SADLER'S WELLS COLT TOPS DEAUVILLE

A colt by super sire Sadler's Wells brought a final bid of FF6,000,000 to top yesterday's second session of the Agence Francaise Deauville August Yearling Sale. The bay Irish-bred yearling, out of Irish Arms (Fr) (Irish River), was consigned by Haras d'Etreham and was purchased by Peter Doyle Bloodstock Ltd. Sold as hip number 91, the yearling is a half brother to stakes winner Charme Slave (Fr) (Sicyos) and Group 1 placed Celtic Cavalier (Ire) (Caerleon). The top-priced filly of the session was lot 108, a daughter of Zafonic and group winner Legend Maker (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Consigned by Haras de la Reboursiere et de Montaigu, the yearling was bought for FF4,000,000 by Shadwell Estate Company. Peter Doyle purchased two of the top five colts and two of the top five priced fillies. John Ferguson brought home two of the top five priced colts. Through two sessions of the five-day sale, 103 yearlings have grossed FF65,940,000 and averaged FF1,244,151. The average rose 29.4 percent over the first two sessions of last year's auction when 115 yearlings grossed FF109,240,000 and averaged FF949,913. The sale continues today at 1:30 p.m.

DREAM REIGNS SUPREME IN BALLERINA

Kinsman Stable's Dream Supreme (Seeking the Gold) bulled her way through in deep stretch to lead home a one-two for her sire in yesterday's GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga. The sophomore filly, who equaled the track record in her career debut over this track, rallied strongly when winning the GI Test S. here July 29. After a sharp half-mile drill in :47 2/5, all systems were go for the homebred. Never far from the front as Cash Run (Seeking the Gold) and Bourbon Belle (Storm Boot) cut out moderate fractions, she angled out off the turn, but switched back inside and knifed between the pacesetters at the eighth pole and drew off powerfully. "The filly ran a huge race today," commented winning trainer Bill Mott. "She broke cleanly, was up close to the pace and when Pat [jockey Day] pushed the button, there was plenty of horse there and she had everyone else at her mercy." A claim of foul against the winner was lodged by D. Wayne Lukas, trainer of Cash Run, but it was disallowed. Even-money Honest Lady (Seattle Slew) attempted to duplicate half brother Chester House's run up the rail, but was forced to steady as Cash Run came over and finished fourth. "I had a clear shot on the fence and it closed up in a second," said her rider Jerry Bailey. "I had no choice but to check out of the race. It's tough to say whether we would have won or not, but I knew Cash Run caused the trouble. Dream Supreme didn't do anything wrong." Dream Supreme became the fourth three-year-old to win the Ballerina.

Bad As I Wanna Be, the outsider of the field, caused the second major shock of the Deauville festival with his win here. Winner of a maiden last time at Windsor, his form was considered far short of what was required to win this, but he made a collection of some of the finest two-year-olds in Europe look ordinary. Bouncing from the stalls, he had the rail position and immediately took to the front as Rolly Polly (Ire) (Mukaddamah {USA}) tracked him and Pyrus (Mr Prospector {USA}) was rousted to prominence. As jockey Gerald Mosse picked up the pace with a quarter mile remaining, he had a healthy advantage over the chasing group. Drawing further and further clear, he was in no danger of being troubled, and his jockey rewarded his impressive display with a pat on the neck crossing the line. Endlesss Summer appeared to confirm Goodwood form with Pyrus, adding significant weight to the form, and justification for the thought that this could be the best two-year-old seen in Europe so far. Mosse said, "He has lots of speed, and when I asked him to accelerate he reacted really well. He handled the soft ground comfortably." Trainer Brian Meehan commented, "I'm obviously delighted. It was a top performance. I wasn't totally surprised as he's a lovely horse. He was disappointing when he made his debut [when unplaced in a Newbury maiden]. Whether the ground was too firm or what I don't know, but he bolted up at Windsor on his next start. He's in the G1 Middle Park S. (Newmarket Sept. 28), but I suppose I'll have to train him as a (2000) Guineas horse now."

