EURO IMPORTS SWEEP OAKS

No Matter What (Nureyev) received a ground saving trip under Victor Espinoza and bursted through the stretch to capture vesterday's GI Del Mar Oaks, giving her sire a sweep of both Grade I races held this weekend in California. The winner of the Prix des Lilas in the French provinces June 7, the chestnut was a good fifth against males in the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot two back, but was off the board in the G2 Prix d'Astarte July 30 before shipping to the U.S. Kept along the inside behind dueling front runners, No Matter What was shifted out for running room in the stretch, hit the front inside the final eighth and withstood furious rallies from fellow U.S. debuters Theoretically (Theatrical {Ire}) and Premiere Creation (Green Tune). Gll San Clemente heroine Uncharted Haven (GB) (Turtle Island {Ire}), the 3-2 favorite, was blocked into the stretch and finished gamely to be fourth. Yet another European shipper La Gandilie (Highest Honor {Fr}) was a head back of the favorite in fifth. "(Trainer Neil Drysdale) said to put her behind horses, to cover her up," Espinoza commented. "He was right and I rode her with a lot of confidence. I had a very good trip and a very good filly."

RIZE-ING TO THE OCCASION

The inside was the place to be Sunday at Monmouth Park and Rize (Theatrical {Ire}) took advantage of his rail draw to land the GII Philip H. Iselin H. The gelding has shown remarkable consistency this year, finishing first or second in his last six starts, including a runner-up performance in the off-the-turf GIII Oceanport H. at Monmouth two starts back and a 4 3/4-length score in an optional claimer at the New Jersey oval in his most recent outing Aug. 2. Dismissed at 10-1 odds in his first graded stakes try, the gelding broke alertly from the inside gate and lead every step of the way for a resounding nine-length triumph over 4-5 favorite Sir Bear (Sir Leon). Winning trainer Norman Pointer exclaimed. "This is by far the biggest race I've ever won. When the Iselin came up a short field, I thought we should give him a chance. This is a thrill." Rize's jockey Jose Ferrer added, "The track was playing so fast that I knew if I went to the lead, I'd be tough to catch. I watched (jockey Joe) Bravo tie the track record sprinting earlier, and he stayed on the fence the whole way, so I knew before this race that was what I was going to do." Ralph Ziadie, trainer of multiple graded stakes winner and beaten favorite Sir Bear, said, "I was concerned about the track all day the way that speed was holding. He ran well, but so did the winner. He came back okay, and that's the important thing." The winner could next appear in the GII Meadowlands Cup October 7.

It was a bittersweet victory for Pleasant Breeze, who pulled up sore in his left front leg after a front-running victory in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup. Allowed to cruise uncontested through fractions of :24 2/5, :49 and 1:12 4/5, the five-year-old had plenty left to hold off second-choice Catienus. The final time was two ticks faster than yesterday's GI Travers S. After the win, jockey Jorge Chavez sensed the gelding was lame. "When we came back galloping nice and easy, I felt he was missing a step," he said. "He seemed to be favoring his left front." Pleasant Breeze's leg was put in a splint and he was vanned off, but there was no evidence of a fracture to the leg, according to NYRA veterinarian Dr. Celeste Kunz. "We're optimistic because there was no extra fluid or displacement," she said. Winner of the GII Meadowlands Cup last October, Pleasant Breeze ran second to Golden Missile in the GI Pimlico Special H. May 13, finishing a nose ahead of Lemon Drop Kid. After failures in the GII Massachusetts H. June 3 and the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 9, the dark bay romped by 4 3/4 lengths over Catienus in an Aug. 4 Saratoga allowance, covering 1 1/8 miles in a meetfastest 1:48 1/5. Catienus continues to prove a lucrative claim. Haltered for \$50,000 from Sheikh Mohammed last April, the six-year-old finished second in this race last year as well as the GII Suburban H. He was headed for the breeding shed this year, but was brought out of retirement and returned in the Aug. 4 allowance to prep for this.

Second in his stakes debut, the Steinlen S. last November, Hap raced once more that winter and won a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 11, before heading to the shelf for four months. He returned successfully June 30 to win at Belmont and again at Saratoga July 28 in the GII Bernard Baruch. Earning his fourth straight victory here, the late Allen Paulson-bred colt also gave the Bill Mott/Jerry Bailey connection their third win of the afternoon. The son of 1987's Male Turf Champion saved ground toward the rear of the ten-horse field, moving up inside to within a length of the frontrunners by the second turn. Down the lane, Bailey found room on the hedge to sneak through, took the lead and held off a game finish from late closing Altibr. "Coming around the turn, I was wondering where I was going to go," Bailey said. "In those situations, you just have to sit and hope for the best and hope a passage becomes open. The horse was quick enough to get there. He made me look really good." Mott added, "I think his horse could probably be pointed to the Breeders' Cup Mile (GI, \$1 million) at Churchill, Nov. 4). He's a mile to a mile and an eighth type of horse."

