CHAMP BACK ON TOP

With Jorge Chavez able to throttle down her sharp early speed, Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) coasted through easy fractions and romped home by five lengths in yesterday's GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga. The champion mare reversed the decision of the GI Go For Wand H. July 30 at Saratoga when she was beaten a length by Heritage of Gold (Gold Legend), who crossed the wire third here, but was placed second with the disqualification of Back in Shape (Wild Again). Breaking sharply in the 1 1/4-mile race, Beautiful Pleasure seized the lead and cut comfortable fractions of :24 1/5 and :48 3/5 after drifting wide on the first turn, with Heritage of Gold reserved about four lengths back. After six furlongs in 1:12 2/5, Heritage of Gold made a run at the champ, but after charging off the final turn very wide, she was full of run. It was the third battle of the year between Beautiful Pleasure and Heritage of Gold, with the latter having taken the Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom in addition to the Go For Wand, which was run over an extremely sloppy track. "I think the difference today was the track," Chavez said. She likes a sloppy track, but it has to be real sloppy, not heavy. She relaxed well out in front. I didn't want to fight her. Even when we were wide around the turns, I let her do her thing. Trainer John Ward indicated the GI Beldame Oct. 14 at Belmont Park would be next for his mare, who prepped in that race before her Breeders' Cup Distaff win. "The same plan as last year," he said. Heritage of Gold, who has a five-race winning streak snapped, could not match strides with the winner in the lane and was nipped for the place by Back in Shape, who had drifted out, interfering with Pentatonic (Cure the Blues). "I didn't think the mile and a quarter was the problem," said jockey Shane Sellers. "It's difficult to let a horse like that go in :48 3/5 and have no one go with her. [Beautiful Pleasure] was just too strong in the lane for us, and we couldn't make up any ground. But she is still the same filly she always has been, and she'll come back to fight again." Said trainer Tom Amoss: "I expected to be in the winners' circle today. I thought she was in good position to go a mile and a quarter. We were very confident, but hats off to the winner. I don't know specifically what's next. I'll talk to Mr. (Jack) Garey, but it will either be New York or Keeneland." Chart p2

MILLION-DOLLAR BONANZA

A pair of million-dollar races, two hours apart, will be the focus of the American racing scene today. Nine three-year-olds looking to make a name for themselves will line up in the GI Travers at Saratoga, while one sophomore will try six elders in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar. Dixie Union (Dixieland Band) headlines the Travers as the morning-line favorite; winner of the GI Haskell at Monmouth Aug. 6 in his last start, he is the lone entrant coming off a victory. Trainer Tino Attard will send out Stronach Stable's Milwaukee Brew (Wild Again), who made a strong move along the rail when third, beaten just a length, to Dixie Union in the Haskell. The bay colt had previously taken four straight, including the GII Ohio Derby at Thistledown July 15. "I'm looking forward to running him at a mile and a quarter," said Attard. "The extra furlong will help us. If the Haskell was a furlong longer, I think we could have won it." He will have jockey Jerry Bailey, the current leading rider at Saratoga, aboard for the first time. Godolphin's Curule (Go for Gin) rallied for second in the GII Jim Dandy Aug. 5, outfinishing Unshaded (Unbridled) (third), Postponed (Summer Squall) (fourth) and Albert the Great (Go for Gin) (seventh). Three thousand miles away, Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy) will test the waters against older horses for the first time in the Pacific Classic, including defending champion and fellow Cal-bred General Challenge (General Meeting). Tiznow defeated Dixie Union in the GIII Affirmed July 1, but could not run down Captain Steve when second to that colt in the GI Swaps S. at Hollywood July 23. Training strongly over the Del Mar surface, he will race without blinkers for the first time. General Challenge is coming off a pair of losses, including a second to Early Pioneer in the 10furlong GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 9, but could give owner Golden Eagle Farm their third Pacific Classic trophy in just the 10th running if he can duplicate last year' effort. Trainer Bobby Frankel, on something of a tear in recent weeks, will send out a pair of impressive last-out winners, Euchre (Pleasant Tap) and Skimming (Nureyev). Euchre hasn't gone this far since finishing third in the Queen's Plate last season, but comes off a solid score in the GII Bel Air H. at Hollywood July 15, where he defeated River Keen (Ire) (Keen {GB}). Skimming ran off and hid by eight lengths in the GIII San Diego H. Aug. 6, but picks up 12 pounds off that wireto-wire victory. Fields p3

