UNDENIABLY UNSHADED IN THE TRAVERS

Trainer Carl Nafzger, yet to send out a winner at this Saratoga meeting, got his first one in a big way as Unshaded (Unbridled) wore down a game Albert the Great (Go for Gin) in the 131st running of the GI Travers yesterday, becoming just the fifth gelding to win America's oldest race for three-year-olds. Nafzger had circled the Travers for his charge back in February and affirmed those plans following Unshaded's good effort when third in the GI Belmont S., despite suffering from heat exhaustion. Off two months after that, Unshaded returned with a solid try when rallying from the back of the pack to be third in the GII Jim Dandy Aug. 5. Sent off as the second choice here, the bay was unhurried in the run up the backstretch as Commendable (Gone West) showed the way, but began to pick it up nearing the far turn. Swinging wide off the turn, he responded to jockey Shane Sellers' urging and gradually cut into Albert the Great's advantage, getting a head in front in the shadow of the wire. "Between the eighth pole and the sixteenth pole, we were not getting to him [Albert the Great]," Nafzger remarked. "At the sixteenth pole I saw we started picking up the pace and we had plenty of time to get by him." Unshaded broke his maiden at Gulfstream in January, and caught the attention of the racing public with a sweeping move in the GII Lexington S., bounding clear to win by three lengths Apr. 22. A run at the three-year-old title may now be in the cards for the Tafel colorbearer, who will seek to emulate former barnmate and fellow Unbridled offspring Banshee Breeze in her 1998 championship season. "He's got to step up," Nafzger continued. "You have to come on strong now, just like I said with Banshee Breeze. We hope he makes the Breeders' Cup [Nov. 4]. There are a lot of decisions to be made. Of course, the Jockey Club Gold Cup [Oct. 14] is definitely one of the races that will be on the consideration list." Trainer Nick Zito was pleased with Albert the Great's effort. "I'm real disappointed that we didn't get there, but I can't thank Albert enough for trying as hard as he did," Zito said. "He just got beat, but that's racing." Favored Dixie Union was well positioned early, but threw his left front shoe en route to a fourth-place finish. A record Travers Day crowd of 54,116 wagered a record on-track handle of \$7,371,991.21. "It was a spectacular day of racing," said NYRA president Terry Meyocks. Chart p2

SKIMMING SPEEDS TO DEL MAR GLORY

Less than a week after stablemate Chester House took the GI Arlington Million for Juddmonte Farms and trainer Bobby Frankel. Skimming (Nurevey) set a sizzling pace under Garrett Gomez en route to sparkling triumph in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar yesterday. Breaking from post five, the third choice quickly showed in front, with Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage) alongside through a quarter in :22.79. Skimming proceeded to lav down a half in :45.53 and three-quarters in 1:09.86 as Forty One Carats passed the baton to three-year old Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy), who gamely gave chase. Kicking clear off the far turn, Skimming opened up by 2 1/2 lengths and maintained a two-length advantage over the sophomore to the wire. "We were cookin' out there; I knew that," Gomez said. "But I was just riding him the way Bobby [trainer Frankel] told me to. He said, 'Leave him alone and let him do what he wants.' So I did." Skimming had done nothing but improve since arriving in the U.S. from England; with the switch to dirt and the addition of Lasix, the compact bay burst into Pacific Classic contention with an eight-length tour-de-force in the GIII San Diego H. over this track Aug. 6. "They don't stay up with him when he goes 1:09," Frankel said. "I like a speed horse on a track like this to go fast, because I don't like horses that finish a little bit breathing down your neck and them having an easy go." Budroyale's full brother Tiznow, making just his sixth career start, had a strong showing in his first try against older horses. "Chris [jockey McCarron] was very happy and the owners and I are very happy with the effort he put in," said his trainer, Jay Robbins. "He ran hard. When I looked at the fractions, I thought it was a little quicker than I expected. But nobody was finishing that big from behind either." Favored General Challenge (General Meeting) had a late jockey change to Laffit Pincay Jr. after regular rider Corey Nakatani suffered a fractured collarbone in a fall during the sixth race. The defending champ came with a run, but flattened out in deep stretch, getting nipped at the wire by Ecton Park (Forty Niner). "He's very difficult to ride," said Bob Baffert, trainer of General Challenge. "To put Laffit in that situation is tough. This horse drives you crazy. [But] I don't like the way he came back. He seems like he has some kind of heat stroke right now." Chart p2

Finally getting the Grade I victory that he had flirted with before. More Than Ready made a successful return to sprinting with an explosive win in the King's Bishop S. Rating in last place under new rider Pat Day behind wicked fractions of :21 4/5 and :44 4/5, More Than Ready circled five wide into the lane and stormed down the center of the track to a comfortable victory over Valiant Halory. "We always knew that this was Plan B; that if he couldn't stretch out, he could always go back to sprinting," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "We thought it was so important to get a Grade I on More Than Ready's resume. If ever there was a horse, in my opinion, deserving of a Grade I win, it's him." Dominant in his early two-year-old season sprinting, More Than Ready reeled off five straight victories before finishing third, beaten a half-length in the one-mile GI Futurity S. and finishing fifth in GI Champagne to end the campaign. He began this year's campaign finishing in a dead heat for the win in the GII Hutcheson S. at seven furlongs before running second in the GII Louisiana Derby and missing by a head in the GI Blue Grass S. Though he finished fourth, beaten six lengths in the Kentucky Derby, it was one of his more impressive performances because he held well after attending the fast pace. After the Derby, More Than Ready finished second to GI Travers S. runner-up Albert The Great July 9 and fourth in the GI Haskell Invitational H. Aug. 6. With the classics over, Pletcher said he plans to keep More Than Ready sprinting, using the Sept. 23 Gl Vosburgh H. at seven furlongs as a prep for the Breeders' Cup Sprint.

