## ECLIPSE IMPLICATIONS IN TRAVERS?

There may be more than the \$1 million purse on the line in the Travers. For at least a couple of the colts, a win in the Grade I event could lead to the three-year-old championship. The 131st edition of the Travers will be run at Saratoga tomorrow. A field of nine will line up, including GI Belmont S. winner **Commendable** (Gone West) and GI Haskell Invitational hero **Dixie Union** (Dixie-land Band), and either one could move to the head of the class with a victory. Kentucky Derby winner **Fusaichi Pegasus** (Mr. Prospector) is the current division leader, but he has not been out since finishing second to **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) in the Preakness and only just returned to the work tab yesterday, breezing three furlongs in :39.20 at Hollywood Park. Red Bullet will be sidelined for the rest of the year (see *News Today*, p2). That opens the door for Dixie Union. The California colt had knee surgery after his 1999 campaign and missed the Triple Crown, but he is trying to make up for lost time. He overcame a world of trouble to take the Haskell by 3/4 of a length and would become the second colt in his division to pocket two Grade I wins if he can succeed in the Travers. (High Yield, already retired to stud, was the first.) Trainer Dick Mandella doesn't like to think much beyond the next race, but he did admit, "I do love my little horse. We've thought from Day 1 that he would do pretty much whatever we asked. He's just that kind of horse--very generous and smart. He's training great and right now we're just looking at the Travers, but obviously there's a lot more in store for him down the road." Commendable is more of a question mark. The D. Wayne Lukas trainee upset the Belmont field at 18-1, but has been off the board in both starts since, finishing fourth in the GII Dwyer S. July 9 and eighth, beaten 17 lengths, in the Haskell. Lukas won the Travers with Corporate Report in 1991 and with Thunder Gulch in '95, but he has been out of the money with his last five starters in the race. Of this year's candidate, he said, "I don't have any excuses for his race in the Haskell. Hopefully, he'll run better in the Travers." After winning the 1 1/2-mile Belmont, the one thing which is not a question mark for Commendable is the 10 furlongs of the Travers. Mandella does not feel Dixie Union will have a problem with the extra furlong either. "He handled 1 1/8 miles very well at Monmouth and I don't see any reason why he won't handle 1 1/4 miles, but we won't know until we try it," he said.

## SHOWDOWN AT SARATOGA

Heritage of Gold (Gold Legend) will attempt to secure her grip on the handicap female division when she faces off with **Beautiful Pleasure** (Maudlin) in the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga today. Trained by Tom Amoss, the five-year-old has defeated last year's Eclipse champion in each of their two meetings this year, including a stellar effort over a sloppy Saratoga strip in the GI Go For Wand H. July 30. In that outing, Heritage of Gold ran down a loose-on-the-lead Beautiful Pleasure in the stretch with a sustained move. The only question which remains is the distance--she finished fourth on the grass last year in the 10-furlong GII Flower Bowl H., and has never gone further than nine furlongs on dirt. Amoss expressed confidence in his charge's capability. "A mile and a quarter may have been a concern for her last year, but not any longer," he said. "She's got great tactical speed and she's very athletic out of the gate. She knows how to save energy. If the pace is hot, she'll sit off it. If it's mild, then she'll be positioned much closer. She was more relaxed and professional last time out than she's ever been." Beautiful Pleasure used this race last year as a springboard to her championship, but will need to find more in order to get back on track. The bay mare scored a pair of easy daylight victories at Belmont, but failed to offer much of a response after opening up seven lengths in the Go For Wand. "She's got her own style," said trainer John T. Ward Jr. "We know she has speed, but it all depends on what the other horses do out there. In this race, there's a long straight run into the first turn, and a lot can happen during the early stages of a race."

**KEENELAND TO OFFER INTERNET AUCTION**

Keeneland has finalized plans to introduce its first Internet auction in conjunction with its 2000 Keeneland September Sale, set for Sept. 11-23. The first Internet sale will be restricted to horses from the September Sale which fail to reach their reserves. Keeneland will offer three Internet Sales sessions on Sept. 16, Sept. 20 and Sept. 25. Each session will begin at 8 a.m. and close at intervals beginning at 4 p.m. on the auction date. Interested buyers who have been pre-approved for credit at the live sale will not have to re-apply for the Internet sale, but new buyers will need to register at least two days prior to the session date. As in live sales, authorized agents with prior approval will be able to bid for their clients. Consignors will have the option of uploading four photos of each Internet auction lot to the website. The Internet system will also offer proxy bidding, allowing an absent buyer to set a limit of the maximum he or she is willing to spend on a specific horse. The Internet auction system will automatically submit bids on behalf of that buyer in the amount of one minimum bid each time another buyer exceeds a proxy bid, until that maximum is reached. "We have spent many months developing the Internet auction system," said Rogers Beasley, Keeneland's director of sales. "There has been a significant investment of resources, manpower and brainpower to get us to this point. Our expertise in selling horses, coupled with The Jockey Club's knowledge of the industry and technology, has helped us create an extremely user-friendly yet comprehensive Internet auction system." Beasley added, "Unlike other Internet auctions, we'll be selling a live animal and there's a different expectation from buyers and sellers because of that. We've had to plan for issues such as inspection periods and credit. We've explored every possible situation and have a plan in place for it. The auction system is a work in progress and we'll make improvements to the system as needed. However, we are extremely confident in the system we are launching. We believe it will be the benchmark for future Internet sales systems." Keeneland will host an Internet Buyers' seminar in the sales pavilion on Friday, Sept. 8.

