SAMUM SUPREME

Samum (Monsun {Ger}) went joint top of the Emirates World Series leaderboard when maintaining his unbeaten record with a battling display to win Germany's richest ever race, the DM1,700,000 G1 Mercedes Benz Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden Baden yesterday afternoon. Trained by German champion trainer Andreas Schutz, Samum added to his blistering success in the G1 BMW Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 2 in courageous fashion. That race proved an emotional affair as multiple champion trainer and legendary Bruno Schutz, father of Andreas, passed away just before the Classic and he had picked out Samum as a yearling. In a triumph for the locals Samum beat multiple group winner Catella (Generous {Ire}) for a German one-two, with Fruits Of Love (Hansel) faring best of the overseas challengers in third. Jockey Andrasch Starke employed waiting tactics aboard Samum and remained in rear as Holding Court (Hernando {Fr}) took the lead from Speedmaster (Monsun {Ger}) after two furlongs. The pack continued to shuffle until second favorite Daliapour (Sadler's Wells) led on the approach to the straight as Samum and Catella made good headway. Samum switched to the centre of the track as the main body of the field swung wide when straightening up and grabbed the lead at the two-furlong marker. He started to drift to his right as Catella challenged at the distance but was far enough in front to avoid causing any interference. With Starke in the drive position, Samum ran on strongly to score before an appreciative crowd. Catella held on well in the closing stages as Fruits Of Love rallied into third, while Daliapour could do no better than fourth. "He is an exceptional colt--probably the best I have ever had," Schutz told Racing Post. "Already before the (Deutsches) Derby, we thought very highly of him. We then learned that he was special and now everyone else knows it too. The ground was not in our favor today, but he showed us that he is a top performer," the trainer added. The winner and runner-up will now point to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 1. Of the third-place finisher, jockey Michael Roberts said, "My horse prefers good ground and he ran a great race today." (Chart p2)

INDIAN LODGE PROVES TOO GRAND

With Cash Asmussen oozing confidence throughout. Indian Lodge (Grand Lodge) scored a decisive win from Kingsalsa (Kingmambo) and Diktat (Warning {GB}) in yesterday's G1 Emirates Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. The race lost some of its lustre beforehand when Sendawar was withdrawn on account of the softened ground. (See related story p???). The winner of the G3 Earl Of Sefton S. at Newmarket Apr. 19 and the G2 KLM UK Mile at Sandown Apr. 28, Indian Lodge's first attempt at the highest level saw him finish third to Aljabr in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 20, and he followed up with a seventh in the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 20. Asmussen positioned Indian Lodge in second from the outset as Fly To The Stars (Bluebird) set a good pace with a five-length lead. As the latter began to send out the distress flares at the quarter-mile marker, Indian Lodge, beneath a motionless Asmussen, cruised by and the Texan only needed to let out an inch of rein to settle the issue in a matter of strides. Kingsalsa was short of room at the furlong pole, but ran on in good style once clear to secure the runnerup spot late.

Movglare Stud S. cont.

Segouyah pounced wide and late to secure the G1 Movglare Stud S. at The Curragh vesterday and provided both jockey and trainer with their first successes in the race. With regular jockey Michael Kinane absent due to suspension, jockey Jamie Spencer gave a tactically astute ride to enhance his burgeoning reputation. Third to stable companion Honours List (Ire) in the G3 Anheuser Busch Railway S. at The Curragh July 2 in her lifetime bow. Segouvah broke her maiden at Tipperary July 27 before finishing second in the Listed Debutante S. at The Curragh Aug. 20. Jungle Moon (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and La Vida Loca (Ire) (Caerleon) dictated matters in the early stages and Stage Presence (Ire) (Selkirk) made her presence felt as the race began earnest, leading briefly inside the quarter. Mala Mala made her bid approaching the final furlong, but no sooner had she gone to the front when Segouyah appeared on the outside looking more than menacing. With Spencer keeping his mount perfectly balanced, Segouyah snatched the lead at the distance and ran on strongly for an impressive win. Hotelgenie Dot Com was outpaced when the tempo increased, but she finished strongly in the closing stages to grab second from Mala Mala in the dying strides. Of the winner Aidan O'Brien remarked, "She's a grand filly and very special. She might go back to six furlongs for the G1 Cheveley Park S. (at Newmarket Sept. 26). She has loads of speed, I've always thought a lot of her and the 1000 Guineas is an obvious target."

