EVEN DOZEN CHASE RICH GERMAN PRIZE

Baden-Baden will offer Germany's highest-ever purse for today's G1 Grosser Preis Von Baden and has been rewarded with a high quality 12-horse field for the meeting's highlight, traditionally the most important allaged domestic Group 1 event. Local hopes rest with the hitherto unbeaten G1 BMW Deutsches Derby hero Samum (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), who is reported to have worked in spectacular fashion last week. His trainer, Bruno Schutz, claims the colt has improved by at least five kilos since his impressive five-length win in the German Derby at Hamburg July 2. He will bid to enhance his international reputation at the expense of some top-class opponents. The foreign challenge comprises four high-class raiders from England, headed by Daliapour (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Last year's runner-up in the G1 Epsom and G1 Irish Derbies, he was third to Montjeu (Ire) on his latest start, the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 29. On his only other starts this term he recorded success in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 9 and the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 11, and he will test Germany's top three-year-old to the limit. Mutafaweq (Silver Hawk) is another with strong claims. Last season's G1 St Leger winner has already tasted success in Germany when securing the G1 WGZ Bank-Deutschland Preis at Dusseldorf July 23. Holding Court (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) is a Classic winner making the trip from Newmarket and he will seek consolation for a disappointing sixth in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh July 2. He is a bold frontrunner who will go very close if reproducing the form of his six-length demolition of a quality field in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 4. The going will be a key factor as he needs cut to show his best. The British quartet is completed by Fruits Of Love (Hansel), who has made only one start this year. It was a winning one, however, which saw him take the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 23 for the second year in succession. Of the remainder, Catella (Ger) (Generous {Ire}) and Caitano (GB) (Niniski) make most appeal for an eachway place. (Grosser Preis Von Baden field, p3)

TURNING ON THE HEAT IN THE HOPEFUL

It looked like he would run out of ground, but City Zip (Carson City) closed the gap with every stride to catch Yonaguska (Cherokee Run) as they hit the wire and create the first dead heat in the history of the GI Hopeful at Saratoga Race Course yesterday afternoon. City Zip, the 7-5 favorite, picked up his fourth straight stakes win and became the fourth horse in history to capture all of the major juvenile races at Saratoga after taking the July 27 GII Sanford S. and the Aug. 16 GII Saratoga Special. The others to accomplish the feat were subsequent Kentucky Derby-winning filly Regret (1914), Campfire (1916) and two-year-old champion Dehere (1993). Yonaguska, off at 7-2 after finishing second in the Sanford, gave trainer D. Wayne Lukas his fifth Hopeful trophy, but just barely. Sent to the lead after a half in :46.21, the dark bay had a length and a half on the field as they turned for home and looked to have the race in his pocket as he maintained a clear lead past the eighth pole. City Zip pressed the pace for a quarter, then dropped back after a half and came six wide into the lane, but ground it out in the final furlong to get even at the finish. "He overcame a lot to win this," jockey Jose Santos said. "We started making our run around the turn and there was no room on the inside. But he came with a huge run [down the stretch] and I'm so happy we could get there." Jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard Yonaguska, was bothered by an equipment problem which might have cost him a solo trip to the winner's circle. "Down the backstretch, the saddle started to ride up on his neck and I lost a lot of leverage," he said. "My plan was to angle him out once we got to the stretch, but I had to keep him on the rail because I didn't want to move with him. I don't think he was on the best part of the track and he still ran a huge race. He'll only get better." Also making an impressive late run was 9-1 Macho Uno (Holy Bull), who, coming off a debut win at Saratoga July 26, closed with City Zip and missed all the money by only a neck. "In the gate, he reared his head up and hit me in the nose," jockey Edgar Prado said. "He gave me a bloody nose, but I was fine." As for his colt's finish, Prado said, "At the top of the stretch, he started ducking in and was goofing around, but he started picking it up again when City Zip came on the outside. He ran a huge race." (Hopeful chart, p2)

So often the bridesmaid, Pipalong (Ire) at last gained her first Group 1 success with a determined drive on rainsoaked Haydock turf, compensating for her 11thplace finish in this race last year. A winner of the Listed Cecil Frail S. over this course and distance June 10, she is, according to trainer Tim Easterby, a much better filly with easy conditions underfoot. Her two previous best efforts actually had been in defeat, when she was third in both the G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket July 13 and the G1 Victor Chandler Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 24, but the manner of this victory suggests a trip to France for G1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp Oct. 1 is a distinct possibility. Jockey Kevin Darley always had Pipalong in a handy position tracking the leaders Bold Edge (GB) (Beveled) and Eastern Purple (Ire) (Petorius {Ire}). She challenged for the lead while going well in the straight and hit the front approaching the final furlong. At that point Sampower Star (GB) loomed large with a dangerous looking bid, but the testing conditions took their toll in the closing stages as Pipalong pulled out all the stops to keep that rival at bay. "She thoroughly deserved that," said a delighted Darley. "She has been placed twice in Group 1s, and for a filly it means a lot to go and win one. She did everything right today and, if anything, I got there a little bit sooner than I would have liked. She pricked her ears and had a bit of a look, but she did enough to win. That's my first Group 1 of the year and it's a great feeling. It is nice to do it on a filly that I've been associated with all year." In a welcome return to form, Tomba (GB) ran a fine race to finish a close third, well clear of the remainder.

