PHOENIX THREE-PEAT FOR O'BRIEN

Trainer Aidan O'Brien, intent on a third straight victory in the G1 Independent Heinz 57 Phoenix S., saddled five two-year-olds for yesterday's race at Leopardstown in Ireland. And, despite having to scratch probable favourite Freud (Storm Cat), O'Brien completed the hat trick with Minardi (Boundary). It was only the colt's second start after he was surprisingly beaten by five lengths as the 5-4 favourite in an Ascot maiden July 29. Racing along the far rail while stable companion Cashel Palace (Ire) (Lure) led, Minardi picked up brilliantly a furlong and a half out and was in front within a few strides, drawing off to win by five lengths. O'Brien said afterwards, "Minardi had been working so well at home that we thought he'd burn up the grass at Ascot, but that was a slowly-run race and he didn't know what he was doing that day. I think we'll give him a little break now and get him ready for the [G1] Dewhurst S. at Newmarket [Oct. 14]." As for morning favourite Freud, the full brother to multiple Group 1 winner Giant's Causeway, O'Brien reported that he was "slightly" lame. "I think it's a muscle which is troubling him, so we'll give him a break before, hopefully, he can pick up some experience later in the season."

MUHTATHIR UPSETS AT DEAUVILLE

Coming off a lackluster sixth in the June 20 G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot, Godolphin's Muhtathir (GB) (Elmaamul) was not given much respect by local punters in yesterday's G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-Le-Buffard-Jacques Le Marois at Deauville. They decided to send Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) off as the odds-on favourite to redeem his reputation which took a dent when he was defeated by Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Prince Of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 21. But the globetrotting Muhtathir, who had already raced in six different countries, strode to an imperious victory with Sendawar looking laboured, although not disgraced, in second. The winning time of 1:34.6 for the mile was only 1/5th of a second off Spinning World's stakes record. The race was run at a sound pace with Crimplene (Ire) (Lion Cavern) dictating matters from Lady Of Chad (Ire) (Last Tycoon (Ire)) and Muhtathir as Sendawar tracked the leaders in sixth. Muhtathir went to the front at the quarter-mile marker as Crimplene came under pressure and Frankie Dettori decided to ask for more approaching the final furlong as Sendawar tried to make his move. Muhtathir's response was one of enthusiasm as he quickened sweetly at the distance and ran on strongly for an impressive win. Sendawar tried his utmost but Gerald Mosse accepted defeat in the closing stages. Kingsalsa finished best of all and ran on strongly from the rear to deprive Crimplene of third place in the closing stages. Godolphin's Simon Crisford explained, "Muhtathir loves to run when fresh and was not guite right in the Queen Anne at Royal Ascot. He also loved the good to firm ground and we will now think about the Breeders' Cup Mile for him." Of the runner-up Alain de Royer-Dupre offered, "Sendawar ran a good race. He doesn't do much in the mornings now and might have needed the race. Also it was his first run over a straight course and it is totally different from running around a bend. He took a breather when they quickened away, lost some ground and could not make it back. His effort was promising and he has some nice races coming up starting in the [Sept 3 G1] Emirates Prix du Moulin at Longchamp." Clive Brittain was not too disappointed with Crimplene's effort and said, "She was beaten by better horses on the day and has done us proud again. She will be freshened up now with the Breeders' Cup in mind." (Chart p. 2)

Catella, injured in a third-place finish in the July 30 G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf, bounced back to the form that earned her a second-place finish in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano at Milan June 18, stubbornly fending off the challenge of Paolini inside the final furlong for a game success. Catella raced in fourth early and, as the field made the final turn, made her bid down the centre of the track. Paolini also made a move from the rear and was quickly into an attacking position inside the final quarter mile. Catella got to the front approaching the final furlong but could not shake off a persistent Paolini. The pair dueled all the way to the line with Catella pulling out the necessary extra close to home to secure the win.

