PICK OF THE LITTER

Raymond Dweck's **Stormy Pick** (Storm Creek) ventured outside of Monmouth Park for the first time and came away with a front-running victory in the GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga yesterday. Sent off as the second choice in a field of nine juvenile fillies, the bay miss broke sharply from post three as favored **Seeking It All** (A.P. Indy) came out slowly just to her inside. Taking command through a quarter :22, Stormy Pick was shadowed by **Look of the Lynx** (Forest Wildcat) to the stretch after a half in :45 1/5, but as she put away that rival, **Nasty Storm** (Gulch) came through along the rail with her bid. Shrugging off that challenge, she drew clear in deep stretch to secure her first Grade I score. **Seeking It All**, still a maiden, rallied well for the show spot. "We expected some early pressure," commented winning trainer Ben Perkins, Jr. "She was the most experienced and tested horse in the field, and we just said we would take it to them." After winning her first two starts by a total of 15 lengths, Stormy Pick finished second in the Colleen S. before taking the Gill Sorority over a sloppy track Aug. 12, where she had the promising **With Ability** back in third. She will likely head next to Belmont. "We'll probably try her back in the Frizette (GI, Oct. 14, Belmont)," said Perkins.

FIFTEEN SET FOR HAYDOCK SPRINT

Untangling today's G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup at Haydock is an unenviable task, so close are the main protagonists on form lines. Part of the problem rests in the absence of Agnes World, who took the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 13, and Nuclear Debate, winner of the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 24, leaving the horses who have filled the places behind them to fight this out. The one exception lies in **Bold Edge (GB)** (Beveled), the only horse in the field to have collected a Group 1 race this year. He did so in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 6, where **Lend A Hand (GB)** (Great Commotion) failed to get past him, having sat in his slipstream all the way up the straight. Richard Hannon's charge is used to being in front, having made the running in all of his best successes, such as the G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot and G2 Diadem S. at the same course last year. If Godolphin's colt is to turn the tables, he must have improved since Deauville, but on the form he showed when storming away with the G3 Duke Of York S. at York May 18, he is entitled to be treated with the utmost respect here. He raced successfully over a mile at two and three, but since he was dropped to seven furlongs and then six by Godolphin, he has thrived. Registering a Group 1 success at six furlongs as a five-year-old, after winning over a mile at two (in the G1 Cran Criterium at Milan), would be a remarkable achievement by his connections. At York in May he had Tim Easterby's game filly **Pipalong (Ire)** (Pip's Pride {GB}) a length-and-a-half behind in second, when Bold Edge was third, and she has since gone on to run third to Agnes World and **Lincoln Dancer (Ire)** (Turtle Island {Ire}) in the July Cup, and to fill the same position in the Nunthorpe S. behind Nuclear Debate and Bertolini. She will appreciate any cut in the ground, and is bound to produce her usual genuine performance. Lincoln Dancer was jumping straight into Group 1 company at Newmarket, having previously been highly impressive when winning the Listed Sandy Lane S. at Haydock May 27, but he acquitted himself well with a second to Agnes World. Looking a natural already in this company, he is sure to figure in the finish. Friday's racing was cancelled following the third race due to unfit ground after heavy rain fell. Haydock officials were hopeful that the ground would sufficiently improve to allow for the running of this rich sprint. *Field, more previews, p2*

