MONTJEU TO MISS CHAMPION STAKES?

Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), already a three-time Group 1 winner this season, may miss a scheduled start in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown, it has been reported. The four-year-old, winner of the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., is tied for the lead in the Emirates World Racing Series Championship, and the Champion is the next leg of the series, but trainer John Hammond told the *Press Association*, "He had a slight training setback and is now only a possible runner. We will review the situation in the middle of the week." Montjeu has won 10 of his 12 career starts and more than \$3 million.

IT'S OFFICIAL: SENDAWAR HEADED TO STUD

According to a report on *Sporting Life* on-line, **Sendawar (Ire)** (Priolo--Sendana {Fr}, by Darshaan {GB}) has been retired. Stud plans have not been announced. The four-year-old was first or second in nine of his 10 starts, winning the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas), G1 St. James Palace S. and G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp at three and adding a victory in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan this season. He made his final appearance in the Aug. 13 G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois, finishing second. He earned \$755,475.

LUJAIN RETIRED

Lujain (Seeking the Gold--Satin Flower, by Shadeed), the second highest-rated juvenile in Europe in 1998, has been retired to Darley's Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England, and will stand for a fee of £5,000, special live foal. Trained by David Loder for Sheikh Mohammed, the colt was the winner of his first three starts at two, including the G1 Middle Park S. He was unplaced in three starts at three and unraced at four. "We're delighted to be standing him," said Liam O'Rourke, Dalham Hall's stud director. "He showed incredible speed, and has a world-class pedigree."

A PERFECT SEASON

Perfect Sting (Red Ransom) came into the GII Diana H. with a 2000 record unblemished by defeat and she kept that perfect scorecard intact with a rallying threequarter length score over License Fee (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) at Saratoga yesterday afternoon. Now 10 for 12 on the grass, the four-year-old put in a rare out-of-themoney performance in her 1999 finale, finishing sixth in the inaugural GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, but came back this year to take the May 7 GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct, June 10 GIII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park and, most recently, posted a head victory in the GII New York H. at Belmont July 15. The 3-5 favorite to make it four-for-four, the bay bided her time in sixth while sitting to the outside, made a quick move between horses on the turn to reach contention and battled past pacesetter License Fee in the final sixteenth. "She got boxed in pretty good and [jockey Jerry Bailey] had to force his way through with her," winning trainer Joe Orseno said. "But it all worked out in our favor." Added Bailey, "I had to get into her a bit in the stretch, but I think she likes cutting it close. This is actually a big win margin for her." As for what's next on the agenda, Orseno said, "She's sound, healthy and moving forward after every race. We'll probably go in the [GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Oct. 7]. It gives her four weeks before the Breeders' Cup."

Never quite able to achieve top-level success in his native France for trainer Andre Fabre, Northern Quest managed a maiden win and three conditions victories before closing out the European portion of his career with a fifth-place finish in Listed company at Nantes, France, last Nov. 4. Shipped to the U.S., the five-yearold was a rallying third in the Dallas Turf Cup at Lone Star Park in his stateside bow and registered his first graded-stakes success when taking the GIII Arlington H. in his last trip postward July 29. Reserved in last position for the opening six furlongs, the second choice tugged his way up into contention between horses, circled three wide into the stretch and overtook longtime leader Alvo Certo in the final furlong before pulling clear. The latter was disqualified and placed third for interfering with Perssonet at the eighth pole. "He didn't break sharp, but the fractions seemed legitimate and I felt OK," winning trainer Bobby Frankel said. "He's a real nice horse. He had some problems, so we gave him some time. He's worth giving the time and he really came around." Favored Blueprint (Bluebird) was well placed throughout, but could do no better than fifth.

After watching him go winless in his first three career starts, trainer Dermot Weld added blinkers to Pine Dance and the colt responded to score his maiden victory at Gowran Park in Ireland May 17. A 3 1/2-length winner in a handicap at The Curragh just 11 days later, the bay finished seventh in his final European start to date. Shipped to the U.S., he was lightly regarded for the GII American Derby over the Arlington turf, but rallied through the stretch to score a 7-1 surprise. An overmatched eighth in the GI Secretariat S. in his most recent start, he was a longshot in his main track debut here as well. Reserved towards the back of the pack while well off the rail, the winner began a four-wide advance on the turn, took over in upper stretch and drew clear. The 2-1 favorite Include (Broad Brush), who had won four in a row by a combined 30 lengths, sat just off the early fractions and came wide into the stretch before weakening to be sixth.