The venerable River Boat registered the biggest stakes upset of the Woodbine meeting, getting his nose down on the line ahead of Craigsteel to score his first gradedstakes victory. The seven-year-old won his final two starts of 1999, including his first overall stakes success in the Bunty Lawless S. last Oct. 23. Kept on the sidelines until May of this season, the bay had been unable to crack the winner's circle until his latest, when he registered a 1 3/4-length victory at 10 grassy furlongs Aug. 13. Contested over a yielding turf course, favored Quiet Resolve set the pace along the rail, tracked by a rank Craigsteel in third and River Boat in fourth. The latter drew even with Quiet Resolve at the head of the stretch and the pair was joined by Craigsteel, but River Boat proved narrowly best under a heavy drive. "He was definitely right today," said winning rider Gary Boulanger. "He showed me an exceptional amount of heart. He gives you his life when you ask him and today it was there."

It was just two years ago that Hal Earnhardt owned part of a three-year-old colt who provided him with Kentucky Derby dreams and those dreams were rewarded with a third-place finish in the 1998 "Run for the Roses." While El Corredor may not be the second coming of Indian Charlie, his performance in his first graded-stakes test is indicative of a very bright future. Fourth in his career debut just two days short of one year ago, the dark bay has been unstoppable since with three consecutive impressive victories. The winner of a Santa Anita maiden last October, El Corredor returned to score a two-length allowance victory Jan. 15, but was sidelined and did not return until tallying a one-length success at Del Mar Aug. 7. Stretching to a two-turn mile for the first time, the Bob Baffert charge was made the slight favorite over former Baffert student Prime Timber (Sultry Song). Settled nicely in fourth as Cliquot led, jockey Victor Espinoza asked his colt to shoot a gap along the rail at the half-mile pole. With that task accomplished, El Corredor and Cliquot raced as a team to the 3/16ths pole, before El Corredor spurted clear and was taken in hand the final 100 yards. "This was a good spot for him," Baffert commented. "Stretching him out was a yest for him today. Now that we know he can get a mile, we can do alot of things with him."

Campaigned exclusively on the infield in his brief career, Rob's Spirit broke his maiden at first asking last October, his only start as a two-year-old. Following a fourth-place effort over the Keeneland lawn in his seasonal bow Apr. 7, he scored a narrow victory in a Belmont allowance May 11 with fresh Lasix added. Trainer Bill Mott decided to add blinkers for his next effort and the bay responded to finish a strong second to Promontory Gold in the GIII Hill Prince at Belmont June 17. Favored at 4-5 in his latest, he made easy work of the GIII Lexington at Belmont, taking that event by 5 1/2 lengths. Beneath Jerry Bailey, Rob's Spirit was rated just off an easy pace, was overtaken briefly in the stretch by Lake Austin (Storm Cat), but dug in when roused by Bailey and was able to hold Whata Brainstorm safe for the victory. "We put the blinkers on him a couple of starts back. He was initially a bit unfocused," explained Mott. "He's been a late developer. We'd like to see if he can compete in the Breeders' Cup, but before that we'll probably need to stretch him out to 12 furlongs." The conditioner singled out the GI Turf Classic at Belmont Oct. 7 as a possible next start.

Unraced as a juvenile, Epitre won at his first attempt at Saint-Cloud Mar. 28. He was thrown in at the deep end when fourth in the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp May 14 on only his third start. He has thrived since being asked to display his ability to stay with second place in the G3 Prix du Lys at Chantilly June 28, and a victory in the Listed Prix de Reux at Deauville Aug. 6. Tackling his longest trip ever, he was ridden with patience until being unleashed inside the final quarter mile for an impressive success. Shuwaib (GB) (Polish Precedent) led for much of the race, but the pace he set stretched the field little. He came under pressure once into the straight where Mister Kick took over. That lead was to prove short lived as Epitre quickened into the lead approaching the final furlong. With jockey Olivier Peslier doing the minimal amount required, Epitre stayed on strongly to draw away from his toiling rivals in the closing stages. Mister Kick kept on well once headed and safely held the Italian raider Sopran Montanelli.

Stakes-placed as a juvenile, Iftiraas emerged this season to win the G3 Dubai Duty Free Fred Darling S. at Newbury in April, beating the subsequent G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas heroine Lahan (GB) and the triple G1 winner Crimplene (Ire). She was then only fifth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp in May, sixth in the G1 Coronation S. at Ascot in June and ninth in the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket in July. She showed a return to form by finishing third in the G2 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville July 30 on her most recent start. Racing in fifth early on as fellow British challenger Out Of Reach set the pace, she moved into third early in the straight and gradually closed on Out Of Reach as the field entered the final furlong. With Out Of Reach running on well along the rail and Danceabout making a strong move on the outside, Iftiraas ran on gamely under strong pressure from her rider to grab the victory close home.

