SWORD DANCER: A RACE OF IMPORT

Four horses who started their careers on the other side of the Atlantic top the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga this afternoon. The morning-line favorite is expatriate Single Empire (Ire) (Kris {GB}), who ships in from California after finishing third in the July 23 GII Sunset H. at Hollywood Park. The six-year-old captured the GII San Luis Rev S. and the GI San Juan Capistrano H. last year, but has been held winless in five tries this season while hitting the board four times. Deploy Venture (GB) (Deploy {GB}), second in the Sunset, has won two of his five tries since shipping from Europe for his four-year-old campaign. The gelding took a Bay Meadows allowance in March and, after running a close-up third in the GI Whittingham H., added the GIII Golden Gate H. June 17. Jockey Victor Espinoza, who took the title at the Hollywood Summer Meet and is currently leading the standings at Del Mar, will fly in from the West Coast for the mount. Another import, Shadwell Stable's Elhayq (Ire) (Nashwan), is a perfect two-for-two since adding Lasix for his second U.S. appearance. The bay captured a Belmont allowance June 24 and came back to take the GII Bowling Green H. at 1 3/8 miles July 8. "I looked at his form and noticed that he bled while racing in England," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "We scoped him and noticed some blood after his first race here, so it made sense to put him on Lasix, and that has been the biggest plus for him. Last time out, in the Bowling Green, he just exploded." As for the extra furlong of the Sword Dancer, McLaughlin said, "A mile and three-eighths was no problem for him. He wants to go a mile and a half." Boatman (Irish River (Fr)) is the final member of the imported quartet. The four-year-old Juddmonte homebred won a Santa Anita allowance on his U.S. debut in January, took a 3 1/2-month vacation, then captured a Hollywood allowance May 4. He shipped East for his latest try and came away with a second-place finish in the GI Manhattan H. at Belmont Park June 10. He picks up only a pound off that effort and is one of the light weights in the field at 114. (Sword Dancer field, p2)

LEMON DROP KID TO LANE'S END

A Grade I winner at two, three and four, Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo--Charming Lassie, by Seattle Slew) will enter stud at Lane's End Farm near Versailles. Kentucky. in 2001. Plans call for the four-year-old to retire after this year's Breeders' Cup Classic. Bred by Lane's End owner Will Farish and the late W.S. Kilroy, the colt is out of a half sister to Broodmare of the Year Weekend Surprise, dam of A.P. Indy and Summer Squall. Successful in the GI Futurity at Belmont Park during his juvenile campaign, he came back at three to take the Belmont S. and the Travers. One of the leading older horses this season, he has victories in the GII Brooklyn H., GII Suburban H. and GI Whitney H. to his credit. To date, he has bankrolled \$2,819,970. "From a pedigree, conformation and performance standpoint, he is certainly the most exciting stallion prospect in training today," Farish said. "I am thrilled to have Lemon Drop Kid returning to the farm where he was born and raised."

GOING FOR GOLD AT WOODBINE

Scatter the Gold (Mr. Prospector), looking to become Canada's seventh Triple Crown winner, is the 4-5 favorite in the C\$500,000 Breeders' S. at Woodbine this afternoon. The three-year-old was still a maiden when he captured the first jewel in the Crown, the Queen's Plate, by 4 1/4 lengths. He came back to best fellow Breeders' S. runner For Our Sake (Alydeed) by a neck in the second leg, the July 23 Prince of Wales S. at Fort Erie. In his lone previous try on the turf, Scatter the Gold missed by a neck in a maiden race at Woodbine in June. "He gave a pretty good indication in his one start on the turf that he likes the grass," trainer Mark Frostad said. "He got into a lot of trouble and came with a big run at the end. I think he'll get a better hold of the grass and be a little closer than in some of his dirt races." As for his chances at the Triple, Frostad said, "I'm pretty happy with what our situation is now. I thought the real test would be the Prince of Wales, and he had a rough trip and overcame it. I'm more confident coming into this race than I was going into the Prince of Wales." Added jockey Todd Kabel, "I'm looking forward to trying to complete the Triple Crown. I've got the horse. Distance won't be a problem at all, nor will the turf. I just need the trip."