Storm Dream was unable to break her maiden while racing in her native country, but ended that four-race campaign with a third-place finish in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 28. The bay shipped across the Atlantic and trounced a field of maidens in her U.S. bow, winning by 14 1/4 lengths at Belmont July 13. She stretched out to nine furlongs for the first time in her latest, the Aug. 21 GII Lake Placid S. at Saratoga, and faded to fourth. The second choice here, the Irish lass sat off the flank of Cedar Knolls (Broad Brush) for a half, sprinted past to take a daylight lead after six furlongs and kept on going to win handily.

One of the breeding world's regrettable truths is that outstanding sires do not always develop into outstanding sires of sires. For every Nasrullah, Bold Ruler, Northern Dancer or Mr. Prospector, there is a Vaguely Noble, a Riverman, a Mill Reef or a Habitat--stallions who faced a struggle to extend their male line, despite having plenty of sons at stud.

Of course, every breeder would like to know which of today's most fashionable stallions will make the grade as sires of sires, and much of their attention is currently focused on the sons of Storm Cat. The pressure on Storm Cat to make an immediate impact in this role has been intensified by the demand for his sons' progeny at the yearling sales. Tabasco Cat led the American-based freshman sires at the 1998 sales with an average of over \$200,000, and the impetus was maintained last year when Hennessy's average fell just short of \$250,000, Tabasco Cat's stood at \$153,800 and Forest Wildcat's at \$115,137 (from an initial stud fee of \$10,000).

At this point it is as well to point out that not even Northern Dancer's Group-winning sons were guaranteed to make the grade (just think of such as Secreto, Ajdal, Salmon Leap, Glow, Glenstal and Tate Gallery), so Storm Cat cannot be expected to hit the target with every single son.

So how are they faring? Of the older sons, Mountain Cat has been sold to Turkey and Tabasco Cat is still waiting for his first graded-stakes winner.

Future Storm, however, was recently represented by Grade II winner Shadow Caster and Catrail has made partial amends for a disappointing first crop through his smart second-crop fillies Zarkiya and Storm Dream.

Probably the one to watch is the very well-connected Storm Boot, whose potential continues to be highlighted by those fast mares Hurricane Bertie and Bourbon Belle.

Hennessy, at this early stage of his career, is still awaiting his first stakes win, but some of Storm Cat's other freshman sons have been quicker off the mark. Forest Wildcat notched up his first stakes success when Spectacular Cat made it three wins from his last three tries in the Spectacular Bid S., and Storm Creek has made such an eye-catching start that he has been has been bought to stand alongside Storm Cat's high-profile sons Exploit and Forestry at Taylor Made. The Taylor Made team must be delighted that they made their move when they did because Storm Creek's daughter Stormy Pick has followed up her success in the GIII Sorority S. with a Grade I victory in the Spinaway S.

Storm Creek, like Storm Boot, appears to have every chance of developing into a better stallion than could reasonably have been predicted from his racing record. Only one of his four wins from 14 starts came in a stakes race, the GIII Sheridan S. over a mile, and that win came shortly after his owner had withdrawn him from a horses-of-racing-age sale.

Is it just coincidence that both Storm Creek and Storm Boot, are out of mares by Mr. Prospector? Remember that Storm Cat's other matings with mares by Mr. Prospector produced Storm Creek's fellow graded-stakes winners Finder's Fee (GI), Sea of Secrets (GII) and Tale of the Cat (GII), plus the graded-placed stakes winners Catienus, Apollo Cat and Katz Me If You Can.

One interesting aspect of Stormy Pick's pedigree is that she is inbred 4x4 to Northern Dancer, through Storm Bird and the similarly bred The Minstrel. The filly is certainly bred for juvenile ability as her dam, Program Pick, won two sprint stakes as a two-year-old and her broodmare sire, the pony-sized Peterhof, won prestigious five-furlong events in Ireland and England at two. Our Michael, the sire of Stormy Pick's second dam Lite A Star, was also at his most successful at two, when he gained five of his eight stakes successes.

