FRONT ROW SEAT

It took three years, but Orchestra Stall (GB) (Old Vic {GB}) added a second G3 Prix Gladiateur win to his 1997 trophy yesterday at Longchamp. After a 2 1/2year absence, the veteran runner returned to the races with a sixth-place effort in the G3 John Porter S. at Haydock Apr. 22 and he regained his winning form with a brave performance in the G3 Sagaro S. at Ascot May 3. Paying ample compliment to the training skills of John Dunlop, Orchestra Stall justified the faith of connections to keep him in training and recorded his second pattern win of the year with another battling performance. He was settled in fourth as Vellano (Ire) (Lycius) led from Wajina (GB) (Rainbow Quest) and Tajoun (Fr) (General Holme), but made his bid at the top of the home run. As Vellano faded soon after turning into the straight, Tajoun took the lead at the two-furlong marker, but jockey Thierry Thulliez asked Orchestra Stall to pounce immediately. The response was positive and Orchestra Stall led at the distance and ran on with enthusiasm to secure the win in good style. The judge was called upon to unravel the three-way photo for second with Wajina gaining the verdict ahead of Tajoun and Le Tintoret (Fr) (Goldneyev).

#### EIGHT CARAT DEAD

Australasia's undisputed broodmare queen Eight Carat (GB) (\*Pieces of Eight II) was humanely destroyed Tuesday afternoon at Sir Patrick Hogan's Cambridge Stud in New Zealand after suffering a heart attack. She was 26. The dam of five individual Group 1 winners, including Australasia's highest stakes earner Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), was purchased by Sir Patrick from Robert Sangster's Swettenham Stud in 1991. Triple Group 1 winner Mouawad (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) followed Group 1 winners Kaapstad (NZ) (Sir Tristram {Ire}), Marquise (NZ) (Gold And Ivory), 10-time Group1 winner Octagonal and Diamond Lover (Aus) (Sticks and Stones). "She gave her progeny a fantastic temperament and remarkable speed; they had the ability to switch up gears even in staying races. She gave them a sensational turn of foot even though they were able to win Derbies," Hogan reflected. "She was an amazing mare. She never worried or bothered her foals. She mothered them well but in the paddock if they wanted to wander off and be inquisitive she would let them and keep an eye on them. If she thought they were in trouble she would wander over, not run--she taught them independence. It was a marvelous thing." Eight Carat, crowned World Champion Broodmare by USA Owner Breeder Magazine in 1996, was pensioned three years ago.

Their pedigrees suggest that they might not stretch out to classic distances, but Yonaguska and City Zip are certainly beginning to forge a classic rivalry. Coming into Saturday's GI Hopeful S., Yonaguska had won two of his three starts, his only defeat coming at the heels of City Zip in the GII Sanford S. City Zip meanwhile had won three in a row--the GIII Tremont S., GII Sanford S. and GII Saratoga Special S .-- since finishing third to Yonaguska in the Flash S. The GI Hopeful S. might have served as a perfect decider, but instead ended with honors even, the pair dead-heating for first, a neck in front of the hugely promising Macho Uno (Holy Bull--Primal Force, by Blushing Groom (Fr)).


Yonaguska was a \$145,000 yearling and a \$1,950,000 two-year-old purchase. City Zip, a \$9,000 Keeneland January yearling, didn't make his \$100,000 reserve at two, but despite the different price tags, the pair have some marked pedigree similarities.

Yonaguska is by a grandson of Blushing Groom out of a mare by a son of Mr. Prospector, and among the names in the distaff side of his pedigree are Tom Fool and The Axe II. City Zip's sire, Carson City, is by Mr. Prospector out of a mare by Blushing Groom, and also has Tom Fool and The Axe II in the distaff side of the pedigree (incidentally, Blushing Groom, Mr. Prospector and The Axe II are all also found in the pedigree of the Hopeful third, Macho Uno).

#### A PERFECT ENDING

The final race at Saratoga 2000 saw PERFECT STING improve to a perfect 4-for-4 this season in the \$500,000 Diana Handicap (G2)

Yonaguska comes from the second crop of champion sprinter Cherokee Run (his first included champion two-year-old filly Chilukki). His dam is by the Mr. Prospector stallion Silver Ghost, and is a half sister to Grade I winner Prenup and graded stakes winner Honor the Hero. The Blushing Groom/Mr. Prospector cross which this mating represents has produced four other Grade I winners, but overall has not been a prolifically successful one. Still, there are a number of other interesting things happening in Yonaguska's pedigree. To start with, his grandsire Blushing Groom is by Red God, who in turn is out of the mare Spring Run. Yonaguska is linebred to Tom Fool, a three-parts genetic relative to Spring Run. With regard to Blushing Groom, it is probably also significant that Yonaguska's granddam is inbred to Swaps, whose sire \*Khaled is a close relative to Blushing Groom's granddam. We can also note that Yonaguska's dam has three crosses of La Troienne, via the sisters Big Event and Businesslike and through Bimlette (by La Troienne's son, Bimelech, and bred on a reverse cross to Big Event and Businesslike). Cherokee Run is also linebred to La Troienne through Bimelech and Big Event.