Medicean was unlucky enough to come up against Giant's Causeway on two of his last three starts previous to this, finishing third both times, but never by more than 2 1/4 lengths. The first of those efforts, in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 20, and the other, in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2, stamped him as a colt of the highest class, but in between he had disappointed when unplaced in his connections' bid to pick up the valuable John Smiths Cup at York. He had all the answers here over the mile that seems to suit him so well, claiming his first stakes success. As Bachir (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) and jockey Frankie Dettori went to the front early, jockey Pat Eddery aboard Medicean seemed initially content to wait in behind with Observatory, but he soon realised the benefit in taking on that horse for the lead, and moved his mount upsides. From there he was able to hassle Dettori's mount while travelling easily himself, ensuring that he had a position to play a hand in the finish on the rain-soaked ground. Asked to go on with quarter mile remaining, he was threatened briefly by the runner-up before asserting with 200 yards to race, and going clear willingly under the Eddery drive. "I'm delighted for the Thompsons [David and Patricia, owners of Cheveley Park Stud], as they put so much into racing," said winning trainer Sir Michael Stoute. "He'll go for the Queen Elizabeth [G1, Ascot, Sept. 23] next."

A four-length winner of the Desert Stormer H. at Hollywood June 10, she finished fourth behind Honest Lady in the GII A Gleam over the same track July 9. Five-forseven, with two seconds, lifetime at Del Mar, she was sent off as the crowd's choice. Angling in from her outside post, the gray mare duked it out with Hookedonthefeelin through fractions of :21 4/5 and :44 3/5 and inched away in midstretch, holding off the late bid of Nany's Sweep. "My mare broke so good," said winning jockey Laffit Pincay, Jr. "I had a nice, big hold on her and she was still moving right along. When I asked her, she was there. She loves it here."

Mick Channon is becoming accustomed to arriving here and upsetting the home defence after Lady Lahar scored her first stakes success to follow stablemates Pan Jammer and Golden Silca. Third in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket July 11 behind Dora Carrington (Ire) and Enthused, she ran below that form when fourth at the same course in the Listed Sweet Solera S. Aug 12. Her best was good enough here, however, delivering a late rattle to beat the Ballydoyle pair Bonnard and Beckett. Racing in behind the pace set by Down To The Woods (Woodman) early, she looked in trouble with two furlongs remaining, being pushed along by jockey Johnny Murtagh. As Beckett took control inside the final furlong, Lady Lahar was finding another gear, and, brought alongside the strong-finishing Bonnard, hit the front with 50 yards remaining to go on to success. "The seven furlongs and cut in the ground were a help and she came home very well," said Mark Wallace, assistant to trainer Mick Channon.

Adilabad had a light campaign befitting most of his owner's promising individuals at two, ending up by creating an impression in a conditions race at Newmarket that he has a strong finish as his main weapon. He displayed that facet to win the Listed Thoroughbred S. at Goodwood Aug. 5, where he got the better of Summoner (GB) in a thrilling final 50 yards. Ridden too aggressively when fifth in the G3 Craven S. Newmarket Apr. 20, that effort is the only blot on an otherwise faultless copybook, and he extended his portfolio to include this prestigious Group 3 contest. He was positioned on the rail in fourth early as first Kingsclere (GB) (Fairy King), and then Merry Merlin (GB) (Polar Falcon) made it a reasonable test up front. Asked to close the gap before the turn into the straight, he assumed the lead with three furlongs remaining, where Albarahin and Forbearing emerged as dangers. Under strong driving, he managed to shrug off the latter before getting down to a protracted battle with the runner-up. Despite the fact that he was headed inside the final quarter mile, he kept responding to jockey Pat Eddery's urgings to get back in front with 150 yards remaining, then withstood the persistent challenge of Albarahin.

Leading freshman sire Storm Creek continued to be popular at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's August Yearling Sale, siring two of the top three yearlings at the sale's final session on Friday. Showing the way at \$90,000 was Hip 1276, a dark bay or brown colt from the stakes-placed mare Sheza My Cissy (Smead). From the consigment of Summerfield, the Florida-bred youngster was purchased by Tom Vanderhyde. Next up at \$83,000 was a chestnut colt by End Sweep, the second foal from the young Seattle Dancer mare Seattle Retreat. Offered by Janie Roper as agent, he was bought by Century Venture VI. Storm Creek also sired Hip 1529, a bay colt out of Yardstick (Sunny Clime), a half sister to multiple graded stakes winner Star Gallant. Sent through the ring by Thoroughstock as agent, he went for \$80,000 to Murray Smith. Overall on Friday, 179 yearlings were sold for a total of \$1,731,200, averaging \$9,672 with a median of \$5,200. With four open sessions this year, OBS sold 771 yearlings for a total of \$7,430,700, with an average of \$9,638 and a median of \$6,000. These numbers were slightly lower than the three-day Open sale in 1999, where 648 yearlings brought \$6,873,600, for an average price of \$10,607 and a median of \$6,500.

Rogerson said the horse would remain in Dubai until next April, when he would fly a team of horses back for the Sydney autumn carnival.
