O'BRIEN ONSLAUGHT AT LEOPARDSTOWN

Trainer Aidan O'Brien has saddled the winner of the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. for two years running, taking the event with Lavery (Ire) in 1998 and with Fasliyev last year. Looking to make it three in a row, O'Brien sends out a five-horse entry at Leopardstown this afternoon. Freud (Storm Cat) has the bloodlines to be a factor. Still a maiden after missing by a half length at The Curragh July 1, the colt is a full brother to the stable's top-class performer Giant's Causeway. His stablemates are Pirate Of Penzance (Southern Halo), winner of the Listed Rochestown S. here June 5, maiden winners Cashel Palace (Ire) (Lure) and La Vida Loca (Ire) (Caerleon), and fellow maiden Minardi (Boundary). The quintet will have their hands full with English challenger Superstar Leo (Ire) (College Chapel {GB}), who followed up her impressive G3 Norfolk S. win at Royal Ascot with success in the Weatherbys Super Sprint at Newbury July 22. She is drawn in stall one, which leaves her trainer William Haggas concerned. He said, "She's in great form, but I gather she's got the 'coffin' draw--she's drawn one and apparently that's not great." Another smart filly from England is Peter Harris' unbeaten Dora Carrington (Ire) (Sri Pekan), who defeated Enthused in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. July 11. When that filly went on to win impressively in the G3 Princess Margaret S. July 29, it was a boost to the form. "She's 100 percent, she's in great form and she's there to do her best," Harris said. "I'd be disappointed if she's not thereabouts, but then again it is a Group 1."

LONG-DISTANCE CALL

There's no doubt he loves the distance. John's Call (Lord at War {Arg}), who had won two of his three starts at the 1 1/2 miles of the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H., proved he could handle the route once again, closing from sixth to win by an eyecatching 9 1/4 lengths over a soft turf at Saratoga Race Course yesterday afternoon. The nine-year-old gelding has now won five of his last six last starts. After taking the Sussex H. at Delaware last September, the veteran captured the Bald Eagle Breeders' Cup H. over a soft turf at Laurel Oct. 24 and came back to win the GIII Laurel Turf Cup at a mile and a half over a yielding course Nov. 11. The chestnut ended the campaign with a disappointing ninthplace finish as the favorite in the Nov. 20 GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct, but returned in the July 23 Cape Henlopen S. going 12 furlongs at Delaware and added yet another score. "He gets six months off every year, so I don't think he knows he's nine," trainer Tommy Voss said. Part of the mutuel field, John's Call was sent off at 7-1 in the Sword Dancer. He saved ground while sitting near the back of the pack, but came up the inside with a bold move on the far turn, then moved to the outside to take command at the top of the stretch and pull away in an impressive performance. "I knew the rail was the place to be, and I wouldn't have moved off it for anything," jockey Jean-Luc Samyn said. "Once daylight opened up, he just took off and exploded. It was a superb race for a nine-year-old to run." Boatman (Irish River {Fr}), sent off the slight 5-2 favorite, pressed the pace, but tired to be eighth. "He fought hard from the five-eighths pole to the three-eighths pole, but John's Call just went on past all of us," said his jockey, Edgar Prado. "The winner was much the best, and today was not my horse's day." Single Empire (Ire) (Kris {GB}), the second choice at 3-1, closed to get third, but was 5 1/4 lengths behind runner-up Aly's Alley (Alwuhush). Kent Desormeaux, aboard Single Empire, said, "We had a great trip. He was letting me know that he was ready to go whenever I asked him. But the course was tough and it took its toll on him. Maybe the ground was a little softer than he would have liked...in the last eighth of a mile, he had to reach down deep into his heart and class to go from fifth to third. He really fought tooth and nail to get past the horses to his outside." (Sword Dancer chart, p2)