RECORDS FALL AT SARATOGA Despite the rains which plagued the first half of the Saratoga race meeting, 10 handle and attendance records were broken at the upstate New York stand which concluded yesterday. Records included: season on-track attendance (978.231), an increase of 6.3% over last year; season on-track handle (\$116,356,627), up 3.9 percent from '99; one-day on-track handle (\$7,371,991, set Travers Day); one-day total commingled handle (\$28,281,323, Travers Day), and on-track Travers Day attendance (54,116). "We're pleased and thankful for the success of this year's meet," said NYRA President and COO Terry Meyocks. "We're gratified with what was accomplished here, both from a business and racing perspective, especially considering the poor weather during the first half of the meet. It's surprising to me that we have had the success in on-track business, considering we lost so many turf races during the first three-and-a-half weeks of the meet. Without question it impacted the handle, both on-track and national negatively. Still, we experienced gains on track and are virtually even in total handle."

CHIEF SEATTLE TO DIXIANA Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew--Skatingonthinice, by Icecapade), second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile last year, has been retired and will stand at Dixiana Farm near Lexington next season, according to *The Blood-Horse* on-line. The three-year-old was purchased privately by Godolphin after his Breeders' Cup performance and, after wintering in Dubai, returned to the U.S. as an intended runner in the Kentucky Derby, but came down with a fever after the trip. He did not make it to the races at all this year and retires with a record of one win, two seconds and a third from four starts and earnings of \$327,000.

"We were surprised by the overwhelming number of quality yearlings that were presented to us during our inspections, and we looked at 1,300 youngsters this spring. The end product is a catalogue full of stronger pedigrees and even better individuals than ever before." A total of 480 lots made the grade, 10 more than in 1999, with buyers once again having the incentive that their purchases qualify for a £200,000 race next year. This sale is more about individuals than pedigrees and those who already have form in the sale ring include lot 342, a colt from the first crop of Woodborough (USA) (Woodman {USA}) who cost Ir£25,000 at Goffs last November; lot 353--the most-expensive Pivotal (GB) (Polar Falcon {USA}) foal of 1999 at 23,000gns; lot 249, an Alhaarth (Ire) (Unfuwain {USA}) half-brother to four winners offered from Furnace Mill Stud, who cost 20,000gns at Tattersalls last November; and the sole Distant View (USA) (Mr Prospector) on show, lot 374, who was bought for \$40,000 by Knocklong House Stud at Keeneland last fall. Lot 227 is a full-brother to Tagshira (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}), winner of a German G2 at the weekend, while lot 391 is a Prince Sabo (GB) (Young Generation) half-brother to Sampower Star (GB) (Cyrano de Bergerac), who finished second in Saturday's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. The sale continues Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings, with each session beginning at 5:10 p.m.

FASTEST 1000 FOR JOHNSTON

Middleham trainer Mark Johnston became the quickest British trainer to reach the 1000-win mark at Hamilton Park yesterday when Double Honour (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) won the opening part of a double. The Scotsman, who is currently Britain's winningest trainer this year with 108 wins, reached the milestone in only 13 years. He totted up the fastest 100 winners in a season on Aug. 26, giving him his seventh consecutive season of reaching the century.

The G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Irish Derby winner Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge {Ire}) will race in Sunday's G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp, trainer John Oxx confirmed yesterday. "He's very well and the plan is to go to France," said Oxx. "We're very happy with him. He had a little break from fast work but he was cantering every day. He's freshened up well and he's in great form. We've got a couple of other horses in the entries, Takali (Ire) and Raypour (Ire), and they both might go. All going well, the Arc is the plan after that." Having won the Epsom and Curragh Classics on June 10 and July 2, Sinndar has been rested with a campaign towards the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien-Barriere Longchamp Oct. 1 in mind. He is 9-2 second favourite for the Arc with William Hill, behind the 6-4 on favourite Montjeu (Ire), while Samum (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), impressive winner of Sunday's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, is 8-1.