Russian Hope was impressive early this year before most of his opponents here had entered serious training. Successful in the Grand Prix du Conseil des Alpes at Maritimes Cagnes-Sur-Mer Feb. 19, he followed that up in the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 11, where he had the likes of Amilynx (Fr), Chelsea Manor (GB) and Caitano (GB) trailing in his wake. His only run since saw a disappointing effort when fourth of five behind First Magnitude (Ire) in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay at Longchamp May 22, one of the horses who could not land a blow at Saint-Cloud. Returning here after that lengthy summer break, he showed all his old enthusiasm to make his most important success to date. Breaking well, he was taken to the front early by jockey Christophe Soumillon, who allowed him to settle into his rhythm, while Flamingo Road (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) and Little Rock (GB) (Warning {GB}) followed him around the turns. Still happy in front by the time the others were creeping closer, he stole a healthy advantage entering the straight, which had his immediate pursuers in trouble. Asked to go on by Soumillon, he lengthened well, and when challenged by favored Daring Miss and Mont Rocher, he found more to hold off his rivals, taking his lifetime earnings beyond the FF2 million mark. "This is a fantastic success and a most deserved one for the horse," said trainer Henri-Alex Pantall. "After winnning the Listed Grand Prix de Cagnes in February and the G3 Prix Exbury, he ran slightly below par in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay, as he suffered a crack on his hoof. We had to give him time and he has returned stronger than ever. We will now dream and consider the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (at Longchamp Oct. 1)."

A multiple graded stakes winner coming into this event, Performing Magic looked to be heads and shoulders above the rest of this field, as his 4-5 odds indicated. The winner of the GII Illinois Derby and GIII Derby Trial this past spring, the chestnut most recently finished a disappointing fifth when shipped to the West Coast for the July 1 GIII Affirmed S. at Hollywood. Performing Magic gave his backers many anxious moments, as he stalked the early pace between rivals, inched closer entering the second turn, moved to challenge in upper stretch, dueled through the lane with 22-1 Mister Deville and outfinished that rival late to just get up by a neck. Performing Magic may have been affected by the oppressive 104-degree heat, according to winning rider Shane Sellers. "In the post parade he felt like he was a little bit dull," he said. "That's pretty much the way he ran today. I think he won or talent alone today."

Ascension started her racing career in Ireland, winning a Leopardstown maiden, before being transferred to Mick Channon's yard at West Ilsey. Under his care, she stepped up to stakes level to take the Listed Rose Bowl S. at Newbury July 22. Here she was sent off the warm favourite to take this next step in stride, and she did so in the fashion of a top-class prospect for next year. Held up by jockey Cash Asmussen in midfield early as Silver Jorden (GB) (Imp Society) cut out the running, she was always travelling easily, as Wooden Doll sat off the pace at the back. With two furlongs remaining, the frontrunner hoisted the white flaf under pressure from Peaceful Paradise and Wooden Doll. When Asmussen his filly down she burst into the lead, before being shaken up and going clear in a matter of strides, leaving the rest of the field trailing as she demonstrated her devastating finishing speed. "She is a very professional filly with lots of ability," Asmussen said, "and she will be able to stay a mile. The trainer had instructed me to ride her like I wished and she really had the answer when I called on her." She is now quoted at 25-1 for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket with William Hill.

Three Points seems to be getting better as he contiunes to cut back in distance and connections may well have found the ideal trip to ensure that his relentless front-running style is used to full effect. Tried over as far as an extended ten furlongs at Chester (in the Listed Dee S. May 11), his trailblazing fizzled out there and at Chantilly, when he was fourth over nine furlongs in the G1 Prix Jean Prat. Dropped back to seven furlongs, his best effort came last time out when chasing home Observatory in second in the G3 Theo Fennel Lennox S. at Goodwood Aug. 4. Here he succeeded on his first try over a furlong shorter to gain his first stakes win. Taken to the front early by jockey Pat Eddery, he had them all in trouble past halfway, where race favorite Danger Over was attempting to keep tabs on him. For a brief period inside the final quarter of a mile, Thierry Thulliez looked as if he might make a fight of it aboard Danger Over, but Eddery had more up his sleeve, and his mount responded enthusiastically to go away again. Mount Abu ran on well to claim third, while Blu Air Force (Ire) (Sri Pekan) could never land a blow.

Were it not for her below-par run when eighth in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. behind Dora Carrington (Ire), from which she returned with a dirty scope, Freefourracing may still be unbeaten. She was impressive in a conditions race at Beverley on her debut, looking outpaced until she delivered a strong finishing run, and followed up at Windsor, where she had to make all. Here she reproduced her original style of running to claim her first stakes success and earn herself a quote of 33-1 for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket with William Hill. Racing in third on the rail early as Waki Music set the pace, jockey Richard Quinn did not have much room in behind the two leaders as the field entered the straight, and he did not appear to be going too smoothly. Jockey Jamie Spencer seemed to have stolen the race as he brought Summer Symphony up the rail swinging impressively on the bridle. As that horse hit the front with a furlong and a half remaining, Quinn got the daylight he needed, and found instant acceleration to pick up the leader in the last strides to win going away. Trainer Brian Meehan, fresh from the success of Bad As I Wanna Be (Ire) in last Sunday's G1 Prix Morny at Deauville, said of her, "She's a lazy little filly, so this was no surprise. She ran a bad race last time in the Cherry Hinton but she had a bad scope after, and she's worked well over the last fortnight, so she came here fancied. She's a lovely filly, and she'll get a mile. Richard (Quinn) said she's exactly what you thought she was."