SCATTER THE GOLD THWARTED IN TRIPLE CROWN BID Scatter the Gold (Mr. Prospector), who captured the June 25 Queen's Plate on the main track at Woodbine while still a maiden and added the July 23 Prince Of Wales S. at Fort Erie to pick up the first two legs in Canada's Triple Crown, was thwarted in his attempt to complete the Triple in yesterday's Breeders' S. on the Woodbine turf. Sent off the 3-5 favorite, the colt settled just off the pace while racing to the outside for six furlongs. Jockey Todd Kabel got into his mount as they raced around the far turn and came wide into the stretch, but the crowd's choice could not muster enough to get the win, ending up third behind 7-2 Lodge Hill (Cozzene). The winner, sixth in the Queen's Plate, was also a maiden in that event, but came back to get his first victory in a 1 1/4-mile special weight test on the Belmont turf July 9--it was his fifth try on turf. Well backed off that effort, he rallied from sixth to come home three lengths ahead of 7-1 Master Stuart (Ascot Knight), with Scatter the Gold another neck back. (Breeders' S. chart, p4)

Looking to make it five straight in graded stakes on the main track, Riboletta was bet down to 2-5 and came through for the crowd. The winner of the May 7 GII Hawthorne H. and May 28 GI Milady Breeders' Cup H., the South American import went off at 3-5 in the GI Vanity H. last time out June 25 and posted an impressive 5 1/2-length tally. Rated in second here as Gourmet Girl set a moderate pace, the bay came with her challenge after six furlongs in 1:11.08, took over at the top of the lane and edged clear, but the race was not without incident for the winner. "My saddle slipped on me twice during the running," jockey Chris McCarron revealed. "It slipped forward, then it slipped back. Then as I was pulling up, it slipped again. I almost went flying over her head." As for Riboletta, McCarron said, "She was trying to take me to the lead right from the get-go. She's aggressive like that. But she's aggressive and very talented. The crowd made With Ability, runaway winner of the June 8 Fashion S. in her latest appearance, the 1-2 favorite over a rain-soaked strip, but it was Stormy Pick who had shown ability in the slop before. The bay made her debut over a sloppy Monmouth strip June 14 and splashed to a 10 1/4-length score as the 13-10 favorite. "When the track came up wet for her first race, [owner Raymond Dweck] asked me what we were going to do and I said, 'we're going to run,'" winning trainer Ben Perkins Jr. said. "You never know when you might need that experience on an off track." That experience paid off. Coming off a second-place finish in the July 23 Colleen S., Stormy Pick broke sharply under jockey Jose Ferrer, but was snugged back to sit second as With Ability cut out rapid fractions of :21.78 and :44.83. Ferrer pushed the button as they came to the half-mile pole and his filly responded, drawing even with the front runner before drawing off in the final furlong to pick up her first stakes score. The race set up perfectly for the winner, but not for beaten favorite With Ability. Still, trainer Mark Hennig was not unhappy with his filly's performance. "I thought she ran all right," Hennig said. "It had been a long time between races and we were a little concerned that she might possibly be a little short for this race. She had never run beyond five-eighths of a mile and then we had to back off on her training when she came down with that little cough. But hopefully she will come out of it well. She'll move forward off this race." What's ahead for Stormy Pick? "She has had four races right in a row now," Perkins said. "The Spinaway [at Saratoga, Sept. 1] is possible, but the Matron [at Belmont, Sept. 17] might be a little better for her. That would give us a chance to give her a little break."

Heat It Up broke her maiden by more than six lengths for a \$50,000 claiming tag May 7. Three starts later, she easily won her first-level allowance condition when stretched out to two turns July 20. Shortening up and ignored at 32-1 for her first stakes try, she was unhurried early along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and charged down the center of the track to get up by a neck in the final strides. Previously unbeaten Plenty of Light, making her first start for trainer Elliott Walden after a 4 1/2-month layoff, finished third after stumbling at the break.

It took Megans Bluff six starts to break her maiden, but she has now won four of her last five starts and earned her first graded-stakes victory here. After a 5 1/2-length maiden win in April at Keeneland, the filly took consecutive allowance starts on the turf at Churchill May 18 and June 22. She tried the Cleveland Oaks last out July 14, finishing a respectable second. Sent off as the second choice, the bay filly stalked the leaders while off the rail, moved up to challenge on the final turn, took command in the stretch and drew off a muchthe-best winner. "She did this easy. All I had to do was keep her in line," jockey Mark Guidry said. "She is such a sweetheart--everything she did was perfect." Feisty Countess (Count the Time), the 6-5 favorite, finished a non-threatening fifth.