Perfect Sting looks to further solidify her standing as the top distaff turfer on the East Coast and will attempt to maintain her perfect record this season. The fouryear-old has made only three starts this year, with victories in the GIII Beaugay H., the GII Just A Game Breeders' Cup and the GII New York H. in her most recent trip to the post July 15. In that race, she bested Snow Polina, who returned to land the GI Beverly D. at Arlington. License Fee, purchased for \$375,000 at the Roberts' dispersal last November, was second by 1/2 length to the top choice in the Beaugay and was the wire-to-wire winner of the GII Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 13, her first graded-stakes victory. A Listed stakes winner in her native England, Fictitious sports a three-for-four record in the U.S., including a 1 3/4-length success in Gulfstream Park's GIII De La Rose H. Mar. 12. Third in the Explosive Bid H. on the turf in New Orleans, Chester House returned to the main track for his next three starts, but hinted at a return to form when a solid second in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar in his second last start. His victory in the Million stamped him a chief contender for the Breeders' Cup Turf, it was announced Aug. 24 that he would be retired to Juddmonte Farms at the end of this year. Dr. John Chandler, who manages Juddmonte Farms for Prince Khalid Abdullah, told Daily Racing Form that a statement would be made Tuesday regarding future plans for Chester House.

MONMOUTH WEATHERS STORM IN 2000

Monmouth Park concluded its 72-day summer meeting yesterday with slight decreases in attendance and on-track handle. A total of 703,690 patrons passed through the turnstiles at the Jersey Shore, a 1.2-percent decline against the corresponding figure from 1999, despite record-setting attendance for opening day (over 50,000) and Haskell Day (41,630). Ontrack handle of \$64,459,934 represented a 6.3-percent decrease from 1999, while betting on Monmouth races from outside sources decreased by 26.3 percent, due to the fact that Monmouth was dropped from the Del Mar and NYCOTB wagering menus. Track officials were nonetheless upbeat. "Our weekends and big days were terrific," said Bob Kulina, vice president of Monmouth Park, "but when you play outdoors you have to deal with the weather you get." A total of 50 turf races were washed off the grass due to weather. Racing on the Jersey circuit shifts this afternoon to The Meadowlands.

SUNLINE GETS EVEN AT CAULFIELD

Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) won yesterday's G2 \$200,000 Memsie S. at Caulfield by 1 1/4 lengths despite being clearly uncomfortable on a track rated slow. Umrun (Aus) (Umatilla {NZ}), sent out the 2-7 favorite, crept doggedly closer to Sunline along the rails to finish second. Jockey Greg Childs, who rode hands and heels, said Sunline was far from content on the track. "She never handled it; she couldn't shake Umrum off. We were probably lucky that there wasn't real topline weight for age horses here or else we might have been vulnerable," he said. "She got away with the race, but only because she is all class." The five-year-old mare, recently crowned Australian Horse of the Year, took her record to 19 wins from 26 starts and earnings to A\$4,964,166. Trainer and part-owner, Trevor McKee said Sunline's next start would be in either the G2 John F Feehan S. at Moonee Valley on Sept. 16 or in the Underwood S. at Caulfield on Sept. 23.

JOCKEY MICHAEL CAHILL HURT

Popular Queensland rider Michael Cahill is in serious condition in Royal Brisbane Hospital after suffering head and chest injuries in a fall at the Sunshine Coast Sunday. A hospital spokeswoman said Cahill was in a "dangerously ill, but stable condition." Cahill fell heavily when his mount, 2-1 favourite Jestica (Aus) (Telesto {Aus}), seemed to stumble about 250 yards from the post. While Cahill first appeared to avoid serious injury. he was struck heavily by a trailing horse. Immediately taken by ambulance to nearby Nambour Hospital, Cahill was later transferred to Royal Brisbane. Sunshine Coast Turf Club general manager Mick Sullivan said: "He had a scan which showed bruising to the brain, but no bleeding and no fractures to his skull which is positive. He's got some bleeding in one lung, but he's very fit and the doctor said that shouldn't present too much of a problem. He was conscious at the track before they loaded him into the ambulance - although he couldn't talk and wasn't really aware who was around him." An inquiry into the incident has been adjourned until Cahill is able to attend. Cahill won the Sunshine Coast jockey's premiership in the 1998-99 season.