**RED BULLET OUT FOR SEASON** GI Preakness winner Red Bullet (Unbridled) will miss the rest of the year after an X-ray revealed a shadow in his left front cannon bone which could indicate the beginnings of a fracture. "We talked to the vets and they said if you push on this, you could hurt him," Danny Vella, Frank Stronach's farm manager, told the *Daily Racing Form*. Hampered by ulcers and a virus, the colt has not been out since running third as the 3-5 favorite in the July 9 GI Dwyer S. He was shipped to Stronach's Adena Springs Farm in Ocala, Florida Tuesday. "He just hasn't been quite right since his last race--something happened in that race," Vella said. The colt will walk 30 days and then swim 30 days before returning to the track in the fall. A winner of four of his six starts to date for earnings of \$980,300, Red Bullet could be back for the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park in February.

**CHESTER HOUSE TO JUDDMONTE** GI Arlington Million winner Chester House (Mr. Prospector--Toussaud {El Gran Senor}) will likely be retired to Juddmonte Farms in Kentucky after the Breeders' Cup Nov. 4, it was announced yesterday. A stud fee has not yet been determined. Produced from Grade I winner Toussaud, Chester House started his career in England, where he captured the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. before finishing third to Royal Anthem in the G1 Juddmonte International. Shipped to the U.S., he closed stoutly to be fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Gulfstream and gained his first stateside victory by 3 1/4 lengths in the Arlington Million. He is a half-brother to Honest Lady (Seattle Slew), a Grade I winner of \$694,168 to date.

Proving the market to be a more than useful guide, Nuclear Debate confirmed favouritism and the form of his win in the G2 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 20 with another exhilarating display of speed to secure his first Group 1 success. Compared to last year, he has enjoyed a relatively light campaign with a total of only four starts, beginning his now three-race winning streak in the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly June 3. After breaking in second-last place from the unfavourable number one draw this time, he struggled early as Rudi's Pet (Ire) (Don't Forget Me {Ire}) set a blistering pace. Bertolini, second in the early going, eased into first past halfway and took a healthy-looking advantage into the final furlong, but jockey Gerald Mosse was not to be outwitted as he positioned Nuclear Debate on the outside to make his bid from the eighth pole. The winner quickened readily and was soon in front, pulling away from his rivals towards the line for an easy win over Bertolini. Looking ahead, winning trainer John Hammond said, "There is a Listed race for him at Newbury (Dubai Airport World Trophy, Sept. 15), but he will have to carry a Group 1 penalty. He will definitely go for the Hong Kong Sprint at the end of the year. He went for the same race last year at the end of a long season, but he's had a lighter campaign this term. He has improved and matured with age and is a lovely horse to train with a wonderful nature."

With the best performance by a two-year-old filly seen this season to date, Enthused went straight to the head of ante-post lists and is priced at 8-1 and below for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. She produced a superb burst of acceleration in the final furlong to win going away, disposing of some highly regarded fillies in the process. Second to Dora Carrington (Ire) in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket July 11, she gained some measure of compensation when easing to victory in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 29. Looking to make it two in a row, the beautifully bred individual was ridden patiently in the rear as Khulan led. The pacesetter was still in front approaching the final furlong; jockey Johnny Murtagh produced Enthused onto the heels of the leaders, but she was hampered as Khulan drifted left under pressure. Not one to let opportunity pass him by, Murtagh switched Enthused to the inside immediately and, with a shake of the reins, urged his mount to the front. The winner quickened in superb fashion and instantly settled the contest; she only needed to be ridden out to confirm her superiority. Khulan kept on well to hold second place from Autumnal, who finished with some aplomb. Murtagh said, "She is the best two-year-old I have ever ridden. She has so much class it's unbelievable. She does it so easy." Sir Michael Stoute added, "I think she will now go for the G1 Cheveley Park S. (Sept. 26). She did well to win today. She gave them three pounds, missed a beat and banged her head leaving the stalls. She was in full flight and went for a split that was denied her, and I thought she couldn't win but she has finished up winning with her ears pricked. She's a real natural."

## HASSINGER JOINS NARVICK INTERNATIONAL

Alex Hassinger, who stepped down from his position as trainer for The Thoroughbred Corp. at the end of July, has joined Emmanuel and Laura de Seroux's Narvick International as principle assistant trainer to Laura de Seroux. Narvick, an international bloodstock agency based in Southern California, currently has 40 horses in training at San Luis Rey Downs. "I'll be training at the farm and going with the horses to the track when they run," Hassinger told the *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm very excited about it. Emmanuel's business has grown so much--he's got strong European ties and prepares horses for Japanese clients. Now they can offer their clients a racing stable in addition to preparation."

A chestnut filly by Storm Boot out of Move Closer (Plugged Nickle) brought a final bid of \$40,000 to top Thursday's session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales company's Open Yearling Sale. Consigned by Kaizen Sales, Agent VII, the half sister to stakes winner Closer She Moves (Native Tactics) was purchased by Heiligbrodt Racing. Kaizen Sales, Agent I, consigned the top colt on the day, a son of Helmsman out of Opal's Notebook (Notebook) named Opal's Helmsman. The bay was bought by Willie Brown for \$37,000. The sale concludes with the final Open session today. Bidding begins at 10:30 a.m.

**SUNLINE NAMED HORSE OF THE YEAR**

Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) was overwhelmingly voted Australia's Horse of the Year for the 1999-2000 season. She became the first mare since Let's Elope in 1991-92 to be crowned champion racehorse. Sunline, who earned A\$2.49 million while winning six of her 11 starts last season--including the G1 Cox Plate--polled 137 of a possible 148 votes at the ceremony in Melbourne to record one of the most decisive wins in the award's 31-year history.