TAGSHIRA BREEZES TO VICTORY Proving to be the perfect advertisement for Tattersalls' Breeze-Up Sale, of which he is a graduate, Tagshira (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) produced a fine burst of closing speed to record his first stakes success in Germany's premier juvenile event. Knocked down for 40,000 guineas at Newmarket last April, which looks something of a bargain now as he provided his freshman sire with his best result to date. Stepping up on a debut second in Milan, Tagshira got off the mark on his only other start when successful in an EBF race at Cologne July 19. Reserved in the rear early as favourite Vicchio (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and Tricky Dick (GB) (Presidium {GB}) set a fast pace. At halfway Del La Rosa (GB) (Sabrehill) and Abidjar (Ger) (Big Shuffle) joined the leaders as the front rank raced in a line of five abreast. As the strong pace began to tell on Vicchio (GB) and Tricky Dick (GB), Sign Of Nike (GB) (Mistertopogigo {Ire}) emerged from the pack to make his bid, followed by Vaillance (Ger) (Dashing Blade {GB}). As the new leaders made the run to the final furlong, Tagshira was produced on the outside with an ominous looking challenge. His momentum carried him into the lead inside the final furlong and he finished strongly in the closing stages to land the spoils in comfortable style. Vaillance got the better of Sign Of Nike in the tussle for second.

City Zip will seek to become only the fourth horse to sweep all three of the Spa's major juvenile events, the GII Sanford, GII Saratoga Special and the Hopeful. Should he add the Hopeful to his resume, the colt will join Regret (1914), Campfire (1916) and Dehere (1993). **City Zip** hasn't lost since finishing third behind **Yonaguska** in the June 9 Flash S. He turned the tables on the highly regarded D. Wayne Lukas trainee with a 2 3/4-length Sanford victory July 27 and solidified his position as a leading two-year-old with a 2 1/4-length victory in the Aug. 16 Special. **Yonaguska** suffered his first defeat in three starts in the Sanford and has not raced since. After winning his debut at Belmont in May, **Scorpion** ran third behind **City Zip** in the July 3 GIII Tremont and chased the colt home again in third and second-place finishes in the Sanford and Special.

SILIC INJURED Silic (Fr) (Sillery), winner of the 1999 GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Gulfstream Park, will not defend his title after bruising his left front foot, it was reported yesterday. Trained by Julio Canani, the five-year-old bay had made one start this season, winning the GI Shoemaker H. at Hollywood Park June 18. "He's out of the Breeders' Cup," Canani told the *Daily Racing Form*. "It's the same thing he did at Hollywood Park before the Shoemaker. He's got bad feet." Precautionary X-rays revealed a bone chip as well, but Canani said it was an old chip. A decision regarding Silic's racing career will be made in the next few weeks.

ALMUTAWAKEL RETURNS Almutawakel (GB) (Machiavellian), winner of the 1999 G1 Dubai World Cup, will return in today's eighth race at Saratoga, a nine-furlong money allowance over the Mellon turf course. The five-year-old bay has not raced on the grass since finishing sixth in the G1 Juddmonte International at York in August 1999. Second in the G1 Oaklawn H. in April, he was given a bit of a break following a sixth behind Lemon Drop Kid in the GII Suburban H. at Belmont July 4. The Shadwell colorbearer will race without blinkers for the first time since the Oaklawn H. and will have Jerry Bailey aboard.

NYRA, TVG INTERESTED IN NYCOTB The New York Racing Association and the Television Games Network will jointly pursue the acquisition of New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation, it was announced yesterday. NYRA and TVG submitted an "Expression of Interest" to the New York City Economic Development Corporation, acting on behalf of the City of New York. Under the terms of a preliminary proposal, NYRA would assume the operation and management of NYCOTB's physical wagering outlets while TVG would assume the management and operation of its existing telephone account wagering assets. "The opportunity to acquire NYCOTB, the largest source of wagering on New York racing, is very important to NYRA from a strategic standpoint," said Terry Meyocks, NYRA's president and chief operating officer. "We believe that the joint bid in concert with TVG represents the most comprehensive and realistic proposal for the privatization and successful operation of NYCOTB at the present time." Ten bidders have submitted offers to the EDC, including Churchill Downs, Magna Entertainment Corp., Penn National and Greenwood Racing. While the EDC would not disclose the amount of the bids, they were described as "very significant."

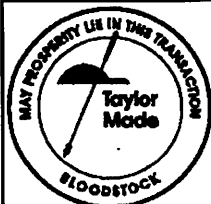