After running fifth in her June 17 debut in a Hollywood Park maiden special weight, Give Praise roared home an eight-length winner for a \$62,500 tag in her second outing July 6. Jumping up to graded stakes company, the Ohio-bred filly stalked the pacesetters as longshot Lazer Storm (Storm Boot) set early fractions of :21.80 and :44.38. Favored Fort Lauderdale took over briefly in the stretch, but was collared by Give Praise just past midstretch. The winner was drawing away at the wire. "I didn't rush her," explained winning rider Laffit Pincay, Jr. "I knew they were going quick up there and I didn't want to rush her. When we got into the stretch, I just wanted to find a spot to let her run. I could tell she could win it. She was full of run. When I went past the wire, she was still strong."

Proving she was no back number when third in the G3 Deutscher Herold Preis at Hamburg June 24, Wild Side went on to win the Listed Grosser Stutenpreis der Stadt Krefeld July 16. Continuing her fine season, she added this first Group 2 success to her portfolio in comfortable style. She went straight to the lead and set a moderate pace from Indian Ruby, Bonvivant and Acamani (Ger) (Winged Love {Ire}). Wild Side increased the tempo as the field approached the final turn but could not shake off the attention of Indian Ruby. The pair went on together with Wild Side always going the better and stayed on good style to easily account for Indian Ruby. Bonvivant kept on well to finish a close up third.

With a half million dollars in earnings under her belt, License Fee, narrowly missed Aqueduct's GIII Beaugay H. May 7, finishing a half length behind the multiple Grade I stakes winner Perfect Sting. Running fifth May 29 in the Winstar Distaff at Lone Star, the mare came back to win Philadelphia's Dr. James Penny H. over a yielding turf July 15. Piloted by Pat Day in this outing, the Elliott Walden-trained Ontario-bred broke from the outside post position, but with her early speed, tucked herself in along the rail and took command for the rest of the race. Setting a moderate pace, she opened two lengths on the field at the top of the lane and drove on for the comfortable success. "We just coasted along the fence," Day said. "And when I asked her to run, she responded gamely. The turf is in great shape." The condition of the grass wasn't a worry for Walden, who said, "I thought she would handle the soft turf fine. Her last race was on real soft ground, too, and she won that. The turf is helping to keep her sound and I think she's really coming into her own now." Looking ahead, the GII Diana S. at Saratoga Sept. 4 is a "definite possibility," Walden said.

1. But it was a close-run affair and Eastern Purple looked like he might have to settle for second again. Having led from the start, he was headed by Conormara inside the final furlong and the filly looked set to win, but South African Basil Marcus, the seventime champion jockey in Hong Kong, conjured a renewed effort out of the gelding, who got up on the line to gain the day.

A half sister to Horse of the Year Favorite Trick, she broke her maiden two races back June 11 and then tackled the GIII Debutante at Churchill July 8, finishing third behind Gold Mover.

HALLOWED DREAMS' STREAK SNAPPED

Hallowed Dreams (Malagra), bidding to surpass the record for consecutive wins held by Cigar and Citation, had her streak halted at 16 when she finished third in the Millennium S. at Evangeline Downs Saturday night. Sent off at 1-10 in the five-horse field, the three-year-old filly bobbled at the start and rushed up to duel with eventual race winner Sparkles of Luck (Mr. Sparkles) through a half mile in :44 4/5. At the eighth pole, the winner pulled away to a two-length victory over Ides Beware (Lac Ouimet) in 1:10 4/5 for six furlongs with Hallowed Dreams tiring to finish another 2 1/4 lengths behind.

"An Information Aggregator":

During the annual Jockey Club Roundtable Conference yesterday in Saratoga Springs, New York, a program was demonstrated which would enable horse owners, breeders and trainers to track their racing and breeding stock online. Jockey Club Information Systems (JCIS), which currently offers pedigree-related information through equineline.com, is developing a program similar to those which allow investors to monitor stock portfolios. Users of the system would enter a series of horses they wish to watch and JCIS would facilitate the transfer of a variety of information, both from their own database as well as racing information from Equibase Company, including past performances, workouts, entries and race results. The company would also create a secure messaging system to simplify communication on horse-related matters. The idea has been well received, according to Carl Hamilton, president of JCIS. "We have had some focus groups and have received a lot of good input from trainers and owners and very positive feedback," Hamilton said. "Our customers are starting to use the Internet as part of their business. The accessibility is there and the time just seems right to undertake this effort," he added. A pricing structure for the service is yet to be determined and Hamilton hopes that the service will be available by the end of the year.
