STRONG OPENER AT DEAUVILLE

The first session of the Agence Française Deauville August Yearling Sale was a success, with the gross rising eight percent to FF60,710,000 and the average increasing 27 percent to FF1,214,200. There was every reason to believe that the French sale would follow the path of recent top sales in America and, as it was last year, the market was international and selective. Attracting the top bid at the session was a half sister to G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas hero King's Best and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Urban Sea which was purchased for FF9,000,000. The daughter of Diesis (GB), from the Haras d'Etreham consignment, was bought by the Suprina agency of Patricia Boutin (daughter of the late Francois Boutin) for Mrs. A.O'Reilly and Baron Edouard de Rothschild. Haras d'Etreham's Marc de Chambure said, "We are thrilled--nine millions francs for a filly is a lot of money. She is a good-looking filly. She may be not the best individual, but she has a tremendous pedigree and this is what people look for in a filly. Overall our other horses sold well also and I am delighted." She was one of nine yearlings that sold for more than FF2 million; 11 others went for more than FF1 million. Buyers came from France, Ireland, England, Germany, Japan, the Middle East and the United States, confirming once again that Deauville has become a strong international market. New patrons from as far away as Australia were also very active. Philippe Augier, the president of the Agence Francaise de Vente du Pur Sang, which conducts the Deauville Sale, was obviously delighted after the first session. "The increase of recent years has been confirmed tonight," he said. "The market in Deauville has become very deep with buyers from all over the racing world. This session has shown once again the importance of the Deauville Sales in the international bloodstock market." (Top Deauville yearlings, p2)

BRINGING DOWN THE HOUSE AT ARLINGTON

He hadn't won since taking the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown back on June 1, 1999, but Chester House (Mr. Prospector) got back to the winner's circle in a big way yesterday, closing up the rail to take the \$2 million GI Arlington Million by a widening 3 1/4 lengths. The win was also a measure of redemption for Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel, who has yet to win a Breeders' Cup or Triple Crown race and finished second in both the Kentucky Derby and the Belmont S. this year. "I was thinking, 'I can't win the big one," Frankel said. "But we did what we had to do--we won a Grade I with a superior horse. I feel a little vindication, I admit it." The royally bred Chester House was also vindicated after nine straight losses. The Juddmonte homebred had been close in four of six starts since shipping to America. The five-year-old was fourth, beaten just 3 1/2 lengths, in his dirt debut in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, then finished third in a pair of stakes, the Mar. 26 Explosive Bid H. on the turf and the Apr. 29 GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. on the main track. After back-to-back off-the-board finishes on the dirt, he returned to the turf for his latest and rallied to be second in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 30. Sent off the fourth choice in an evenly matched Million field, the dark bay rated in midpack while hugging the hedge as Asidero (Arg) (Fadeyev) set a moderate pace, then shot through an opening at the top of the lane and easily held off second choice Manndar (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}). "I was right where I wanted to be, saving ground," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "The only problem was that I knew I was going to be jammed in there, but I felt confident that if I waited long enough it would open up." Manndar was not so lucky. Squeezed back at the start, the two-time Grade I winner was taken up on the far turn and again in the stretch, but finished well to get second. "We didn't have an ideal trip," trainer Beau Greely said, but added, "Het got beat by a good horse." The 5-2 favorite, Bienamado (Bien Bien) came with a bid at the top of the lane, but flattened out late and ended up fourth. "When I pressured him, it was like he was saying, 'I'm giving you all I've got,'" jockey Kent Desormeaux said. Slickly (Fr) (Linamix (Fr)) was rank early and tired late, finishing last. "My horse didn't handle the track at all," jockey Frankie Dettori said. "The whole race, he was lugging out. He was never comfortable." (Arlington Million chart, p2)