City Zip's sire Carson City is becoming one of the most reliable speed sires around. He is bred on a Mr. Prospector/Blushing Groom cross (the reverse of Yonaguska) and along with the sisters Queena and Chic Shirine is one of the best representatives of that nick. City Zip also has the Spring Run/Tom Fool combination, and via Nijinsky II (sire of Carson City's second dam) also has Flaming Page, who like Spring Run and Tom Fool has a combination of Menow and Bull Dog. Out of a mare by the up-and-coming broodmare sire Relaunch, City Zip has a third dam by \*Hawaii, a horse with some complex and very useful links to the pedigree of Blushing Groom.

#### **PEDIGREE SHORTS**

The result of the Jersey Jumper S. might be one for our Australian friends to note. The winner was Dark Ending (f, 2, End Sweep--Dark Champagne, by Hooched). She is by End Sweep, who now shuttles between Arrowfield Stud in Australia and Shadai Farm in Japan. Through the success of Danehill, the Danzig line has become extremely prolific in Australia. End Sweep, who is by Forty Niner (sire of Ecton Park and Distorted Humor out of Danzig mares) has looked a potentially good foil for Danzig mares, but the cross-which would have had limited opportunities to date-hadn't actually earned black-type until the stakes win for Dark Ending, who is out of a mare by a son of Danzig. Incidentally, Dark Ending's pedigree also has a clever twist since the dams of Forty Niner and Hooched (broodmare sire of Dark Ending) are both by Tom Rolfe out of mares by Double Jay, giving Dark Ending three-parts relatives 3x3.

The Miller Genuine Draft Cradle S. revealed a promising staying juvenile in the shape of Mongoose (c, 2, Broad Brush--Salty Gal, by Cox's Ridge). Mongoose is one of at least four stakes winners by Broad Brush out of mares by Cox's Ridge. This is interesting, since Broad Brush is inbred 3x3 to daughters of \*Turn-To (grandsire of Cox's Ridge) and out of a mare by Tom Rolfe (a horse who has combined well with Cox's Ridge). In this case Mongoose not only has Turn-To 4x4x4, but also Tom Rolfe 4x4, since his granddam is by Salt Marsh, a son of Tom Rolfe.

The Torrey Pines S. at Del Mar was captured by Saudi Poetry (f, 3, Storm Cat--Gone to Venus, by Gone West), who represents a breeding pattern we are probably going to see a lot more of in the future. Both her sire and her broodmare sire are out of mares by Secretariat, giving her Secretariat 3x4 as broodmare sire of the sire and broodmare sire. Given that, in addition to Storm Cat and Gone West, stallions out of Secretariat mares also include such as A.P. Indy, Summer Squall, Dehere and Chief's Crown, to name but a few, this looks to be a duplication with a tremendous number of possibilities.

There are two methods of inbreeding to Mr. Prospector which particularly appear to pay dividends at the moment. One is through Fappiano and other strains, and the other appears to be through sons and daughters. Of the sources of daughter strains, we can particularly note Silver Deputy (dam by Mr. Prospector), who is not only sire of a couple of stakes winners out of Mr. Prospector-line mares, but who is now also broodmare sire of El Corredor (c, 3, Mr. Greeley.-Silvery Swan, by Silver Deputy), winner of Sunday's Gll Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. He is by Mr. Prospector's grandson, Mr. Greeley, and has Mr. Prospector 3x4.

IMPEACHMENT INJURED Dogwood Stable's Impeachment (Deputy Minister--Misconduct, by Criminal Type) suffered a tendon tear and his future racing career is in serious doubt. The three-year-old colt is the only horse to have competed in all three Triple Crown races this year. He ran third in both the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness and fifth in the Belmont. In his most recent start, Impeachment ran fifth in the Aug. 26 Gl Travers S. "An ultrasound examination has revealed a fairly significant tear," explained Dogwood Stable president Cot Campbell. "We are shipping him from Saratoga to Dr. Robert Copelan in Lexington for evaluation, but his future as a racehorse at this point seems unpromising." Impeachment won one of 11 starts, finishing on the board in four others and earning \$350,450.