Penny's Gold put a rather disappointing effort when fifth to America (Ire) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp Apr. 30 behind her by filling the runner-up spot in the G3 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly June 4. That day Zarkiya (Ire) was too strong in the finish, but Penny's Gold has clearly progressed since, taking the Listed Prix de la Calonne here Aug. 3 in stride, before taking this, her most important prize to date, in style. Held up in fourth early as Island Sands was sent on in front, jockey Thierry Thulliez had her switched off and travelling easily. As Dettori gradually applied the pressure aboard Island Sands, Penny's Gold was asked to close as Leave Us Leap moved ominously upsides the leader. As that horse failed to get past the favourite, it was Thulliez who had all the aces, and, with a minimum of fuss his mount quickened past the duelling pair before drawing away, and was eased down near the line for a comfortable success. The Overbrook homebred broke one of the oldest track records when she registered 1:32.80 on the straight mile, compared to 1:33.20, the record since 1974. "Penny's Gold will be entered in the Prix du Rond Point [G2, Longchamp, Oct. 1], but will need good ground to run," said trainer Pascal Bary. "The Queen Elizabeth S. [GI, Oct. 8], at Keeneland, is another possibility." Island Sands, winner of last year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, had not been seen since finishing fifth in the Irish equivalent last May. Frankie Dettori said: "Island Sands has run a good race after such a long time off, but the ground was much too fast for him."

It has not been a long time since Elle Danzig dominated the German racing scene at the highest level, being champion filly in 1998 and winning just about all there was to win at three. At that age she won the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich, the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) and G2 Preis der Diana (German Oaks). She has even been known to partake in some overseas bashing, such as her victory in the G1 Premio Roma last November. This year she has been relatively disappointing, no less so than when seventh of eight behind Shiva (Jpn) in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 30. She bounced back here to win this race for the second consecutive year, and put herself back on the map. Held up early, travelling easily in middivision, as Timahs (GB) (Mtoto {GB}) and Aboard (Fr) (Hero's Honor) disputed the lead, she was brought to challenge Hangover Square and Kalatos as those swept to the front with two furlongs remaining. She swept to the front with a furlong remaining, before going away from the game runner-up, and the horse that followed her home in second last year.

ARTAX RETIRED (AGAIN) Last year's champion sprinter Artax (Marquetry--Raging Apalachee, by Apalachee), recently returned to training after standing his first season, has been re-retired after an aborted comeback, announced trainer Louis Albertrani yesterday. "He has officially been retired," Albertrani said. "He's had some minor setbacks that have interfered with his training schedule. We were planning on running him back in the Breeders' Cup Sprint [Nov. 4], but that won't happen now. Retired following a suspensory injury, Artax covered 93 mares at Clermont Farm in Germantown, New York, but will stand at Kentucky's Taylor Made Farm beginning with the 2001 season.

Trainer Todd Pletcher, currently atop the Saratoga trainers' standings, has a tough two-fisted entry in this Grade I event. More Than Ready cuts back from several two-turn affairs and will be tough to beat here. A 9 3/4length victor of the GII Sanford last season, he has never been beaten at sprint distances and will have blinkers off after a fourth in the GI Haskell at Monmouth Aug. 6, and will have a new pilot in the form of Pat Day. "I'm not really sure if he's better sprinting or at the middle distances," Pletcher remarked. "I think [today] will let us know where we should go from here." Barnmate Left Bank has three straight allowance scores over his elders at today's distance and will be making his graded stakes debut. Wake At Noon put up big Beyers when winning three sprint stakes in a row at Woodbine, but broke in the air when fourth in the GIII Amsterdam over six furlongs Aug. 4. Bevo, the lone Grade I winner in the field, is five-for-seven lifetime, but has not raced since finishing second by nine lengths to Trippi in the GII Riva Ridge S. at Belmont June 10.

This race has played host to the fortunes of such talented milers as Mark of Esteem (Ire), Selkirk, Milligram, Kris (GB) and Known Fact, and always gives the impression of being a very strong Group 2 event. This year's renewal is no disappointment. Although Godolphin, who have won two of the last four runnings, had four entries at the five-day stage, the state of the going has prompted the team to elect G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Bachir and Pacino, winner of the G2 Mehl-Muhlens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas). The former, who is the choice of Frankie Dettori, will appreciate the faster ground. He was disappointing when sixth in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 20 last time, having tried to take on Giant's Causeway almost from the outset. The improving Observatory, whose trainer John Gosden took this in 1998 with Muhtathir (GB), followed up his G3 Jersey S. success at Royal Ascot June 21 with more in the G3 Lennox S. here Aug. 4. Sir Michael Stoute saddles Medicean, who has twice filled third place behind Giant's Causeway in the G1 St James' Palace S., and G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2. The colt thrives on this faster ground and must be respected.
