASS

Last year's Travers winner Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo) swooped past Cat Thief (Storm Cat) en route to a two-length victory in yesterday's GI Whitney H. at Saratoga to stake his claim as the best handicap horse in the country. The bay colt was third behind Golden Missile (A.P. Indy) in the GI Pimlico Special in May, but added blinkers for a 7 1/4-length romp in the GII Brooklyn H. June 11, then defeated Behrens (Pleasant Colony) by 2 1/2 lengths in the GII Suburban H. July 4. "He's the best horse I've ever trained," said winning trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "I've had a lot of good ones, but he's the best." The lukewarm 2-1 favorite secured a good position from his rail post as David (Mt. Livermore) showed the way with Cat Thief in close pursuit. Angled out four wide on the far turn, Lemon Drop Kid swept aside Golden Missile and set his sights on Cat Thief, driving past that rival in the final sixteenth. "This is the best dirt horse I've ever ridden," exclaimed winning jockey Edgar Prado. "I made my move at the threeeighths pole because I wasn't sure if I would get another chance to move again. He dug in real game when Cat Thief came back." The Jeanne Vance colorbearer will start three more times this season in an effort to gain the Horse of the Year title. "It looks like he's at the top of his game and all we have to do is keep him healthy and strong," said Schulhofer. "There's a month to the Woodward [9f, 9-16], then a month to the Jockey Club Gold Cup [10f, 10-14] and three weeks to the Breeders' Cup [Classic, 10f, 11-4]." Jockey Jorge Chavez had lost his regular ride aboard Behrens to Jerry Bailey, but wound up on Cat Thief for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I knew my horse had a chance to win this race since he won the Breeders' Cup Classic against most of these horses," Chavez said. "He ran well for me, it was just that the other horse ran better." Second-choice Behrens clipped the heels of Golden Missile after getting squeezed at the start and was in contention at the top of the stretch, but lacked a solid finishing kick and finished third. English shipper Running Stag (Cozzene) had a rough trip, getting shuffled back to last before rallying for fourth. Whitney chart p2

WHISTLING DIXIE

California shipper Dixie Union (Dixieland Band) closed determinedly to capture his first Grade I victory in the \$1 million Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park yesterday. The dark bay colt started his career in highly promising fashion, capturing four of his first five starts before finishing fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, his lone unplaced effort. Given some time to come back following the detection of knee chips, he resurfaced in at Hollywood, capturing an allowance May 7. He then ran into top sprinter Caller One in the Laz Barrera H. over seven furlongs, finishing second, and was second once again, beaten a neck by Tiznow, in the GIII Affirmed H. July 1. "I thought he was the best two-year-old around last year, but then he chipped his knee in the Breeders' Cup," explained winning trainer Richard Mandella. "The surgery went well, and we thought it was possible to make the Triple Crown. But the weather forced him to miss some training at Santa Anita, so we scrapped our plans and ended up here." Breaking from post eight, the 9-2 shot was checked as he made his way in to save ground, but settled nicely on the backstretch. Shifted to the outside by jockey Alex Solis approaching the stretch, he finished strongly down the lane, edging past favored Captain Steve (Fly So Free) in the final strides. Milwaukee Brew (Wild Again) put in a strong run along the rail and just missed second by a head. "Commendable (Gone West) got me take up a little down the backstretch," Solis said. "Luckily, this horse is very athletic and he got right back into it." The Travers (10f, 8-26), Saratoga's Midsummer Derby, may be next for the Kentucky bred. "We're looking at the Travers, but that depends on how he comes out of this," Mandella remarked. "If the race sets him back, we wouldn't go, but if he's okay, we'd love to go." Diamond A Racing Corp., part owner of the Haskell hero, had a big day at Monmouth, teaming up again with Mandella and Solis as Reciclada (Chi) took the GIII Eatontown H. on the front end. If ever there was a natural front-running type of racehorse, then surely Bold Edge would be its epitome. His greatest successes have come when he has been allowed to command from the front throughout his races and demonstrated that style to effect when winning last year's G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot, and again when taking the G2 Diadem S at the same course in September. This season he has been anchored by penalties for those successes, no more so than last time when he finished fourth in the Royal Ascot race he won last year, not helped by a four-pound penalty there. Breaking well from the stalls and taking up the running in the early stages, Bold Edge was never truly pressed throughout the first half of the race by the Japanese challenger, Dojima Muteki (Jpn) (Tudenham King {Jpn}). As Gorse stayed close, with Dettori on Lend A Hand positioned ominously in fourth in behind, the five-yearold looked vulnerable, but he was happy in front and only starting to race by the final quarter of a mile. As jockey Dane O'Neill got serious, Dettori was closing inside the final furlong, and it looked for a short while as if Lend A Hand might get to him, but the stubbornness of the leader paid off as he lengthened away from his challenge to hold him at the line. "This horse loves the lead and they let him have it his way," said Richard Hannon, Jr., representing his trainer father. "In these circumstances he is a real fighter. We were not too sure going into the race as he had injured a rib on his last run at Ascot and he only had one serious piece of work going into the race."

Skimming, sent off as the third choice in the wagering, ran off and hid from a solid field to capture his first added-money event. Belying his grassy pedigree, the bay colt broke his maiden over the Wolverhampton allweather surface in January before returning to the land of his birth. With a third in the GII Mervyn LeRoy May 13 sandwiching a pair of optional claiming victories, the Juddmonte homebred shipped to lowa and finished a fine second in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker Breeders' Cup July 5. Breaking sharply, he quickly made the lead and inched away from National Saint under a snug hold from jockey Garrett Gomez down the backstretch. Giving the field the slip on the turn, he kicked clear and widened his advantage down the stretch, with Gomez wrapping up on him late. "Bobby [winning trainer Frankel] just told me to let him be out there, to just see what happened," Gomez said. "At the quarter pole, I asked him to quicken some and he went. Man, that gas tank was full." The GI Pacific Classic (10f, 8-26) could be next for Skimming.

Aldo finished third in the GIII Pilgrim S. on turf last year, but began his three-year-old campaign on dirt and finished a respectable second to graded stakes-placed Brave Quest before switching back to the grass. With an impressive late charge, he narrowly took a Belmont allowance June 1 before trying the GIII Lexington S. last out July 16, where he finished fourth after racing wide over a soft course. "He doesn't like the turf when it's real soft," trainer Billy Badgett said. "I was a little disappointed with his last race, but even [jockey] Edgar [Prado] said that it was real soft course that day. Slew Valley was purchased privately after impressing in his turf debut July 1, winning a quick Belmont allowance by 3 3/4 lengths. He has since been transferred from the Gary Sciacca barn to the Michael Dickinson stable. "I've had him for about three weeks now," Dickinson said. "He's got a very straightforward attitude around the barn, I haven't asked him to do anything serious yet." Parade Leader, a full brother to multiple graded stakes winner Parade Ground, won his 2000 turf debut June 17 at Churchill Downs before finishing fifth in the Lexington, just behind Aldo. "Last time out, he was a victim of a slow pace,"trainer Neil Howard said. "He's been training well since that start."