Yet another day of rain washed out turf racing at the Spa, but the switch of the downgraded Glens Falls H. to the sloppy main track didn't bother I'm Indy Mood, who rallied to earn her first stakes victory and her first victory on the main track. The mare, who has gone winless since last October, finished second in her latest dirt start, the Feb. 9. Very One H. at Gulfstream. She re-

She returned June 3 to finish sixth in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. and followed that with a second in an allowance June 23. Last out she finished sixth in a stakes at Delaware July 22. "I thought she had her best shot to win on the dirt," trainer Jimmy Toner said. "I don't think she could beat some of these fillies on the turf." As the second choice in the field reduced to six, the Texas-bred stalked the pace early, angled out into the lane and wore down favored Idle Rich after a prolonged stretch duel. While the winner has made 20 of 26 career starts on turf, the performance may have convinced Toner that her future may be on the main track. "I just might keep her on the dirt and wait for a sloppy track," he said.

DANZIG TOPS STALLION ACCESS SALE AGAIN

For the third straight year, seasons to Claiborne Farm's Danzig (Northern Dancer) topped Fasig-Tipton's Stallion Access Inc. Champagne Sale of Selected Seasons and Shares. The 2000 edition of the event, held last night in Saratoga Springs, New York, saw the first 2001 no-guarantee season to the top-class sire go for \$262,000, and a second bring \$235,000. The price for the 23-year-old stallion has risen each year. In 1997, he averaged \$130,000 for three season; in 1998, he topped the sale at \$215,000; and last year he attracted a high bid of \$225,000. Lane's End's Kingmambo (Mr. Prospector) was the second-most popular stallion at the sale, with his one nomination attracting a bid of \$190,000. Overall, 27 seasons brought \$1,045,000, an average of \$38,704. There were 12 nominations listed as not sold.

STAR-STUDDED ARRAY OF INT'L JOCKEYS AT ASCOT

Blue Square Shergar Cup Day at Ascot today features one of the highest-calibre group of international riders ever assembled on a single day's racing in Britain. Champions from Britain, Ireland, Hong Kong, Singapore, Italy and star names from Australia and Japan, who have won over 20,000 races between them, will be in the saddle for this £400,000 Europe versus the Rest of the World challenge. Frankie Dettori, one of the world's best-known jockeys, has just returned to action after recovering from injuries sustained in a plane crash in June and is to captain the Dubai Duty Free Rest Of The World Team. He will be leading a side that includes Jumaat Saimee, the charismatic three-times champion of Singapore; Japanese star Masayoshi Ebina; South African Basil Marcus, who is the most-successful overseas rider in the history of Hong Kong racing with seven titles; and two of Australia's most-famous jockeys, Greg Hall and Damien Oliver. The European defence will be captained by the 11-times British champion Pat Eddery, who has over 4,300 career wins to his name in many of the world's top races. Kevin Darley and Richard Quinn, the pair with whom Eddery is fighting a battle for this year's domestic jockeys' title, will be on his side in the Shergar Cup. They will be joined by the Italian sensation Mirco Demuro who, despite being just 21, has been champion jockey in his home country three times. The Virgin Atlantic European team is completed by Johnny Murtagh, the three-times Irish champion who won this year's English and Irish Derbys on Sinndar, and his compatriot Mick Kinane, who can boast 11 Irish championships and victories in such races as the Belmont S., Melbourne Cup, Japan Cup, Epsom Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Douglas Erskine-Crum, Ascot's chief executive, said: "We are thrilled to be able to welcome two such outstanding teams of jockeys to Ascot for Blue Square Shergar Cup day. I cannot think of another occasion when such a distinguished group of riders has ridden on the same day in Britain and it will be a privilege to watch them in action." Sponsors Blue Square have made European team captain Pat Eddery their 2-1 favourite to gain the most points at today's Shergar Cup meeting. Dettori is next best at 11-4, with Darley at 7-2 and Murtagh at 5-1.
