LOOKING FOR A SWEEP IN INTERNATIONAL

Horses have won the G1 Eclipse S. and the G1 Juddmonte International S., to be run this afternoon at York, in the same year. They have also combined the G1 St. James' Palace S. and G1 Sussex S. But no horse has ever won all four. This year's renewal of the International will allow Giant's Causeway (Storm Cat) not only the chance to do so, but to do so in the space of two months. Those two months have been nothing short of remarkable for Aidan O'Brien's colt, who clinched success at Royal Ascot June 20, at Sandown July 8 and at Goodwood Aug. 2. Victory here will see him surpass the unique achievements of Henry Cecil's Wollow (Ire) in 1976, who took this race, the Sussex and the Eclipse as a three-year-old. Three of the International favorite's rivals have failed to get past him so far this year, while another is in the race strictly to aid him in his bid for immortality. Of those Giant's Causeway has beaten so far, only Sir Michael Stoute's Kalanisi (Ire) (Douyoun {Ire}) has come close to outbattling him; at Sandown, he was marginally in front yards before the line only to lose out to the last thrust of the winner. He has not raced since, but as that was his first try at Group 1 company he could be progressing fast. At Royal Ascot, on the day that Giant's Causeway was plundering his first Group 1 event of the year, he was taking the G2 Queen Anne S. by a half-length from Dansili (GB). The runner-up went on to run Giant's Causeway to three-quarters of a length at Goodwood, which must mean they are practically inseparable. The Knavesmire will provide a level playing ground for a fascinating rematch. If there is to be a fly in the ointment here, it could be David Elsworth's Lear Spear (Lear Fan), who has been off the track since finishing a disappointing ninth to Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 25. Nevertheless, he got within 4 1/2 lengths of that horse on the dirt in Round Three of the Listed Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum Challenge Mar. 2, and that has to be respected. Despite a switch to Mick Channon's stable, Barathea Guest (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) looks up against it on form, having followed the favourite home in both the English and Irish 2000 Guineas. GRAPE TREE ROAD TOPS DEAUVILLE DAY 3

Monday's third session of the Deauville August Sale saw a colt by first-year sire Grape Tree Road (GB) (Caerleon), winner of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris, top the day with a bid of FF3,800,000. From the consignment of Haras d'Etreham, the yearling was purchased by John Ferguson, agent for Sheikh Mohammed. It was a very solid session overall, with 84 percent of those offered selling, including 10 which brought more than FF\$1 million, compared with just four seven-figure yearlings at last year's third session. Thirty others brought between FF500,000 and FF\$1 million yesterday, demonstrating the strength of the middle market. The gross was up 60 percent and the average rose 25 percent. International buyers continued to be active, with 14 different countries represented by purchases yesterday afternoon. Philippe Augier, president of the Agence Française, was thrilled, saying "This session has confirmed that the third day is now every bit as international as the weekend. The selection and the quality of the horses for sale is such that all buyers now stay to follow the sale and buy on Monday. It is particularly satisfying that despite the greater number of horses presented, the percentage sold is also well up." (Top yearlings, stats, p3)

GAVIOLA STREAKS TO SARATOGA WIN

Looking for her fifth straight victory, Gaviola (Cozzene) was sent off the 9-10 choice in yesterday's GII Lake Placid H. at Saratoga and, after setting all the pace, drew away to extend her streak with a 2 1/4length tally over 20-1 Good Game (Fly Till Dawn). "This filly just keeps getting better and better every time she runs," winning trainer Billy Turner said. "[Jockey Jerry Bailey] really did a fantastic job with her today, he let her run at her own pace and she finished great." The gray started her skein with a Gulfstream allowance win in February, then took the GIII Herecomesthebride S. over that course Mar. 1. She came came to notch an Aqueduct allowance score May 4 before adding the GIII Sands Point S. at Belmont Park June 18 to her resume. As for what's next. Turner said, "I'll probably go in the Garden City Breeders' Cup (GI, Sept. 10) at Belmont next time out." (Lake Placid chart, p2)

Times have changed enormously since the champion sire Lexington recorded the last of his 16 titles in 1878, 28 years after his birth, and since Bonny Scot became champion sire for a second time in 1882, 29 years after he was born. Even so, the extraordinary Mr. Prospector still has a chance of bettering their achievements in today's much more competitive world of racing.