One of the biggest surprises of the season came at Deauville Aug. 13, when Sendawar failed to match the impressive acceleration shown by Godolphin's Muhtathir (GB) at the end of the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois. Godolphin may be able to spring something on the home team once again with the five-year-old Diktat. Winner of the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville and of the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup last year, he suffered his only defeat of the season when off the board in the G1 Prix de la Foret here in October. He started 2000 with a disappointing sixth-place effort in the G2 Keio Hai Spring Cup at Fuchu May 14, then finished a neck second to Hong Kong's Horse Of The Year Fairy King Prawn (Aus) in the G1 Yasuda Kinen June 4 in his latest appearance. Sendawar was once the sort of animal who needed no excuse, rampaging his way through the championship mile races last year, including this event. However, signs that the four-time Group 1 winner was not untouchable were seen in his disappointing fourth behind Dubai Millennium (GB) in the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot June 21 before being comprehensively beaten last time at Deauville. That said, if he is back to the form of not too long ago, where his devastating turn-of-foot destroyed proven top-level performers, he will be hard to stop. One thing that could stop him, however, is the weather--connections have said if there is more rain, he could scratch. Andre Fabre has taken three renewals of this race, and his admirably consistent Dansili could garner him another. Last time he was beaten three-quarters of a length by no less a horse than Giant's Causeway in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2. He was third in this event last year, beaten by Sendawar by just over a length and a half, and he could easily make the frame again.

Cliquot looks to break a three-race runner-up streak and to pick up his first win of the season. Four-for-six as a three-vear-old last year, the dark bay ended the campaign with a win in the restricted On Trust H. at Hollywood Park, but finished off the board in his first three starts of 2000. Off from March until June, he returned to finish second behind National Saint in a Hollywood allowance test, then filled that place in the July 9 GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood and the Aug. 20 GII Pat O'Brien H. over this track last time out. National Saint was making his first start in more than seven months in that Hollywood allowance, then flattened out to be be eighth in the Triple Bend. In his most recent try, he was a well-beaten third behind Skimming in the Aug. 6 GIII San Diego H., but he won his two previous starts over this track and is two-forthree at a mile. El Corredor makes his stakes debut in his first try beyond 6 1/2 furlongs. Fourth in his career opener last September, he broke his maiden in October, returned to win a Santa Anita allowance in January and then, after another extended vacation, added a score in an optional claimer over this track Aug. 7.

On the Comeback Trail:

Surfside (Seattle Slew), a four-time Grade I winner who has been sidelined since finishing fifth in the Apr. 8 GI Santa Anita Derby, worked five furlongs in 1:01 over Saratoga's Oklahoma training track yesterday morning. The three-year-old filly underwent surgery to remove chips from both front ankles in the spring. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas is hoping to have her back at the races at the beginning of October. "We're still debating about where we should send her after Saratoga," Lukas said. "She trains well at Churchill Downs, but she'd run wherever a race would be most advantageous for her. I'd like to get her one start before the Breeders' Cup."

Also on his way to a comeback, GII Louisiana Derby winner Mighty (Lord at War {Arg}) went a half mile in :49 1/5 at Oklahoma. The Frank Brothers trainee has not been out since running seventh in the Apr. 15 GI Blue Grass S. He injured the carpal tunnel behind his right knee in the race. "He's really coming back to himself, he's getting fitter and stronger," James Jones, Brothers' assistant, said. The colt could return in the Sept. 23 GII Jerome H. at Belmont Park.

Golden Missile Breezes:

Out for just an open gallop over the Saratoga main track yesterday morning, Golden Missile (A.P. Indy) went a half mile in :51 3/5, a little faster than trainer Joe Orseno had anticipated. "It was a controlled open gallop," Orseno said. "I wanted him to go in :55, but since he has been training so well since the Whitney, he went a little faster then we expected him to." Golden Missile bruised his foot during a fifth-place finish in the Whitney and missed a scheduled start in the Aug. 27 GII Iselin H. at Monmouth, but will head to Turfway Park Tuesday for the Sept. 16 GII Kentucky Cup Classic.