Second to GI Kentucky Oaks winner Secret Status in the July 1 GI Mother Goose S., Jostle had turned the tables in her latest appearance, leading every step through soft splits en route to 3 1/4-length score in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 22. The second choice at 7-2 despite that victory, the dark bay made it two in a row with a change of tactics this time. Allowed to settle this time as Valleydar, the rabbit for Secret Status, set a leisurely pace, the Fox Hill Farm colorbearer made her move after a mile to put a head in front and was never threatened despite running the final quarter in :26.25. "I was really surprised that she won as easily as she did," trainer John Servis said. "I thought Secret Status would be real tough at a mile and a quarter. But Jostle just keeps getting better. As far as the three-year-old filly championship goes, I don't know what else you could ask for." Added winning jockey Mike Smith, "The race unfolded like I pictured it in my mind. Jostle proved today that she would have no problem rating off the pace, and I actually think she's a better horse when she does rate." Secret Status, who was a surprising second behind her stablemate early, outgamed Spain (Thunder Gulch) for the place spot. "I thought she ran OK," trainer Neil Howard said. "She might have been closer to the pace than I would have wanted--I thought the pace could have been quicker in the first part, but I don't think that was any fault on the jockey's part. I really don't know what happened. I'll have to figure it out." But he continued, "Jostle is a nice filly, there's no two ways about it."

The winner of the GII Black Helen H. at Gulfstream Park in April, Snow Polina ran into a buzzsaw named Perfect Sting in her next two starts, finishing third in the June 10 GIII Just A Game Breeders' Cup H. and second after setting the pace in the 1 1/4-mile GII New York H. last time out July 15. Sent off the second choice at a generous 9-2, the chestnut stalked the frontrunners while sitting on the outside, rallied to take over at the top of the lane and had enough left to turn back the late charge of odds-on Happyanunoit. "She was very good in the warm-up today," trainer Bill Mott said. "Sometimes she washes out going to the gate, but I didn't see any signs of that." Jockey Jerry Bailey agreed, saying, "She was very relaxed. About the three-sixteenths pole, I just let her loose. I knew that the favorite was somewhere right behind us, but I thought I would just worry about my horse." The winner goes next in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Park Oct. 7.

Murghem had before this been seen as toughness personified, such is his workrate and method of racing, but now he has shown that he has the necessary class to win at this level. Having taken three Listed races previous to this, he filled the runner-up spot last Saturday in the Shergar Cup Classic. He showed his mettle by bouncing back to claim his greatest success yet. Taking up the running early, as is his customary style, he was allowed to dictate as Savoire Vivre and Nowhere To Exit (GB) (Exit To Nowhere) were too keen. Picking up the pace with a mile to race, he still had plenty left in the tank by the time they turned into the home straight, which he used to apply the pressure to his rivals. Savoire Vivre moved ominously well on the rail to deliver a challenge with a quarter mile remaining, but drifted right and failed to catch the winner. At the line Murghem still had a comfortable margin. His connections will now have a look at the world's top staying events. "The G1 Melbourne Cup (Nov. 7) is not foremost in my mind--I think we will aim at the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh Sept. 9 before going to the Hong Kong Invitational and the Dubai Sheema Classic," said trainer Mark Johnston. "He was brilliant today and I am absolutely delighted. He will have a short break now."

Shooter made his debut at Monmouth Aug. 5 and came away with an impressive 8 1/4-length score. Stepping right into stakes company off the effort, the bay sat second as T P Louie set a sizzling pace, drove to the front as they turned for home and outfinished Snow Ridge to take the photo. "He ran a great race," trainer John Dowd said. "He broke extremely sharp, but then he settled nicely and finished well. He is very talented." Two hours before the first race at Canterbury today, officials announced the much-hyped comeback of Might And Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) would not take place as the seven-year-old was scratched from the G2 Warwick S. But early in the day, many of a 6,000 crowd at the track were unaware they wouldn't be seeing the pin-up galloper and several maintained they would have been pleased merely to see Might And Power parade in the enclosure. It seems to be confined to the tissue on the outside of the suspensory. If he was finished, I'd be the first to admit it." Later in the day, owner Nick Moraitis said x-rays and scans showed no major damage. "There is a bit of filling in the joint, but there is no ligament or tendon damage. We are not sure whether maybe he's just knocked it in his box."
