GOLD CUP CHALLENGE

A field of nine has been entered for Sunday's renewal of the \$1 million GI Sempra Energy Hollywood Gold Cup at Hollywood Park. Morning-line favorite General Challenge (General Meeting) will break from post position seven. The four-year-old gelding jumped to the head of the class with a 1 1/4-length victory in the Mar. 4 GI Santa Anita H., but crashed back to earth with a dull third-place effort in the Apr. 9 GII San Bernadino H. He hasn't raced since, while recovering from surgery for an entrapped epiglottis. The Bob Baffert trainee has the confidence of jockey Corey Nakatani who calls General Challenge, "as good a horse as I've ever ridden." Out of Mind (Brz) (Sestero {Brz}), juvenile champion in his native Brazil, won the GII Mervyn Leroy H. over this track in May before running second to Running Stag in the June 3 GII Massachusetts H. in his last trip to the post. The five-year-old bay will break from post nine in his attempt to earn a first Grade I victory. The Irish-bred Blueprint (Ire) (Generous {Ire}) will be making his American debut Sunday. The five-year-old, off since winning the May 5 G2 Sagitta Jockey Club S. at Newmarket, will break from post four in his first race on the dirt. Both Out of Mind and Blueprint have been supplemented to the race for \$25,000. The last supplemental entrant to win the Gold Cup was Sultry Song in 1992. Juddmonte Farm's Chester House (Mr. Prospector), fourth in last year's Breeders' Cup Classic, blew out a half mile vesterday at Hollywood in :48 4/5. After the move, trainer Bobby Frankel commented, "I think he's going to run really well in this race." Post time for the race, which is the fourth of five in the "NTRA Champions on FOX" Super Series, is 2:40 p.m.

CHIEF SEATTLE INJURED

Godolphin's **Chief Seattle** (Seattle Slew) suffered a knee injury that will force the colt to miss Sunday's GII Dwyer S. and could jeopardize his future racing career, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The three-year-old, runner-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Champagne S., was purchased by Godolphin in February and has yet to run for the Dubai-based stable. Chief Seattle returned lame from a Sunday work at Belmont Park. X-rays revealed no fracture, but there is cartilage damage. Godolphin assistant trainer Tom Albertrani told the *Form*, "We're still trying to decide if he's going to be a racehorse or if he's going to be retired. At this point, we're not sure."

EL GRAN SENOR PENSIONED

Champion and leading sire El Gran Senor (Northern Dancer--Sex Appeal, by Buckpasser) has been retired from the breeding shed due to continued fertility problems. The 19-year-old will spend the rest of his days at Ashford Stud, where he has stood since beginning his stud career in 1985. Bred in Maryland by a partnership including E. P. Taylor, Vincent O'Brien, John Magnier and Robert Sangster, El Gran Senor was a champion at two and three in both England and Ireland and captured seven of eight lifetime starts, his only loss coming by a nose to Secreto in the 1981 Epsom Derby. From his limited books, he has sired 47 stakes winners and seven champions to date, including champion sprinter Lit de Justice, a freshman sire this season; and dual Guineas winner Rodrigo de Triano, Currently, he is represented by Spanish Fern, winner of the 1999 GI Yellow Ribbon S. and the GII Santa Ana H. this season, and The Seven Seas, heroine of the GIII Bewitch H. at Keeneland in April. As a broodmare sire, his daughters have already produced Grade I winners Grand Slam, Honest Lady, Popular Bluff and Vicar.

Beat Hollow (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), as well as Ela Athena (GB) (Ezzoud {Ire}) and Gracioso (USA) (Nureyev {USA}), were withdrawn from Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown yesterday, leaving eight horses to stand their ground. Sakhee, runner-up in the G1 Epsom Derby and currently available at 9-4, has been deposed as the favourite by Henry Cecil's Shiva, who has been backed down to 2-1 with the sponsors as rain eased the ground at the course to the soft side of good, which favors the Japanese-bred runner. Michael Kinane is still hoping that he will be fit to ride G1 St James' Palace S. winner Giant's Causeway, currently available at 7-1 with the firm. Kinane said yesterday, "I am hoping, but I will have to pass the doctor on Friday if I am going to do it." Australian Damien Oliver might step in for the ride should Kinane be unavailable.