The prospect of his once again becoming champion sire by North American earnings, some 30 years after his birth, became an enticing possibility after Chester House's win in the Arlington Million added another \$1,200,000 to his sire's bankroll, already significantly bolstered by Fusaichi Pegasus' Kentucky Derby triumph and by Scatter The Gold's wins in the first two legs of the Canadian Triple Crown.

With Chester House now seemingly well positioned to win more of the top turf events and Fusaichi Pegasus expected to contest the Breeders' Cup Classic, Mr. Prospector may yet prove more than a match on the domestic scene for his son Seeking The Gold and for such as A.P. Indy and Storm Cat.

Of course, Mr. Prospector was bred for longevity. His sire Raise A Native successfully covered a sizeable book at the age of 26 in 1987 and his broodmare sire Nashua was 29 years old when the last of his 77 stakes winners was conceived.

By my reckoning, Chester House's latest win makes him no less than the 43rd Grade I winner for his sire. A breakdown of this total provides food for thought. If you divide Mr. Prospector's career into three decades, you find that the five stud seasons he spent up to and including the age of nine produced six Grade I winners; the 10 years from 10 to 19 produced 29; and that, from the age of 20, he has so far come up with another eight (plus Scatter The Gold). Only two of these last eight were conceived after Mr. Prospector reached the age of 22. While there may well be more to come from the Claiborne champion's last three crops, doesn't his record suggest that even the very best stallions struggle to maintain full effectiveness in their veteran years?

Of course, Mr. Prospector's impressive Grade I tally includes quite a few which shone on Europe's turf tracks, such as Kingmambo, Machiavellian, Distant View, Miswaki, Jade Robbery, Lycius, Ravinella, Coup de Genie and Ta Rib. But I believe that Chester House has the distinction of being only his sire's second Grade I winner on turf in the U.S. His record suggests that he is happier competing on turf than dirt, but there is no doubting his ability to handle a dirt track. With 1 1/4 miles established as his best trip in England, he was pointed to the Breeders' Cup Classic instead of the Mile or the Turf when he made his debut for Bobby Frankel. Chester House finished a fine fourth behind Cat Thief, Budroyale and Golden Missile and might well have done even better had he not stumbled at the start.

It isn't too surprising that Chester House's major wins have come on turf, even though he is a half-brother to the excellent Honest Lady, whose four graded victories --including her Grade I success in the Santa Monica H.-have all been gained on dirt. Their dam, Toussaud, is by the exceptional Irish colt El Gran Senor, which makes her a granddaughter of Northern Dancer. Toussaud did all her racing on turf, notably winning the Gl Gamely H. and finishing fourth to Lure in the Breeders' Cup Mile.

Kingmambo and the Japanese-based Jade Robbery are consistently successful Mr Prospector stallions whose dams were high-class racemares by sons of Northern Dancer. No doubt this will reflect well on Chester House when the time eventually comes for him too to retire to stud.

Filly Dies in Staring Gate Accident:

A two-year-old filly suffered fatal injuries before the start of yesterday's third race at Saratoga when she reared and subsequently fell in the starting gate. Outrage (Slew City Slew) reared in the gate and kicked the filly to her outside, Nice Weather, who suffered abrasions to her left hind leg and was subsequently scratched. Outrage, trained by Allen Iwinski, fell in the gate and suffered a fractured pelvis. A bone fragment severed an artery, which caused her death. "We tried to treat her for shock, hoping that wasn't what happened and she was just traumatized," said New York Racing Association Veterinarian Dr. Celeste Kunz. "But the injury was very apparent."