#### DONCASTER SALE OFF TO POSITIVE START

Doncaster's St Leger Yearling Sale began in great style yesterday with the average up 11 percent on last year. The top-price of 36,000gns was paid for a Primo Dominie (GB) filly offered by her breeder John Ford from Manor House Farm Stud. The filly's half-sister Boomerang Blade (GB) (Sure Blade {USA}) won the £200,000 race for graduates of this sale two years ago and not surprisingly her younger sibling is on course for that race. "The aim will be to win the race again although this filly is completely different from Boomerang Blade, who is a compact bay, while this is a big chesnut who takes after her mother," said Ford, who signed for the filly and will retain a share with the remainder being bought for Peter Skinner. The sale started on a high when the first lot, a colt by Mind Games (GB) was bought by agent Sam Bullard for 25,000gns. He will be ioining his Cool Jazz (GB) half-brother That's Jazz (GB) at Michael Bell's Newmarket stable. Mind Games also unexpectedly had the last lot offered after lot 126. his colt from Penmaric Stud re-appeared having earlier been led out unsold at 24,000gns. He was bought by Lambourn trainer David Arbuthnot for 30,000gns on his second visit to the ring. "I liked him a lot and he is by a sire who has done very well and you need a six-furlong horse for the race," said Arbuthnot. Tim Easterby, who had a first G1 success on Saturday with Pipalong (Ire) in the Haydock Sprint Cup, was busy re-stocking with his list headed by a So Factual (USA) colt offered from Britton House Stud who cost 26,000gns. #### **WEEKEND TO CLEAR UP ARC PICTURE**

The coming weekend sees the European racing landscape dotted with prep races for the Oct. 1 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. With the immediate destiny of Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) in doubt, options are certainly not short for his vital preparatory run. If he goes to Ireland for Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown, he could face up to 12 rivals. Should he miss the race, Giant's Causeway (USA) (Storm Cat {USA}) looks set to take his place in his bid for a fifth consecutive Group 1 success in three months. "Giant's Causeway is a possible at this stage. We will be watching the Montjeu situation," trainer Aidan O'Brien said. "If Giant's Causeway runs then I'll run something else. I cantered him yesterday and again today, and will canter him all week but you can't undo the fact he had last week off." One of those set to take either one of these on is Godolphin's Best Of The Bests (Ire) (Machiavellian {USA}), impressive winner of the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville Aug. 15. He was supplemented yesterday to the Champion S. at a cost of Ir£78,000. Sumitas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) looks set to become Germany's first representative in Ireland, as the runner-up to Dubai Millennium in the G1 Prince Of Wales' S. Royal Ascot June 21 was confirmed a likely runner by trainer Peter Schiergen. Indian Danehill (Ire) (Danehill {USA}), winner of the G1 Prix Ganay Longchamp Apr. 30, is cross entered for the Irish race as well as Sunday's G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp, one of the three 'Arc trials' there on Sunday. The G2 Prix Niel on the same card is the target of G1 Epsom and Irish Derby winner Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge {USA}) and he may have G2 Prix Noailles winner Kutub (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), and G2 Prix Eugene Adam winner Sobieski (Ire) (Polish Precedent {USA}) to deal with there. The G1 Prix Vermeille, the highlight of the afternoon, may witness a fascinating dual of Oaks winners, as G1 Epsom Derby winner Love Divine (GB) (Diesis {GB}) and G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) winner Egyptband (USA) (Dixieland Band {USA}) could lock horns. The latter is one of three notable entries from Criquette Head, alongside G2 Prix de Malleret winner America (Ire) (Arazi {USA}), and G3 Prix de Royaumont winner Sadler's Flag (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}). Godolphin looks set to be represented in the race by G1 Epsom Oaks third, and G1 Irish Oaks runner-up Melikah (Ire) (Lammtarra {USA}).

"You can only gauge champion stallions by Group 1 winners and Sadler's Wells is in illustrious company now; it emphasises the enormity of what Sir Tristram achieved. It is a pretty difficult club to join," he said

Springsteen (Aus) (Danehill {USA}) has been purchased for "a seven-figure sum" by Queensland studmaster Greg Kelly of Royston Stud, the Australian newspaper reported. Springsteen, a \$500,000 yearling half-brother to Golden Slipper winner and successful sire Marauding (NZ) will continue racing for Peter Hayes until next spring when he will go to stud. "He's now back in work with the Australian Guineas next year his first autumn mission," Kelly told the Australia. "It is a bit of a risk paying such big money, but if he can get a Group 1 then he'll be cheap. Sons of Danehill are really firing, and remember. Danehill and Marauding stock have won six of the last eight Golden Slippers."
