SPINNING DREAMS

A field of nine fillies will meet in the season's first Grade I event for juveniles in today's GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga. Leading the way is the field's lone graded stakes winner, Raymond Dweck's **Stormy Pick** (Storm Creek). A daylight winner of her first two outings, she bounced back from a second to **Queen Carson** (Lord Carson) in the Colleen S. at Monmouth July 23 to take the GIII Sorority S. over that rival Aug. 12, run over a sloppy Monmouth strip. The morning-line favorite is the maiden **Seeking It All** (A.P. Indy), who had a tough trip when beaten a neck by Gold Mover in the GII Schuylerville S. at the Spa July 26. "I was very happy with that race," said trainer Mike Hushion. "She had a less than perfect trip and almost won. We've been pointing to the Spinaway since the Schuylerville was official. Everything has gone according to plan this summer." The royally bred **Weekend Gold** (Seeking the Gold) rallied from just off the pace to break her maiden going 6 1/2 panels over this track Aug. 7 and should appreciate the extra distance here. She is out of a full sister to A.P. Indy. The most experienced youngster in the field is **Two Item Limit** (Twining), winner of two of her four Florida starts before shipping to Saratoga for her latest, the GII Adirondack S. Aug. 14. The bay filly was second behind runaway winner Raging Fever that day over a very sloppy track.

DERBY WINNER BACK ON TRACK

Kentucky Derby winner **Fusaichi Pegasus** (Mr. Prospector) had his second three-furlong drill in a week Wednesday at Hollywood Park. The colt, working in company with stablemate Bodyguard (GB) covered the distance in :38 2/5 over a fast track. His work last Thursday was completed in :39 1/5. Fusaichi Pegasus is expected to ship to Belmont on Sunday in anticipation of a limited fall campaign likely to culminate with the Breeders' Cup Classic. The Neil Drysdale trainee has not started since finishing second to Red Bullet in the Preakness S. in May.

KAYF TARA TO STAND AT OVERBURY Millionaire **Kayf Tara** (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}--Colorspin {Fr}, by High Top {Ire}), a winner of four Group 1 races, is to stand at Overbury Stud in Gloucestershire in 2001, under the management of Darley. A 210,000gns TAHOU yearling and highweight older horse in England and Ireland at 14+ furlongs, the Godolphin colorbearer won both the G1 Ascot Gold Cup and G1 Irish St. Leger twice. "We are thrilled to be standing Kayf Tara," said Simon Sweeting, a former assistant trainer to Henry Cecil and co-leaser of Overbury Stud, with his father, Christopher. "He was an exceptional racehorse, one of the best of the last 10 years over any trip. He's got both the looks and the pedigree to be a great success at stud." No fee has been announced.

Germany's premier juvenile event has attracted a competitive field of 12. The highly regarded **Abidjar** was third on his debut at this track June 4 and then secured two valuable restricted conditions prizes, at Hamburg June 30 and Cologne Aug. 19, and is the most likely favourite in an open race. He will be seriously tested, not least by the stoutly bred **Vicchio**, who was an impressive winner when breaking his maiden on his racecourse debut at Frankfurt July 16. **Denice**, who cost DM500,000 as a yearling, is in good form having broken her maiden at Hoppegarten July 22, and followed up with second place in a DM200,000 restricted conditions race over course and distance Aug. 25. The British-trained **Prince Of Blues** will travel with some ambition although still a maiden after five starts. His last three efforts were in stakes company, lately when a competent eighth in the G1 Independent Heinz 57 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 13. **Tagshira**, **Tricky Dick** and **Del La Rosa** can stake legitimate place claims.