Love That Red, winner of the GI Malibu last December, returned from a three-month absence to run second in the July 29 GIII Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. in his first start for trainer Bob Baffert. Favored in the short field of five, the gelding stalked the pace, made his bid along the inside on the turn and kicked clear to win going away. "I had a great trip and I had a lot of horse," said winning jockey Corey Nakatani. "I was stalking them today and at the three-eighths I asked him and he just went up in there and did his thing." Baffert added, "We got the perfect trip. We were in the perfect spot and when he got through on the rail, it was all over." The GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. winner Elaborate (Gilded Time) reared up at the start and never got into the race, finishing last.

Takali deserves his own share of the limelight since he helped his stablemate Sinndar (Ire) to claim the G1 Irish Derby July 2, when he was employed to hassle Holding Court (GB) in front. In this race he built on his recent success in the G3 Meld S. July 29 to win his most important prize yet. He tracked the pacesetter in second early, and, with two and a half furlongs to race, was asked to take up the running by jockey Johnny Murtagh. From there he had to shake off the attentions of Molomo, but managed to do so and win by a head. John Oxx said afterwards, "He'll be a better four-year-old than a three-year-old, as he's a big, tall horse, and will take time to fill out his frame. He could possibly be pacemaker to Sinndar in the G2 Prix Niel (Longchamp Sept. 10) next."

Showing that he still retains all his powers, Persian Punch bravely secured the G3 Henry II S. at Sandown May 29 and followed up with a creditable sixth to Kayf Tara (GB) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup June 22. He was fifth in his latest start in the G2 Goodwood Cup Aug. 3, but returned to winning form in emphatic style here to add another group race success to his already impressive tally with in-form Richard Hughes showing why he is rated one of Europe's top jockeys. Another trip to Australia to contest the G1 Fosters Melbourne Cup at Flemington in November is still very much on the cards. He finished third in that race in 1998. Persian Punch was sent straight into a four-length lead from 9-5 favourite Pairumani Star (Ire) (Caerleon), Wajina and Three Cheers. They remained the same almost throughout and the race began in earnest as Hughes increased the tempo turning out of the back straight. Persian Punch poached a three-length lead into the straight and was ridden to maintain his advantage from the quarter-mile marker. He had the race in the bag at the distance, as the remainder fought for the minor honours, and he only needed to be pushed out to record a comfortable victory. Wajina stayed on well to hold second place as Three Cheers ran on in good style in the closing stages to secure third.

Edneator broke on top and led every step to light up the board in winning his first stakes. A true local hero, the son of the Storm Cat horse Delineator had made all 14 of his previous starts at Emerald Downs. Second two back for a \$60,000 tag July 16, he followed that up with a fifth in the July 30 Mt. Ranier Breeders' Cup H., finishing behind four of today's rivals. Off smoothly from post six, the Washington-bred was pressed by Handy N Bold (Bold Laddie) through testing fractions of :44 3/5 and 1:07 4/5. As that horse faded, Edneator fended off the challenge of favorite Big Ten down the stretch and equalled the track record.

Golden Silca turned in perhaps her best performance this year when fourth last time in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2 behind Giant's Causeway, but the closest she has got to Group 1 success came here in last season's Irish 1000 Guineas when beaten a short head. At this level she is a force to be reckoned with, however, and proved that again by claiming her fifth stakes success. With two rivals to beat here, she raced in second place early as Muakaad made the running. Entering the straight, she was relegated to last by Duck Row, before being produced to go to the front with 150 yards remaining and sprinting away to win with something in hand. Mark Wallace, assistant to winning trainer Mick Channon said, "There are no firm plans. She's a tough and honest filly, and this was the ideal opportunity for her."

Gaviola rides a four-race win streak into her first Spa outing. The grey filly, unbeaten since finishing third in the GIII Sweetest Chant S. at Gulfstream in January, captured the GIII Herecomesthebride S. in March and, most recently took the June 18 GIII Sands Point at Belmont. While still a maiden, Storm Dream ran third in the May 28 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. She stormed to a 14 1/4-length demolition of her North American bow, a July 13 Belmont maiden special weight. Solvig was favored in the July 31 GIII Lake George off wins in the June 4 GIII Regret and June 24 GIII Pucker Up, but managed only a ninth-place effort behind Millie's Quest.