A colt by leading sire Zafonic (USA) brought a record DM700,000 top the Baden-Badener Auktionsgesellschaft Yearling Sale yesterday. Offered as lot 178, he is a half-brother to Scandinavian champion Kill the Crab (Ire) (Petorius {Ire}) and the Irish G1-placed juvenile Referendum (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}). The secondhighest priced yearling was lot 181, a full sister to German champion two-year-old El Maimoun (GB) (Royal Academy {USA}). A new record aggregate of DM11,955,500, surpassing the previous record by more than 1 million Deutschemarks. "A very good sale, and a strong and healthy middle market as well as a very pleasing international participation," said Axel Donnerstag, BBAG's managing director. The progress of German bloodstock was noted as many foreign purchases were recorded, with yearlings being sold to the United States and Hong Kong as well as nearly all European countries, including England and Ireland.

Most of the Northern Hemisphere's Classics have already been run and many of the other top races are now consigned to the history books. Once again Irishbred horses have stamped their class the world over, winning 18 Group or Grade 1 races (through 31 August) in six different countries on three different continents. This quality and the overall strength in depth of Ireland's Thoroughbreds was well illustrated last year when Irishbreds accounted for 215 European Pattern Race wins, well ahead of the second most successful producer, Great Britain, with 191 wins.

Irish-breds Sinndar, Bachir, Petrushka, Crimplene and Xua have taken eight European Classics between them in 2000, with the highlight being Sinndar's impressive annex of the English and Irish Derbys. The Deputy, now based in the U.S., was another Derby winner, taking the Grade I Santa Anita equivalent. Dual Classic heroine Crimplene chalked up her third consecutive Group 1 win by impressively beating older horses in the Nassau S. at Goodwood and trainer Clive Brittain is now aiming her for the Breeders' Cup.

The older horse division is just as strong, with Group 1 success already achieved this year by a number of Irish-breds including Daliapour, Indian Danehill, Manndar and Sendawar. Meanwhile, All the Way struck a blow for his country when impressively winning the Emirates Singapore Derby.

Unless breeding to race, the place to search for new talent is in the auction ring, and there currently exists a favourable exchange rate for the Irish pound, meaning significant savings when buying bloodstock at public auction in Ireland. And when buyers can pick up international Group performers such as the ultra-tough Yavana's Pace, Super Tassa, Skip and Su Tirolesu for between IR1,150gns and IR7,400gns, a clear message is sent. The Irish auction houses at Goffs and Tattersalls (Ireland) are places where dreams can come true.

The middle range of the market is just as strong. You could have bought dual Classic-winning miler Bachir for just IR50,000gns at the 1998 Goffs Orby Sale, and for just IR21,000gns you could have owned Cape Town, a stakes winner in England and third behind Bachir in the Irish 2000 Guineas in May.

Group 2 winning fillies Miletrian and Lady Upstage cost just IR70,000gns and IR36,000gns, respectively, while multiple Group 2 winning globetrotter Fruits Of Love was another bargain at just IR75,000gns.

In this year's juvenile ranks, G3 Coventry S. hero CD Europe cost just IR£20,000 last year while G3 Molecomb S. heroine Misty Eyed is clearly worth much more now than the IR£3,200 paid for her last autumn.

The first of the upcoming Irish yearling sales will be held at the Tattersalls (Ireland) complex in Fairyhouse, County Meath on 19-20 September. Catalogues are now available at www.tattersalls.ie. More than 530 yearlings representing some of the best stallions in the international market will be on offer.

Next are the two-day Goffs Orby Sale and one-day Goffs Challenge Sale in Kill, County Kildare on 3-5 October. The catalogue is available on-line at www.goffs.ie. It was the Orby Sale which offered Petrushka, Bachir, Oath, Island Sands, Saffron Walden and Hula Angel, all Classic winners in Ireland or Britain in the last two seasons.

The Challenge Sale, on the other hand, is where you could have bought 1999 Italian Classic winner Alabama Jacks for just IR13,000gns.

Anybody making the journey to Ireland for any of the public auctions conducted by either Goffs or Tattersalls (Ireland) can take advantage of the services provided by Irish Thoroughbred Marketing (ITM). Under the Inward Buyer Programme, the overseas buyer just needs to present his or her airline ticket, along with proof of purchase at the sale, to the ITM desk in the foyer of the sales area. ITM will then present the purchaser with a cheque equivalent to the cost of the purchaser's airfare from the country of origin to Ireland, up to a maximum amount, depending on the country of origin.

If you are making the journey in order to purchase horses privately, then ITM can also help. In addition, for first-time visitors, ITM can also provide assistance with booking hotels, arranging transport or organising an interpreter.