VICAR RETIRED Multiple Grade I winner Vicar (Wild Again--Escrow Agent {El Gran Senor}) has been retired to Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. Purchased as a yearling for \$260,000 at Keeneland July, he will stand the 2001 breeding season for a fee of \$10,000 live foal. A winner of two of his three starts as a two-year-old, Vicar blossomed early in his three-year-old season, capturing the Fountain of Youth and Florida Derby, both Grade I events at Gulfstream Park. Unplaced in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, the dark colt was beaten a head in the Gil Jerome H. and a neck in the Phoenix Breeders' Cup H. at Keeneland against older horses. Third to Successful Appeal in his first start this season, he closed out his career with a fifth in the GIII Salvatore Mile July 22 at Monmouth. He earned \$835,142. Vicar was syndicated under a "breeders only" arrangement that will establish a base of 40 selected mares in each of his first three years at stud. A limited number of nominations will be available for purchase through the farm. "Vicar is most exciting because he represents quality at great value," said John W. Phillips, managing partner of Darby Dan. "To have a multiple Grade I winner with his pedigree and conformation, standing for only \$10,000, makes my life easier...especially because of the pre-booking arrangement with the syndicate members."

GREENWOOD LAKE TO STONERIGGS Grade I winner Greenwood Lake (Meadowlake--Au Printemps {Dancing Champ}), retired in May after suffering a condylar fracture in March, will stand the 2001 breeding season at Stoneriggs Farm in Ocala, Florida for a fee of \$6,000 live foal. The bay colt, a half brother to Canadian champion Charlie Barley and Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Success Express, was one of 1999's top juveniles, winning the GI Champagne S. at Belmont and the Gil Remsen S. at Aqueduct. Fourth in the GI Fountain of Youth in February, he was injured in a workout just before the GI Florida Derby. A \$195,000 Fasig-Tipton July yearling and a \$205,000 Fasig-Tipton Calder two-year-old, Greenwood Lake retires with \$430,620 in career earnings.

Gratiaen, unbeaten since adding blinkers, bravely earned his first stakes success. Unplaced in his first two starts, the bay colt was blinkered for the first time July 2 and stormed home by 10 lengths, then followed that up with a six-length allowance score going seven furlongs Aug. 13. Breaking alertly, he shadowed Turnofthecentury through solid early fractions, put a head in front at the three-eighths pole and was all out down the stretch to prevail over the late-charging Storm the Gate. "I was a thrilled with the way he fought back because I was a little worried [about] being down inside," said winning trainer Richard Schosberg. Added jockey Edgar Prado, "I'm very glad the wire came when it did." Image Maker (Distinctive Pro), in line for a \$250,000 bonus after winning the first two legs of the New York Triple, flattened out in the stretch to finish fourth.

SALE BOASTS IMPROVED RESULTS

The first domestic sales auction of the year, organized by Razza Pian Del Lago, began in Siena on Wednesday evening. For the first time Henry and Harry Beeby, of Doncaster Bloodstock Sales, were in attendance to assist Stefano Luciani at the auction. Of the 99 lots catalogued, 91 were offered for sale. An aggregate of L1.88 billion was secured for the 68 lots sold at an average of L27,647,059. The average was up 13 percent over 1999 when 36 of 46 lots offered sold for a total of L880 million, an average of L24,444,444. Top trainer Bruno Grizzetti purchased the two highest priced lots, with Lot 2, a Bluebird (USA) colt out of the Woodman (USA) mare Wooderine (USA), from the family of Italian 1000 Guineas winner Ancestral Dancer (GB) (Siberian Express {USA}), being knocked down for the sale high of L140 million. Grizzetti was also on hand to pay L105 million for Lot 86, a filly by Kris (GB) out of the Classic winning Danzica (Ire) (Rusticaro {Fr}). Both of Grizzetti's purchases were bred by one of Italy's leading operators, S. Uberto Farm. The third highest price was the L98 million paid by Allevamento Nuova Sbarra for Lot 74, a Spectrum (Ire) filly out of Run For Me (USA), who is a Danehill (USA) half-sister to Britain's Champion juvenile filly of 1989, Negligent (Ire) (Ahoonora {GB}). She will go into training at the Rome base of Lorenzo Brogi. The next sale will be the traditional ANAC Sale at Settimo Milanese, near Milan, Friday Sept. 15.