Ekraar picked up his first win in five starts since breaking the track record at Goodwood in last season's G3 Champagne Lanson Vintage S. with a victory in a conditions event at Newbury July 16. That effort showed some signs of his fine juvenile form and he continued in the winning vein with a smooth success against a field of quality opponents. Never far from the front as Dehoush (Diesis {GB}) dictated the pace, Ekraar swept into the lead with a half mile to run. Still travelling smoothly at the quarter-mile marker as French Fellow and Inglenook (Ire) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) tried to stamp their mark on the race, he was not to be denied, running on strongly to record a comfortable win. Forbearing rallied from the rear in the closing stages and wrested the runner-up spot from French Fellow.

Out of the money in only one of his nine previous starts, Agol Lack had given indication of his potential when second in the G3 La Coupe at Longchamp June 15 and most recently when third in the Listed Grand Prix de Compiegne July 5. He continued along the right road to record his first stakes win in fine style. The colt was settled in a prominent second behind favourite Alrassaam (GB) (Zafonic) in the early stages, but was relegated to third as Kabool moved up from the rear to press the leader after three furlongs. Kabool moved to the front as Alrassaam dropped away tamely at the top of the straight, but jockey Olivier Peslier let out an inch of rein at the quarter-mile marker and Agol Lack responded by smoothly taking command. He quickly established a comfort zone between himself and the remainder and he strode out well to the line for an easy win. Alrassaam proved to be a major disappointment and trailed in last of the eight runners.

The question of what was responsible for his disappointing showing there is still not answered--maybe his stamina gave out over the extra two furlongs, or maybe taking on the winner too early finished him--but he is likely to bounce back here in a race he missed last year due to the heavy underfoot conditions. This time the ground is in his favour, due to the dry period at Deauville, and he will take the world of beating in his attempt at a fifth Group 1 success. Clive Brittain has decided to send his tough campaigner Crimplene here, who won only eight days ago in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood over nearly two furlongs further. The filly is a dual Guineas winner, having taken the G2 German 1000 Guineas May 7 and the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas May 28, and a three-times Group 1 winner, adding the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 23 to her impressive portfolio. Another three-year-old filly worth noting is Lady Of Chad, who returned to winning ways impressively last time in the G2 Prix d'Astarte here July 30. Last year she was the joint-top rated juvenile filly in Europe, but she disappointed when eighth in the G1 French 1000 Guineas May 14 and seventh in the G1 French Oaks June 11.

All of Arctic Owl's major victories have been over further than this trip and his connections will still look at the 1 3/4-mile G1 Irish St Leger Sept. 16 and the two-mile G1 Melbourne Cup in November as his major targets, but he showed he can handle the shorter distance against horses of this class. Towards the rear for most of the race as Murghem led, he made swift progress on the wide outside in the straight and quickened into the lead over a furlong out. Murghem would not give in easily, however, and Arctic Owl had to fight to just hold on at the line. "I always used to think he wanted two miles and soft ground," said trainer James Fanshawe, but if anything he's gotten faster and speedier as he's gotten older. One-time Classic hope Bernstein is back. Always close to the pace set by Auenklang, Bernstein threw down his challenge to the favourite over a furlong out and the two market leaders battled all the way to the line, with Bernstein proving just the stronger, while 33-1 shot Vita Spericolata came out of the pack to run them close. "He is very fast," said winning trainer Aidan O'Brien. "I had just trained him too light for the Guineas as we tried to make him settle and relax to get the mile. He was just about ready now for a racecourse gallop, so we felt that we might as well bring him here and let him gallop for this prize. It was a very nice way to come back. Mick (Kinane) said he was racing very lazily and laid back early on today, which is the result of us trying to get him like that for the Guineas, but he has tremendous speed. Bernstein is a possible for the Breeders Cup Sprint because he is coming on in leaps and bounds."
